NORTH, ORMOND SHARE LEAD — MEET TODAY

POOR KICKING COSTLY TO BLUES, "DE LA"

After three rounds, North Old Boys and Ormond are the only unbeaten teams in A Section, and they meet at Ormond today to decide outright leadership.

North were not altogether convincing in a hard game against De La Salle last week, although they finished well to win by 20 points, but shocking kicking for goal might well have cost "De La" the game — they had five more scoring shots than North.

University Blues also suffered from inaccuracy in front of goal, especially in the second half, and they went down to the Blacks by three points.

North looked the better side in general play but often broke down in attack, wasting the good work of players further afield, while De La Salle, who also failed to capitalise on the numerous chances they had, at least usually managed to score points.

De La Salle led by 10 points at three-quarter-time, and North had the use of wind in the last quarter. North levelled the scores, but then "De La" in a desperate bid for victory, tore forward in an inspired burst to goal and regain the lead.

They were playing the better football at this stage and looked as if they might take the game, but then North swung into action and went on to win well. North added 6 goals in the last term.

The Blues led the Blacks by 20 points at the interval, but kicked 3-13 in the second half, including 1-7 in the last quarter, to kick themselves out of it, and the Blacks scraped home.

Caulfield Grammar opened up a lead of nearly 8 goals over Marcellin in the first quarter and still led by 13

points at half-time. Marcellin kicked two valuable goals against the wind in the third term to trail by 26 points at the final change.

Marcellin added 5-7 to a point in the last quarter and finished 10 points in front.

Old Trinity were no match for Ormond and St. Bernard's completely overwhelmed Coburg.

Old Melburnians kicked 18-9 (117 points) against Old Scotch, but were beaten by 10 goals, Geelong beat St. Kilda CBC by 9 points, and Ivanhoe scored their first win when they beat Monash Blues by 16 points. It was Monash's first defeat.

Old Xaverians continued on their winning way with an 8-goal victory over Fawkner, Old Ivanhoe crushed Kew and AJAX had only 14 points to spare over Old Carey.

Alphington scored a big win over Old Camberwell to retain top place. They are up there alone now, as Old Geelong went down to Assumption by 16 points in a high-scoring game. Power House surprised St. Kevin's with a 19-point win and State Bank beat an inaccurate Elsternwick by 10 points.

Old Mentonians toppled AMP Society and West Brunswick crushed Heatherton. Commonwealth Bank's accuracy (15-5) gave them a 4-point win over St. Bede's (12-19).

In the Juniors, University Blacks shocked the Blues, winning by more than 6 goals and Monash University tossed the leaders, North Old Boys, by 29 points. Reservoir caused an upset in Section 2, beating the previously undefeated Caulfield Grammar by 9 points in a great game (23-10 to 20-19). It was Reservoir's first win. Fancy kicking 139 points and being beaten!

There were some upsets in the Reserves — De La Salle beat North, Old Melburnians beat Old Scotch, Hampton Rovers beat Melbourne High, Fawkner beat Old Xav's (all by big margins), Assumption beat Old Geelong, State Bank beat Elsternwick, West Brunswick beat Heatherton by a goal, A.M.P. beat Old Mentonians by a similar margin, and St. Bede's trounced Commonwealth Bank.

PREVIEWING TODAY'S GAMES

A SECTION

Last week we had a MATCH OF THE DAY at Elsternwick Park — Well done NOEL RUNDLE — today we have another.

University Blacks and Caulfield Grammarians — The Blacks surprised me last week and Caulfield let me down. It's a hard one to pick but Blacks experience on the wide Elsternwick oval could give them the points.

UMPIRE'S CORNER

As mentioned in last week's issue we are breaking away from the mere Rules and Interpretations of the Game and explanation of various interpretations, and bring you an interesting article on how fit the umpires must be and how this fitness is achieved.

Aussie Rules' football is one sport where the adjudicator, in this case the field umpire, must attain a high standard of physical and mental fitness.

It can be said — that in actual fact the umpire must reach a standard of physical fitness superior to that of the contestants.

When you consider sports such as cricket, soccer, tennis, baseball and hockey to mention but a few one may be correct in saying that this umpire being superior in fitness to the players is unique to "Aussie Rules".

A referee in boxing, tennis or soccer certainly does not achieve a standard of fitness superior to the contestants. This uniqueness is certainly something to ponder over.

UMPIRES AT TRAINING

Every Tuesday and Thursday evening since the beginning of March the field umpires have undergone a planned sequence of physical training which will equip them for the season ahead.

A typical Tuesday nights training in March would consist of:

1. 5 laps clockwise of the oval (jogging) last one done at brisk pace.
2. Series of selected exercises designed especially to develop speed, stamina, strength, mobility and power.
3. 10 "run throughs" down the ground gradually lengthening stride — jog back to start — continuous i.e. no rest.
4. 10 "down the ground" incorporating four or five 10-metre sprints, jog back to start alternating forward and backward running, continuous (no rest).
5. Three laps Indian File — last on file sprints up to front alternating inside and outside of file — last hundred metres all out sprint.
6. In pairs — 4 laps of the oval — $\frac{1}{2}$ lap jog, $\frac{1}{2}$ strong sprint, front pair drop off the rear, repeat with new leaders.
7. One jogging lap followed by one hard lap of oval.
8. Replace track suit and practice ball bouncing.

This is then followed by a warm shower and perhaps a short discussion or "hints seeking" by the umpires with the Umpire's Coach.

During the course of a game many problems arise for the umpire, upon which he must make an instant decision. Sometimes an explanation or chat with the advisor can help an umpire in future matches.

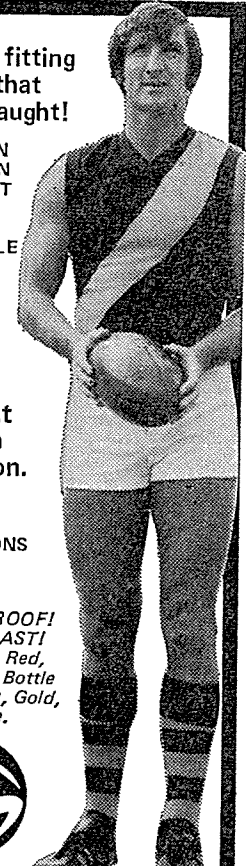

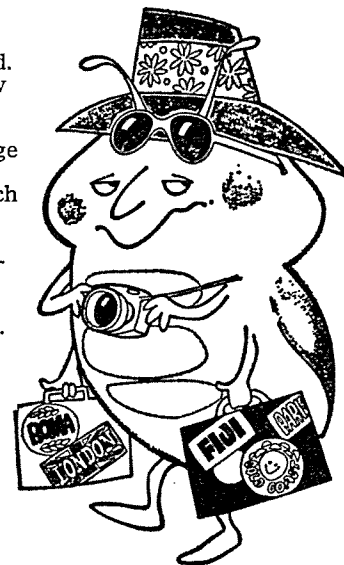


