## The First Sunday Match for 1982 A Look at Week Two

**This weekend sees the first of the V.A.F.A.'s scheduled Sunday 'A' Section matches at Elsternwick Park. The results so far have, however, altered the anticipated character of the chosen match as neither Old Xaverians nor University Blues (the protagonists) has yet been able to defeat its opponent on the field. In fact, to date neither has even looked like posing a threat.**

Last Saturday both trailed all day before finally losing; the Blues to the Blacks by thirty-eight points and Old Xaverians at the hands of Ormond, by thirty-four points. In other matches, A.J.A.X. remained unbeaten by virtue of their twenty-seven point win over Old Scotch. North Old Boy's sustained a final team foray to increase a four point lead to twenty-three points at the siren in their match against De La Salle whilst Collegians twenty-one point victory over Marcellin saw them return to where they should have started from.

Newcomer to **B Section**, Bulleen Templestowe have started the season well with two big wins — last week's against their 1981 stumbling block Alphington who were unable to keep pace with B-T's after half-time. Old Melburnians also enjoyed their second big victory in as many games with a seventy-three point win over Old Brighton.

Old Paradians returned to "square one" at the expense of Kew, whilst Ivanhoe capitalised on last week's points-reversal even though held goal-less by St. Bernard's in the final quarter. Monash Blues' nineteen point win over Caulfield enabled them to draw level.

**C Section** provided a very mixed bag of results — with only four points separating Hampton Rovers and Geelong whilst the margin between St. Kevin's and Old Haileyburians was sixteen goals greater. Coburg opened its score with a thirty-nine point win at the expense of M.H.S.O.B. West Brunswick led Old Camberwell until the third quarter but could not sustain the effort, whilst St. Kilda held Fawkner goal-less for two terms on the way to recording their eighty-nine point win.

The "big winner" in **D Section** was St. Bede's OC to the cost of University Reds

who failed to maintain their first match promise. The team who failed to capitalize the most was Old Ivanhoe, who had registered twenty scoring shots to nil at the end of the first term — but only led by forty-five points. The other winners were St. Pius, North Brunswick and State Bank — all by comfortable margins.

The **E Section** honours went to Old Carey Grammar who were nearly twenty-nine goals too good for ANZ Bank. The "excitement" of the week was provided by the Elsternwick/Balaclava encounter. Only one point separated these two going into the final term. Both sides kicked erratically in this term with Elsternwick offending less often. Thornbury "got home" by sixteen points from Therry, whilst Banyule drew away from Old Trinity after half time. The final match saw Thomastown "turn the tables" on first round leader Old Mentonians.

In **F Section**, U.H.S.O.B. scored a comfortable win over Old Geelong, after a closely fought first half. Other matches saw Brunswick, Commonwealth Bank, Bulleen United and Footscray take the points — all with apparent ease.

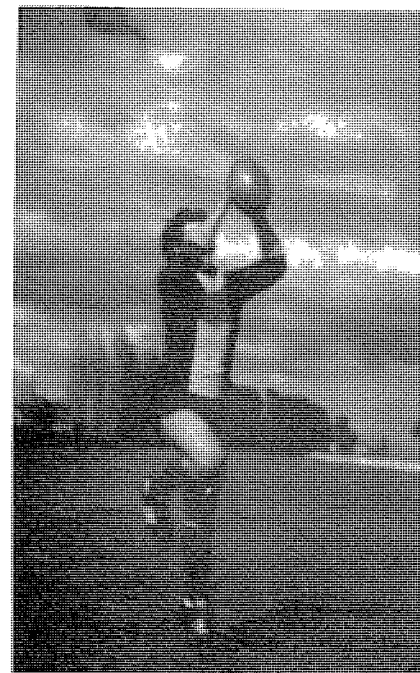
