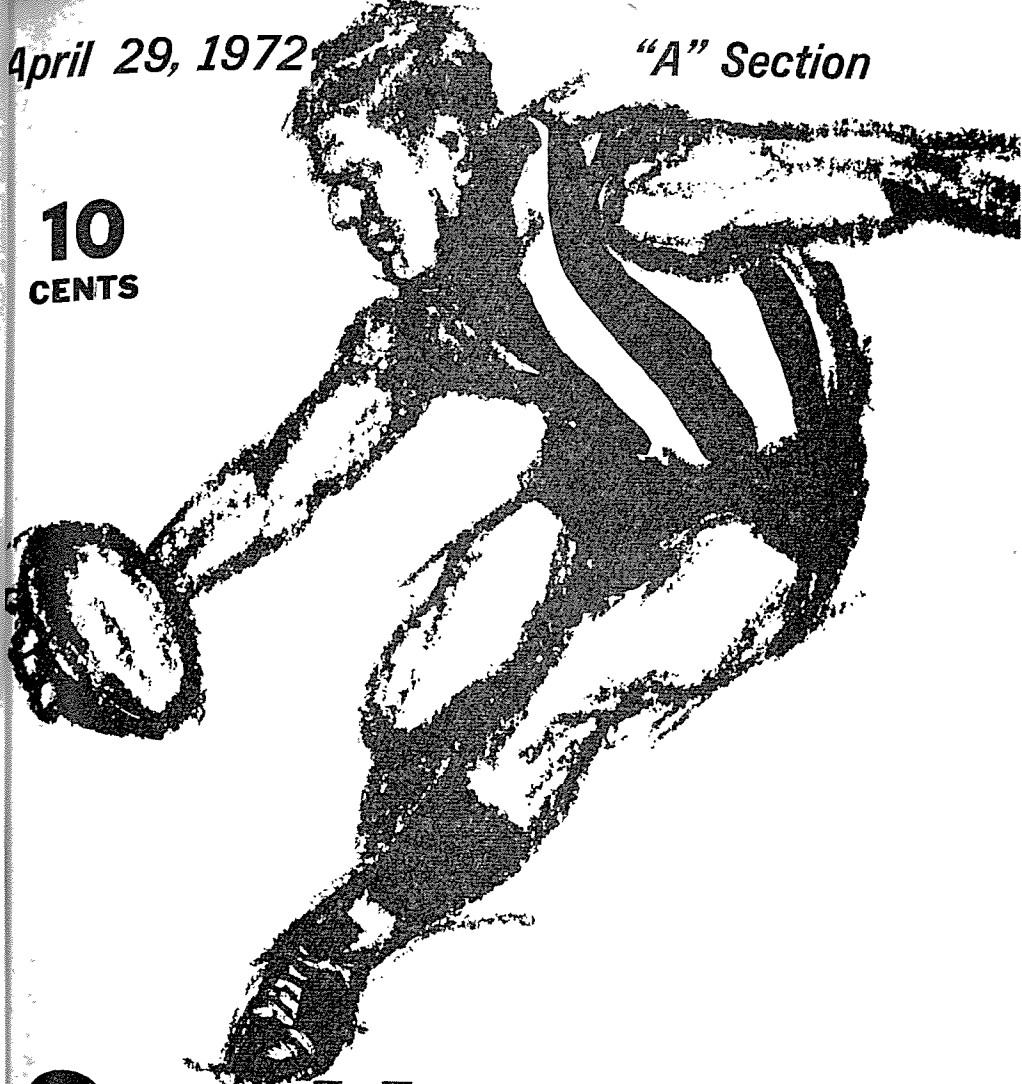

BLUES, ST. BERNARD'S, CRASH AGAIN FIVE TEAMS UNBEATEN, FIVE YET TO WIN

A peculiar situation has arisen in A Section after only two rounds of matches, with five teams having won both games and the other five having lost both.

University Blues and St. Bernard's, who finished second and third respectively last season, both failed badly again, St. Bernard's going down to the 1971 premiers, Ormond, by 73 points and the Blues losing to Caulfield Grammarians by exactly the same margin.

Melbourne High, two goals down to North Old Boys in the first round, were again involved in the closest match in the section, being beaten by four goals by Old Paradians.

Geelong, who pipped Old Trinity by a point the previous week, again figured in a close result, but this time went down by five points to Ivanhoe.

Four other games were decided by less than a goal, two of them by a point.

Ormond's superior forward work played a big part in their win over St. Bernard's. They led by 29 points at the interval but raced away in the third term to add 7 goals and put the result beyond doubt.

Caulfield Grammar were away to a good start against the Blues and held a substantial lead at the first change. They were stronger in the air and their much more accurate disposal on the forward line helped them to an 8-goal burst in the third term.

Melbourne High started well against Parade, who were off the target when they did settle down. But High faded out and Parade added 7 goals in the second quarter to lead by 32 points. High staged a determined finish and looked to have a chance but Parade steadied to win comfortably.

Coburg's strong centre-line and nippy rovers, together with their fast, play-on game was more than De La Salle could cope with, and after an even first term, Coburg went away to an easy win.

Monash Blues failed to take advantage of their opportunities in the first term and North Old Boys held them

out in the second quarter to lead by 15 points, Monash did little better after the interval and were beaten by 5 goals.

Inaccurate kicking for goal cost Geelong the game against Ivanhoe, who fought back to score narrowly after trailing by 10 points in the last quarter.

University Blacks scored a 3-goal win over Collegians, and but for inaccuracy in front of goal, could have won by much more, as they had 32 scoring shots to 19. Old Scotch beat Old Carey by more than 8 goals and Old Trinity thrashed Uni. High. Kew proved too strong for Tooronga-Malvern and won by 33 points.

Assumption beat St. Kilda CBC by 5 points in a high-scoring thriller and Old Haileybury beat Old Melburnians by 3 goals. Power House easily beat Fairfield, Reservoir Old Boys had more than 5 goals to spare over Old Xaverians, and National Bank scored from Commonwealth by a similar margin.

La Trobe Blacks won by a point from St. Pat's, but the other games in D Section were decided by clear-cut margins.

Marcellin overwhelmed Old Ivanhoe, kicking the big score of 34-11 (215 points) to Old Ivanhoe's 14-14. These teams met in the F Section Grand Final last year, when Marcellin won by 29 points. AJAX beat ANZ Bank by 17 points, but State Savings Bank and AMP Society had easy wins.

Old Mentonians, considered unlucky not to gain promotion to E Section, were well beaten by Old Camberwell, the margin being 6 goals, while Dookie beat North Brunswick by 11 points.

Parkside turned the tables on Hampton Scouts, who beat them for the Junior Section 2 premiership, winning narrowly by 5 points, while Power House beat Monash by 8 points.
