

ST. BERNARD'S CLEAR LEADERS AGAIN STRONG FINISH ROUTS BLACKS *Ormond's Shock Defeat by Monash*

St. Bernard's finished too strongly for University Blacks in last week's main match and are now clear leaders again.

Ormond, who were sharing top place with St. Bernard's and the Blacks, went down to Monash Blues in a surprise result. It was Monash's first win in six rounds.

Now, the Blacks and Ormond share second place with North Old Boys, the three of them being a game ahead of Reservoir Old Boys, with three more teams being a game further behind.

At the halfway mark of the home-and-home series, only three teams remain undefeated — St. Kilda CBC, Monash Whites and De La Salle Reserves.

University Blacks opened well against St. Bernard's, kicking 7 goals in the first quarter, and were 11 points ahead at half-time.

But St. Bernard's fought back in the third term and the scores were level at the last change. Then the home side cleared right away in the final quarter, slamming on 8 goals to win by 38 points.

They showed more initiative in the last quarter than the Blacks, who may have temporarily lost a little of their edge.

Monash "jumped" Ormond with 3 goals in five minutes and keeping up the pressure, gained a firm grip on the game in the second term when they added 4-3 to 3 behinds to lead by 33 points at the interval.

Ormond improved in the second half, but their forwards were off the target, which was a contributing factor in their defeat, as Monash held on to win by 14 points.

Coburg also opened well against Reservoir Old Boys, but Reservoir came back in the second term to lead narrowly at the interval.

The defences of both sides were on top in the third quarter, when Coburg edged to a 5-point lead, but Reservoir

finished a shade more strongly in a free-scoring last term and were winners by 6 points.

An 8-goal burst in the second quarter by the bigger Old Trinity side gave them a 10-point lead over Old Paradians. Parade came back in the last quarter and led by 10 points but Trinity finished on to win by 11 points.

Trinity outmarked Parade, who were kept in the game by their accurate kicking for goal.

Geelong looked to have a chance of opening their account when they were only 13 points behind North Old Boys at the final change, but North kicked 5 goals against the wind as Geelong faded, and scored a comfortable win.

Marcellin moved a step closer to the four with a 29-point win over Collegians and now trail Ivanhoe (fourth) only on percentage.

Ivanhoe went down to Gaulfield Grammarians by 3 points in a tense finish to a game that was close all day. Old Scotch ruined their chances of beating Kew with poor shooting for goal. They had six more shots and were beaten by 9 points.

University Blues beat Old Carey by 29 points to hold top place and De La

Salle were not troubled by Old Haileybury.

Uni. High dropped from fourth to sixth when St. Kilda CBC beat them by 31 points, and Power House, who beat Alphington by 17 points are now in the four on percentage.

Old Ivanhoe scored easily over Old Melburnians but bottom team Brunswick ran Melbourne High (third) to 6 points.

Leading team Hampton Rovers suffered their second successive defeat when they went down to State Savings Bank by 25 points. But Bank's win back-fired somewhat, as they lost their place in the four to Old Geelong who now head them on percentage. Old Geelong easily beat Assumption.

West Brunswick scored a surprise 2-goal win over ANZ Bank, and AMP Society crashed against Elsternwick, who won by more than 8 goals, while St. Bede's beat Old Mentonians by 3 points.

Thornbury had only 5 points to spare over LaTrobe Reds but Monash Whites, Heatherton and Bulleen United all won easily.

It is interesting to note that the five home teams won in B Section and all the visitors won in F Section.

Ivanhoe, Coburg and Ormond all had easy wins in Junior Section 1, and Hampton Rovers beat North Old Boys by more than 6 goals in the main Section 2 game.

In the Reserves, St. Bernard's beat the Blacks by 7 points, Ormond beat Monash Blues by 10 points, the same margin by which Old Trinity beat Parade, and North Old Boys beat Geelong by 4 points.

Collegians' poor kicking was mainly responsible for their 8-point defeat by Marcellin, Parkside beat Old Brighton by 21 points, State Bank beat Hampton Rovers by 11 points, ANZ Bank beat West Brunswick by more than 4 goals in a low-scoring game and Elsternwick scraped home from AMP Society by 4 points.

With half the season now behind us, St. Bernard's, University Blues, St. Kilda CBC, Monash Whites and Coburg Juniors are clear leaders of their respective sections.

In D Section, Hampton Rovers, Fawkner and Old Xaverians share top place while AJAX and St. Pat's-Monivae are equal top in E. Section, and Hampton Rovers and Old Carey are level at the top of Junior Section 2.

Three of the Reserve Sections have outright leaders — St. Bernard's, De La Salle and AJAX. Parkside and St. Kilda CBC share the lead in their section, Fawkner, State Bank and Old Geelong are equal at the top of D Reserves and Monash Whites and Heatherton share top spot in F Reserve Section.

A "SPANNER" IN THE WORKS

Spence (Spanner) Williams has been a player of many parts in his Amateur Football career which spans more than 200 games, includes 20 Finals appearances, six State games and two in an Australian Amateurs side.

Spence was nick-named "Spanner" at the Launceston Carnival in 1967 and the name has stuck to him. It's rather appropriate too for quite often opposing sides have found him to be a "spanner" in their works.


Spence (or Spanner) Williams started with Old Paradians in 1961 after leaving school and first played on a half-back flank or in the back pocket.

He was Captain of the school side and while still at school he played for some years with Heidelberg in the Diamond Valley League, where, in 1960 he had the distinction of playing in two Grand Finals on the same day.

He missed season 1962 and played only a few games with Parade Reserves in 1963, but took part in the finals that year and was also in the senior team in the Second Semi-final.

He played with Old Paradians from 1961 until midway through season 1972, when he transferred to Coburg.

Spence was a member of the Victorian team at the Launceston Carnival in 1967



when he was used as a rover and ruck-rover and he roved for Parade in the Grand Final the same year.

He was selected in four other Victorian teams and captained the side against South Australia in 1971. In his six appearances with Victoria he never played in a losing side.

Spence was first rover for the Australian Amateurs in 1968 when they competed in the ANFC Division 2 Championships at Canberra.

A sojourn overseas caused him to miss the 1970 season but he came back in 1971 and has been a full-time student since then.

When he crossed to Coburg the following year Spence played in the centre, but after missing the 1973 season, he went back to his ruck-roving job last year.

When Coburg coach Alan Salter transferred to University Blues as coach this season, Spence went with him, and is a ruck-rover with the Blues, of whom he was elected Vice-Captain by the players, a tribute to his popularity.

He hopes of course to be playing in the finals with the Blues this season and if he (and they) maintain their present form, that looks a certainty.

Spence already holds a degree of Bachelor of Arts and a Diploma of Physical Education. He was a Phys. Ed. teacher for six years then a computer programmer for a year prior to his overseas trip. Now he is doing a Master of Science course.

Spence has always looked after himself and seems to be playing as well as ever. He considers that being a non-smoker and virtually a non-drinker has helped considerably in maintaining his form.

Although Spence will be 34 next month, he was selected in the Inter-Varsity side this season, gained a place in the Australian Universities team, and was runner-up for Best and Fairest award at the Inter-Varsity Carnival at Adelaide.

Seventeen of his Finals series games have been with Old Paradians all but two of which with the seniors (the two Reserves were in 1963), and his other three have been with Coburg.

PERMITS CLOSE SOON

Applications for permits for season 1975 will close with the Records Secretary of the V.A.F.A. Mr. Bruce De Lacy, 67 Charman Road, Mentone, 3194 on Tuesday.

The only application considered after that date will be that of a player affiliated with a club in the amateur body of South Australia, Western Australia or Tasmania, who is transferred to Victoria in his employment.

A player who has played with a club in the V.A.F.A. this season, and has subsequently played with another club, must stand down for two matches before being eligible to play for his V.A.F.A. club again.

In a case such as this, the date on which he last played with the other club must be shown in his permit application.

Re-registration of a player whose permit is still in force, that is, a player who has not played with any other club since he last played with the club with which he is seeking re-registration may be made at any time up to the last home and home match.

While on the subject of Permits it may be as well to draw the attention of Club Secretaries (and any other club official who may be involved in signing up a player) to the fact that it has been brought to our notice that a number of minor Leagues are now making payments to players.

It is therefore absolutely essential that every new player or applicant for a Permit be thoroughly questioned as to his Amateur status, and as to whether he has received payment of any kind, or any trophies or presents etc.

If you are in any doubt whatsoever, contact the Chairman of the Permit Committee, Mr. F. H. Coldrey (Phone 92-4797).

Remember the club will suffer loss of points and incur a fine, if you play a player who is subsequently found to be ineligible.


