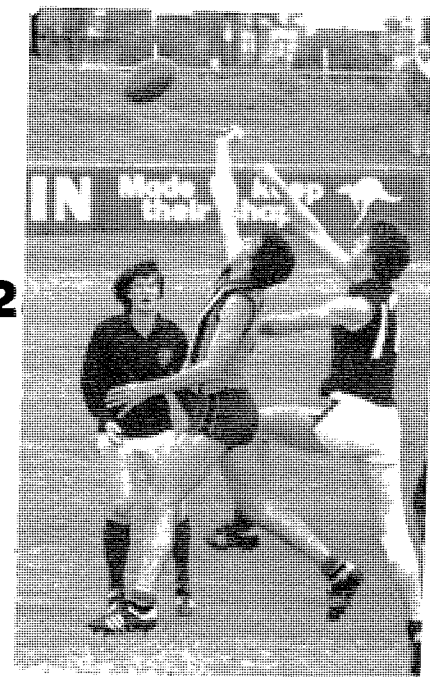

## Fred Coldrey: 50 Years' Service

At the V.A.F.A.'s annual Cocktail Party — held last week at the R.A.C.V. Club — a special "50 Years' Service" presentation was made by Association President **Alex Johnson** to Mr. **F.H. (Fred) Coldrey**.

Mr. Coldrey has enjoyed an illustrious career in amateur sports ranging from athletics to football, with sidelines in gymnastics and boxing.

His football involvement began in 1926 when he was a member of the 1st Hampton Scouts Troop football team. He was a foundation member of the Hampton Rovers F.C. (1928), and won that club's first Best and Fairest in 1929 and 1931. He played over 250 games and participated in another 350 as boundary umpire. Between 1928 and 1970 he held every executive position (except Secretary) for Hampton Rovers, including 6 years as president and 12 years as Club trainer. He still acts as the Club's advisor on V.A.F.A. matters. Life membership to his Club was bestowed in 1938.

His wider involvement with the V.A.F.A. itself began when Hampton Rovers entered this Association in 1933, with Mr. F. Coldrey as its appointed delegate. He became a member of the Permit Committee in 1936 (and has been chairman thereof since 1954) and the Umpire Committee in 1938 (serving on this for 30 years). Also in 1938 he was elected to the Executive (a position he still holds). The ensuing years have seen Mr. Coldrey serve on many of the Association's other sub-committees. He has also been Manager or Assistant Manager of numerous V.A.F.A. representative teams. In 1962 he

was elected as a vice-president of the newly-formed Victorian Junior Amateur Football Association and was President of the V.J.A.F.A. from 1950 until this body was absorbed as the U 19 section of the V.A.F.A. in 1953.

1958 saw Mr. Coldrey presented with Life Membership to the V.A.F.A. and in 1972 he was the recipient of a Merit Award from the Australian Football Council.

Besides this, Mr. Coldrey has found time to be actively involved in amateur athletics — first competing with St. Stephens' Harriers in 1927. He was Club Track Captain from 1939-41 and Sprint Coach of the Club from 1945 to 1955. He was appointed as a "track finish judge" of the V.A.A.A. in 1945 and as a "chief finish judge" in 1954. This appointment led to Mr. Coldrey's officiating at both the 1956 Olympics (Melbourne) and the 1962 Commonwealth Games (Perth).

To attest his versatility, Mr. Coldrey acted as a Scorer for the gymnastics at the '56 Olympics; and to confirm his commitment to football he was assistant organiser of the demonstration game of Australian Rules Football played at the Melbourne Olympics in 1978 the V.A.A.A. recognised Mr. Coldrey's efforts with a special award.

The Amateur Footballer — indeed all amateur supporters congratulate Mr. Coldrey on the occasion of this special presentation in recognition of his service to the V.A.F.A.

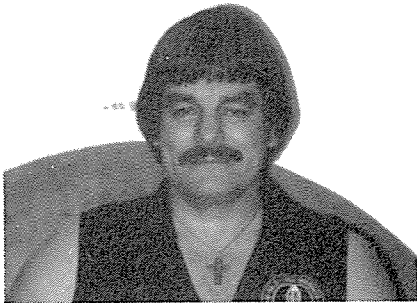

V.A.F.A. 500**

Congratulations go to **Laurie Aghan** who coaches his 500th game in Amateur Football against St. Bernard's today — an achievement I'm sure any player or coach would be very proud of. With an incredible total of 756 games in open football, including 100 senior V.F.A. games (coaching Yarrville and playing with Port Melbourne, Sandringham and in a Northcote premiership) and 154 games with other affiliated leagues such as the Federal Eastern Districts and Sunday Suburban. Laurie often played 3 games in a weekend.

He also coached the V.A.F.A. State side in 1974 and has an unblemished record against both South Australia and Tasmania.

Undoubtedly, one of Laurie's greatest feats in the Amateurs was with Reservoir Old Boys who rose from "E" in 1970 to "A" in 1974 — winning the 'C' and 'B' premierships on the way.

In 1975 Laurie returned to the V.A.F.A. as coach of Yarrville but 1976 saw him back in the V.A.F.A. — this time with Old Scotch Collegians. Success followed in 1977, with the premiership double in "B" and the Senior "A" flag were relegated at the end of the 1979 season — only to return to A Section in 1980.

This year, Laurie switched to Old Melburnians — with notable success. Both seniors and reserves are assured of finals berths. Laurie confesses that his one aim in Amateur football is to see O.M.'s succeed back in A Grade.

16 grand finals for 9 premierships in 13 years is certainly a magnificent record to look back on and **Lorna, Jason, Kimberley** and all players and supporters congratulate you on this remarkable feat. All O.M. fingers are crossed that your "history" in September will read: 14 years: 18 grand finals: 11 premierships. Well done Laurie!

## LOOKING BACK

### 5 YEARS AGO — 1977

**Ormond** (A), fourth and one game clear of **U. Blacks**, retained its lead when it scrapped home by 3 points from **De La Salle O.C.**, second in 'A', final scores 9.13 to 9.10. Best were **Corben, Russ, Bourne** (O) and **Mellenry, Crothers, McDonnell** (De La).

With his goals in **Old Paradians'** ('B') 56 point win against **Old Melburnians**, **John Jordan** brought his tally to 500. His tally was the club best for 44 years, and had only ever been exceeded by two really great names — **Alan La Fontaine**, captain and centre for **Melbourne** in their League Premiership teams in 1939, 1940, and 1941, who kicked 18 in a match in 1929, and **Phonse Kyne**, captain, then coach of **Collingwood** and in fact coach of the Magpies last Premiership team in 1958, who kicked 12 in 1933.

**Old Xaverians** congratulated **Peter Fraser** on equalling the club record of 234 games held by **Peter Raffaele**. Always a forward due to his great pace, Peter was currently leading, "C" Reserve goal kicking.

"B" Section coaches were **Ted Farrell** (Coll.), **Ian Davis** (Geel), **Bill McWhinnie** (Ivan.), **Darryl Cranch** (M. Blues), **Brendon Danaher** (Old P.), **Laurie Aghan** (Old Scotch), **Mike Porter** (Old Hailey.), **Tony Anderson** (Old Melb.), **Barry Evans** (Res. O.B.) and **Norm Caine** (St. Kilda C.B.C.O.C.).

### 10 YEARS AGO — 1972

**Caulfield Grammarians**, after trailing **Ormond** by 45 points at the last change, put in a great last term to go down by only 5 points.

Best were **Candy, Macdonald, Ward** (C.C.) and **Wood, Bourne, Jackson** (Orm.).

In a tight finish **Ivanhoe** scraped home by 4 points from **Collegians** to hold fourth position in 'B' Section. Collegians threw the game away by kicking 2.8 in the final quarter.

**St. Kilda C.B.C.** retained fourth position in 'C' Section by defeating **Fairfield** — a reward for accuracy, 11.1 up to the last finish up with 16.2 while the opposition, **Fairfield**, squandered opportunities with 13.17.

**Celleja** kicked 8 goals out of 16 but did not rate a mention in **St. Kilda's** six best who were headed by **Bilston, Browne, and Casey**.

**Reservoir Old Boys** ('C') and **Old Camberwell** ('F') were still undefeated.

250 games to **John Wall** (Nat. Bank), playing coach of Reserves, and 150 to **Les Caldwell** (Old Melb.) and **Barry "Tanglefoot" Wilson** (Old Melb.).

### 15 YEARS AGO — 1967

**University Blacks** (9.16) defeated **Kew** (6.14) to take that team's place in the 'A' section four.

**Collegians** and **Coburg** were both in the fight for the four.

'B' section four was settled — **Ormond, U.H.S. Old Boys, Uni. Blues, N.M.C.B.C.O.B.** (now **North Old Boys**) but all were in the fight for the top two positions.

Clubs headed for relegation were **Old Melburnians** ('B'), **St. Kevin's** and **Old Haileybury** ('C') and **Preston** ('D').

'B' section captains were **Tony Borrack** (Com. Bank), **Bernie Blight** (Ormond), **Jack Egan** (St. Kilda C.B.O.C.), **Graeme Jobling** (Uni. Blues), **Ken Middleton** (Geel.), **Rod Payne** (O.M.), **Col Kinnear** (U.H.S.O.B.), **Ray Hewat** (F.T.C.O.B.), **T. Heffernan** (De La Salle) **Bob Spurling** (North O.B.).

**Mick Mulcahy**, back from the Carnival starred for **Old Xaverians** with 6 goals in their narrow loss by 8 points to **Melbourne High**.

### 30 YEARS AGO — 1952

**Commonwealth Bank**, battling for fourth position in 'A' section, kicked 9.3 in the third quarter, a record at **Harry Trott Oval**. **Don Malcolm** dished seven.

100 games to **Les Morgan** (Alphington) and **Tom Baird** (F.I.C.O.B.).

Battling it out for top place in 'D' section and the right of challenge were **Caulfield Grammarians** and **St. Kevin's Old Boys**, both with 15 wins and only one defeat.

Best player for **Ormond** was Australian Amateur half back, **Geoff Harris**, who was switched to the ruck and registered six goals.

## UMPIRES' CORNER

### DOYEN OF UMPIRES' BIG DAY AT ORMOND

In his last season the doyen of V.A.F.A. field umpiring, **Bob Cogdon** today umpires his 350th game.

Although it is Bob's wish that today's milestone be "low-key", our Association believe today's achievement, by its most admired and respected member should not go unheralded.

Both on and off the field, Bob is the epitome of a gentleman and if there is an example to anyone that age or size should be no barrier to continuation of their active on-field participation in Amateur Football, then there can be no finer example than Bob.

Bob started his V.A.F.A. football career with **Caulfield Grammarians** under 19's over 30 years ago. He modestly says that he was not good enough to make the senior team when he was no longer eligible for under age football. In those days, the club senior sides did not have Reserves and so Bob played senior football in another competition, until he joined the V.A.F.A. umpires panel in 1954.

He stayed with the Amateurs until 1956 when he was moved to **Geelong** in his employment with **Royal Insurance**, a company he was associated with for 32 years.

Bob umpired with the **Geelong District** for two years and after a break returned to the

Amateurs in 1969. He has officiated in every season since then.

In his career, Bob has umpired in 10 finals including truly deserved 'F' Grade Reserves Grand Finals in the last two years. Although we have not been able to confirm his correct age, (his application form for last season said 53, yet this year's shows 52), this rotund grey-haired gentleman has never failed to honour his commitment to the V.A.F.A., hail, rain or shine, including training with no task evaded. This correspondent remembers one inspirational sight last year. With no disrespect to his young and agile son **Jon**, the final task at training was a run around the perimeter of **Elsternwick Park**. Although giving most of his mates between 20-30 years, Bob into "the home straight" was trailing the main pack by a few hundred metres. I thought, "what a remarkable effort", then was shocked twenty seconds later, when around the corner, came **Jon**.

In the past few seasons, Bob has umpired 'A' and 'B' Reserve Games, giving him some of the most enjoyable days in his career. He has come to know numerous players and on a number of occasions, we believe receives enthusiastic ovations from players before the game. Truly an indication of his on-field popularity.

Bob was awarded life membership to our Association in 1980 in recognition of his outstanding service to V.A.F.A. umpiring.

We wish him well in both the forthcoming finals and his retirement. He will be sadly missed next year.
