EDITORIAL

V.A.F.A. FORAY INTO SUNDAY FOOTBALL SOME BIG WINS AND SOME NOT SO BIG LAST SATURDAY

This weekend marks another adventure for the V.A.F.A. with the playing of a home-and-away game at Elsternwick Park on Sunday.

The introduction of Sunday Grand Finals in 1978 met with tremendous success, which was emulated in 1979. The large followings enjoyed by both Ormond and AJAX should ensure that this weekend's games are similarly successful affairs. It should be noted that "normal" conditions for a first round match will prevail. There will be no special allowances made to either club because it is a Sunday rather than a Saturday.

Whilst there are no further Sunday matches planned for the first round at this time, it must be reasonable to assume that if this weekend proves to be as entertaining as it is hoped, then the Elsternwick Park Fixture Committee will be eager to repeat the idea at a later date in the season.

This is a fine chance for all clubs in the V.A.F.A. to see a normal (as opposed to final) "A" Section match and it is hoped that all clubs will be well represented. The standard of football played in "A" Section is exceptionally high and clubs from the other sections can only benefit from observing such a game. The display of skill and speed will be further enhanced if the day should prove to be fine and calm.

"Calm" is certainly not the best adjective possible to describe the conditions that prevailed almost uniformly last weekend. A blustering northerly wind had a devastating effect on many of the games played — as even a cursory glance at the quarter-by-quarter scores will indicate.

Accuracy was not a feature of the day's scoring — though some notable exceptions were Marcellin (A Section), Kew (B Section) and Old Haileyburians (Junior Section 1).

The "big" scores of last Saturday were notched up by Clayton and Thomastown, both of F Section, and by Banyule in Junior Section 3. Each of these teams scored in excess of thirty goals. There was a bit of "tit-for-tat" in the Clayton/Banyule scoring as in both sections these two sides were opposed. It is

interesting to note also that in each case the high scorer was the visiting team. So much for the supposed home ground advantage!

At the other end of the winning margins scale several teams "got home" by less than one straight kick. In B Section Old Xaverians trailed Monash Blues by 13 points at the last change but kicked 6.4 to 4.2 in the last term to secure their one-point win.

In C Section MHS Old Boys staved off a determined last quarter bid by Old Trinity to score by one goal — Trinity booted 8.1 in the term as against the Old Boys' 4.2.

Scores were level at three-quarter time in the D Section match between Heather-ton and Power House. Final term accuracy won the game for Heather-ton — they recorded 3.1 whilst Power House could only manage 2.6 from 8 scoring shots.

ANZ Bank led Mentone Old Boys by a goal at the last change in their E Section encounter but could not hold out and finally lost by the same margin.

In A Reserve University Blues were unable to bridge the 13-point gap AJAX had opened up by three-quarter time. The final siren saw AJAX still two points up.

PREVIEWING TODAY'S GAMES

A SECTION

De La Salle play host at Waverley Oval today to Ivanhoe. De La Salle last week again proved too strong for their opposition and should account for Ivanhoe today. The battle of the University sides should prove a very interesting tussle indeed. Both teams are undefeated and Blacks may now be running into a bit of form after a slow start. Marcellin O.C. take on Old Melburnians out at Bulleen today. Although Marcellin have lost both their opening games, they have not been disgraced and again should acquit themselves well. Dillon, Fitt and Price have been playing consistently well and with their "sticking power" may prove a handful for the OM's backs. The Old Melburnians came back with a good win last week and are now starting to combine well. With Simon Trumble playing the ever-reliable game in the back-line and Tony Lester getting kicks around the ground, they will prove just too strong in a very even struggle.

On Sunday AJAX play Ormond at Elsternwick Park. AJAX put up a good performance against league-leaders University Blues last week and AJAX's coach, Sid Myers, should be relatively happy. He will be looking however for a win to start getting the percentages AJAX's way. Ormond started their list of wins for 1980 last week and will try to keep going where they left off. Morris, Bourne and Dove are doing well and will have to again play well if they are to keep the smaller, faster AJAX boys from getting too many possessions in a close game. I will go for AJAX.

Last Saturday's results have served to show no side can be over confident of taking the points. A typically even season can be expected. Today's games should give further strength to this line of thinking.

Two winners last week, Collegians and Fawkner, meet on the Harry Trott Oval.

This season Collegians have done everything asked of them by coach Bruce Ferguson. In winning their two games they have had a reliable avenue to goal through Parsons. A disadvantage to Fawkner could well be the big ground. They play their best football when play can be closely contested. I favour Collegians on their own ground to take the honours, largely through quick ball movement.

If Rodger continues to dominate their forward line today, Kew coach Hayes could be forced to return to his practice match theory and play Blay in defence. Although such a move would upset Kew, I believe their strength and skill will enable them to defeat Monash Blues.
