

MIKE BIRRELL — OLD CAREY'S SUPER RUCKMAN

Two Best and Fairest awards and once Runner-up in three seasons of football — that's the record of Old Carey's star ruckman, Mike Birrell.

Mike started with Old Carey in 1971 and won the B Section Best and Fairest in his first season, when he was 18.

Just to prove it was no fluke he repeated the performance the following year, (and was Runner-up in 1973). On each occasion he was six points clear of his nearest opponent.

Then in 1973 he was beaten by only a point by Phil Pryor, of Collegians.

But that's not all — Mike was selected in the Victorian team to play against South Australia at Adelaide in 1972 and won the award for best player in the Victorian side.

It wasn't altogether surprising that this performance earned him a place in the team to visit Launceston for a match against Tasmania later in the same season, and it's probably not surprising to learn that he was adjudged the best player in that Victorian team also.

Yes, that's right — two Association Best and Fairest and two Best Player trophies in Interstate games in his first two seasons of Amateur football.

Mike was a member of the Victorian Carnival team in 1973 (at Melbourne) but missed almost the whole of last season when he was travelling around Australia.

But he's back in business again in 1975, and played in the Victorian team against Tasmania at Elsternwick Park in June, being mentioned among the best players.

Mike who is only 22, stands at 6 ft. 4 ins. and weighs 13-7 according to the information given for the Interstate match this year. At the 1973 Carnival his weight was given as 14-7.

Perhaps the fact that he plays in the ruck, usually for the whole game has caused him to shed some weight or was it the trek round Australia last year that did it?

In his short space of time on the Amateur football scene, Mike Birrell has certainly made a name for himself — who knows to what further heights he may climb!

BLACKS HOLD OFF RESERVOIR ORMOND DOWN NORTH — KEEP FOUR OPEN Coburg's Great Last Quarter

The four is still wide open — and seven teams, possibly eight, are still in the running for the finals at the end of the month.

University Blacks held off a strong challenge by Reservoir Old Boys to retain second place and Ormond's win over North Old Boys kent the fight for the four still alive.

Had North won, it would just about have closed the door, but they were badly off target and paid the penalty.

There were upsets in other sections also — University Blues were thrashed by Caulfield Grammarians, Parkside beat Old Ivanhoe and Fawkner went down to State Savings Bank, to mention but a few.

Coburg and Monash Blues, fighting to keep in the running for the finals staged an even three quarters, but Coburg ran right away from their opponents in the last term, kicking 11-10 to 2 behinds, and romped home easy winners.

Coburg made better use of the wind and looked to have a slight edge when they led by 2 goals at the

interval.

University Blacks broke away from Reservoir in the second term and went to a lead of 23 points. They maintained their advantage and were in a strong position when they turned for home with a 4-goal advantage.

But Reservoir held the Students to 2 points in the last term and made a bold bid for victory. The Blacks held firm and scored by 3 points, to

remain in second place.

North Old Boys virtually handed the game to Ormond in the first quarter when they could manage only 8 behinds with the strong wind, and were a point behind at the first change.

Ormond showed how it was done in the second term when they added 7 goals and were 31 points to the good at the interval.

North were still off the target in the third quarter and Ormond kicked another 7 goals in the last to score a comfortable win — their first in six matches.

St. Bernard's also had difficulty in scoring goals in the first term against Old Trinity, who trailed by only 14 points at quarter-time.

But St. Bernard's held Trinity well in the second quarter and were still 13 points in front at the long break.

St. Bernard's rattled on 8 goals in a solid third quarter and looked to be well in control with a lead of 44 points but Trinity came back strongly in the closing stages and were beaten by only 16 points.

Old Paradians trailed Geelong by 8 points at the interval of an even game but they put on 6 goals in the third term and finished strongly to win by 39 points.

Ivanhoe scored a comfortable win over Marcellin, the margin being 31 points. This proved costly to Marcellin, as they lost their place in the four to Caulfield Grammarians, who scored a runaway win over the leaders, University Blues.

But the Blues are still firmly entrenched in top place, two games clear of De La Salle and Ivanhoe.

Kew scored a surprise 3-point win over Old Carey, whose final four hopes suffered a setback. Collegians beat Old Hailevbury by 25 points and De La Salle overwhelmed Old Scotch.

Parkside held their place in the C Section four with a convincing 38point win over Old Ivanhoe, and Alphington had to battle to score by 17 points from Old Melburnians in a high-scoring game.

St. Kilda CBC knocked Power House down to seventh when they won by nearly 9 goals, while Uni. High and Melbourne High had big wins over Brunswick and Old Brighton respectively.

The keen fight for positions in D Section continued with Fawkner losing top place to Hampton Rovers and Old Geelong swapping fourth place for Old Xaverians' third.

Fawkner's shocking kicking (7-24) cost them the game against State Savings Bank, who kicked 13-4 to win by 16 points and stay in the running for the four, particularly in view of National Bank's shock 3-goal win over Xavier.

Elsternwick trounced St. Pat's-Monivae by nearly 10 goals to jump into second place and North Brunswick kept the Section wide open by beating LaTrobe Blacks by 3 goals.

An even bigger surprise was ANZ Bank's defeat of the leaders, AJAX. by 27 points, and Old Mentonians iolted AMP Society's hopes with a 21-point win over them.

Heatherton scraped home from Bulleen United by 5 points and LaTrobe Reds beat University Reds by 6 points. Beverley Hills kept themselves in the fight with a comfortable win over Glenrov.

The four in Junior Section 1 is practically decided, although Old Scotch. with a 4-goal win over Power House. still retain a faint chance of making it. Coburg and University Blues had easy wins over University Blacks and

Monash University respectively in the other games.

Section 2 is very much alive, with Reservoir, St. Bernard's Bulleen-Templestowe and Thomastown fighting for fourth place, and the first three are level on points.

Reservoir overwhelmed St. Bernard's by more than 20 goals, knocking them out of the four, and Bulleen-Templestowe beat Thomastown by 33 points.

Old Trinity dropped from top to third in the Reserves when they went down to St. Bernard's by 40 points and University Blacks beat Reservoir by 35 points. Ormond dashed North Old Boys' hopes when they beat North by 5 points.

A 9-goal defeat by Ivanhoe sent Marcellin down from second to fourth. Melbourne High's big win over Old Brighton and Old Ivanhoe's 7-goal defeat by Parkside put High in the four and dropped Old Ivanhoe to sixth St. Kilda CBC beat Power House by 14 points but House held their place.

Fawkner easily beat State Bank, who are now fourth only on percentage from Old Xaverians, comfortable winners over National Bank.

AJAX beat leaders ANZ Bank by 25 points, A.M.P. won easily from Old Mentonians, Heatherton beat Bulleen United by a goal and Thornbury beat Footscray Tech, by 7 points in a low-scoring struggle.

Last week's results did little but add to the confusion in most sections — perhaps today's games will clear the air a bit more.

UMPIRE'S CORNER

By Kevin McKay

TOP UMPIRES COME FROM HARD WORK AND CONCENTRATION

You must be keen to hit the top as a foot-

ball umpire.

By "keen" I mean a lot more than the mere desire to umpire a game.

There has to be ambition to succeed, determination to overcome the many dis-

appointments.

There's got to be plenty of "natural guts" a good Australian word that, to absorb the set-backs that will come the way of every

It takes a tremendous amount of sand to accept the back slaps and hand-shakes one day and the next Saturday just plain nobody. One day you umpire well—they flock around—you get the natural feeling of elation—"it's good"—

The next week nothing will go right, you feel like handing in your whistle —
"you could be a leper" — The way you're shunned.

If you battle over over all the setbacks, all the disappointments that will come your way, and stick to it, you have the first essential to become a top "whistle-blower". Next test of an umpire's character comes

with the monotony of training. It can be monotonous too. I know all

about it - I've been through it. about it — I've been through it.

It's mighty easy to think about skipping training, particularly if it's wet and cold "Pon't do it".

Boys come to me straight from school who are just about right for development into field umpires — (there's always one

or two rough edges).

Perhaps one boy is not aware of the importance of an umpire's position, may be another doesn't realise his time-on signals are not right.

There are always a lot of men around ready to impart advice to young umpires,

but they are what I call false prophets.

They don't know nearly as much as they profess.

On the other hand there are many good men around who have been "out in the centre" and know what it's all about and are just as keen for your success as you are.

When a good fellow — perhaps an old umpire takes an interest in you, listen to his tips. Sort out the wheat from the chaff and try to build on it.

Some boys have a natural ability to be an umpire, others have to work really hard at it. Many times I have seen the hard working hack athlete outstrip the junior champion or, shall I say, "the natural".

He has to start a long way behind, but by dint of hard work, and a lot of sweat and determination, "he has made it".

I think the "natural umpire" starts a long way out in front, but he can also fall a long way in arrears unless he battles on to make himself even better.

This all leads me to the crux of the position - you must have the will to be a

top umpire. You must have the determination to pick yourself up when the setbacks have knocked you down.

It takes character - it's the will to win,

despite everything.

Remember that you umpire only as well as

you are fit.
The "three quarters" umpire lacks the will to get to the top, if he's finished physically he can't go on with the job in that vital last quarter when the call is the greatest.

So again I say — "Never slack your training". It's hard to come up fighting Saturday after Saturday, I've been through it, I can sympathise.

But there's only one remedy. Get up with the field. The field won't come back to you.

So it's back to the old grind, training, development work and more training.

Early this season I asked a young um-Early this season 1 asked a young umpire if he was enjoying umpiring — his reply — 'Yes I really like it, but isn't it lonely out there'' (how very true!).

1. There is certainly no free kick called

"flying too soon".

2. If a player bounces the ball and is then grabbed and does not re-take possession of the ball he must receive a free kick for holding the man, the umpire should of course allow the player doing the tackl-ing a chance to release his hold on the

player who was grabbed.

3. Kicking in danger is paid under "undly rough play" — umpires in the Amateur Association are instructed to police this rule strictly.

A player attempting to pick up the ball and kicked in the hand certainly comes into this category and should at least receive a free kick.

4. A non-playing coach is certainly not allowed on the playing arena during the playing of the match, except of course to address his team at \(\frac{3}{4} \) time.

ELIGIBILITY OF PLAYERS FOR RESERVE AND JUNIOR SECTION FINALS

The attention of clubs is drawn to the restrictions which apply concerning players eligible to take part in Final matches in the

Reserve and Junior Sections.

The Rule relating to eligibility of players in Reserve Section Finals reads:—

A player who has been a member of a senior team of any club in nine or more matches during the home-and-home matches in any season shall not be eligible for inclusion in the reserve team of a club taking part in a final match in the same season unless both the senior and reserve teams are participating in a final match on the same day.


Provided that no player shall be eligible for inclusion in a reserve team taking part in a final match in any season unless such player has been a member of such reserve team in at least TWO home-and-home matches during the said season.
JUNIORS

A player who has been a member of a senior or reserve team in more than five matches during any season shall be ineligible for inclusion in a junior team taking part in a semi-final, final or grand-final match in the SAME SEASON UNLESS he has been a member of the junior team for more than five matches in the same season.
