

BLACKS DOWN TO MONASH RESERVOIR THRASH TRINITY St. Bernard's clear leaders again

Monash Blues surprised University Blacks last week and scored a 5-point win to keep their final four chances alive. The Blacks are still second but hold this position by only a small percentage margin over Reservoir Old Boys, who meet them today.

Reservoir virtually put Old Trinity out of the running with a big win at their expense. It was Reservoir's sixth successive win.

Ormond lost their fifth game in a row, going down to St. Bernard's by just over five goals. St. Bernard's are now on top on their own again.

All but three sections have clear leaders, the exceptions being A Reserve, B Reserve and C Reserve.

Monash showed more determination than University Blacks, who were really only kept in the game by their very accurate kicking (12-3).

Perhaps Monash had more incentive — defeat would have virtually ended their final four chances, and the Blacks overwhelmed them in the first round to start a string of losses, after Monash ∞ had won their first three games.

Reservoir were much too strong for Old Trinity, who failed by more than 14 goals. Reservoir's small men cut Trinity's defence to pieces and Trinity had trouble in getting through the home side's strong backline.

Ormond gave St. Bernard's too big a start and although they had a chance of pulling the game out of the fire early in the last term, St. Bernard's finished too strongly and won by 31 points.

St. Bernard's with the breeze, kicked 7-5 to 1-1 in the first quarter and this was where they won it. Ormond didn't take full advantage of the wind in the second term and ended a poor first half (for them) with a deficit of 22 points.

Ormond showed great improvement | big

in the third quarter when they allowed St. Bernard's to increase their lead by only 3 points, each side kicking 3 goals.

Ormond started the last term with two quick goals but then their run ended and St. Bernard's took control to run out comfortable winners.

Dominating round the centre, North Old Boys were not greatly troubled by Old Paradians, and won by 34 points.

Geelong just missed again — failing by 5 points against Coburg in a generally poor game. (They ran St. Bernard's to 6 points a couple of weeks previously).

There were some close ones in B Section.

Ivanhoe just got home from Old Haileybury by 4 points, due to slightly less inaccurate kicking, while University Blues' accuracy gave them a 3point win over De La Salle.

Caulfield Grammarians can blame their poor shooting for goal for their 8-point defeat by Old Carey and Kew pushed Marcellin to 9 points, although Marcellin had 14 more scoring shots.

In the other game, Collegians had no trouble in beating Old Scotch by a big margin.

UMPIRE'S CORNER By Kevin McKay

SOLID BUMPING

The Rules of the game permit solid bumping or pushing from the side.

Sometimes such bumps or pushes are very vigorous, but if they are correctly placed on the side or front of an opponent they are quite fair under the rules, and should not be penallsed, provided the ball is within 5 metres.

There must be no jostling at the centre before the ball is bounced.

There must be no interference whilst the ball is about to be thrown in from the boundary.

Breaches such as deliberately kicking or forcing the ball out of bounds must be penalised everytime they occur.

A mark taken 'on the goal line, is deemed to be a mark.

The ball must be completely over the goal line in the case of a score, and also in the case of out of bounds.

If a juggled mark is started on the goal or behind line and completed over the line it is a behind.

A similar case on the boundary line the decision would be - Out of bounds.

Law 17 S — states — 'all breaches, of the laws must be penalised whether the ball is dead or in play".

The effect of the law is over-riding -

offences "must be penalised". Here are some possible ways in which it can operate.

1. The field umpire about to bounce the ball to start play sees an offence.

He does not bounce the ball but, if it is to the advantage of the side, that is to say the offence takes place within a team's forward area, he awards a free kick to the player offended against.

If a forward offends against a defender then he warns the offender and still bounces the ball in the centre.

2. A forward kicking for goal is dropped after the ball has crossed the goal or behind lines and the "all clear" given.

The goal umpire signals the score; then the field umpire awards the player offfended against, another kick.

If he scores again, that score also counts. It is therefore possible to score two goals without the ball being bounced in the centre.

It could be three or four if the offences were continued.

Most free kicks are easily defined and should not be overlooked unless the granting of the free kick penalises the side, then the call should be "play-on".

It is EMPHASISED that umplres SHOULD have a COMMONSENSE outlook on free klcks.

ELIGIBILITY OF PLAYERS FOR RESERVE AND JUNIOR SECTION FINALS


The attention of clubs is drawn to the restrictions which apply concerning players eligible to take part in Final matches in the Reserve and Junior Sections.

The Rule relating to eligibility of players in Reserve Section Finals reads:-

A player who has been a member of a senior team of any club in nine or more matches during the home-and-home matches in any season shall not be eligible for in-clusion in the reserve team of a club taking part in a final match in the same season unless both the senior and reserve teams are participating in a final match on the same day.

Provided that no player shall be eligible for inclusion in a reserve team taking part in a final match in any season unless such team in at least TWO home-and-home matches during the said season. JUNIORS A player who has been a member of a

senior or reserve team in more than five matches during any season shall be ineligible for inclusion in a junior team taking part in a semi-final, final or grand-final match in the SAME SEASON UNLESS he has been a member of the junior team for more than five matches in the same season.
