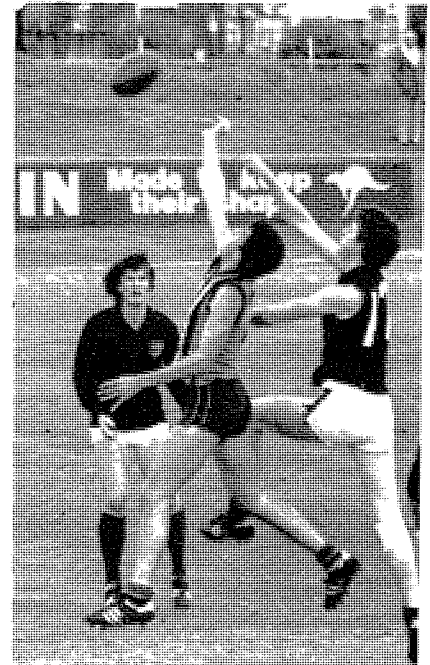

5 YEARS AGO — 1977

Umpires in charge of main finals were **Rowell** (A), **Hindle** (B), **Dodds** (C), **Rowe** (D), **Goodman** (E), **Mead** (F), **Grubb** (J.1), and **Tracey** (J.2).

North Old Boys, a point ahead of **De La Salle** at the last change, kicked 5.5 in the final term to 1.1 to go into their third successive “A” Section grand final. **Scanlon**, **Murray**, **O’Connor** (N.O.B.) and **Donegan**, **Fitzpatrick**, **McHenry** (De La) were best.

Old Scotch, kicking 15.13 to **R. O.B.’s** 10.16, won their way back to “A” Section, while in the “C” Section **Final Parkside** continued their great finals form with a strong last term to defeat **A.J.A.X.** by 23 points. **Quaife**, **Howell**, **K. Clarke** (P) and **Bluzer**, **H. Ritterman**, **Aarons** (A.J.A.X.) were best.

Old Brighton gained promotion to “C” with a 57 point win over **St. Kevin’s O.B.**, while **West Brunswick**, with **Bruce Ivey** the star, held out **North Brunswick**, who kicked 7.3 to a solitary point in the last term, to win by 13 points and go into “D”.

10 YEARS AGO — 1972

With only a point between the teams at the last change, **Geelong’s** 4.5 to **Uni. Blacks** 1.5 in the final quarter earned the country boys promotion to “A” Section in 1973. **P. Betts**, **E. Smith** and **Thorton** (Geel.) and **Moffatt**, **Hill**, **Lipshut** (Blacks) were best.

Other teams to win Grand Finals were **Assumption O.C.** (C), **Parkside** (D), **Marcellin O.C.** (E) and **Elsternwick** (F).

15 YEARS AGO — 1967

Old Paradians who lost only two games in the first round, and both to **Melbourne High**, turned the tables to run out winners 15.11 to 10.12.

Best were **Proctor**, **Sambell**, **Ford** (Old Paradians) and **Needham**, **Turnbull**, **Macdonald** (M.H.S.).

Elsternwick beat **Coburg** in “C” Section second semi, 9.8 to 7.13, while **St. Kevin’s** defeated **Caulfield Gram.** 10.12 to 8.14 to take the “D” Section premiership.

Old Scotch beat **Ormond** 10.14 to 7.15 in the Junior Section Final and were to meet again in the Grand Final.

UMPIRES' CORNER

FIFTEEN METRES PENALTY

A popular misconception among many players and supporters of Australian Rules Football is that the 15 metre penalty is imposed by umpires as a means of disciplining players.

The 15 metre penalty is imposed when there is **UNDUE DELAY** and such delay is **DELIBERATELY** caused.

The player on the mark may be brought back not more than 15 metres.

1. If an opponent deliberately deprives the possession of the ball to the rightful player thereby causing undue delay.
2. If an opponent deliberately goes over a player's mark. The umpire must be aware that the opponent knew the correct spot for the mark (he probably told him) before penalty is imposed.
3. If an opponent deliberately deprives possession of the ball to the rightful player by handing the ball from team mate to team mate and thereby unduly delays the return of the ball to the rightful player.
4. If an opponent deliberately holds a player who has been awarded a mark or free kick and thereby causes undue delay.

5. If an opponent deliberately knocks to the ground a player after he has been awarded a mark or free kick thereby deliberately causing undue delay to play.
6. If an opponent deliberately withholds the ball from the player who is to take the kick and causes undue delay by:
 - a. retaining possession of the ball;
 - b. throwing or rolling the ball away so that the rightful player has to cover unnecessary ground to retrieve it;
 - c. knocking the ball from the hands of the player who is to take the kick;
 - d. when in possession of the ball fails to make a genuine attempt to return the ball to the rightful player on the full.
7. Any other deliberate attempt to waste time or to deprive the rightful player of possession of the ball.

The penalty may be imposed in the case of a player being permitted to kick for goal after the first sound of the siren. It does not matter whether or not the field umpire has signalled to the timekeeper to add time, as the penalty may be imposed at any time.

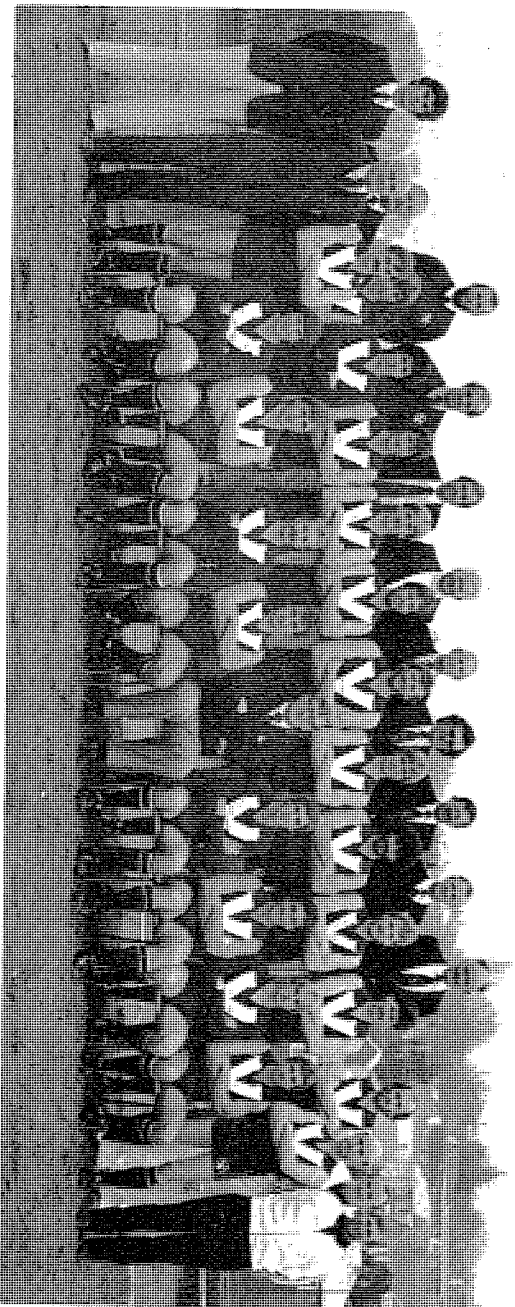
