# NORTH OLD BOYS CAUSE BIG UPSET EASY WIN OVER COBURG

# Four Share Top Place, Six in B Section

North Old Boys caused probably the biggest upset of the season so far when they outplayed Coburg and scored an easy 40-point win.

Four teams are still undefeated, with Caulfield Grammarians heading the list on percentage. Ormond, Old Paradians and North Old Boys follow in that order.

In B Section, there are no less than six teams sharing top place, the previously unbeaten Old Scotch and Ivanhoe going down to Old Trinity and University Blacks respectively.

Marcellin had to lower their colours to Glenhuntly, who finished 23 points in front, thanks particularly to better shooting for goal.

The Blacks had 33 points to spare over Ivanhoe, and Old Carey had a narrow 4-point victory over Collegians.

Reservoir Old Boys retained top place with a 15-point margin against Assumption, but National Bank, previously unbeaten, went down by nearly 8 goals to Old Xaverians, who scored their first win, while Fairfield thrashed Old Melburnians to the tune of 50 points.

Old Brighton and La Trobe Blacks suffered their first defeats at the hands of Parkside and Old Geelong respectively, both of whom opened their accounts. Parkside won by 12 goals but the other was much closer, Old Geelong scoring by 13 points.

Brunswick's win over Alphington made them clear leaders of their Sec-

State Savings Bank are the only unbeaten side in E Section, as a result of their 15-point win over Old Ivanhoe, who suffered their second successive defeat.

Monash Whites were another leading team to be defeated, going down to Old Camberwell by more than 8 goals. St. Bede's opened their account in Amateur Football when they beat Old Mentonians by 9 points. It was

their greater accuracy which won it for them (14-9 to 11-18), and it was also Mentonians' second loss in a row.

Ormond gained revenge for their defeat in the 1971 Junior Section Grand Final when they overwhelmed University Blacks to win by over 10 goals. St. Bernard's beat Hampton Scouts by 7 points and Parkside beat Melbourne High by 11, while in Section 2, North Old Boys scraped home from Coburg by 5 points.

North's ability to score goals against the wind played a big part in their eclipse of Coburg, who managed only 2 points that way. North won on all lines, and rattled on 6 goals in the second quarter to lead by 29 points at the interval.

Coburg led by only 4 points at the final change and North raced away in the last term to add another five.

De La Salle matched things with Ormond for the first half and trailed by only 16 points, their dogged defence worrying Ormond a great deal.

But Ormond kicked 5 goals against the wind in the third quarter and it was all over. Ormond had most of the play in the last and should have won by a huge margin, but they kicked only 4-15 in this period. They still won by over 13 goals.

Although beaten across the centre, Caulfield Grammarians were much too strong generally for Melbourne High, who kicked only one goal from 12 scoring shots in the first half, and Caulfield won convincingly.

After an even first half, in which neither side used the wind to any great advantage, St. Bernard's finished too strongly for University Blues, kicking 4 goals against the wind in the last term to win by 35 points.

Old Paradians always looked the winners over Monash Blues, and were more than 8 goals ahead at the finish.

Old Trinity jumped to top place with their 19-point win over Old Scotch, and Geelong, who kicked 11 goals in the last quarter to beat Kew by almost this margin, moved up from seventh to second.




