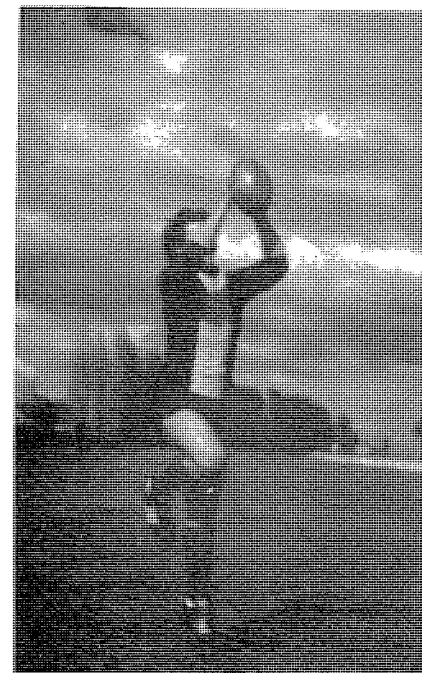

## Under 19's Stage Assault on Scoreboards

The third week of competition again saw the Under 19 teams dominate the scoreboard, which augurs well for the forthcoming encounter with the Victorian Football Association under-age side. Top honours went to Ivanhoe in Junior 2 who notched double figure goal tallies in three of the four terms. This section also had Monash Blues and Banyule register in excess of twenty-five goals.

In Junior Section One, each of the successful sides scored over twenty goals, with the Melbourne University side heading the list, narrowly ahead of Ormond and De La Salle. Old Scotch Collegians experienced the most-spirited opposition from Bulleen-Templestowe. Only three points separated the two at three-quarter time, but Old Scotch kicked away thereafter and, by the end, had established a twenty-seven point margin.

Old Camberwell Grammarians in Junior Section Three recorded a better-than two hundred point win over Old Ivanhoe. The antithesis was provided by Fawkner and Old Melburnians, who, after a match of fluctuating fortunes, could not be separated. After a slow start, Bulleen United kicked twenty-eight goals after quarter time, to win by nearly thirty from Heatherton.

In A Section, North Old Boys unwittingly emulated the feats of so many of the Juniors by recording a twenty-goal plus win over former section co-leader A.J.A.X. Marcellin O.C. were able to widen the gap between themselves and the other leader Ormond at each interval finally winning by twenty-one points.

A seven-goal burst by Old Paradians (in B Section) enabled them to establish a match-winning lead over Old Brighton Grammarians. Conversely, Alphington and Ivanhoe engaged in a see-sawing battle which culminated in a two-point win to Alphington.

In C Section each of the victors achieved three figures — a feat copied by only one of the losers: Fawkner. Indeed, their opponent — Hampton Rovers — could really only be considered as "still in the game" at three-quarter time by virtue of their very accurate kicking till then (coupled with Fawkner's inaccuracy).

Similarly accurate until the same point in the game were St. Bede's O.C. (D Section) who were also scoring goals at a rate of (almost) two for one. Eight goals to one in the second term saw Assumption O.C. well on the way to their one hundred and one point win over Heatherton. University Reds looked set to record another win — until the latter stages of the final term when St. Pius ran riot and snatched a three goal lead in equal time.

Thornbury held A.N.Z. Bank goalless in the last quarter of their E Section match and kicked fourteen goals themselves to score their two hundred point win and a healthy percentage boost. Thomastown posted sixteen goals ten to draw right away from Banyule after the long interval.

In F Section Clayton turned a three-quarter time deficit of seven points into a winning margin of similar dimensions in their match against Peninsula Old Boys. A fourteen goal win to Footscray I.T.O.B. has taken them to the top of their Section ahead of Bulleen United, who are also undefeated (and have yet to encounter the "bye").

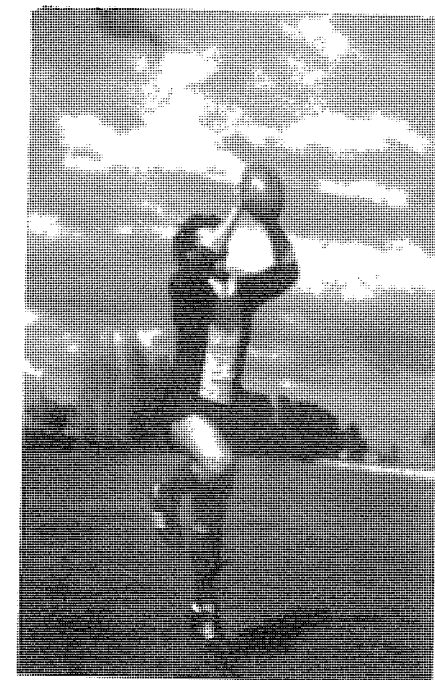
