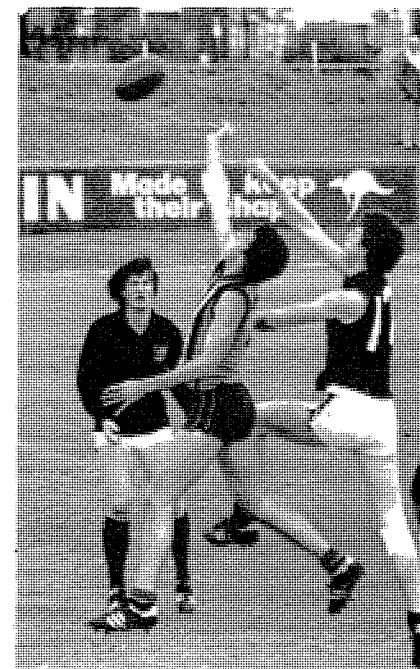

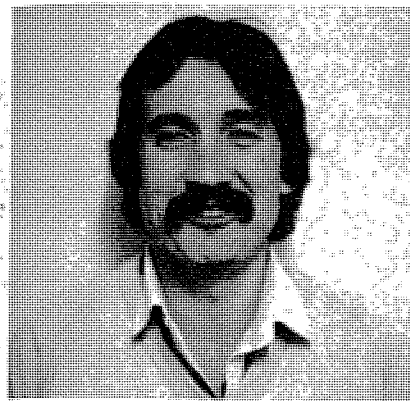

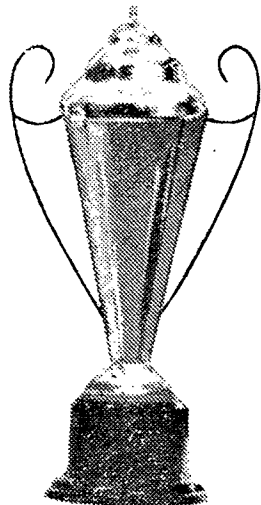

5 YEARS AGO — 1977

Umpires' Corner featured “Gentleman” Jim Peters, who had completed 450 games of football both as a player and umpire — 9 years as a field umpire and 6 years as goal umpire.

Ormond (A) continued its slide with its third successive defeat — 10 points ahead of **Marcellin** at the last change, it scored only 4 behinds in the last quarter to **Marcellin's** 6.5 and was now only one game ahead of **Uni. Blacks**.

North Old Boys (A) undefeated after 14 games, were 3 games ahead of **St. Bernard's O.C.** and **De La Salle O.C.**

Old Geelong marvelled that a rather shorter than average pair of legs had carried their great little rover to 100 games — **Sandy Gilbert** who has also played 100 games with M.H.S.O.B. in their great “A” Section days.

150 games to **Peter Gartner (Marc.)** and **Don Barton (Geel.)**.

10 YEARS AGO — 1972

St. Bernard's (5th) lost another chance of getting back into the four when they faded towards the finish and went down by 11 points to a determined **Monash Blues (8th)**.

Scores were 12.12 to 9.19 while best were **De Young, Flett, Amor, Loweck (7 gls)** for **Monash** and **Iannazzo, King, and Wade (St. Bernard's)**.

Battle for the four was tough in ‘B’ Section with **Univ. Blacks** on top with 40 points and four teams one game behind. **Geelong, Old Scotch, Old Trinity** and **Ivanhoe**.

De La Salle scored their first win for the season at the expense of **Old Paradians, Bothe, Peart (7 gls)** and **Ashford** were the stars in a convincing win as “De La” led all day.

Only sad note was that champion ruckman **Henry Halasa** dislocated his thigh bone and it looked like curtains for the season.

150 games to **Old Brighton** “living Legend” 17-stone **Roger Wilson**, Reserves coach for years, and enthusiastic urger of the seniors, meat pie in one hand and transistor in the other.

15 YEARS AGO — 1967

Coburg's accuracy, 12.3 enabled them to defeat **Collegians** 10.7, by 8 points.

Old Camberwell scored only 5 points against **Glenhenty (20.22)**.

Top scorers for the day were **Ormond Juniors**, 35.19 (**Wallis 11, Grace 6**), who defeated **Commonwealth Bank 4.7**.

Graham Daff played his 250th game for **Collegians** — **Graham** had also represented **Victoria** on numerous occasions.

Others to chalk up 150 games were **Adam Shostak (A.J.A.X.)**, **Cam McMillan (O.G.G.)**, **Graham Tozer (Old Brighton)**.

John Fisher (Kew) and **Mick Mulcahy (Old Xaverians)** had been appointed captain and vice-captain respectively of **Carnival** team to play at **Launceston**. (John is now V.A.F.A. State Coach — ed.)

‘A’ Section umpires for the day were **Doherty, Hinton, Marks, Marshall and Murphy**.

30 YEARS AGO — 1952

Well-known **Alphington** identity, **Perc Adams**, played his 100th game.

KIDS!**

We've seen numerous footy books brought out in recent years, but most concentrate on the adult reader. Some have leanings towards the young reader, but very, very few have any true appeal for the 8-14 age group.

This was until a book titled "How to play FOOTY - Australian Rules" was recently released - written by the man who writes "The Watcher" column in Melbourne "Age" - Garrie Hutchinson.

A father of three children, including a keen young footballing son, six years old Alexander, Garrie has shown in this book that the importance of presenting to youngsters a well-described and yet funny (by way of superb illustrations drawn by Tony Ward - well known as a children's book illustrator) approach has long been missing.

As the wording on the press release states "Football is one of those addictions - that if caught young enough - NEVER leaves the victim."

Besides the illustrations, well written and easily understood description of the skills and tactics of our great game are included. There's

also a "Glossary of words necessary to understand the game", plus a little about the history of Australian Rules Football.

However ALL this makes it super value at \$3.95 for 52 pages of A-C-T-I-O-N - available from your local newsagency.

Most important feature we believe is that the book is absolutely ideal for almost anyone to read - the kids will love it; for an overseas visitor wishing to know about our game; to send overseas so our game can easily be explained; and this is particularly relevant to the many Rotary students who are on exchange to the U.S., Canada, Japan, etc. It's simply a matter of giving them a copy of this book.

But we believe the person who should get most value from the book is the Teacher - male or female - both at studentship level and more advanced.

"How to Play Footy" is published by McPhee Gribble Publishers of Carlton, well known in the children's book publishing business.
