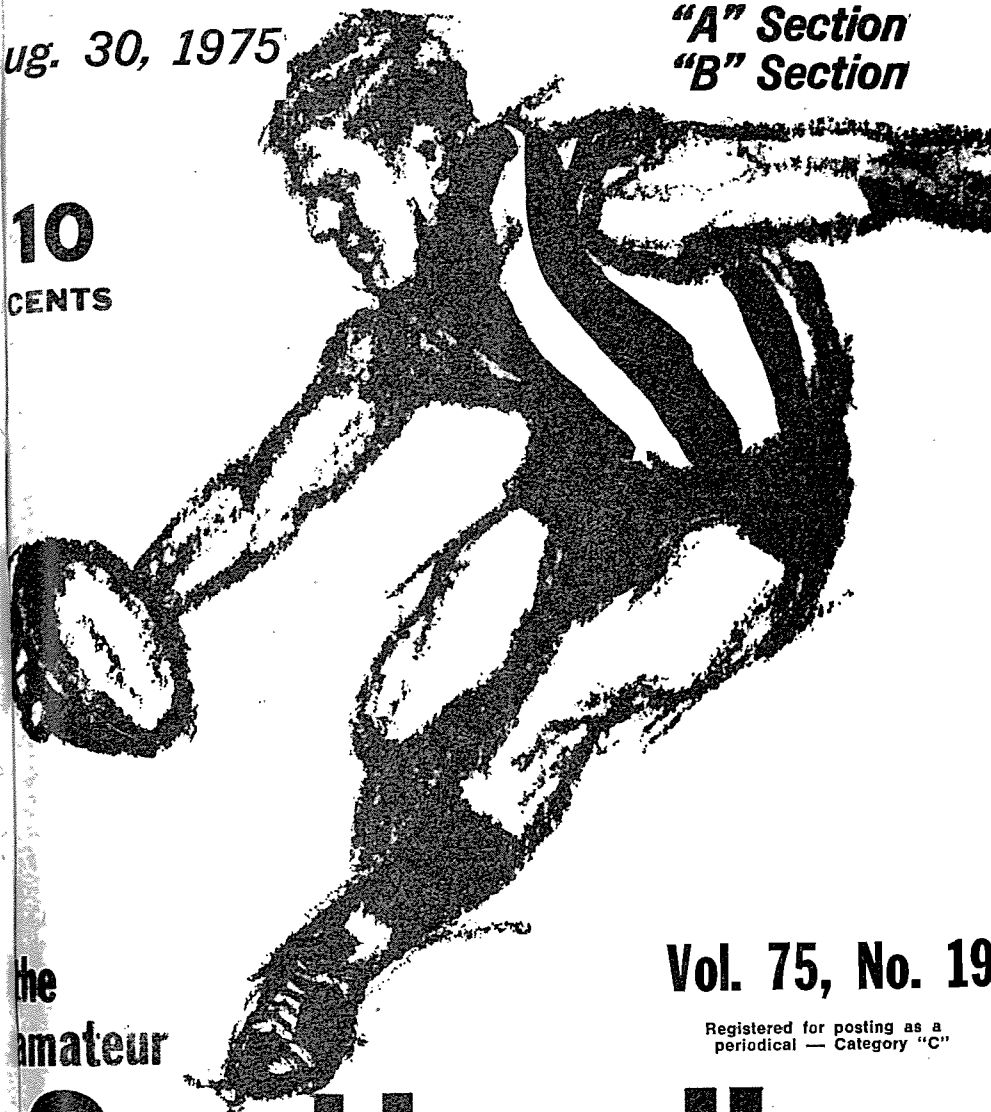

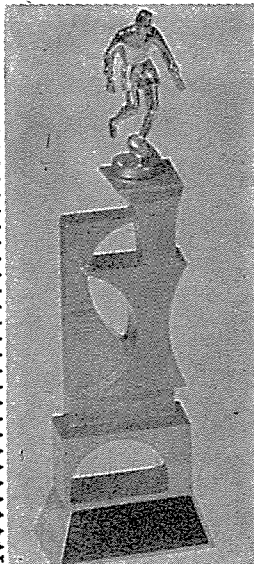

BLACKS BEATEN, BUT HOLD 4th PLACE MEET NORTH O.B. IN KNOCK-OUT SEMI-

Only one change in doubtful fours

University Blacks were beaten by St. Bernard's in a close struggle last week, but managed to hold their place in the four.

Ormond, who finished level with them on points, were unable to beat Monash Blues by a big enough margin to overcome their percentage lag.

It will be the first time for more than 10 years that Ormond have missed out on the final four.

Prior to last week's round, seven of the 15 "fours" were not finally decided, but there was only one change in the doubtful ones. AMP Society Reserves lost their place to West Brunswick.

The number of contenders for premiership honours has been narrowed down to 56, and will be reduced by another 14 today, when the losers of the First Semi-finals will retire from the contest.

University Blacks took the honours in the first half and led St. Bernard's by 19 points at half-time in a low-scoring game. But St. Bernard's added 5 goals in the third term and held Blacks in the last to run out winners by 10 points.

Reservoir Old Boys looked to have Coburg's measure when they shot to a 31-point lead early in the last quarter, but Coburg fought back strongly and went down by only a goal in a tense finish.

As a result, Reservoir held second place and Coburg's slender chance of making the four disappeared.

Old Paradians gained an early break on Old Trinity and held on to score by 3 points but it didn't save them from relegation. They are entitled to consider themselves unlucky — for they finished with seven wins.

Ormond were untroubled to beat Monash Blues by 28 points, after leading throughout (but they needed to win by a much bigger margin to have gained a place in the four) and North Old Boys easily beat Geelong.

Caulfield Grammarians clinched their place in the four with a decisive 35-point win over Ivanhoe. These two teams meet again today in the First Semi-final.

Marcellin won by 15 points from Collegians but were relying on Ivanhoe to beat Caulfield to get them into the four.

Old Carey caused an upset when they beat top side University Blues by 12 points in a low-scoring struggle, Blues' shocking kicking (3-13) causing their downfall.

De La Salle had little difficulty in beating Old Haileybury by just over 6 goals and Old Scotch had nearly 11 goals to spare over Kew.

Parkside made sure of their place in the finals with an easy win against Old Brighton, and dashed the hopes of Alphington, who were much too strong for Power House.

Uni. High ran St. Kilda CBC to 16 points, Old Ivanhoe beat Old Melbourne by 15 points and Melbourne High overwhelmed Brunswick.

Old Geelong crashed against Assumption, going down by more than 6 goals. Hampton Rovers beat State Savings Bank by 4 goals while Fawcner, Old Xaverians and Commonwealth Bank finished well in front of their respective opponents — National Bank, Old Camberwell and St. Kevin's.

AMP Society scored a 16-point win over Elsternwick and North Brunswick ran AJAX to 15 points. St. Pat's-Monivae had a narrow escape against LaTrobe Blacks, getting home by only 5 points.

In the battle to avoid relegation, Old Mentonians were successful, beating St. Bede's by 9 points.

Footscray Tech., who ran Heather-ton to 3 points the previous week, were soundly beaten by Monash Whites, Thornbury kicked a big score against LaTrobe Reds and Heather-ton had plenty to spare from Beverley Hills.

In the Junior Sections, Reservoir Old Boys held their place when they beat Bulleen-Templestowe by 21 points. Hampton Rovers beat North Old Boys by 29 points and St. Bernard's finished well down against West Brunswick.

Three teams finished equal top in A Reserve Section, but there was no major re-shuffle.

St. Bernard's, who beat University Blacks by 10 points, slipped from top to second, their place being taken by Old Trinity, easy winners over Old Paradians. Coburg trounced Reservoir by more than 13 goals, but were unable to move up from third place.

University Blues kicked a huge score against Old Carey in an effort to make the four, but De La Salle and Ivanhoe both won easily and held their places.

Marcellin failed badly against Col-legians and dropped from second to fourth, finishing level with De La Salle and Ivanhoe but well behind them on percentage.

Poor kicking cost Old Geelong the game against Assumption, who scored by 2 points. Old Xav's won easily from Old Camberwell and State Bank were comfortably beaten by Hampton Rovers to leave the four unchanged.

AMP Society dropped out when they went down by 4 points to Elsternwick, and ANZ Bank slipped to third as a result of their 8-point defeat by West Brunswick, who gained a place in the four. This also allowed AJAX to move up to second.

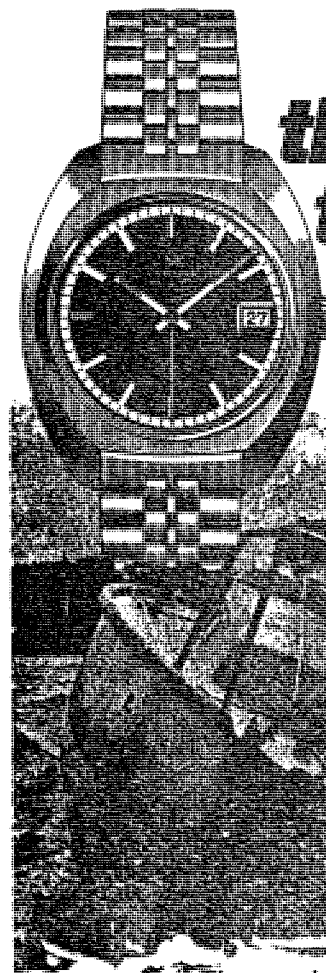

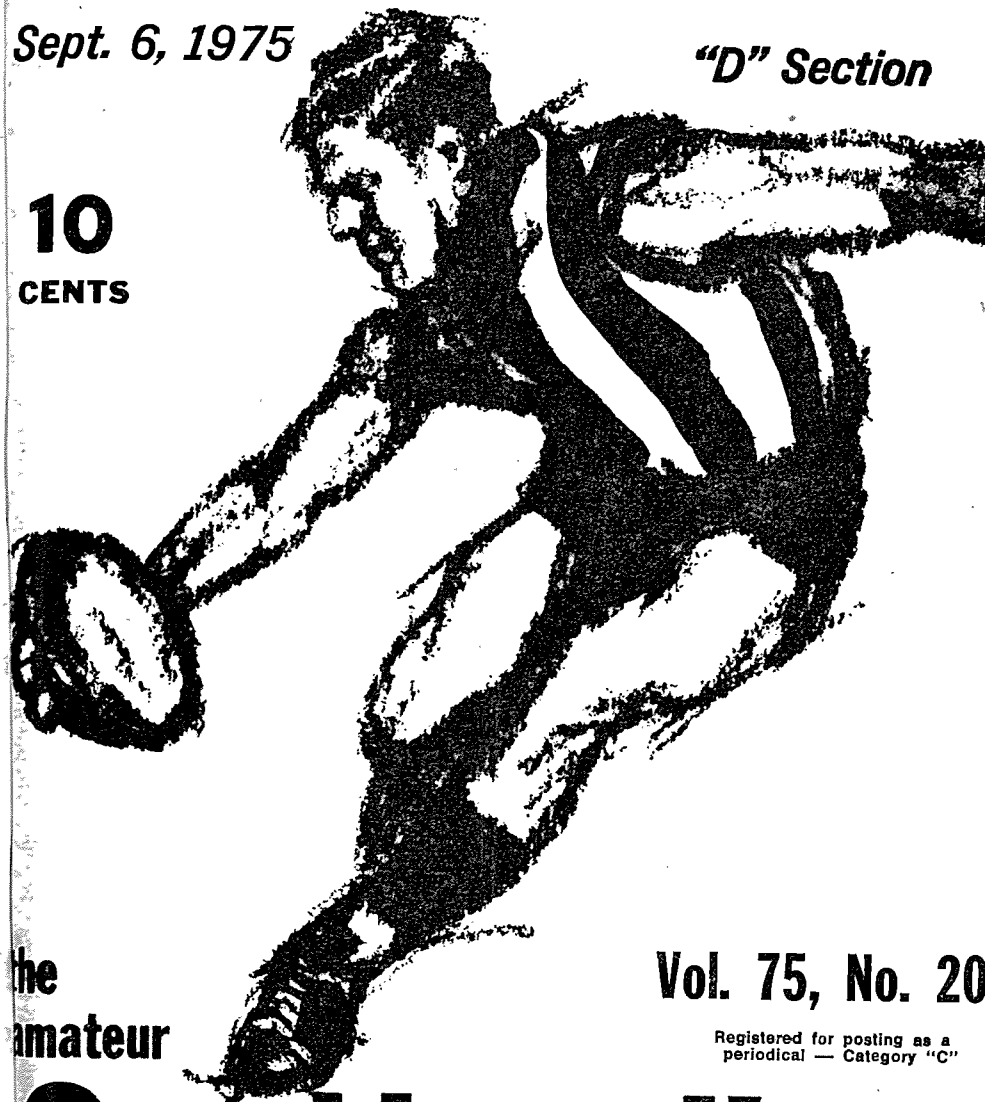
