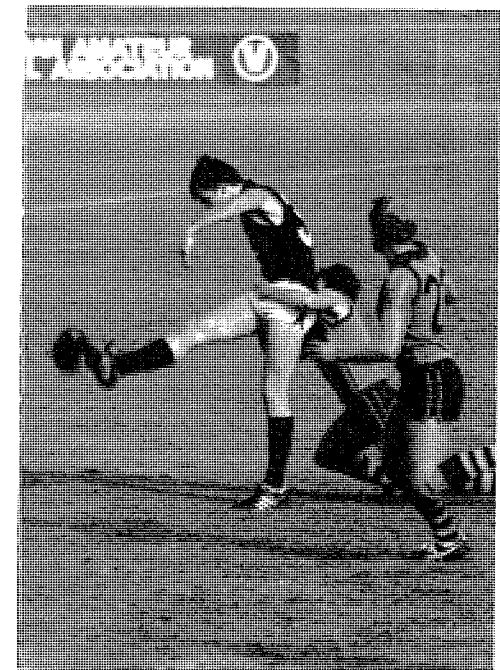

Cooke**, **M. Yeo** (Old Carey). Coach was **Peter O'Donohue** with **Brian Lauder** as manager and **John Butcher** as assistant.

### 10 YEARS AGO — 1972

200 games to **John (Herb) Adams** (North Old Boys) and 100 to **John Butcher** (Caul. Gram.).

End of an era for **Old Haileyburian** when veteran **Andrew Home**, 205 games in 12 years played his last game. In his 12 years **Andrew** only missed 8 games, none of which was due to injury.

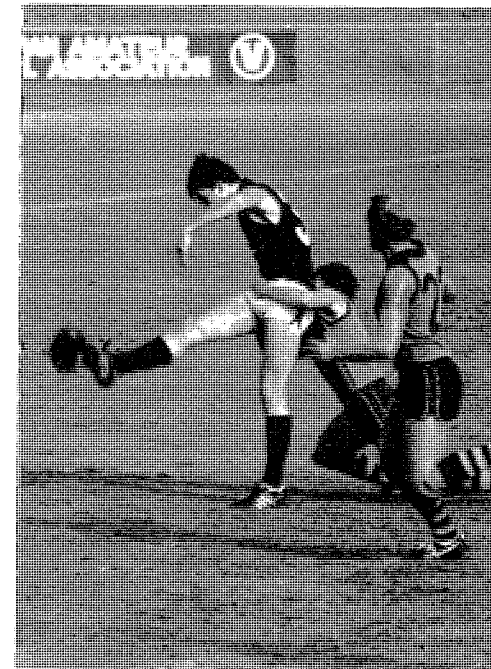
