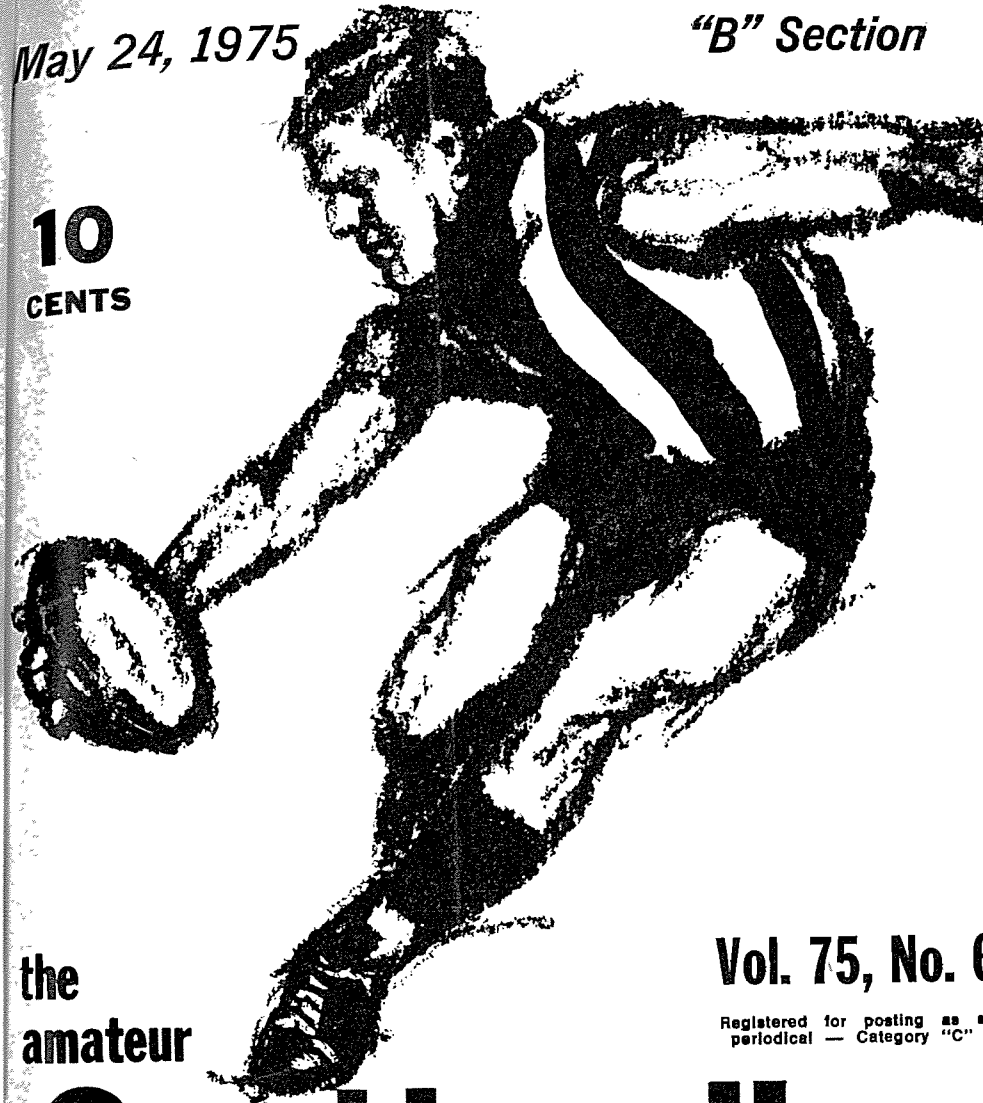

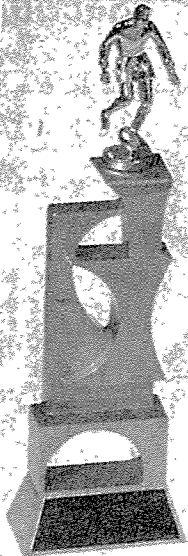

ST. BERNARD'S FINISH ON TO BEAT ORMOND NOW SHARE TOP PLACE WITH BLACKS

North O.B. sneak into Four — Monash out

St. Bernard's strong finish against Ormond enabled them to score a 17-point win and join University Blacks at the top of the premiership list. The Blacks are just ahead on percentage.

North Old Boys were too strong for Old Paradians in a game marred by inaccurate shooting for goal, and sneaked into fourth place, knocking Monash Blues down to fifth.

Two rounds previously, Monash were alone at the top of the ladder but defeats by University Blacks and Old Paradians have sent them tumbling out of the four.

The two teams relegated to B Section this season head the list there — University Blues are unbeaten and Caulfield Grammarians are six points behind them.

Ormond led St. Bernard's by 5 points at half-time, but St. Bernard's kicked on in the second half and Ormond couldn't bridge the gap in the last term.

The game was of high standard and was very even throughout.

Reservoir Old Boys kicked 8 goals in the second quarter to race to a 26-point lead over Old Trinity, and although Trinity added 7 goals in the third term they still trailed by 7 points.

Trinity fought the game right out but Reservoir, with the wind in the last quarter, finished 14 points in front in a high-scoring game.

Reservoir's short-passing and handball were features of their play.

North Old Boys carried too many guns for Old Paradians and led right through to win by more than 6 goals.

Coburg were much too strong for Geelong and won by nearly 11 goals.

Old Haileybury gave Ivanhoe a fright and ran them to 9 points, but Ivanhoe had nine more scoring shots, winning 16-15 to 16-6.

Unbeaten University Blues had a

close call against De La Salle, scraping home by 7 points, and Kew beat Marcellin by 22 points.

Collegians finished too strongly for Old Scotch and ran out winners by 28 points. Scotch trailed badly in the first half but put on 4 goals in the third quarter and looked like winning it when they got to within a goal early in the last term.

But they tired towards the finish and Collegians went away to score comfortably.

Caulfield Grammar stopped Old Carrey's run with a jolt, winning by 10 goals.

Melbourne High beat Parkside in a high-scoring encounter and Old Brighton surprised Alphington to win by 15 points. Power House beat Brunswick by 13 points, Old Ivanhoe easily accounted for Uni. High and undefeated St. Kilda CBC were not troubled by Old Melburnians.

Fawkner and Assumption had a great battle before Fawkner got home by 5 points and State Savings Bank suffered their first defeat for the season, going down to Old Xaverians by a point.

But Bank's inaccuracy caused their downfall, as they had 9 more scoring shots, kicking 14-17 to Xavier's 16-6.

Commonwealth Bank opened their winning account at the expense of National Bank while St. Kevin's and Old Camberwell were well beaten by Old Geelong and Hampton Rovers respectively.

There were no surprises in E Section, where Elsternwick's more accurate kicking gave them a 34-point win over North Brunswick.

AJAX and AMP Society had big wins over Old Mentonians and St. Bede's respectively and St. Pat's-Monivae comfortably beat West Brunswick. In the other game, ANZ Bank scored easily from LaTrobe Blacks.

Monash Whites beat Heatherton by 4 goals with one fewer scoring shot. It was Heatherton's first defeat. Bulleen United had nearly 6 goals to spare over Glenroy, Thornbury easily beat University Reds, and LaTrobe Reds were no match for Bulleen-Templestowe.

In the Junior Sections, Coburg handed out a big defeat to Ormond, and Parkside beat Ivanhoe by 23 points. University Blacks scraped home by 2 points from Old Scotch but the Blues were not troubled by Power House.

In Section 2, Reservoir Old Boys suffered their first defeat, going down to Hampton Rovers by more than 6 goals. North Old Boys also had their first loss, their conquerors being Old Carey, to the tune of 5 goals.

Old Paradians beat Geelong by only 8 points but St. Bernard's kicked the huge score of 35-29 (239 points) against Caulfield Grammar.

UMPIRE'S CORNER

By Kevin McKay

"TIME KEEPERS"

Each club shall appoint a time keeper whose duties shall be—

A. To keep the time of each quarter on time cards, complete same and give to the field umpire at the completion of the match.

B. To sound a bell or siren at the start and finish of each quarter and to keep sounding it until the field umpire indicates to them that he has heard it.

C. To add "time-on" to the playing time of the quarter whenever directed to do so by the field umpire or when a goal or behind has been scored.

The time to be added on shall, in the case of a goal, be the time which elapses between the waving of the flags by the goal umpire and the bouncing of the ball in the centre by the field umpire; in the case of a behind, the time which elapses between the waving of the flag by the goal umpire and the kick off from behind.

"TIME-ON"

The field umpire shall instruct the time keepers to "add time-on".

1. If there is any undue delay in getting the ball back when it is out of play.

2. If a player wilfully wastes time.

3. If a player goes over an opponent's mark and does not go back immediately when told to do so.

4. When more than one opponent stands on the mark of a player.

5. When a player who has been given a

free kick plays or kicks without going back to the spot where the free kick was given.

6. In all other cases when play is unduly delayed.

"TIME-ON" — HOW INDICATED

A. The field umpire shall instruct the time-keepers to add "time-on" or to stop adding time-on by sounding his whistle and raising his arm high above his head.

B. The time to be added on shall be the time that elapses between the two whistles. Should the time keepers fail to hear the second whistle they shall stop adding "time-on" when they see the ball is again in play.

Umpires are instructed to sound their whistle loudly and raise their arms quickly and to the fullest extent.

TIME-KEEPERS — keep sounding the bell or siren until the field umpire hears it, a quick short blast unheard by the field umpire could cost a team the match.

FROM "HAWKS" TO "BLACKS" — OVER 33 YEARS

John (Peter) O'Donohue, who is Assistant Coach of the Victorian teams for the 1975 Inter-state games, has had a very colourful career both as footballer and coach. One of Peter's greatest achievements was bringing University Blacks up from B Section to win the A Section flag in 1974.

After leaving St. Patrick's College, Sale, in 1942, Peter joined the Royal Australian Navy and in the same year played his first three games with Hawthorn in the V.F.L.

He played another three games whilst on leave and was discharged after overseas service with the Navy to line up with the "Hawks" in 1946.

From 1946 to 1952, Peter played 108 Senior games, was Vice-Captain in 1949, 50 and 51 and Captain in 1952.

Among his other successes was playing coach of West Perth who were finalists in 1953 and 1954 — Deniliquin (premiers 1957) and coach of Northcote (V.F.A.) in 1959 and 1960.

He returned to Hawthorn as Assistant Coach in 1965, became Senior Coach in 1966 and was Chairman of Selectors in 1967. Then he went back to coach Northcote in 1968 and 1969.

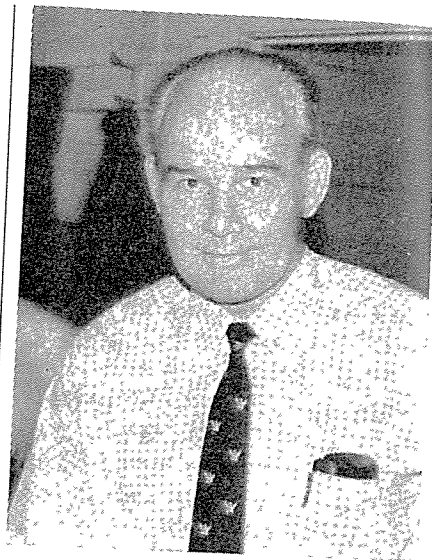
After considering many offers early in 1970, Peter became coach of University Blacks (B Section, V.A.F.A.).

Due to his untiring efforts and the formulation of a great team, the Blacks were runners-up to Reservoir Old Boys in B Section in 1973 and last season saw Pete at his very best in steering the Blacks to an A Section premiership (from fourth position after just scraping into the four—Ed.).

He enjoyed success as coach of the Victorian team of 1972 which visited and defeated Tasmania and has had the distinction of coaching the Melbourne University team to three Inter-varsity premierships, the latest being in Adelaide last week.

This achievement gained him selection to the exalted position as coach of the selected All-Australian team.

Peter is married, and no doubt after reading this article, you will have gathered that his wife Marg. must have given up much

of her time to help him, and particularly the University Blacks Ladies Committee.

Peter and Marg. have a son, 18 year-old Sean, who plays with Marcellin Old Collegians in B Section.

In his private life, Peter is an officer with H.M. Customs Department.

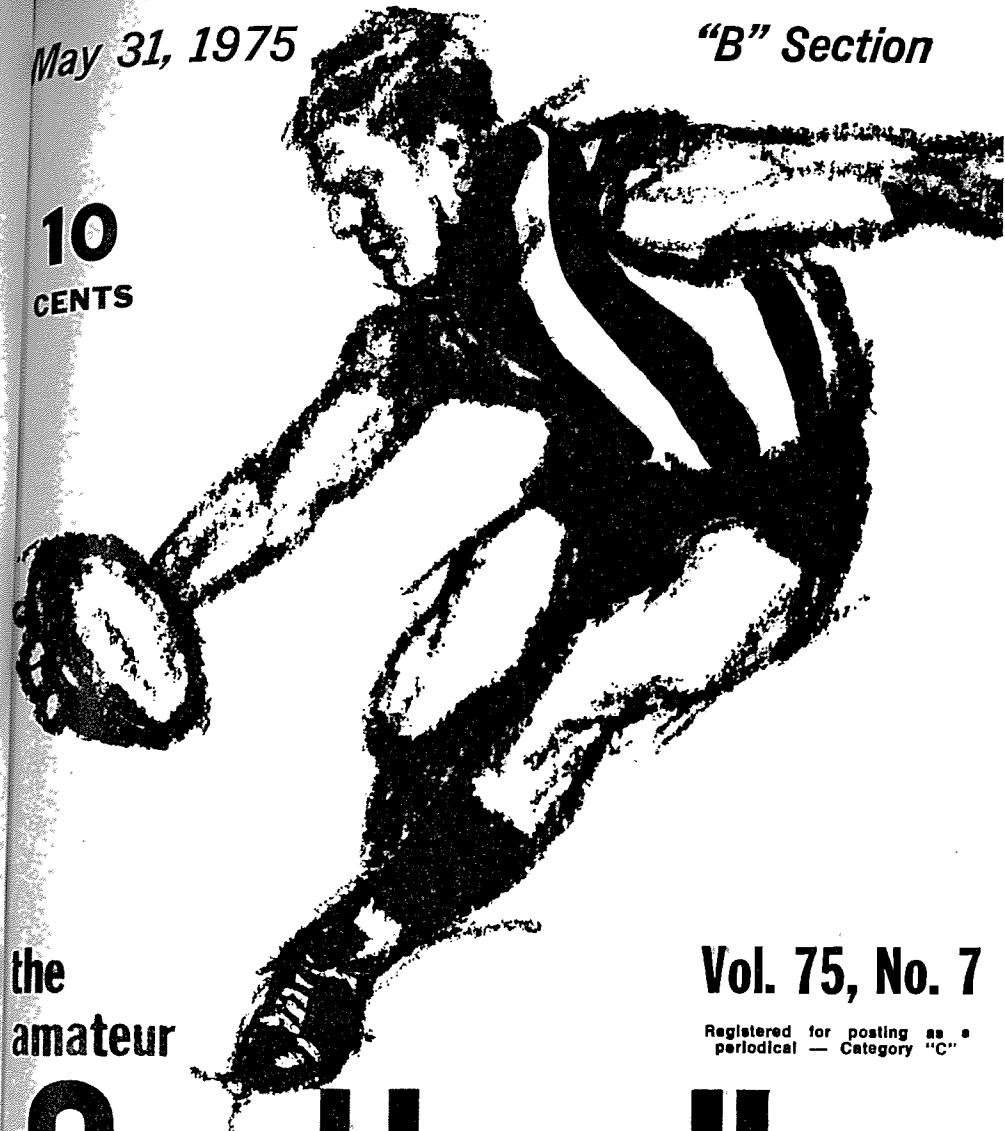
