### ● LAST WEEK'S HIGHLIGHTS

## ST. BERNARD'S THIRD LOSS IN A ROW BLACKS' THIRD TERM CARRIES THEM TO WIN CHANGES IN ONLY TWO OF THE FOURS

St. Bernard's suffered their third successive defeat when they went down by 29 points to University Blacks in the final round of home-and-home matches last Saturday.

The Blacks' 10-goal effort in the third quarter was too much for the now struggling St. Bernard's.

Of the six sections in which the composition of the final four was in doubt, four remained unaltered, but Commonwealth Bank (F Section) and Old Mentonians (E Reserve Section) lost their places to Footscray Tech. and North Brunswick respectively, and there was some internal reshuffling in some cases.

The Blacks trailed St. Bernard's by 11 points after a scramble first half, but rattled on 10.5 to three points in the third term, their high marking and play-on game being telling factors in their success.

St. Bernard's came back in the last quarter but could not bridge the gap.

An even more prolific quarter was De La Salle's 12 goals in the second term against Caulfield Grammarians, who kicked three — 15 goals for the term.

The third quarter at Elsternwick produced 13 goals — nine to North Old Boys and four to Marcellin, but in contrast, only one was scored in the last.

Old Trinity almost finished the season with a win — they looked set to "break the ice" when they led University Blues by 32 points at three-quarter-time but the Blues just got up in the last term to win by 2 points.

There were some desperation games in B Section — at the lower end of the ladder — in a bid to avoid relegation.

Collegians beat Old Melburnians easily, Old Haileybury beat Ivanhoe by 16 points and Geelong scored by a point from Old Paradians.

But Geelong's effort was in vain, as they finished ninth, 2.6% behind Mon-

ash Blues, both of them, with Collegians, having seven wins. Bottom team, St. Kilda CBC, won six games.

Ivanhoe's defeat cost them second place, which went to Reservoir Old Boys.

Parkside thrashed Old Xaverians, to hold their place on percentage from Old Ivanhoe, who beat AJAX by 23 points. Hampton Rovers, who appeared to be well in the running, crashed badly against Kew.

Old Camberwell made sure of their place with a big win over LaTrobe Blacks, denying Power House the chance to play in the finals.

Commonwealth Bank failed badly against Footscray Tech. and paid the penalty by losing their place in the four to Tech. Thornbury surprised by beating St. Bede's by 11 points.

In Junior games, University Blacks kicked 17-12 but were beaten by more than 10 goals — St. Bernard's kicked 27-13. University Blues had a 6-goal win over Old Scotch, but it wasn't enough to bridge the percentage gap to oust North Old Boys, who kept their place by .8%.

In the Reserves, North Brunswick's 4-goal win over West Brunswick took them into the four in place of Old Mentonians, whose poor percentage proved costly.

# PREVIEWING TODAY'S GAMES

## A SECTION

University Blacks showed up numerous flaws in the somewhat spasmodic St. Bernard's line-up which leads me to believe how premature my prediction was that St. Bernard's had made it after toppling North Old Boys a few weeks ago.

It's a crazy situation when the only team to have beaten North has found itself only a matter of weeks later struggling to justify its inclusion in the final four.

Ormond, by contrast, are finishing their work off nicely. Their potential depth with players like Shane Dove, Bruce Bourne, Jeff Russ, Rob Cameron, Kevin Ladd and Bruce Corben highlight that well-known Ormond machine.

Brilliant St. Bernard's skipper, Greg Wade, appears to be playing a lone hand in a side once studded with equally brilliant team mates.

I wonder if their astute coach "Gus" Mitchell has an answer to what must be his biggest dilemma for years?

Neither side is prolifically served in front of goals — Peter Thompson has been struggling this season for St. Bernard's and the adaptable Bruce Bourne with 40 goals rates second on a moderate goal-kicking list.

The game will therefore be won from opportunities created round the ground.

I fancy Ormond will win comfortably but caution prevails. St. Bernard's have always had the knack of blasting themselves out of trouble.

Ormond will survive the clash to avoid "mothballs" but not by that large margin that some might envisage. Rest assured the game will be well worth seeing — so don't stay away — Ormond to win by 11 points — JIM FIDGE.

## B SECTION

Ivanhoe or Old Paradians — A big question remains to be answered about today's contestants. Having both suffered convincing defeats at the hands of bottom sides last week, were these two taking things easily, or are they pretenders?

There remains a third possibility to which I, as an unsuccessful tipster am bound to subscribe — namely that the section is very evenly matched as one side with seven wins must drop to C Grade next year.

There is little doubt in my mind that Parade have a very experienced line-up with names like Ross Duke, John Jordon, John Tudor and Gerry Carroll who have all graced the turf in A grade finals, with many others carrying fine records in support. Against these men will be pitted Bill McWhinnie, the Stewart brothers, Charlie Stredwick and Graham Renshaw — all fine players, but

relatively unexperienced in the pressure of final games.

However, it is Steve Kohut, Parade's spring-heeled ruckman whom I believe will tip the scales, particularly if we are blessed with good playing conditions.

Both sides have built up a record for inconsistent performances of late, sufficient to match that of your correspondent. Without much conviction, I lean towards Old Paradians to come out narrow winners and live to fight another day.

Old Ivanhoe's bid to make the finals is to be commended — a win over AJAX was a tremendous finish for the season. A pity Old P's didn't put a few more games together earlier in the season — they could have been contenders for the flag.

Fawkner once again kicked the sweep and really stand out as the side to beat.

"C" Section have drawn two very good grounds for the semis.

The first will be a replay of last week, and the question is "Can Parkside do it again". Both teams have had troubles away from their home grounds and each have played in many finals with varied success.

I feel Old Xav's have slipped a bit and Parkside should go out chock full of confidence — I'm going for them to win this all important clash.

## UMPIRE'S CORNER

#### FIFTEEN METRES PENALTY

The 15 metre penalty is imposed when there is UNDUÉ DELAY and such delay is DELIBERATELY caused.

The player on the mark may be brought back not more than 15 metres:

1. If an opponent deliberately deprives the possession of the ball to the rightful player thereby causing undue delay.
2. If an opponent deliberately goes over a player's mark. The umpire must be aware that the opponent knew the correct spot for the mark (he probably told him) before the penalty is imposed;
3. If an opponent deliberately deprives possession of the ball to the rightful player by handing the ball from team mate to team mate and thereby unduly delays the return of the ball to the rightful player;
4. If an opponent deliberately holds a player who has been awarded a mark or free kick and thereby causes undue delay.
5. If an opponent deliberately knocks to the ground a player after he has been awarded a mark or free kick thereby deliberately causes undue delay to play.
6. If an opponent deliberately withholds the ball from the player who is to take the kick and causes undue delay by:
  - (a) retaining possession of the ball;
  - (b) throwing or rolling the ball away so that the rightful player has to cover unnecessary ground to retrieve it;
  - (c) knocking the ball from the hands of the player who is to take the kick;
  - (d) when in possession of the ball fails to make a genuine attempt to return the ball to the rightful player on the full.
7. Any other deliberate attempt to waste time or to deprive the rightful player of possession of the ball.

The penalty may be imposed in the case of a player being permitted to kick for goal after the first sound of the siren. It does not matter whether or not the field umpire has signalled to the timekeepers to add time as the penalty may be imposed at any time.

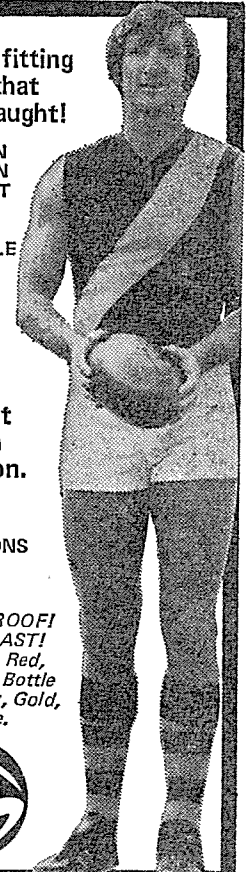

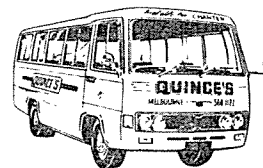

### ELIGIBILITY OF PLAYERS FOR RESERVE AND JUNIOR SECTION FINALS

The attention of clubs is drawn to the restrictions which apply concerning players eligible to take part in Final matches in the Reserve and Junior Sections.

The Rule relating to eligibility of players in Reserve Section Finals reads:—

A player who has been a member of a senior team of any club in nine or more matches during the home-and-home matches in any season shall not be eligible for inclusion in the reserve team of a club taking part in a final match in the same season unless both the senior and reserve teams are participating in a final match on the same day. Provided that no player shall be elig-

ible for inclusion in a reserve team taking part in a final match in any season unless such player has been a member of such reserve team in at least TWO home-and-home matches during the said season.

### JUNIORS

A player who has been a member of a senior or reserve team in more than five matches during any season shall be ineligible for inclusion in a junior team taking part in a semi-final, final or grand-final match in the SAME SEASON UNLESS he has been a member of the junior team for more than five matches in the same season.

In ALL matches the quarter-time interval must not exceed 3 minutes, the half-time interval (that is from the end of the second quarter to the commencement of the third quarter) must not exceed 15 minutes, and the three-quarter time interval must not exceed 5 minutes.

# ARRANGEMENTS FOR FINALS

Clubs taking part in the final series must arrange between themselves the following:—

- (a) Which club will wear black knicks and which white.
- (b) Which club will supply goal flags, time bell, numbers for scoring board, etc. Check with the home club of the ground being used whether these items are available.
- (c) Check with the home club of the ground being used regarding keys to dressing rooms.
- (d) EACH CLUB MUST PROVIDE ONE NEW BALL, the winners to have first choice of balls after the game.
- (e) EACH CLUB MUST PROVIDE a Goal Umpire's Coat (laundered).
- (f) EACH CLUB should arrange to provide its own boot last and hammer.

(a) EACH CLUB MUST BE PREPARED to supply a Boundary and Goal Umpire if required. (Independent Boundary and Goal Umpires may be supplied at some games.)
