

Amateurs upset VFA by 20 pts

The Victorian Amateurs produced a strong finish to score a surprise 20-point win over the VFA at Sandringham last Sunday.

The VFA looked to have a slight edge for most of the day, but had no counter to the Amateurs' last-quarter burst which yielded 10.3 to 5.2 to climax a fast and entertaining game.

It was the first match between the two bodies, although the VFA had met a combined Australian Amateur side before.

The VFA was first into attack but the Amateurs hit back for the first goal before Port Melbourne veteran Fred Cook hit the post. Two quick goals and the VFA led by 15 points.

The rest of the quarter was goal for goal, with the VFA 10 points in front at quarter-time.

The VFA built its lead to 23 points early in the second quarter, but the Amateurs fought back strongly to cut the deficit to five points.

In a see-saw period of play the lead changed hands three times. It was fast football with both sides throwing everything into it. Two quick goals gave the VFA a 10-point lead at the interval, but the game was still wide open.

Excessive handball and ineffective short passing nullified many of the Amateurs' advances, but they still managed to hold the VFA to a lead of 11 points at the last change.

Early in the last quarter two goals put the Amateurs in front and then a free to Ian Cordner close in and a goal to Jennings opened up a 13-point gap.

The Amateurs were finishing very strongly and confidently, while the VFA appeared to be tiring. However, the VFA still managed to reduce the Amateurs' lead from 20 to eight points with a couple of quick goals and once again the game was in the balance.

But the Amateurs steadied and two goals regained their decisive 20-point lead.

5 YEARS AGO -- 1977

Coach **Shane Maguire** returned to the **North Old Boys** team. (I think it was Shane's first comeback but certainly not his last. N.R.)
