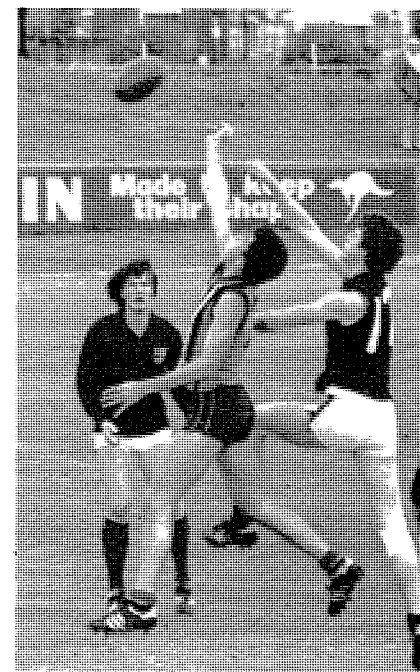

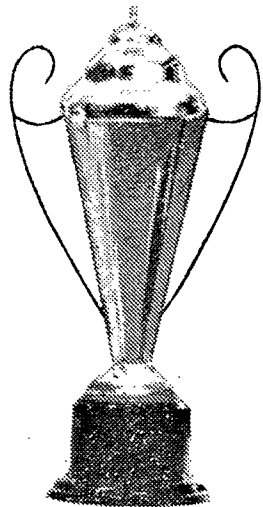

## ELIGIBILITY

The following extracts from the "Rules of the Association" are published to remind Club Secretaries of the requirements regarding player eligibility for the final series as passed at the V.A.F.A. Members' Meeting on 1st November, 1980.

- Rule 13. Grades shall be the categories of the premiership competition matches in which a player may be eligible to represent a Club.
- Rule 14. The Grades shall be the Senior Grade, the Junior Grade, and, the Reserve Grade.
- Rule 15. The first\* and second† rounds of the Senior Grade shall be open to all eligible and registered players to represent the Club with which they have been granted a permit.
- Rule 16. The first round of the Junior Grade shall be open to all eligible and registered players who have not attained the age of 19 years on or before the 31st December of the preceding year.
- Rule 17. The second round of the Junior Grade shall be open to all eligible and registered players within the age limits prescribed in Rule 16 to represent the Club with which they have been granted a permit provided that a player who has represented a Club in an aggregate of more than five matches in the Senior Grade and Reserve Grade in the first round in any season shall not be eligible unless he has represented such Club in more than five matches in the first round of the Junior Grade in the same season.
- Rule 18. The first round of the Reserve Grade shall be open to all eligible and registered players to represent the Club with which they have been granted a permit.
- Rule 19. The second round of the Reserve Grade shall be open to all eligible and registered players to represent the Club with which they have been granted a permit provided that no player shall be eligible to represent a Club unless such player shall have represented such Club in at least two matches of the Reserve Grade in the first round in the same season and further provided that no player shall be eligible to represent a Club after having represented such Club in more than eight matches of the Senior Grade in the first round in the same season unless such Club shall be represented in a match of the second round of the Senior Grade on the same day. In the event of a draw taking place in a match in the second round of the Reserve Grade, all players who took part in the drawn game shall be eligible to take part in the game to be replayed.
- Rule 20. Notwithstanding anything herein contained in these Rules a player shall not be eligible to play —  
(i) In any Grade whilst under suspension by the Independent Tribunal.  
(ii) In any Grade pending investigation by the Independent Tribunal of any charge against such player unless the Independent Tribunal otherwise orders.
- \*Rule 35. The first round shall be the home and home matches in which each team shall be scheduled to play every other team twice provided that this may be varied by the Executive Committee to meet the exigencies of the number of Clubs represented in a Section.
- †Rule 39. The second round shall comprise the first semi-final match, second semi-final match, preliminary final match and grand final match in each Section. Any drawn match shall be replayed.

## LOOKING BACK

### 5 YEARS AGO — 1977

Coburg caused a real surprise in "A" when after scoring only three goals in the two previous games they finished 15 points ahead of the Blues who had the chance to make themselves safe from relegation. Best were Royal, P. O'Brien, McAuliffe (Cob.) and Hager, Carroll, Standish (Blues).

Old Paradians (3rd, in B Section) kicked themselves to a 5 point defeat against Old Scotch (1st) who won by 8 points, 8.7 (55) to 5.17 (47). Best were Currie, Morgan, Rogerson (Old Scotch) and J. Assetta, T. Considine, Lyons (Old Parad.).

Hampton Rovers (5th in C Section) kept their final four hopes alive when they annihilated A.J.A.X. (3rd), 22.15 to 9.10. Best for Rovers were Slattery, Tregear, and Blair.

Ally Bolger celebrated his 200th game with Parkside Rovers against Fawkner. In a quite remarkable performance Ally failed to get a kick; however his club didn't let him down as they defeated the previously unbeaten Fawkner Reserves team. The "scribe" reported that Ally, a life member (twice) had seen better seasons but was still trying.

### 10 YEARS AGO — 1972

Upsets were the order of the day when Old Trinity and Ivanhoe joint leaders in 'B' Section, were both beaten. Old Trinity finished strongly against Old Scotch, but went down by 9 points. Anderson, Kefford, Duffy (Scotch) and Just, Macaw, C. Fellows, (Trinity) were best.

University Blacks, trailing Ivanhoe by 3 points at the last change, kicked 6.3 to 2.2 in the last quarter. C. Corder, McLean, Moffatt (6 goals) for the Blacks and Robinson, Berry and Hughes (Ivanhoe) starred.

'A' Section coaches were John Caspars (Caulfield Gramm.), Alan Salter (Coburg), Ken Purcell (De La Salle), "Jocka" Nelson (M.H.S.O.B.), Clyde Laidlaw (Monash Blues), Bob Spurling (North Old Boys), Ted Farrell (Ormond), John Booth (Old Paradians), Gus Mitchell (St. Bernard's) and Barry Johnston (Univ. Blues).

The umpires bade farewell and thanks to Joe Jamieson who had looked after them so well at Elsternwick for some years, and had also greatly assisted the Association.

200 games to Hampton Rovers veteran Dave "Brickie" Fullagar who joined the juniors in the late fifties and had given great service to the club.

### 15 YEARS AGO — 1967

Collegians stopped Kew's winning run of 5 games straight when they led throughout to score by 3 goals.

The two top teams in 'C' Section St. Bernard's and Alphington were both beaten by 1 point, by O.G.G.'s and Monash respectively.

John Wood played his 250th game for Brunswick (John has since been president of the club).

Parkside, undefeated with 11 wins, were 3 games clear of Hampton Rovers and A.J.A.X. in 'D' Section.

In 'A' Section Old Scotch, Ivanhoe and Old Xaverians were in the last three positions — yet only a game behind Collegians who were fourth.

### 10 YEARS AGO — 1952

"Curley" Gemmell played his 150th game for Ivanhoe.

'A' Section captains were Phil McLaughlin (Old Paradians), Sam Birtles (Hampton Rovers), Evan McGregor (Ormond), Harry Meredith, (Univ. Blacks), Geoff Sinclair (Univ. Blues), Perc. Adams (Alphington), Jack Thomas (Commonwealth Bank), R. Ferguson (Collegians), Peter Cox (Old Melburnians). Who captained Old Scotch in 1952?

Old Paradians with only one victory to their credit, went down to joint leaders Old Melburnians by only 5 points, while Commonwealth Bank (4th) continued to be a hoodoo side for the other joint leader, Ormond as they led all day to defeat Ormond 7.11 to 5.9.

Starts for the Bank were Alan Shiel, Miles Hurley and Don Malcolm.

### COLLEGIAN MILESTONES

No Collegians' fingers need be crossed about another player whose 150th appearance for Collegians shall take place today against De La Salle, **Richard Maxwell Loder**.

Rick first played with the Lions in 1973, during which year, he modestly reports, he was Captain of Athletics and a member of the Wesley A.P.S. Football side. His association with Collegians goes back almost to birth. the senior side as a primarily defensive utility player.

The writer has searched in vain for records of Rick's great achievements. Common sense prevents the writer from asking Rick himself. It seems Rick has not won a great number of awards but has certainly proved himself to be a great clubman and team member. His 150 games have been played almost exclusively in the seniors and with a minimum of fuss. He has only missed 4 games due to injury in 9 years, despite having his nose rearranged on 5 occasions and has otherwise only missed a handful of games. Rick himself believes his main claim to fame was as a member of that brilliant Collegians centre-line of the '70s — **R. Loder, Rice** and **T. Loder** which was the scourge of B Grade and second only to Bourke, Barrott and Clay at the time (or so says Rick!).

Rich has served the club well off the field also being a committeeman for 5 years and secretary for 2. He was the "Outstanding Clubman" for season 1976 and in his own words is "a top bloke". Well done Rick. Good luck in your 150th game from all at Collegians.
