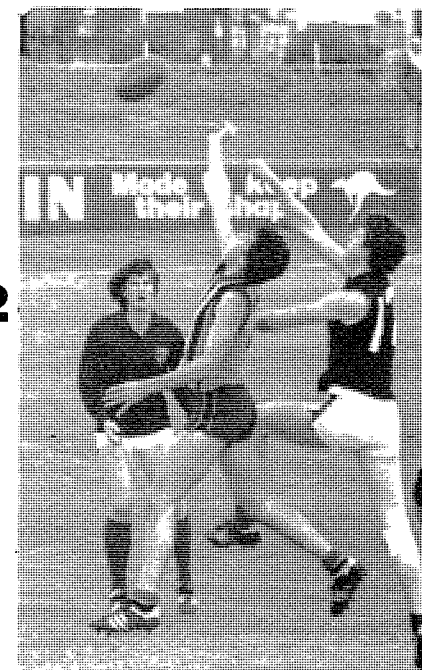

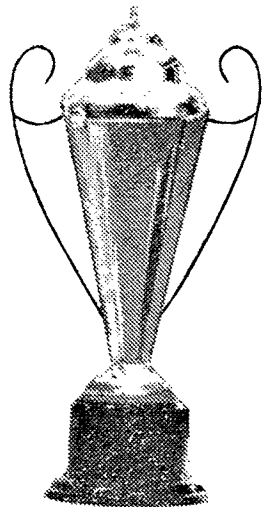

LOOKING BACK

5 YEARS AGO — 1977

Barry Shearer, Alphington's vice captain and centre half back, played his 200th game for the club. In his illustrious career Barry had been a great clubman, captain of the last premiership team, best and fairest three times, club delegate and holder of the club record for 149 consecutive games.

Geelong's effort in beating **Old Paradians** (4th in "B" Section) by one point was to no avail as they finished ninth, 2.6% behind **Monash Blues**, both on 28 points. **Old Haileybury** avoided relegation and cost **Ivanhoe** the double chance in "B" with a 16 point victory. Best were **G. Campbell**, **Houghton**, **Code**, **Houston**, (5 gls.) (Old H.) and **Stredwick**, **Van**, **R. Stewart** (Ivan.).

In "C" **Old Ivanhoe** (5th) defeated **A.J.A.X.** (2nd) by 23 points but failed to gain a place in the four as **Parkside** (4th) kicked 7.8 to **Old Xaverians** (3rd) solitary goal in the last quarter to win by 59 points.

Leading goalkickers after 18 rounds were "A", **John Butcher** (Caul. Gram.) 660, "B" **John Jordan** (Old Parad.) 61, "C" **M. Walsh** (U.H.S.O.B.) 66, "D" **John Priestley** (Old B'ton) 60, "E" **I. Henderson** (A.M.P.) 58, "F" **John Tenace** (Bull-Temp.) 93, **J. I. Woolfe** (Ivan.) 58, **J. J. James** (H. Rovers) 70.

10 YEARS AGO — 1972

Coburg and **St. Bernard's** met at Coburg to decide fourth place in "A" Section and who would meet **Old Paradians** in the first semi.

The result was never in doubt as Coburg made good use of the wind in the first quarter to kick 8.5 to 1.2. **Warfe**, **Sullivan**, **Jim Sabri**, and **Gardner** (5 gls) were best for Coburg, **St. Bernard's** battled hard but went down by 10 goals.

In the only last round match affecting relegation, **Old Geelong** outclassed **Hampton Rovers** to win by 12 goals and save their position in "D" Section. **Calder**, **Hopkins** and **Whalley** (O.G.G.) and **Nash**, **A. Moore**, **Ryan** (Hampton) were best.

Dave Berry celebrated his 200th game for **Ivanhoe** as one of the best afield and the older he gets the better he goes — Club best and fairest in 1971 and captain in 1972.

150 games to **Ian Cameron** (Ormond) **Phil Carey** (St. Kilda C.B.C.).

Kevin Kinlock, after 18 seasons and 282 games with **Brunswick**, and captain of club's 1970 premiership team, decided to call it a day — a career of wonderful service in which Kevin held many club offices.

15 YEARS AGO — 1967

Coburg's captain, **Brian Callahan**, played his 200th game.

Crucial games to decide second place were: 'B' Section — **Ormond** v **U.H.S.O.B.** (result was 8.12 to 5.6) 'C' Section — **St. Bernard's** v **Monash** (St. Bernard's crumpled in an astonishing way with victory going to Monash — scores were 1.6 (12) to 6.18 (54)).

ELIGIBILITY

The following extracts from the "Rules of the Association" are published to remind Club Secretaries of the requirements regarding player eligibility for the final series as passed at the V.A.F.A. Members' Meeting on 1st November, 1980 and amended at the V.A.F.A. Members' Meeting on 2nd August, 1982.

- Rule 13. Grades shall be the categories of the premierships competition matches in which a player may be eligible to represent a Club.
- Rule 14. The Grades shall be the Senior Grade, the Junior Grade, and, the Reserve Grade.
- Rule 15. The first* and second† rounds of the Senior Grade shall be open to all eligible and registered players to represent the Club with which they have been granted a permit.
- Rule 16. The first round of the Junior Grade shall be open to all eligible and registered players who have not attained the age of 19 years on or before the 31st December of the preceding year.
- Rule 17. The second round of the Junior Grade shall be open to all eligible and registered players within the age limits prescribed in Rule 16 to represent the Club with which they have been granted a permit provided that a player who has represented a Club in an aggregate of more than five matches in the Senior Grade and Reserve Grade in the first round in any season shall not be eligible unless he has represented such Club in more than five matches in the first round of the Junior Grade in the same season **unless such Club shall be represented in a match of the second round in the Senior Grade on the same day. In the event of a draw taking place in a match in the second round of the Junior Grade, all players who took part in the drawn game shall be eligible to take part in the game to be replayed.**
- Rule 18. The first round of the Reserve Grade shall be open to all eligible and registered players to represent the Club with which they have been granted a permit.
- Rule 19. The second round of the Reserve Grade shall be open to all eligible and registered players to represent the Club with which they have been granted a permit provided that no player shall be eligible to represent a Club unless such player shall have represented such Club in at least two matches of the Reserve Grade in the first round in the same season and further provided that no player shall be eligible to represent a Club after having represented such Club in more than eight matches of the Senior Grade in the first round in the same season unless such Club shall be represented in a match of the second round of the Senior Grade on the same day. In the event of a draw taking place in a match in the second round of the Reserve Grade, all players who took part in the drawn game shall be eligible to take part in the game to be replayed.
- Rule 20. Notwithstanding anything herein contained in these Rules a player shall not be eligible to play —
- In any Grade whilst under suspension by the Independent Tribunal.
 - In any Grade pending investigation by the Independent Tribunal of any charge against such player unless the Independent Tribunal otherwise orders.
- *Rule 35. The first round shall be the home and home matches in which each team shall be scheduled to play every other team twice provided that this may be varied by the Executive Committee to meet the exigencies of the number of Clubs represented in a Section.
- †Rule 39. The second round shall comprise the first semi-final match, second semi-final match, preliminary final match and grand final match in each Section. Any drawn match shall be replayed.

200 GAMES AT KEW

Bruce Smith joined **Kew** in 1970 and immediately won a Most Consistent Player award for his first year. He followed this with the Best and Fairest award in 1971 and continued to rank high amongst the awards ever since. He has been five times Best and Fairest with numerous 2nd, Best and Fairest, and Best Team Man awards. He was a driving factor in the 1979 Grand Final that took Kew to B Grade. He has been Captain, Chairman of the Social Committee and an active worker for Kew for many years. He won Best Clubman award, for 3 consecutive years, whilst his most recent prize was that of Debbie whom he married earlier in the Season.

All at Kew acknowledge Bruce's continual support and dedication to the Club and sincerely hope that his new home, out in the sticks, won't prevent him from continuing his association with Kew.

All your team-mates hope you will continue as captain next year Crown — after you lead us to another Reserves pennant this year.

Thanks for all your effort Will and congratulations on staggering to your 100th game.
