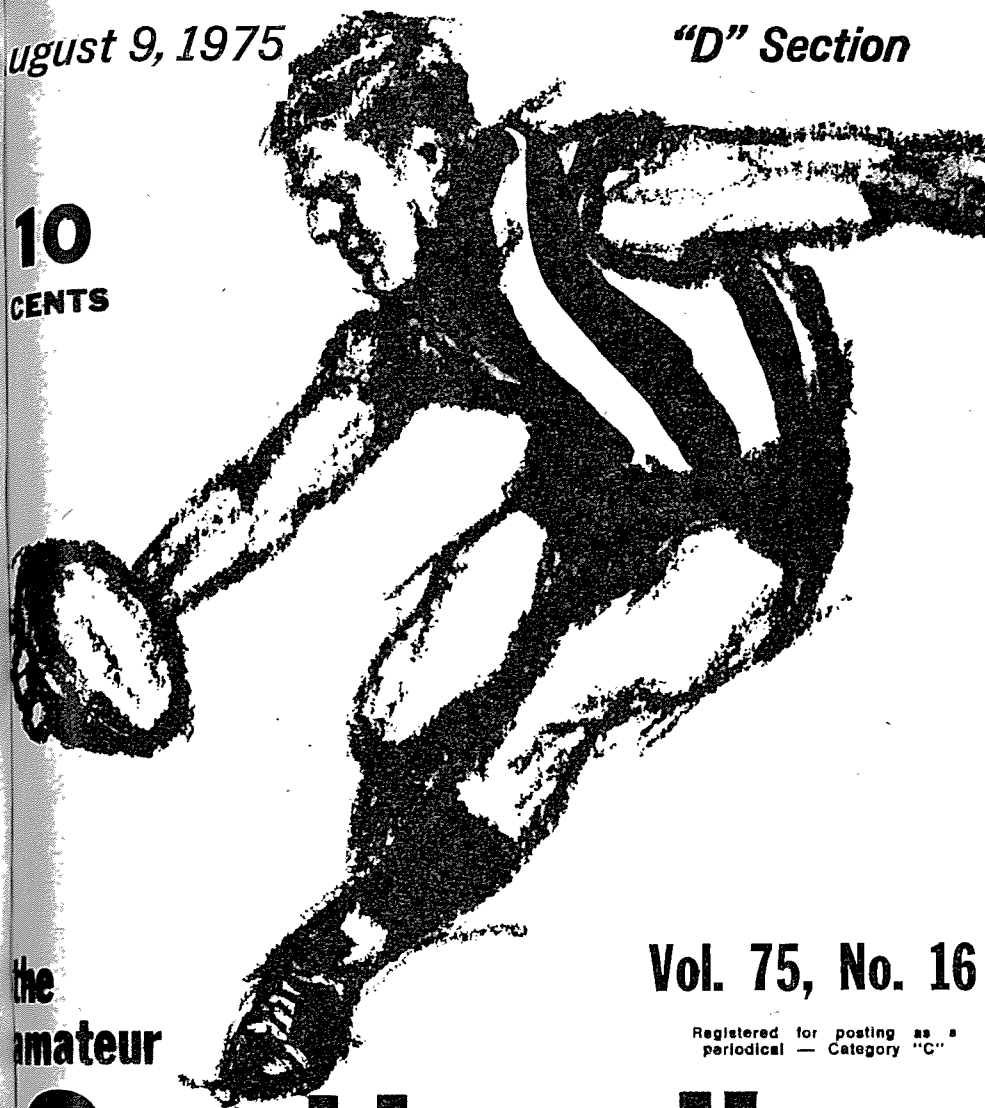

## COBURG BEAT BLACKS NARROWLY RESERVOIR JUST MISS AGAIN *Trinity finish on over Monash*

Last week's opening paragraph — "The four is still wide open — and seven teams, possibly eight, are still in the running for the finals at the end of the month" — still holds good, except that we ought to just say eight teams are in the fight for the four, but the last two of these, Old Trinity and Monash Blues, have only a slender chance of making it.

Poor kicking by University Blacks undoubtedly cost them the game against Coburg, who won by six points, and Reservoir Old Boys again left their run too late, going down to North Old Boys by two points.

Seventeen teams in the "fours" were beaten, but only two — LaTrobe Blacks and Reservoir Old Boys Juniors lost their places in the top bracket.

The Blacks started well against Coburg and were 14 points ahead at the first change, but managed only seven behinds in the second term to lead by 4 points at the interval.

Coburg added 5-2 to 3-3 in the third quarter and were 7 points to the good. It was a tense struggle in the final quarter but Blacks were unable to make up their leeway.

It was a hard-fought game throughout, with both sides applying plenty of pressure.

North Old Boys' superior teamwork and backing-up were big factors in their win over Reservoir Old Boys.

North led all day and looked to be heading for an easy win but Reservoir fought back strongly in the last quarter and nearly pulled the game out of the fire, going down by only 2 points.

North broke away in the third quarter after an even first half to lead by 27 points but Reservoir added 6-3 to 2-2 in the last term.

Monash Blues looked to be in a fairly safe position when they led Old Trinity by 19 points at half-time. They put in a good second term, kicking 6-1 to 4-3, after 2 quick goals

just before quarter-time gave them a 9-point advantage at the first change.

Then Trinity took a hand, adding 5-8 to 1-1 in the third quarter to go to a 2-goal lead. Trinity went further ahead in the final term and at one stage led by more than 4 goals but Monash got within 2 goals at the finish.

Geelong surprised a lethargic Ormond in the first half and led by 7 points at the interval, but it was a different story after that. Ormond kicked 8-3 to 1-5 in the third quarter and went on to an easy win.

St. Bernard's wiped Old Paradians' chances off in the first term when they slammed on 9-6 to a point and cruised home to win by a very big margin.

There were a couple of surprises in B Section, too. Old Scotch made themselves a step safer from relegation when they beat Ivanhoe (third) by 16 points, and Old Haileybury ended Old Carey's hopes for the finals, pipping Carey by 4 points.

Caulfield Grammar scraped home from Marcellin by 2 points, De La Salle beat Collegians by 13 points and University Blues' shocking kick-

ing (12-30) reduced their winning margin over Kew to 16 points.

The only section in which all teams in the four won was C Section, but there were some close ones. Melbourne High beat traditional rivals, Uni. High by only 9 points and leaders, St. Kilda CBC had only 11 points to spare on Alphington.

Parkside finished 29 points ahead of Power House, Old Ivanhoe won comfortably from Old Brighton and Old Melburnians overwhelmed Brunswick.

Hampton Rovers beat Old Geelong by 26 points and State Savings Bank didn't improve their final four prospects when they went down to National Bank by 2 points, poor kicking for goal being the main factor in their defeat.

Commonwealth Bank got home by 2 points from Old Camberwell, and Fawkner and Old Xaverians had easy wins over St. Kevin's and Assumption respectively.

E Section was the one for upsets, as three of the top four teams were beaten, the exception being AJAX, who beat LaTrobe Blacks (fourth) by 2 goals and knocked them out of the four.

Elsternwick (second) were well beaten by ANZ Bank, the margin being 29 points, and St. Pat's-Monivae (third) went down to AMP Society by the same margin, while West Brunswick beat Old Mentionians by 13 points in a bid to stay in the section.

### ELIGIBILITY OF PLAYERS FOR RESERVE AND JUNIOR SECTION FINALS

The attention of clubs is drawn to the restrictions which apply concerning players eligible to take part in Final matches in the Reserve and Junior Sections.

The Rule relating to eligibility of players in Reserve Section Finals reads:—

A player who has been a member of a senior team of any club in nine or more matches during the home-and-home matches in any season shall not be eligible for inclusion in the reserve team of a club taking part in a final match in the same season unless both the senior and reserve teams are participating in a final match on the same day.

North Brunswick, with an easy win over St. Bede's, climbed into the four.

All of the home teams won in F Section, where Heatherton kicked a huge score of 41-25 (271 points) against Bulleen-Templestowe. Bulleen United beat Thornbury by 15 points, Beverley Hills and Monash Whites had easy wins over University Reds and Glenroy, and Footscray Tech. beat LaTrobe Reds by 5 goals.

The main Junior Section game resulted in Ivanhoe beating University Blues by 8 points (14-9 to 12-13) while the Blacks overwhelmed Power House and Ormond easily accounted for Old Scotch.

In Section 2, poor kicking cost Hampton Rovers the game against Bulleen-Templestowe, who won by 11 points (12-14 to 9-21). Old Carey beat Reservoir by more than 7 goals to knock them out of the four, St. Bernard's, with a big win over Old Paradians, taking their place.

North Old Boys trounced Thomastown to shatter their final four hopes and West Brunswick beat Caulfield Grammar by 3 points.

Three Reserve leaders were beaten, Coburg going down to the Blacks by 3 goals, De La Salle failing badly against Collegians and ANZ Bank being well beaten by Elsternwick. Other "four" teams to suffer defeat were Power House (13 points), Hampton Rovers (a goal) and Glenroy (28 points), all being beaten by the leaders in their respective sections.

Provided that no player shall be eligible for inclusion in a reserve team taking part in a final match in any season unless such player has been a member of such reserve team in at least TWO home-and-home matches during the said season.

#### JUNIORS

A player who has been a member of a senior or reserve team in more than five matches during any season shall be ineligible for inclusion in a junior team taking part in a semi-final, final or grand-final match in the SAME SEASON UNLESS he has been a member of the junior team for more than five matches in the same season.

### 5 Years Ago

South Australia won the Perth carnival when they beat the other three competing states, West Australia, Victoria and Tasmania, in turn.

Victoria, trailing S.A. by 44 points at 4 time, kicked 7.2 in the last quarter to 1.2 by S.A. to go down by 7 points.

Best for Victoria were Barry Morphet, Terry Brown, Ian Turnbull, Tony Hunt, Peter McInerney, and Jeff Russ.

Only 4 Victorians were named in the Australian team picked after the carnival, McInerney (half back flank), Brown (wing), Turnbull (centre half-forward) and Morgan (emergency).

Eleven South Australian, four West Australian and 2 Tasmanian players made up the 20 with Bob Newton (Tas.) as captain.

Terry Brown (Old Geelong) won the medal for best and fairest.

Biggest upset for the round was the defeat of leaders in 'E' section, Reservoir Old Boys who went down to AJAX by 17 points. Rubenstein, Smorgon, and Herzfell were best for AJAX.

200 games to Collegians' youthful veteran, Bruce Ferguson and George Mehl (of AJAX) who had played 197 consecutive games.

### 10 Years Ago

Coburg's determined 7-point victory over Collegians and Melbourne High's 3-point defeat by Univ. Blues put Coburg into the four for the first time for the season and M.H.S. dropped to 6th.

John Johnson was starring on the wing for West Brunswick.

Commonwealth Bank paid tribute in their club history to Harry Heathershaw, VAFA vice president, who was their first coach when Bank joined the VAFA in 1947.

Roy Stabb was in his 9th year as coach.

A century of games to Harry Sollander (AJAX), Reg Luscombe (Geelong), Peter McKinnon (Old Brighton), Gary Amlet (Caulfield Gramm.) and Barry Saunders (Univ. Blues) while it was 150 up for Gerald Fuge (Alphington) and Bernie Blair (M.H.S.O.B.).

### 25 Years Ago

The A.N.F.C. Carnival was played in Brisbane in shocking conditions on a ground badly affected by rain. The Australian Amateur team (first of its kind) came through with distinction, winning the premiership in Division 2 by beating New South Wales, Q'land, and A.C.T. (Canberra).

Sam Birtles (Hampton Rovers) won the R. T. Rush trophy as best and fairest player in Division 2, while trophies for best players in each match were won by Jack Quinn (S.A.), Peter Cox (Old Melburnians) and Alan Reid (Geelong).

Ormond were 3 games clear on top and were certain of the double chance.

Kew (C Section) and Ormond Juniors were the only teams still undefeated.

## UMPIRE'S CORNER

### "DO YOU KNOW?"

That umpires were first introduced into Australian Rules football in 1872 — prior to that the rival captains had decided any points and had awarded free kicks.

That uniforms were first introduced in 1873 — hitherto caps had been the only distinguishing mark.

That 1912 saw the league introduce the numbering of players.

The same year the Association introduced boundary umpires.

The League in 1912 introduced stewards with the power to report.

The first recorded football match was played on August 7th, 1858 between Scotch College and Melbourne Grammar School.

1946 saw the laws of the game amended to allow the replacement of two players.

The first night match in Victoria was played under electric light at Olympic Park in 1935 — attendance was 20,000.

The Melbourne University Football Club was admitted to the League in 1908 and played in that competition until it disbanded in 1915 on account of the first world war.

Clubs likely to be taking part in the semi-finals and finals are requested to furnish the age, height and weight of players from whom the teams for these matches will be chosen, as soon as possible.

The information is required not later than MONDAY, AUGUST 18th.

Clubs with Senior and Reserve teams both in the finals are requested to furnish separate lists, showing in the Reserve team list ONLY those eligible to play with the Reserves, and omitting from the Senior list those players who have no chance of being selected in the senior team.

There may be a few players on both lists. Lists must be in NUMERICAL (NOT ALPHABETICAL) ORDER, and must be in the correct sequence — Number, Name, Initial, Age, Height, Weight e.g.

# COMING TO THE BLACKS' DEFENCE — ROD McLEAN

University Blacks' defender, Rod McLean, has proved to be a most reliable back-man in his 100 or so games for the club, but he has also shown to advantage in many other positions — in fact he could be classed as a real utility player.

Rod, who hails from Cheltenham High School, joined the Blacks in 1970, after having played with Melbourne (VFL) Third Eighteen.

He was quick to catch the eye of the Victorian selectors, for he represented his State in the match against Tasmania at Elsternwick Park the following year.

Since then he was overlooked for Interstate honours until this year when he played against South Australia, also at Elsternwick Park.



Rod has played most of his football in defence — back pocket or half-back flank, but he has also played on the half-forward line, as a rover and ruck-rover.

He was Vice-Captain of the Blacks in 1973 and last season he had a taste of League football, playing nine games with Melbourne Reserves.

He missed six VAFA matches, but still played well enough in the remaining 15 to win the Best and Fairest award.

Rod, who has just turned 25, is 6 feet tall, but at 11 stone 7, is rather light for his height.

He played his one hundredth game for the Blacks earlier this season, and his form should ensure that he chalks up many more.

And there doesn't appear to be any reason why he should not get the chance to play in the Victorian side at the Adelaide Carnival in 1976.

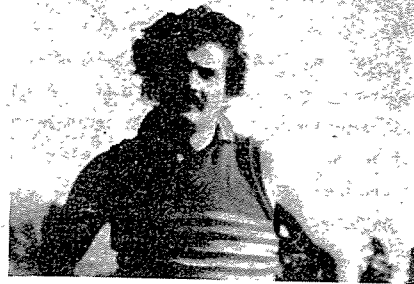

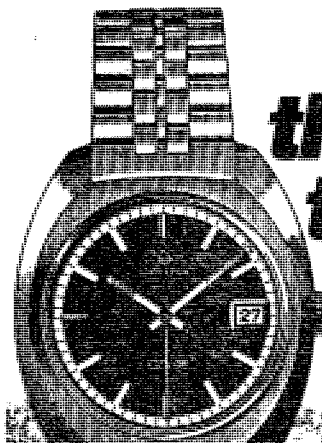

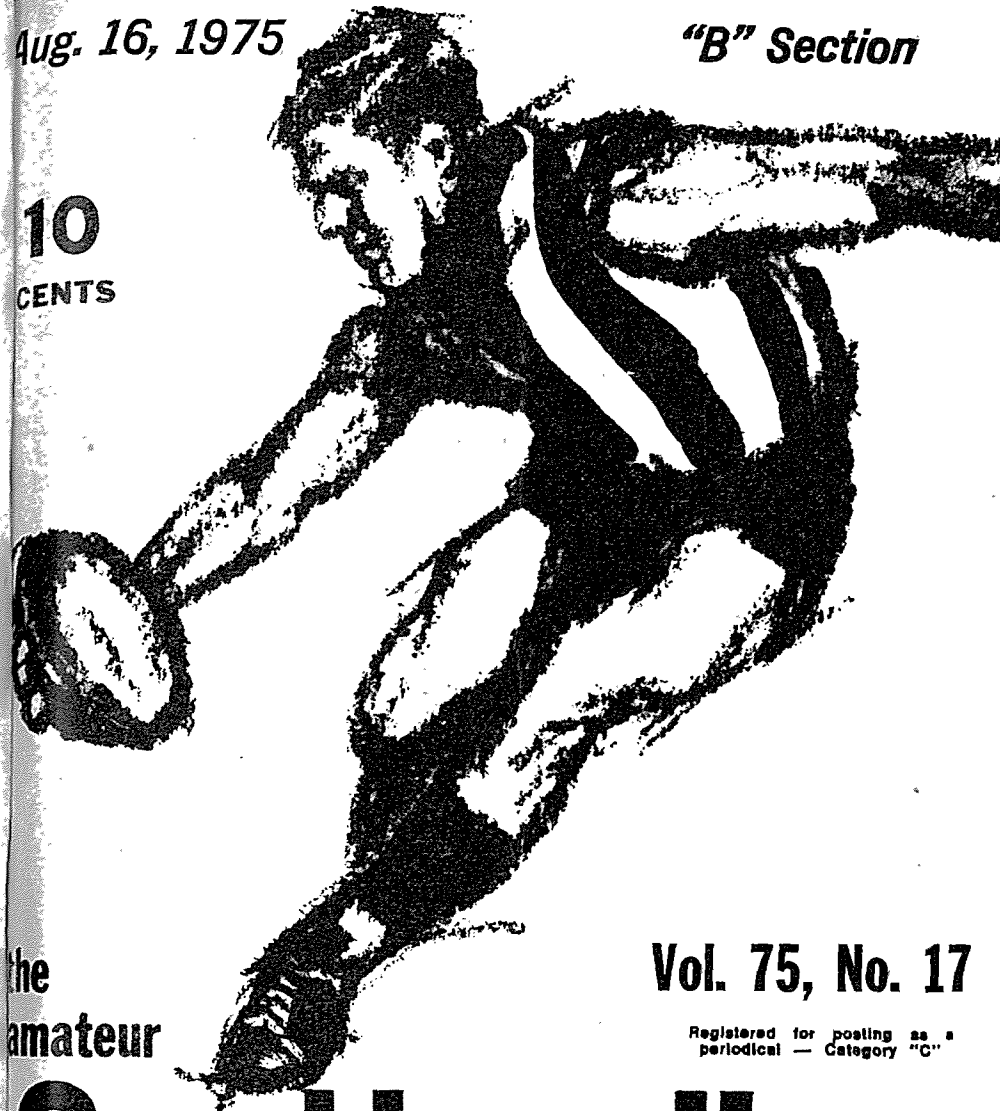
