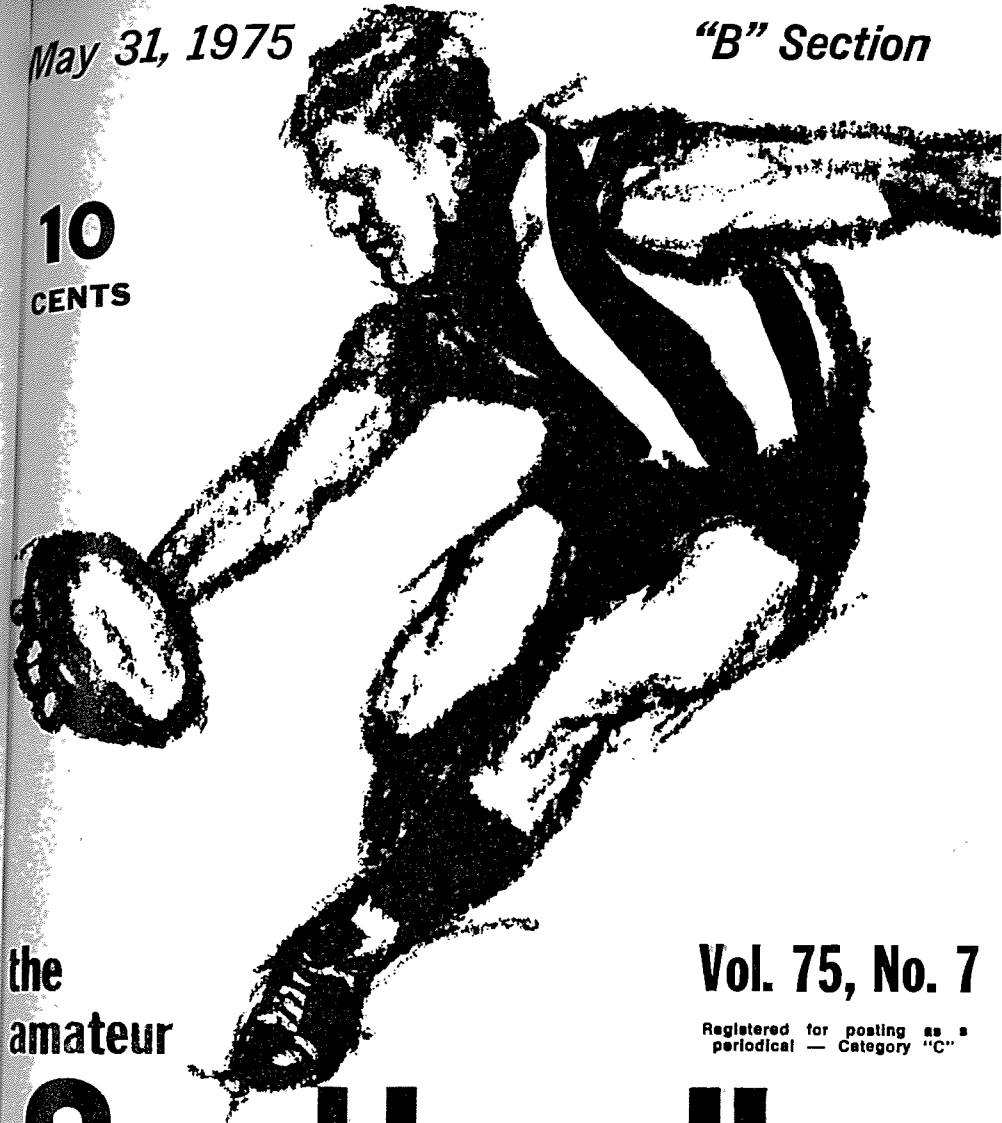

ORMOND BEAT NORTH IN A THRILLER BLACKS DOWN TO RESERVOIR — AGAIN! ST. BERNARD'S 13 GOAL BURST IN THIRD TERM Six leaders beaten — First loss for five of them

Ormond got home by a point in a thrilling finish against North Old Boys, with a behind kicked within the last minute of play.

The scores had been level for some minutes prior to that and it looked as if a drawn game would result.

University Blacks succumbed again to their hoodoo team — Reservoir Old Boys — going down by seven points after a great start.

St. Bernard's were in trouble against Old Trinity in the first half, but a phenomenal burst of 13 goals in the third quarter ended Trinity's chances of causing an upset.

Coburg pushed themselves up into final four calculations when they beat Monash Blues by almost 9 goals. It was Monash's third successive defeat and they have crashed from top place down to 7th although out of the four only on percentages.

Coburg's two wins in a row have lifted them to sixth.

Coburg cleared out in the second quarter when they kicked 7 goals to lead by more than 6 goals at the interval. They adapted themselves to the windy conditions better than Monash, who were outplayed all day.

Neither North nor Ormond took full advantage of the wind in the first half, and seemed to be able to score almost easily against it. Ormond kicked 3 goals against the wind in the first term to be only 7 points down but were still 2 points in arrears at half-time.

Ormond kicked 3 goals straight in the third term but North added 5-8 and were 22 points in front.

Ormond started the last quarter in great style and after wiping off their deficit went to a 13-point lead, and it looked all over.

But North fought back gamely to level the scores and were unlucky to be beaten right at the finish.

This is their second defeat in the last minute of play — the Blacks did the same a few weeks ago with a goal just before the siren.

Ormond continually broke down in attack against a strong North defence for a good deal of the game, but it was the North forwards who missed several chances to make the game safe in the last quarter and Ormond's accuracy (16-9 to 14-20) won it for them.

The Blacks kicked 6-9 to 4 points in the first quarter against Reservoir Old Boys and were still 17 points in front at half-time.

But Reservoir kicked 9 goals against the wind in the third quarter and held the Blacks to 2-3. Reservoir finished on well to score by 7 points.

Geelong led Old Paradians for most of the game and looked set for their first win when they were 21 points in front at three-quarter-time, but Parade kicked 5 goals in the last term, getting to the front shortly before the finish to win by 6 points.

Ivanhoe lost their place in the four when they went down by 28 points to Marcellin, and have dropped to seventh. Collegians, with a win over Old Haileybury by the same margin, have gone into the four.

The wind played havoc with the forwards' accuracy in the latter game, Collegians kicking 8-15 to Haileybury's 4-11.

University Blues continued their winning run, scoring from Caulfield Grammar by a comfortable 27 points. Old Scotch failed badly against De La Salle and their second successive defeat has sent them from fourth to ninth.

Old Carey beat Kew by 17 points to move up to sixth.

Melbourne High won their third in a row to move into the four but they had a struggle to beat Old Brighton by 10 points. St. Kilda CBC didn't have things all their own way against Power House who ran them to 3 goals.

Old Melburnians had a big win over Alphington, pushing them out of the four, and Old Ivanhoe were much too strong for Parkside.

Fawkner overwhelmed State Savings Bank, winning by more than 11 goals. Bank's poor shooting for goal added to their discomfort.

Elsternwick who went down to St. Pat's-Monivae by 26 points, dropped to third, behind A.M.P. and St. Pat's on percentage.

AMP Society struggled home by 5 points against Old Mentonians, who had plenty of chances. They kicked 4-21 to A.M.P.'s 6-14.

Heatherton beat Bulleen United by 3 goals, displacing them from second, and Beverley Hills scored an easy win over Glenroy.

In Junior games, Coburg beat University Blacks by 8 goals and knocked them out of the four, while Ormond thrashed Parkside to move into third place.

In Section 2 St. Bernard's beat Reservoir by 21 points and took their place in the four.

Among the Reserves, Old Trinity beat St. Bernard's by 8 points, Monash Blues beat Coburg by 14 points and Old Haileybury beat Collegians by 28 points.

Power House beat St. Kilda CBC by 20 points, Parkside annihilated Old Ivanhoe, Melbourne High easily beat Old Brighton, Fawkner trounced State Bank, AJAX beat ANZ Bank by 3 points and A.M.P. beat Old Mentonians by 11 points.

Six leading teams were beaten in last Saturday's round — University Blacks, Elsternwick and four Reserves — Collegians, St. Kilda CBC, State Savings Bank and ANZ Bank. It was the first defeat for all except the Blacks.

Now only five teams remain unbeaten — University Blues, St. Kilda CBOC, Hampton Rovers Monash Blues Reserves and De La Salle Reserves.

UMPIRE'S CORNER

FIELD UMPIRE

The whistle is all powerful. An umpire should have the best whistle available.

An umpire speaks through his whistle, and should give it every ounce of power he has.

Always carry two whistles.

Endeavour to understand players — a knowledge of their style can be invaluable.

Speak kindly and reasonably to them. Answer queries if asked in a proper manner — otherwise ignore them.

Call your decisions so that players know why they have been penalised.

A word or two at the right time will frequently let a player know what he is doing wrong; but don't be trapped into lengthy discussions — or arguments.

You are there to protect the fair player. See that the man who is playing the ball in accordance with the laws is permitted to play it that way.

Never permit acts of mis-conduct to go unpunished.

When a free kick or mark has been awarded, always be within calling distance, so that you have the player under control.

The members of the Umpire's Association join with me in offering congratulations to St. Bernard's coach Gerrard ("Gus") Mitchell on his appointment as coach of the interstate team.

Gerrard has been a most successful coach of his own club and we wish him well in the games against Tasmania and South Australia.

Flushed with his tennis success Simon Marks (the umpire's answer to Jimmy Connors) is trying to arrange an umpire's tournament.

"Do you know that" in 1874 the rules of our game were called "The Victorian Rules of Football" and rule 13 read:—

— No player shall play with more than one club during any season.

For the purposes of this rule, schools be not considered clubs.

The 1874 rule book contained only 13 rules and five definitions.

Today's modern rule book contains 33 rules plus 193 paragraphs and 17 definitions — almost a circulating library.

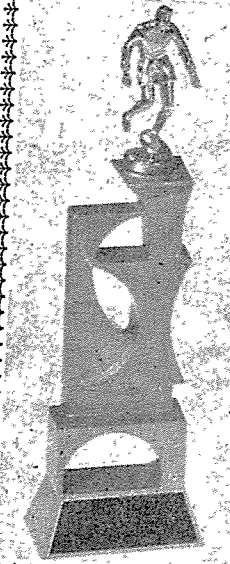

A "COBURGER" SINCE HE WAS FIVE

Coburg's new coach, Graham Warfe, has been interested in the club since he was five years old, when he was the club mascot.

Now, after playing 247 games with the Juniors and Seniors, he is directing affairs from the "other" side of the fence.

Graham made his debut as mascot back in 1949, and then went to play with West Coburg Under 15 team.

He came back to Coburg at the age of 15 to play with their Junior team (Under 19). He was with the Juniors for four years and was captain the last two of these seasons.

He won the Junior Section Best and Fairest award in 1963, and the club trophy the same year.

Graham played his first senior game at the end of that season — in the finals — and was a playing member of this team until the end of season 1974.

He was captain of the side for eight years — from 1967 to 1974, and won the club Best and Fairest trophy in 1973, after being runner-up three times. He also won several other club trophies.

Graham first played in the Victorian team in 1966 and was Vice-Captain of the team which played in Tasmania in 1969. He was Captain of the Victorian team at the Perth Carnival in 1970.

Graham claims to have played in most positions for Coburg, but mainly in the centre and the back pocket (What about the ruck? — Ed.).

He missed a lot of games through injuries — two broken collarbones, a dislocated elbow, and has had his nose broken several times.

He has had a bad knee since 1966 and finally had a cartilage removed. (The "bad" knee didn't seem to affect his ability, for he has played many fine games since then — Ed.).

Graham considers Peter Scanlon the best "all round the ground" player he has play-



ed with, and the best player for his size is Norm Beattie.

From a back-pocket player's point of view, he names Mick Mulcahy (Old Xaverians) and Hugh Ford (Old Paradians) as the hardest resting rovers to mind.

Graham, now aged 30, started his new venture rather shakily, as Coburg lost three of the first four games. But they have won the last two and are back in the firing line we are accustomed to seeing them.

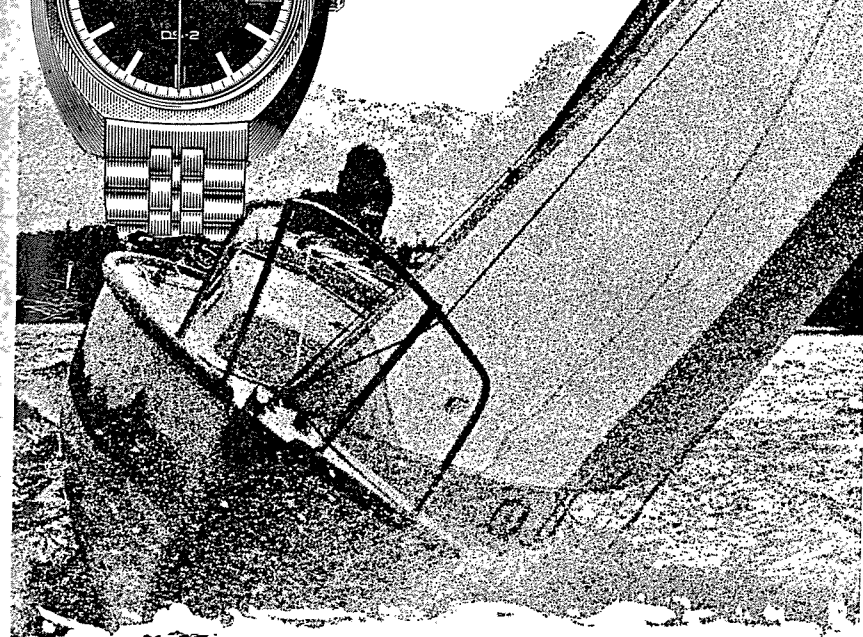

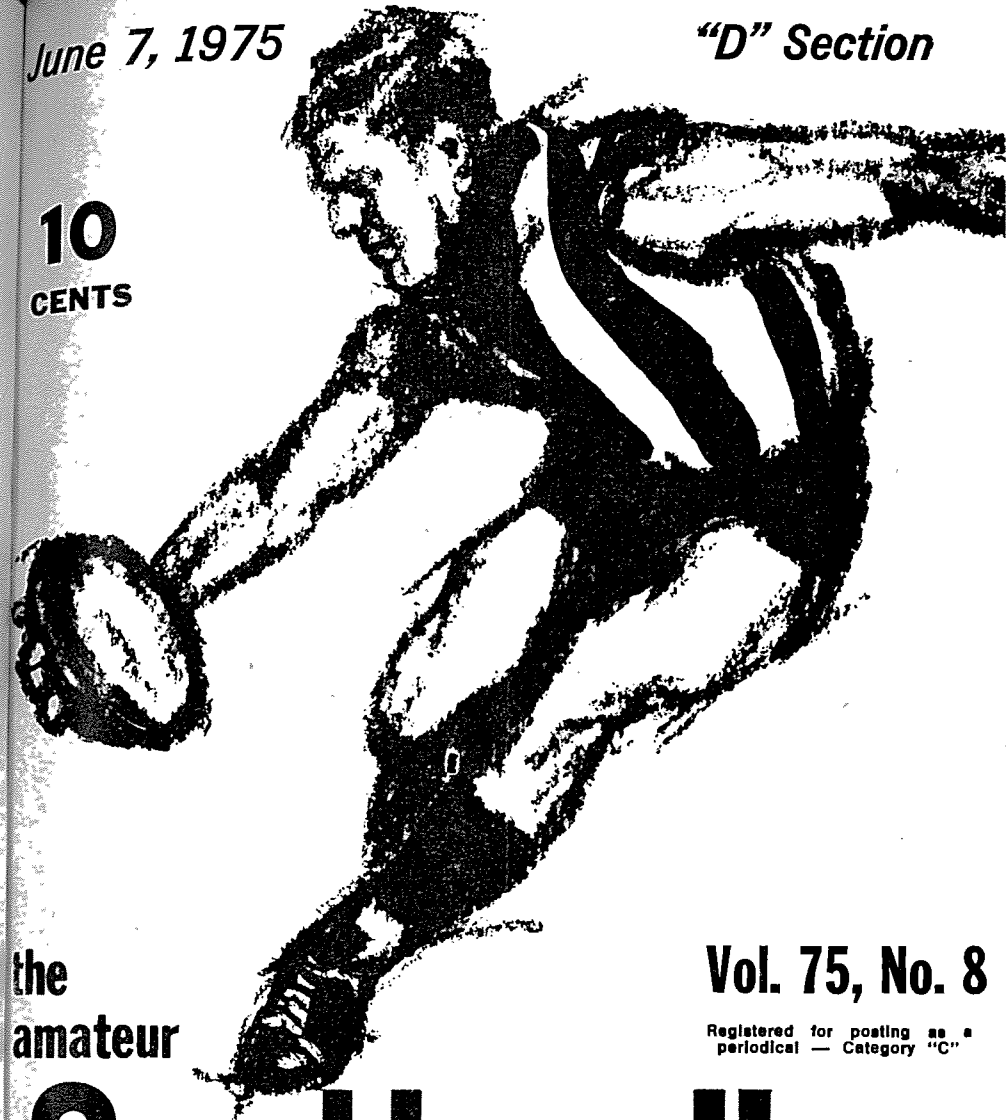
