## VAFA celebrates Community Umpiring Round

This week the significant contribution and role umpires play in our great game across community football in Victoria will be celebrated at all levels.

Community Umpiring Round is an annual AFL event supported by our state body AFL Victoria and recognises those men and women patrolling the boundary line, manning the goal line, and controlling the action out in the middle.

Coming out of COVID community umpiring numbers statewide have suffered significantly for a variety of reasons, however what can be guaranteed is that every man and woman who walks out in the green uniform each weekend at VAFA grounds, are committed to playing their part to ensure the VAFA continues to be the place to umpire.

The VAFA continues to have wonderful partnerships with the SMJFL and YJFL where we provide both pathway and coaching opportunities for aspiring, young, up-and-coming umpires wanting to develop their skills in Senior and U19 football. The VAFA continues to host the SMJFL umpiring group every Monday night at Elsternwick Park as we look to build and nurture the next generation of umpires.

To celebrate the occasion, the AFL will forgo normal training sessions and travel to community umpiring groups across Victoria. The VAFA had nine of the AFL's top officials across Field, Boundary and Goal facilitate VAFA training this week and talk about their experiences both at community and AFL level. These opportunities are highly valued by community umpiring groups, where members are extended the chance to engage and interact with the game's elite officials.

The VAFA's current representation on the AFL and state league lists is at the highest number in Association history.

## Rumble in the Toorak jungle as Xavs meet Blues

The VAFA Match of the Round on RSN Carnival will cover the heavyweight bout between **Old Xaverians** and **University Blues** at Toorak Park. Xavs will enter the match as slight favourites after they defeated St Kevin's OB by 71 points in a dominant display at TH King Oval. Julian Soccio, who was outstanding one week earlier against Scotch, kicked three goals as did the ever-dangerous Denis Symeopoulos. Marcus Stavrou was BOG and is one of the form midfielders of the competition three rounds in. As for the Blues, the secured their second win against Old Melburnians and it was the usual suspects of Cameron O'Shea, Ayce Cordy and Ben Capra who led from the front. This clash is as mouth-watering as any this year with Ayce vs Holmes, Capra vs Bewick (maybe) and Grimley vs Shoenmakers. Tune into RSN Carnival from 1pm for the Saturday Warm-Up before the MOTR broadcast at 2pm.

**Collegians** will look to maintain their strong Round 3 form when they host **Old Brighton** at Harry Trott Oval. It was a must-win for the Lions on Saturday, and they prevailed over a gallant Old Scotch by 33 points. Josh Watson debuted for the Lions with 25 disposals, nine tackles and three goals to earn himself the Mecwacare Men's Rising Star nomination, while Hugh Johnson (3), Ollie Jackson (2) and Dave Mirra (2) were a constant threat up forward. Old Brighton, who sit second on the ladder, were too strong for Caulfield Grammarians and it was Harry Hill and Nick Pavlou who once again starred through the midfield. The midfield battle of Hill, Pavlou, and Fisher against Michie, Sheridan and Boucher will go a long way to deciding this one, as will Verney vs Mirra if the key Lion spends the game up forward again.

One of either **Old Trinity** or **Caulfield Grammarians** will claim their first win of 2021 when the two meet at the Daley Oval this weekend. The Fields, in particular, have had a tough opening three rounds against Uni Blues, Old Melburnians and Old Brighton. Julian Dobosz had his best outing for the year against the Tonners with three goals, while Angus Cameron found plenty of it. Brett Eddy also

had a season-high two over the weekend, giving the T's key defenders two tallies to worry about. Alex Emery has been in outstanding form for the T's over the past two weeks with his standout performance against OM's in the R2 Friday night clash backed up with a BOG display against the Snow Dogs.

**St Kevin's OB** will be looking to bounce back after a disappointing showing against Old Xavs when they travel to Macqueen Park and take on the **Scotches**. Following their 3.9 (27) over the weekend, they now have the lowest points for of any side, something we can expect the likes of Tom Boyd, Billy Kanakis and Shaun Kennedy to rectify as the key targets up forward. Scotch were impressive for three quarters against the Lions but ran out of steam (and men) with Gene Van Den Broek, Sam Dawborn, Josh Halsall and Matthew Seed failing to see out the game due to injury. They will be seriously buoyed by Will Carrington's effort on Dave Mirra as well as Mack Rivett's dominant first half.

After suffering their first loss of the season to Uni Blues, **Old Melburnians** will hope to get back on the winners list against **St Bernard's** at EP. Ed Nichols would be leading OM's B&F with nearly every vote on offer after another remarkable outing over the weekend that included three goals, while George Hurley-Wellington also continued his hot form. The fourth-placed St Bernard's, who sit above both Uni Blues and SKOB, continue to impress despite the youthful age of their playing group. They ran out 50-point winners over Old Trinity and it was Darren Colaco who starred with five goals. Jarrod Walters, 22, and Ben Overman, 20, were the Bernie's best.

## Young Jacka shines on debut

As the bugles rang aloud and a sea of poppies appeared across local grounds all over the city, the wider football community paused to remember and commemorate the ultimate sacrifice the ANZACs paid that allowed us to play and enjoy this great game, an incredibly important and emotional weekend for all. On the football side, the Uni Blacks and Beaumaris kept their records unblemished, setting up a captivating top-of-the-table clash this weekend. Haileybury continued their hot start to the year with another comprehensive win, while AJAX and Carey secured thrilling single-digit victories to cap off a fantastic weekend of footy in Premier B.

In a weekend that saw **Old Carey** pay tribute to their 2010 Premier B Premiership side, the Panthers ensured their first win on the year with a thrilling three-point finish over **Williamstown CYMS**. In what ended as a wet-weather classic at Carey Sports, the Panthers outlasted their opponents in the low-scoring affair with Tom and Ben Jepsen playing pivotal roles in the midfield and down back respectively. Veteran Ryan Joy kicked three of the CY's eight while big man Sam Callard was named their best. Carey will now look to make two on the trot as they head Gerry Green for a matchup with Parkdale while the Seagulls face the Tigers with both sides eager to get back on the winners list.

Despite being just 16-years of age and running out in the senior side for the first time, the bright lights proved no issue for youngster Harry Sheezel as he bagged four majors to help push **AJAX** over the line in a six-point thriller over **Fitzroy**. Despite wayward kicking from the Jackas, Sheezel and young gun Noah Webb helped elevate their side down the stretch and ultimately grab the four-points in an impressive away win. Rory Patterson kicked three and was named Fitzroy's best in a disappointing result that feels like one that got away. AJAX will now welcome a tough Haileybury outfit to Gary Smorgon Oval in a top-4 clash while the Roys square up with De La, eager to right some wrongs.

Continuing their incendiary start to 2021, **Old Haileyburians** proved once more that they will feature prominently come seasons end as they travelled to Brindisi Street Oval and took apart **St Bedes/Mentone Tigers** by 28-points. Samuel Loewe once again starred up-forward for the Bloods with another four majors, being judged best afield in the process, while Durras Seccull also popped up for another three goals. James Mangoni made it 10 straight kicks from the last fortnight with another impressive four-goal display for the

Tigers while veteran Michael Barnes stood tall as usual for his side. As we look ahead to Round 4, the Bloods face off with **AJAX** in what promises to be fantastic clash, while Bedes travel across town to match-up the CYs.

Paying tribute to their skipper Jordan Quaile in his 100<sup>th</sup> game, the **University Blacks** used the wet and wild weather in the second half to hold off **De La Salle** and run out convincing 45-point victors at Waverley Oval. Despite the weather turning the ball into a bar of soap (and eventually making it go flat), the Blackers still managed to bag 14-majors from their 21-scoring shots, with Daniel McCullough kicking four and Alastair Robbins having three. Captain Jordan Quaile was named his sides best in his hundredth game for the club. Michael Griechen and Hugh Nicholson had two apiece for De La while recruit Darren Minchington was named his sides best. Our match of the round for this weekend will see the Blackers welcome Beaumaris to Melbourne Uni Oval for a mouth-watering top-of-the-table clash while De La head to Brunswick Street Oval to face Fitzroy in a contest both sides need to win to keep tabs with the top of the table.

Our final clash for Round 3 saw **Beaumaris** take care of business and run out 123-point winners over **Parkdale Vultures**. In an extremely long and hapless afternoon for the young Vultures line-up, the Sharks led from siren-to-siren with Chris Grigoriadis having himself an afternoon with a bag of six, while five other Sharks kicked multiple in the percentage and confidence boosting win. Lewis Diggins and Josh Ward were named Beaumaris' best. Ryan MacDermid and Sam Hart were the lone goal scorers for Parkdale as they were outmatched and outclassed at one of the toughest places to play in the competition. The Sharks now face-off with the Uni Blacks in our match of the round at Uni Oval while the Vultures quest for their first win now comes against Old Carey.

## Hoers run down Nodders, OGs hold off Bullants

**Old Ivanhoe** grabbed a much needed first win as they ran over **Mazenod** by 49 points. After holding the Nodders to two goals in the first half, the Hoers were able to use the great game of Max Jones, and three goals from Richard Skok (five goals in the last two games) and Luke Velluto (seven goals on the season) to ease to victory. The Nodders will be disappointed they could not back up their terrific win against Marcellin in round two, but they will be encouraged by the performance of Damian Byrne who has been in terrific form and was once again Mazenod's best on the weekend. Mazenod will look to end Monash's undefeated run this week at Monash University. Old Ivanhoe will be back home to take on a Marcellin team that will be hungry for a win after two disappointing losses.

In what most pundits pictured as a potential blow-out in the making, **Old Geelong** just held out **Preston** to win by 27 points at Como Park. The Bullants put up a terrific fight all day, and were only seven points down entering the final break. However, they failed to score in the last quarter as the Oggars defence showed their strength which has been so reliable all season (Old Geelong have conceded the second least number of points through the first three rounds). William Sloss continued his terrific start to the season in a best-on-ground performance while Joseph Kemp kicked three. Jackson Curic continued his stellar form up forward for the Bullants as he kicked two more bringing his season total to nine after the first three rounds. Preston will play Old Mentonians in a must win matchup to keep their season alive. Old Geelong will face UHS-VU as they look to keep their undefeated streak going.

**Old Mentonians** got their first win on the board as they beat **UHS-VU** by 44 points at Keysborough Playing Fields. While the Panthers continued their trend of inaccurate kicking (25.35 on the season), they put on a dominant display which included holding the Vultures scoreless in the third. Josh Gorman was best-on-ground while Darcy Brown continued his excellent start to season. UHS-VU will be disappointed as they drop to 0-3, but will be encouraged as they won the last quarter in a tough day. The Vultures will have their next opportunity to get on the board against Old Geelong in which looks to be a tough ask going on the Oggars form. Old Mentone will look to make in two on the trot as they face a feisty Preston team who looks for their first win.

In a tale of two halves, **Ormond** defeated **Marcellin** by 21 points at Marcellin College. The Eagles got off to a very hot start as Ormond got used to seeing Daniel Cullinan hit it down to Jordan Perry who would kick it on the spot to a red-hot Steven Fitzgerald (who kicked four in the first half) resulting in Marcellin holding at 27-point lead at the main break. However, it was the Monders who took control of the third quarter kicking six goals to one (including two monster back-to-back bombs from Blake Picone) leading to Ormond holding a narrow two-point lead at 3QT. Harrison Burt and Steve Tolongs (who kicked five on the day and was best-on-ground) took over the fourth with the help of returning captain Tom Buckley to run away kicking three goals to none in the final quarter. The Monders will face Hampton in the match of the round at E.E. Gunn Reserve. Marcellin, who will feel they should have won the last two games they narrowly lost, will look to get back on track as they travel to face Old Ivanhoe.

In what was the clear match of the round, **Monash** just outlasted **Hampton** by 4 points at Boss James Reserve. The game started in a very contested way which did not allow either team to take control as Monash led by 1 point after the first. The next two quarters were just as tight as Monash still led by a singular point at 3QT. As the rain started to pour, in the end, it was the experience of Nicholas Argento, who was best-on-ground kicking two goals off the wing, and another dominant display from ruckman MacGregor Cameron (who is putting together an early case for the LS Zachariah Medal) that led the Blues home. Hampton, despite the tough loss, will take plenty of positives out of the great play from Sam Seach and Eren Soylemez (four goals) who played their first games for the season. Hampton will have another crack at an early season favourite in Ormond as the Rovers look to show the league they are the real deal. Monash will look to stay unbeaten as they face Mazenod at home.

## Anzac Day Ceremonies

VAVA clubs lined up in unison across the weekend and honoured the Anzac Day weekend. 




