LOOKING BACK

5 YEARS AGO — 1977

North Old Boys suffered their first defeat for the season when **St. Bernard's** beat them by a point in a thrilling finish, with a goal being scored from the last kick, an instant before the final siren. Best were **Mitchell, Cahir, Nadzielski** (St. B) and **O'Connor, Welch, Sheales** (North O.B.).

M.H.S.O.B. saluted their unsung heroes, boundary umpires **Doug Whorlow** and **Don Pritchard**, who have run 200 and 150 games respectively.

With three rounds to go the battle in "B" Section to avoid relegation was intense with **Geelong** on 24 points followed by **Old Haileybury, St. Kilda, C.B.C.O.C.** and **Collegians** on 20 points.

Don Dodds, who started as a goal umpire in 1963, decided to try out as a field umpire and since 1964, has now umpired over 250 games, including two "B" Section grand finals.

A.J.A.X. (3rd, in "C") withstood a strong finish by **Fawkner** (1st) to defeat the top team by 13 points and keep alive their double chance prospects. Best were **Feldpicer, Bluzer, Schulberg** (A.J.A.X.) and **Richardson, Ferguson, Ward** (Fawk.).

Caulfield Grammarians most prolific goalkicker, **John Butcher**, played his 200th game. His great career had included interstate selection in 1971, 1975, 1976 and to date, over 600 goals. (John was elected to V.A.F.A. Executive in 1976 and served with distinction until retirement in 1981, N.R.)

10 YEARS AGO — 1972

Ormond and **Old Paradians** played an exciting draw after Parade had many chances to clinch the game. However the two points enabled them to move up to third place ahead of **Coburg**.

In a high scoring game **Ivanhoe's** accurate kicking, 23.10 played a big part in the defeat of **Old Trinity**, 17.17, and they rose from fifth to third, knocking Trinity out of 'B' Section four.

It was disappointing for Trinity who after 10 games had been on top with only two defeats.

Robinson, Berry and **Ireland** were best for **Ivanhoe**.

Geelong ("B" Section) had every chance to make their position in the four secure by beating **Old Scotch** but poor kicking in the final term (4.11) let them down and they were beaten by 4 points.

Well known umpire **Ian Marsden** was standing for Doncaster City Council (won the election and later became Mayor — Ed.).

Victoria finished top strongly for **Tasmania** and ran out winners by 32 points after Tasmania had got within 7 points of Victoria 10 minutes into the last quarter.

Best for Victoria were **Birrell, King, Wade, McCrae, Rojo** and **Duke**.

15 YEARS AGO — 1967

Collegians' inaccuracy (5.18) against **Caulfield Grammer** (12.7) cost them a place in the four.

Noel Stokes played his 200th game for **Kew** — Noel had been captain, **Club Best** and **Fairest** (3 times) and **Australian Amateurs** players.

Six teams were still in the fight for fourth position in "A" Section.

Commonwealth Bank skipper, **Tony Borrack**, played his 150th senior game.

South Australia after a surprise defeat by **Tasmania** on the first day, convincingly beat **West, Aust.** on the second day and were to play **Victoria** on the final day.

30 YEARS AGO — 1952

After 14 games **Ivanhoe**, with only one defeat (by **Geelong** at Corio Oval), were on top in "B" Section with a percentage of 229.9.

Geoff Frost played his 100th game for **Power House**.

Ivanhoe Juniors toppled the undefeated **Ormond Juniors 8.14** to **7.12**. Stars for the victors were **Teddy Holberry, Louttit**, and **Mick Anderson**.

And just to show the effects of inflation bound copies of 1947, 48, 59, 51 and 52 issues of "Amateur Footballer" were advertised for sale at seven shilling and sixpence per copy.

Two teams, now long departed, had a stirring battle in "B" Section with **North Alphington 8.8** to the victors over **Myer 8.7**. I'll bet it was quite a game!
