# EDITORIAL

## We get underway & it's great to be back

Well done one and all – we got Round 1 away.

After the longest pre-season on record, we finally got VAFA footy back last weekend and a huge congratulations and thank you to the entire community for all of your efforts.

Firstly, we put our hand up and own the fact that umpire allocations and communication with clubs was not where it needed to be last weekend. While we all experienced a crazy run into Round 1 with shortened weeks before and after Easter, we definitely can do better to support our clubs.

By way of explanation, our umpire numbers were down due to the school holidays which stretched already scarce umpire resources, and the shortened week meant umpire appointments were somewhat delayed. That delay impacted our communication to clubs which in turn added to the already burgeoning workload of our club volunteers – not ideal, certainly not planned and we do apologise.

There are further complexities related to the appointment of umpires across all levels of our men's and women's competition. A matter which has been thoroughly reviewed ahead of this weekend's matches across the competition and which will be addressed as a matter of priority across the next month.

What we assure the VAFA community is that our communication to clubs will be far timelier and the equity of appointments will remain a focus.

As we settle into the season proper it is opportune to further advise of a couple of important initiatives in place for this season.

The VAFA Alcohol Policy has been reviewed and revised allowing for (2) major shifts (refer VAFA website for the full policy)

1. Club matchday functions can now operate from midday until the end of half-time, in addition clubs can make application for (2) extended functions which will allow for functions to run beyond half-time of the main game.

2. Clubs can also now provide the opportunity for reserve grade players to enjoy an aftermarket function with the opposing team in their social rooms

Let's be really clear on the above changes and shift of policy conditions, the VAFA is not encouraging drinking in the outer or around grounds at VAFA matches, what we are doing is providing the opportunity to enjoy luncheons, functions and aftermatches within an extended timeframe and in a controlled environment - in the main to keep our communities together.

Concussion has been a hot topic in recent times, and rightly so. The revised VAFA Concussion Policy is available on the VAFA website and is an updated version from the National Community policy which has been in place since 2017.

The VAFA have also teamed up with Monash University to support concussion research at community level.

Obviously, the main focus is around the time required for players to spend time out of the game should they experience a concussion or related symptoms – namely (12) days, with the focus being on players to seek expert medical opinion in relation to the diagnosis and assessment of the injury.

Clubs have also been advised to keep thorough records of concussions within their club. This will enable the VAFA to conduct their own assessment of the prevalence of concussions in our game, so as to guide us in player welfare strategies and potential rule changes in the future – all in the interests of player welfare.

The VAFA have also teamed up with Monash University to support concussion research at community level. Already a number of our clubs have taken up the opportunity to part of this leading study which aims is to establish exactly how blood tests can be used to take some of the guesswork out of concussion management. We thank the University Blacks FC for initial research into this important area of player welfare.

Plenty of exciting weeks ahead – enjoy Round 2.

# WILLIAM BUCK MEN'S PREMIER PREVIEW

## A late change to the William Buck Premier script

By half-time of the **University Blues** and **Old Brighton** clash on Sunday, you would've been hard-pressed to find any non-heart-and-soul-Tonner who felt the comeback was a realistic chance. As one of the biggest Brighton believers of them all, I really lowered my colours when I left Elsternwick Park at the main break with Brighton 26 points down. The reigning premiers were in control, Sam Grimley and Hugh Goddard were too tall, and the Blues midfielders were far too big. Well, so I thought. After failing to capitalise on the cyclonic conditions in the first term, the Tonners turned it around in the third term with eight unanswered goals, including four within a seven-minute stretch. Finn Campigli kicked two of his three goals while the other six were shared. Harry Hill and Nick Pavlou picked up where they left off in 2019 and put in dominant displays for the Tonners, while Lachlan Filipovic wrestled back the momentum against Ayce Cordy as the match progressed. Despite the loss, the Blues will be buoyed by Grimley and Goddard. It wasn't a day for the high-marking forwards, but those two were almost unstoppable in the first half. I'm not sure whether I'm excited or slightly concerned for the opposition when that pair and the two-time Woodrow Medallist are in full flight at the same time.

Taking it back one day and **Old Melburnians** lived up to the hype surrounding their finals chances in 2021 with a comprehensive 54-point victory over **Caulfield Grammarians**. With Gus Borthwick, Tom Paule and Andrew Tashevski-Beckwith offering their usual bullish behaviour in the midfield, their off-season acquisitions of the Haysmans (Ben and Lachie) and the Nichols (Ned and Will) allowed for run, dash, and quality ball movement on the outside – something new senior coach Paul Satterley would have loved witnessing in the heat of battle. Sam Dunell was a class above, as was Josh Freezer down back, but it was James Regan – who was playing just his second senior game – who impressed up forward with three goals. Regan kicked 58 goals in Premier Reserve two years ago but has forced his way into the senior side through weight of goal kicking numbers in the practice matches. It was Caulfield's first shot at William Buck Premier since 2012 and there were myriad positives for Simon Williams and his men to take from the game – namely, the standout performances of Isaac Morrisby and defender Nathan Peterson. Julian Debosz's 65m set shot goal would have also got the blood pumping – not just in the commentary box.

One man rarely wins a game off his own boot, but in the case of **Old Xav's** Rohan Bewick against **St Bernard's** on

Saturday, we can make an exception. The former Brisbane Lion opened his goal kicking account at the eight-minute mark of the first term and went on to boot another four throughout the quarter before finishing the day with a bag of 10. This allowed Xavs to lead all day, but it was heartening to see the Snow Dogs fight back with 11 goals to nine after quarter time. From their end, Marcus Holland kicked six of their 11 in a one-forward show. Will Hams and Dan Robinson found themselves in the best for Xavs and with Ryan Schoenmakers successfully debuting as a swingman, the ceiling looks as high as it's been since 2016.

It certainly wasn't a one-man display like #RoBew, but **St Kevin's OB** supporters would be ecstatic with the debut of Tom Boyd in their 30-point win over **Collegians** at TH King. Boyd kicked four goals throughout the day, with the last of those sealing the victory in the final term. Conor Ross, who has added serious size to his frame, was a standout alongside Josh Wallis, while Nick Wood starred in his role across half forward and slotted two goals. The Lions, who were without their captain Sam Hibbins, continued to apply pressure all day with Viv Michie leading the charge. On debut, Josh Prudden and David Mirra proved they're going to be a handful for opposition teams.

**Old Scotch** didn't look like losing in their return to William Buck Premier as they ran out 66-point winners over **Old Trinity** to secure top spot after Round 1. Despite missing GT Moore Medallist and ruck star, Tom Downie, the Cardinals kicked away to a 32-point half-time lead and progressively built on it with four goals in each of the final two terms. In just his second senior match since 2018, Sam Dawborn kicked two and was named best afield for Scotch, while former Big V U19's player Max Martin booted a game-high three goals. After playing just three games in 2019 due to injury, Seb Nicolosi returned for the T's while former East Brighton FC player Hugo McGlashan made a successful debut as one of the T's best.

## AJAX arrive as De La survive to kick off Prem B in 2021

The Jackas have launched onto the Premier B scene with a convincing victory over Old Carey, marking their first victory in the competitions second rung since June 23<sup>rd</sup> 2018. De La Salle also returned to Premier B and surged past an improved Old Haileyburians in a classic at Waverley Oval, while the Sharks, Tigers and Uni Blacks all claimed large victories to kickstart their year.

Despite trailing by a solitary point entering the fourth, **AJAX** used a strong breeze to surge past **Old Carey** in the final frame to stamp their name back into Premier B with a 16-point victory at Carey Sports Complex. In a game of runs that went back and forth all afternoon, it was the Jackas who came out on top thanks to three majors apiece to Brandon Joel and Nick Cohen, with the latter named best afield. The Panthers were led by Harrison Bean who also bagged three goals while Ben Jepson was named his sides best. **AJAX** will now welcome a tough Beaumaris outfit to Gary Smorgon Oval while Carey will be eager to nab win number one against Old Haileyburians.

In the match of the round, a blustery Waverley Oval was the site for **De La Salle** to claim their first victory in Premier B since 2005, running out slim four-point victors over **Old Haileyburians**. Ryan O'Meara and Geordie Nagle led the Dees while Matt Colak and Nick Bufalo kicked two apiece to keep the pesky Bloods at bay. The new look Haileybury held a strong 15-point half-time lead in this one and looked well on their way to a shock Round 1 victory but were ultimately overrun. Durras Seccull bagged four while brother Brede Seccull was named his side's best. The Dees now will travel across town for a matchup with Williamstown CYMS while Old Haileybury will face another former William Buck Premier opponent in Old Carey, eager to claim victory number one.

Suffering their first defeat in just under 950 days, **Williamstown CYMS** were welcomed into Premier B and downed by 65 points at the hands of **Beaumaris**. The Sharks used a wave of pressure and the fortress of Banksia Reserve to overwhelm the CY's with 28 scoring shots to eight. Chris Grigoradias continued his strong play from 2019 with four majors while Riley Mihailovic kicked two and was named best afield. Williamstown CYMS were gallant but ultimately outclassed in their first Premier B match in their clubs history, the talent is there but may

need some time to adjust to the competition. William Chan kicked two and while Tom Johnstone and Josh Kellett were named their sides best on the day. The CY's will now square off with De La Salle while Beaumaris will play off against another former Premier C side in **AJAX**.

The unveiling of the new sports complex at Brindisi Street Oval was topped off by **St Bedes/Mentone Tigers** running out convincing 69-point victors over **Parkdale Vultures**. Blustery conditions made accurate kicking an issue but despite this, the Tigers dominated possession with 32-scoring shots to 13. Brayden O'Toole (3) and Josh Cowan (2) were the only multiple goal scorers with seven other Tigers getting on the scoreboard. Zac Calvez was named BOG. Ryan Macdermid kicked both of Parkdale's majors while Brad Austin and Ethan Marshall were named the Vultures best as they began their youth movement. Bedes now have the arduous task of facing off with University Blacks at Melbourne Uni Oval while Parkdale return home to square off with Fitzroy.

Our final match for Round 1 saw **University Blacks** commence their 2021 campaign with a strong 40-point victory over **Fitzroy**. The Blacks used a seven goal to two second half to overrun the Roys and leave Brunswick Street Oval with the four points, beginning their quest to return to William Buck Premier on the right foot. Darren Mumford kicked three, Alastair Robbins and Jordan Quaille snagged two apiece while gun recruit James Sansom was named best afield. Tom Wilson and Nino Lazzaro kicked two each for Fitzroy who can take good things away from this clash against arguably the competitions best. Uni Blacks return home for a grudge match against St Bedes/Mentone in what promises to be a classic, while the Roys will look to get on the win column against Parkdale.

## Premier C does not disappoint as Blues run over Bullants

It has been 576 days since we had Premier C footy to look forward to and it did not disappoint.

**Hampton** hosted **Old Ivanhoe** in a match that most would have pictured the Hoers winning with relative ease. With a strong wind, the Rovers jumped Old Ivanhoe with a seven goal to two first quarter. A five goal to one second quarter for the Hoers saw a two-point game entering the second half. After a tight third quarter, the Rovers held Old Ivanhoe goalless in the fourth walking away 28-point winners in an early show of force. Nathan Smith kicked three in a best on ground performance while Daniel Stanford was a force up forward for Old Ivanhoe. The Rovers will look to make it two from two when they play UHS-VU at Brens Oval this week. The start to the year does not get any easier for the Hoers, as they host Old Geelong this week in another massive matchup.

**Old Geelong** will be happy with their 27-point victory over **Mazenod** at Como Park last weekend. The first half was a tight battle, with the Oggars only leading by five points at the major break. However, a four goal to one third quarter was enough for Old Geelong to get the job done in the second half. Captain Scott Dixon dominated, while the Nodders saw a very strong all-around effort from the team with seven individual goal kickers. Mazenod will play Marcellin away in a very tough round two matchup that should show how competitive each team will be this year. The Oggars will play a fiery Old Ivanhoe at Chelworth Park who will look to make up for a disappointing showing against Hampton.

In an interesting game, **Ormond** beat **Old Mentonians** by 56 points at Keysborough Playing Fields. After Darcy Brown, who was instrumental all day for Old Mentone, kicked the first, the Panthers were fired up for the first half. However, they were held back by inaccurate kicking which evidently teams cannot afford to do against a loaded Ormond team. A 34-point lead in the first half was quickly expanded to 50 after the third and Ormond was able to comfortably hang on despite Mentone kicking a few late. While Suckling and Allan were both clearly in the best, it was the other new recruit, Callum Cathcart, who stole the

show booting home eight goals in his Ormond debut. The Panthers new recruit, Lachie Mirams, also impressed in his debut. The Monders will host Preston at E.E. Gunn this Saturday. Old Mentone will look to bounce back against a red-hot Monash who are looking to be early contenders.

**Marcellin** walked away 85-point winners against **UHS-VU** who played their first game in the Premier sections in 44 years. In a wire-to-wire victory, the Eagles never looked like losing as Isaac Nolan dominated kicking seven of his own. Mitchell Jones was a standout for Marcellin, while the Vultures can take positives out of the outstanding game from Todd Cracknell. Marcellin will be favourites as they host Mazenod this week after the Nodders experienced a tough loss to Old Geelong. The Vultures will look to bounce back this week against an impressive Hampton side at Brens Oval – which has been a fortress over the past four years.

Our final matchup saw the **Monash Blues** return to Premier C in red hot form after beating **Preston** by 85 points at W.R. Ruthven Reserve. In a very competitive first half, the Bullants surprised many as they led by two points at half time in their first ever game in the Premier sections. However, a 16 goal to two second half saw Preston overrun in the end by a classy Monash side. The Blues will be ecstatic with 10 individual goal kickers, which featured returning player Sam Le Lievre kicking three in a best on ground performance. Lewis Fotheringham and Jackson Curic (who kicked five goals) impressed for the Bullants who will face a tough Ormond team this week. The Blues will host Old Mentone in a game that is poised to be fast paced and high scoring.

Speaking to The Age's Peter Ryan last year, Payze said he would've found it hard to retire on 399.

"That said, it's a long way at my age I couldn't absolutely guarantee it but certainly my intention would be to keep playing," Payze said.

"You're a long time retired."

Thankfully, Payze decided to continue his career and added another significant milestone to his CV after kicking his 1000<sup>th</sup> goal two years ago.

Payze debuted in 1998, represented the Big V in 2000 and won the Fullerton Medal (Division 2) in 2005.






