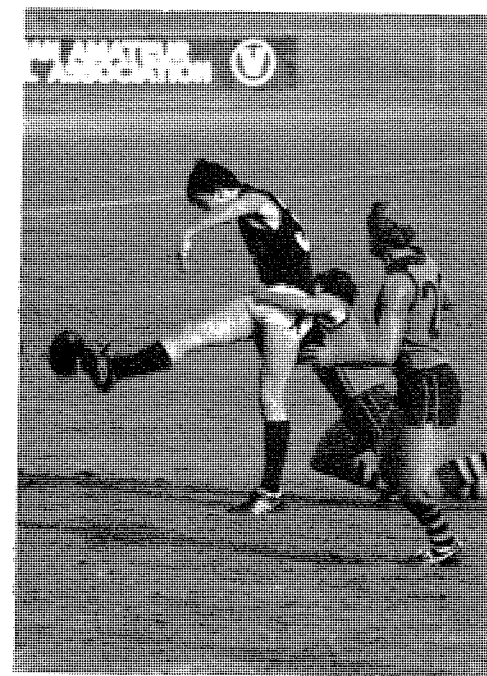

Accuracy Proves Its Worth Yet Again

ONLY THREE SENIOR TEAMS UNDEFEATED

The completion of the first five weeks of the Season sees only three Senior sides undefeated: Old Camberwell Grammarians and St. Kevin's Old Boys — C Section and Old Ivanhoe Grammarians in D Section. Old Camberwell achieved their place in the list by disposing of another contender for the "unbeaten" title — St. Kilda C.B.O.C. — by nearly ten goals. St. Kevin's assumed second place on the ladder — and closed the percentage gap on Old Camberwell when they their past players day with a nineteen goal win over Fawkner. The C Section thriller was between M.H.S. Old Boys and Hampton Rovers with the three point margin favouring M.H.S.O.B. at the final siren. Perhaps thirty scoring shots as against thirty-seven provides an adequate comment on this result. Old Haileyburians opened their 1982 account with a seven goal win over West Brunswick. (This was O.H.'s first win since the middle of the 1981 season), whilst the final match saw Coburg record a similar win over Geelong and so stay in touch with the leading group.

In A Section, the biggest winning margins were recorded by North Old Boys in Sunday's Elsternwick Park fixture and Marcellin O.C. — the two sides now first and second respectively on the ladder. A goalless second term and an inaccurate third term probably cost De La Salle the chance to stay with the leaders. They were finally defeated by five goals — by University Blues — but should have led by a lot more than three points at the first change. Collegians' three goal win over Old Scotch Collegians was enough for them to move into the form ahead of A.J.A.X. (at the expense of Ormond) who had only nine points to spare in their match against Ormond.

Old Brighton Grammarians also began their 1982 points tally when they overpowered Ivanhoe in the final term, kicking 8.1 to 2.5 and winning by eight points. The B Section match at Elsternwick Park on Saturday resulted in a twenty point win to Alphington — a victory aided perhaps by the final term inaccuracy of Kew, whose scoring flurry netted only 4 goals 8 behinds. Another result effected by last quarter inaccuracy was the draw between Monash Blues and St. Bernard's O.C. The Blues led by twenty seven points into the last term and added 3.2 but St. Bernard's stormed home — adding 7.5 to level the scores at 119 apiece in their second cliff-hanger for the season. Top of the ladder Old Melburnians and Bulleen-Templestowe each recorded steady wins: OM's by 32 points over Caulfield and B.T.'s by 11 points over Old Paradians who were finishing on but kicked themselves out of contention (again!).

In D Section undefeated Old Ivanhoe notched a sixty-one point win over previously third placed St. Bede's O.C. who subsequently

slipped to fifth place — behind Parkside on points and North Brunswick and University Reds on percentages. The Reds moved into the four by virtue of their run-away eighty-seven point win over Assumption, whilst North Brunswick "held on" because they were defeated by St. Pius by only ten points. In the other matches, Power House and Heatherton were unable to counter Parkside (who scored by 6 goals) and State Bank (who scored by 7 goals).

Therry C.C.O.B. proved again the value of steady goal shooting when they beat E Section leader Thomastown by twenty-seven points, with three less scoring shots. Eight goals to one in the final term enabled Banyule to defeat Balaclava and keep on level terms with the leaders. Old Carey Grammarians came from behind at three-quarter time to win by sixteen points and so stay near the top, whilst Thornbury led Old Mentonians all day and were able to slip into fourth spot on percentage due to their sixty-nine point winning margin. The battle to "break the ice" was won by Old Trinity Grammarians in very handsome style (over A.N.Z. Bank).

The F Section top four are separated by percentage — although the top two — Brunswick and Bulleen United have got to be accredited with "Bye" points. These two both recorded comfortable wins last week, as did fourth-placed U.H.S.O.B. — Brunswick scored by ten goals over La Trobe University whilst eight goals separated Bulleen and Peninsula O.B. and U.H.S.O.B. doubled the points score of St. John's O.C. Monash Whites notched its second win for the year at the expense of previously fourth-placed Footscray I.T.O.B. and Old Geelong bounced back from last week's loss to defeat Clayton by forty-nine points.

LOOKING BACK

5 YEARS AGO — 1977

1976 grand finalists **St. Bernard's O.C.** and **North Old Boys** played at Elsternwick Park for the **John Adams & Geoffrey Tobin Perpetual Trophy**. Both clubs joined the Association in 1963, with St. Bernard's winning its first "A" Section flag when it defeated North in 1975, and North reversed the result in 1976 to win its first flag. The trophy was provided by John Adams (North) and Geoff Tobin (St. Bernard's) who were the respective captains in 1963 and both of whom later became President of their respective clubs.

North Old Boys justified their position at the top of the ladder when they overwhelmed St. Bernard's by 57 points. **Conti, Hall** and **Leeack** starred for the victors while **G. Wade, Nadzielski** and **Drennan** battled hard for the losers.

Old Carey, with only one win to its name in "C" caused a surprise when they inflicted first defeat on **Old Xaverians** by 16 points, final scores: 10.29 to 10.13. At the last change Old Carey had scored 5.24. Best were **Cooke, Andrews, Curnow** (Old Carey) and **Romanin, O'Neill, Nankervis** (Old Xaverians).

10 YEARS AGO — 1972

Ormond showed their 1971 premiership win was no fluke when they completely out-classed a very disappointing **Coburg** to romp home easy winners by 98 points. Best were **Burney, Wood, Swan** (Ormond) while **Ebbage, Willoughby** and **Leckie** battled hard for Coburg.

In three of the five "C" Section games both sides reached the century — **R.O.B.** (132) (Best **Bates, Trevascus** and **F. Ruininga**) d **St. Kilda CBC** (103) (Best, **Casey, Clinch, Esmonde**); **Assumption O.C.** (142) (**O'Donnell, Faulkner, Leorke**) d **Old Melb.** (101) (**Dick, Niemann, Snellman**); **Fairfield** (104) d **Old Xaverians** 100 (**McKenzie, Naughton, Howard**).

Caulfield Grammarians held a dinner at the M.C.G. to honour 11 years of coaching by **John Wilson**, covering 1961 to 1971 during which Caulfield won two pennants, D Section, 1961 and A Section 1970.

100 games to **Assumption's** "Mercurial Wizard", **Graeme Howard**, **'Rocket' Rod Brown** (Old Melb.), **Paul "Stooge" Nugent** (Assumption), **Bernie Sheehy** (North O.B.), **Rod De Boos** (Old Trinity), **Laurie Sheehan** (St. Kilda C.B.C.), **Geoff Lyons** (De La Salle) and 200 games to **Ormond's Graeme ('Lumpy') Moran**.

15 YEARS AGO — 1967

Coburg suffered their first defeat — victors were **Univ. Blacks** by 45 points with **Millner** (6 goals) a star. In 'B' Section **North Old Boys** won their first game at the expense of **Ormond**, previously undefeated.

100 games to **John MacKenzie** (Old Scotch) and **Ian Brown** (Old Geelong). Among the notes "what an asset **Kevin Heath** is to Assumption **Old Collegians** — 22 marks to half-time, and another 18 kicks in second half".

30 YEARS AGO — 1952

Champion full forward, **Duncan Anderson** kicked 12 goals for **University Blues** (20.16) who defeated **Old Paradians** (9.13). **Commonwealth Bank** (9.14) scraped in from **Hampton Rovers** (9.12).

Stars for **Ivanhoe** in a big win over State Savings Bank were **Jim** and **Jack Neeson**, **Ken Aldred** and **John Manuell**.

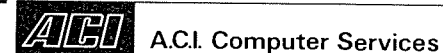

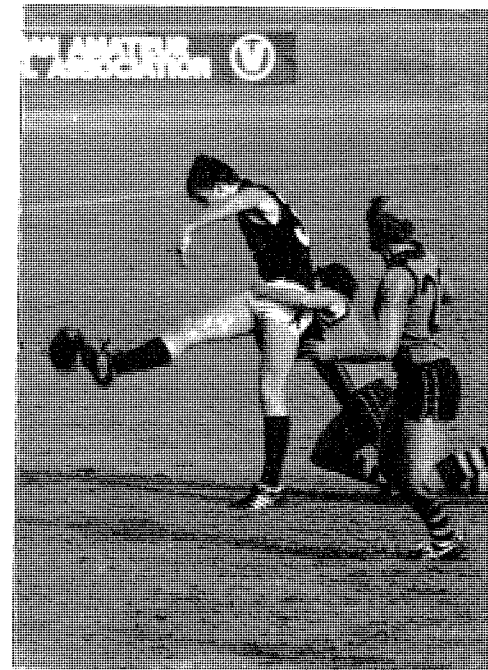
