Ormond, Parade, Caulfield Start Well But Blues Fail Against Coburg

Last year's premiers, Ormond, and B Section premiers, Old Paradians, started the 1972 season well with big wins over Monash Blues and St. Bernard's (third in 1972), and Caulfield Grammarians, who just missed the four on percentage, overwhelmed De La Salle.

But University Blues, runners-up, went down by six goals to Coburg, who finished much too strongly for them.

Geelong just scraped home from Old Trinity, C Section runners-up, their accurate kicking giving them a 1-point win, but Tooronga-Malvern, who won the C Section premiership, failed by almost 10 goals against Old Carey.

The Blues gained a 3-goal lead over Coburg in the first quarter but Coburg rattled on 6-7 to a goal in the second to lead by 19 points. Blues got to within a goal at the last change only to fade against Coburg's 7-goal burst in the final term.

Parade always had an edge on St. Bernard's and went right away in the second half, when St. Bernard's kicked only 2-8.

A 7-goal effort in the second quarter gave Ormond a commanding lead over Monash Blues and they added another 8 goals in the last to run out easy winners.

Caulfield Grammar were never in danger of defeat from De La Salle, who had no counter for Caulfield's pace, aerial supremacy and much more effective forward work.

North Old Boys celebrated their return to the top section with a win over Melbourne High by 12 points. North's more accurate kicking was the deciding factor in a close game.

Old Scotch surprised University Blacks who went under by 19 points, and Collegians, although somewhat off the target, scored a comfortable win over Kew.

Old Trinity should be well satisfied with their debut in B Section, for they kicked 15-12 to Geelong's 16-7.

Trinity's strong finishing burst just failed.

Ivanhoe had a big win over Uni. High in the other B Section match.

Old Melburnians beat Old Xaverians by 10 points but should have won by much more as they had 10 more scoring shots. Power House beat Old Haileybury by 11 points and National Bank finished 4 goals in front of St. Kilda CBC.

Assumption were too strong for Commonwealth Bank and Reservoir Old Boys had a big margin to spare over Fairfield.

Old Brighton scored easily at the expense of Footscray Tech. and La Trobe Blacks celebrated their promotion with a 20-point win over Parkside.

St. Pat's also started off in the higher section with a win over Hampton Rovers by 21 points. Alphington had a good win over St. Kevin's and Brunswick beat Old Geelong by 26 points.

Marcellin and Old Ivanhoe, new-comers to E Section, had easy wins against AJAX and ANZ Bank respectively. Old Mentonians won comfortably from Dookie and Longerenong while newcomers, St. Bede's, did fairly well in running Elsternwick to 33 points.

Hampton Scouts, Junior Section 2 premiers last year, pipped Old Scotch by 4 points but Parkside, runners-up to them, went down by a big margin to University Blacks, who, as University, were Section 1 premiers in 1971.

Monash surprised Ormond, runnersup, beating them by 18 points, 12-24

to 12-6.

University Blues, making their first appearance in the Junior Section, kicked the huge score of 43-34 (292 points) against another newcomer, Brunswick.

The other new club, Beverley Hills, found Caulfield Grammar far too

strong.

Among the Reserves, Ormond beat Monash Blues by a point, St. Bernard's beat Parade by 9 points and Uni High beat Ivanhoe by 5 points.

UMPIRES CORNER

RULES and DEFINITIONS

Handball — simply means that the ball is held clearly in one hand and hit with the clenched fist of the other hand. The hand holding the ball can be moved in any position, provided the ball is on the hand.

The only penalty occurs when the ball is thrown off one hand before being punched with the other hand.

It often happens that a player tries to handball, but is pulled and so gives the impression that the ball has been thrown. This is caused by the action of "the pull" and should not be penalised.

Laying over the ball — the player who does this prevents everyone else from playing the ball, so if he is held

correctly must be penalised.

If a player bounces the ball whilst being held it is "holding the ball" — if the hold and the bounce are made simultaneously — "play-on".

GOAL UMPIRES

Goal umpires must receive the "all clear" from the field umpire **before** giving a decision.

Goal umpires must not go out into the playing area, and turn around to watch the ball going between the posts.

Always stand behind the goal line and in line with the flight of the ball.

HINTS FOR BOUNDARY UMPIRES

Boundary umpires must always keep their eyes on the play and players, and the field and goal umpires.

They must keep out of the way of

players.

The ball is not out until it has completely crossed the line. If any portion of the ball is on the line — it is still in play.

LOOKING BACK

Five years ago — 1967
Coburg easily defeated Old Xaverians to be only undefeated team in "A" section after two rounds.

AJAX team manager was having trouble with his team list — four Rittermans, four Rubinsteins, three Rotsteins.

Ten years ago - 1962

A season to send coaches and secretaries crazy, it started on April 14, then no football on April 21 — Easter Saturday.

By the way Reserves in 1962 played in following sections — South-west, south-east and north-east, arranged geographically as far as possible.

Twenty years ago — 1952

A player to make his name in football made his debut with Ormond Juniors — Laurie Mithen — A section fairest and best in 1953, and star centreman of Melbourne's premiership teams in the 1950's.

Among the clubs were Myer, East Malvern, Murrumbeena, Parkdale, Balwyn, Caulfield, Teachers College, Bellfield, Brighton, E.S. & A. Bank, none of which are now competing in the V.A.F.A., although E.S.&A. Bank have amalgamated with ANZ Bank following the merger of the two Banks.




