



#### 5 YEARS AGO - 1977

Umpires' Corner featured "Gentleman" Jim Peters, who had completed 450 games of football both as a player and umpire — 9 years as a field umpire and 6 years as goal umpire.

#### 30 YEARS AGO - 1952


Well-known **Alphington** identity. **Perc Adams**, played his 100th game.

SUPER NEW FOOTY BOOK TO HELP KIDS!

We've seen numerous footy books brought out in recent years, but most concentrate on the adult reader. Some have leanings towards the young reader, but very, very few have any true appeal for the 8-14 age group.

This was until a book titled "How to play FOOTY - Australian Rules" was recently released - written by the man who writes "The Watcher" column in Melbourne "Age" - Garrie Hutchinson.

A father of three children, including a keen young footballing son, six years old Alexander. Garrie has shown in this book that the importance of presenting to youngsters a welldescribed and yet funny (by way of superb illustrations drawn by Tony Ward — well known as a children's book illustrator) approach has long been missing.

As the wording on the press release states "Football is one of those addictions that if caught young enough - NEVER leaves the victim."

Besides the illustrations, well written and easily understood description of the skills and tactics of our great game are included. There's also a "Glossary of words necessary to understand the game", plus a little about the history of Australian Rules Football

However ALL this makes it super value at \$3.95 for 52 pages of A-C-T-I-O-N - available from your local newsagency.

Most important feature we believe is that the book is absolutely ideal for almost anyone to read - the kids will love it; for an overseas visitor wishing to know about our game: to send overseas so our game can easily be explained; and this is particularly relevent to the many Rotary students who are on exchange to the U.S., Canada, Japan, etc. It's simply a matter of giving them a copy of this book.

But we believe the person who should get most value from the book is the Teacher - male or female both at studentship level and more advanced.

"How to Play Footy" is published by McPhee Gribble Publishers of Carlton, well known in the children's book publishing business.
