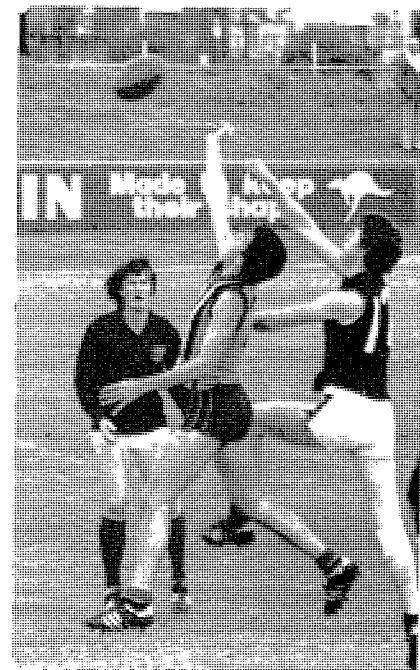

COLLEGIAN COMMENTS

Peter Lupson, Collegians popular Reserves full-forward played his 50th game for the Lions against North Old Boys some four weeks ago.
