

## A Hotch-Potch of Results and Margins

The match of the day in A Section last weekend was between De La Salle and Ormond - second and third respectively on the ladder at the beginning of their match. The end of the day saw De La Salle consolidate second whilst Ormond had slipped to fourth - and could thank Old Xaverians' inaccuracy that they were still in the top echelon. De La held the ascendancy at each of the intervals, managing to increase their lead each term. Similarly, Collegians held sway over AJ.A.X. at the breaks in their Mother's Day encounter at Elsternwick Park. This match was marred by final quarter inaccuracy though. Only ten points separated the teams at the third break and as each struggled to assert its supremacy, accuracy was replaced by doggedness. AJ.A.X. could only muster four behinds whilst Collegians did manage to convert two of their ten scoring shots and emerge twenty-six point winners.

Old Xaverians failed to capitalize on their chance to slip into the four when they notched thirty-three behinds (eighteen before half time) in their encounter with University Blacks. Marcellin nust consider themselves a little lucky to have taken the points from University Blues who were finishing on much the stronger of the two. Again, inaccuracy led to many of Marcellin's troubles: they kicked one six in the third term. North Old Boys had no trouble in dealing comprehensively with Old Scotch after the first quarter (scoring twenty-two goals to nine between then and full time) and thus affirming their hold on the number one spot.

In 'B' Section, Ivanhoe proved the value of precision in front of the goals when they scraped home by the narrowest margin from Kew. This game had seen fortunes fluctuate throughout, with a different leader at each change. Kew led by fourteen points into the last quarter and each recorded five scoring shots in the period - Ivanhoe's four one swinging the points in their favour. In each of the other matches, honours were nearly even until half time but became a bit one-sided thereafter. Probably most surprising was the fourteen goal defeat Old Melburnians inflicted on Bulleen-Templestowe, who had trailed by only nineteen points at the long interval. The third quarter proved its importance again and again last week as it was here that St. Bernard's, Monash Blues and Alphington all achieved their match-winning leads.

Old Camberwell Gram. snatched top billing. on the **C Section** ladder with a twenty-five goal win over Fawkner. In fact previous leader St. Kevin's O.B. and Old Camberwell swapped places. St. Kilda C.B.O.C.'s thirteenthree win over Hampton Rovers was

sufficiently large for them to maintain second place ahead of SKOB's who took three and a half quarters to establish their will over Geelong, at Queen's Park. West Brunswick gradually wore Coburg down to record their first win of the year by fourteen points. The Melbourne High — Old Haileyburians match was all over at half time: the two sides scoring identically in the second half.

Old Ivanhoe Gram. maintained its superiority in **D Section**, albeit narrowly, when they defeated State Bank by eight points after trailing by nearly three goals at half time. Narrow wins — but important — were also recorded by Parkside (home by five points from St. Bede's) and Assumption O.C. who turned a three-quarter time deficit of one point into a credit of two points at the final siren. Percentage-boosting (and position improving) wins were scored by University Reds and North Brunswick over Power House and Heatherton respectively.

Similarly, in **E Section**, only Thomastown remain undefeated, though their ninety-one point win over Balaclava was not enough to maintain their two hundred plus percentage figure. Banyule's four goal defeat of Old Mentonians enabled them to move into third place despite their relatively lowly percentage. All results in this section were in fact by comfortable margins — the other winners being Old Carey Gram., Elsternwick and Therry.

**F Section** is still a bit difficult to follow because of the "Bye" though some trends are starting to develop. The "powers" at this stage are Commonwealth Bank and Brunswick, followed fairly closely by Bulleen United and Clayton.




