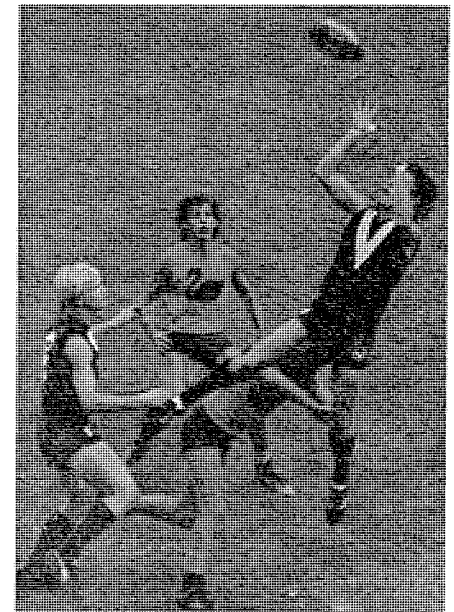

EDITORIAL

CONDITIONS AFFECT FINAL FOURS ORDER ORMOND SNEAK IN!

It seems that winter has really arrived and as the grounds become heavier and colds and 'flu' take their toll, the clubs that scored early premiership points can begin to reap some of the benefits. It is much harder to come from "down the list" in these conditions. Indeed in some Sections the four has taken on a decidedly settled look over the past couple of weeks, and the advent of less than ideal conditions.

Last week's "winning" (or is it non-losing?) margins ranged from 0 to 210 points with two "draws" being recorded — one in D Section, the other in Junior Section 3 — St. Bernard's (A) in Junior Section 1 registering a thirty-five goal win over Ivanhoe.

Another comfortable win was recorded by University Blues over their co-students the Blacks in A Section. St. Bernard's stayed with the leaders by virtue of their two point win over North Old Boys. A thirteen goal plus win by Ormond over A.J.A.X. enabled them to slip into the four while a seven goal win over Old Melburnians has allowed Marcellin to now entertain a slim hope of making the finals — they are certainly well clear of the relegation zone: though they must keep winning to maintain either of these hopes.

Kew's tendency of the B Section number one spot was short-lived, when they trailed Monash Blues all day before finally being defeated by twenty-three points. Collegians re-asserted themselves with a twenty point win over Fawkner in a very low-scoring game, whilst Old Xaverians and Old Scotch Collegians both had percentage boosting wins. Other winner — in another low-scoring game was Old Paradians, who seem to have decided that they wish to stay in B Section for another year.

The Elsternwick Park match last week saw the C Section leader Old Brighton inflict Bulleen-Templestowe's fifth consecutive defeat, the "luck of the draw" has allowed B-T. to hang on to fourth as their nearest rivals — Old Haileyburians, St. Kevin's and M.H.S. Old Boys were all similarly dealt with. Nothing is straightforward in C Section as the fifth match saw Old Trinity Gram. defeat Old Camberwell Gram. — and

so re-open the relegation stakes in earnest.

State Bank moved in third spot behind Old Carey Gram. on percentage following their narrow win over the second side in D Section last Saturday. St. Bede's were less fortunate as they could only manage a draw against ninth-placed A.M.P. Society. That draw and their own defeat by Heatherton has put country Colleges "in the hot seat" with regard to relegation now. Alphington dealt a crushing blow to Beverley Hills, the margin being over thirty goals.

In E Section the top four all recorded wins last week though none could be considered as really comfortable although three were against teams well down the list. The biggest winning margin in the Section was that of A.N.Z. Bank who over the past two weeks have made a concerted effort to avoid slipping back to F Section next year.

Following last Saturday's results the F. Section four has taken on a "new" look with three first year sides (Thomastown, Peninsula O.B. and Coolaroo Rovers) occupying the placings behind University Reds. Previous leader Thomastown led the Reds for three quarters last week but could not withstand a determined last term by the home side. Therry C.C.O.B., and Footscray I.T.O.B. moved a little closer — with narrow wins whilst Commonwealth Bank recorded a fifty point win in their game against Banyule.

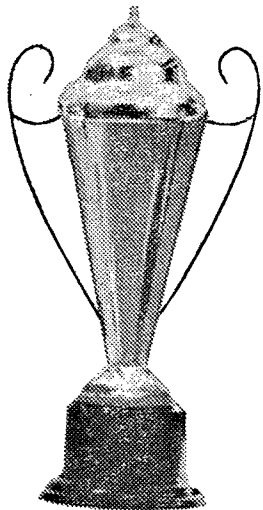

PREVIEWING TODAY'S GAMES

A SECTION

AJAX play host to St. Bernard's O.C. today. AJAX were again disappointing last week and now have the distinct possibility of being "the other" team to go down to B Section. St. Bernard's again had a good win last week and the conditions at present are suiting them. On the firm AJAX ground the game will not go quite their way all the time, but their overall strength will see them through to win well.

University Blacks meet Ormond at home this afternoon. Uni. Blacks were beaten rather well last week by Blues and will be looking to improve today. Allanson, Perrett and Christie have shown the way but it will need a full team to topple "The Monks" today. Ormond came back with a solid win last week and will certainly want to maintain that winning way, which seems to have eluded them over the past few weeks. If they are to make a concerted effort in the four, then a win today is a must. In a very close game, the winner possibly moving right into the four, I will go for Ormond.

The match of the day, which may be the prelude to the grand final, is between De La Salle O.C. and University Blues. De La got back into business last week, but on their home ground things may not be that easy.
