
BELATED 50TH GAMES AT OLD PARADIANS

IN THE GOAL SQUARE

HEAVY GROUNDS AND WET WEATHER LEAVE THEIR MARK — ORMOND IN STRIFE NORTH O.B. ONLY ONE GAME AWAY — XAVS ON THE MOVE — COLLEGIANS??

Low scores were the order of the day as most players had their first taste of wet weather and muddy grounds for two years or more. In the 29 senior matches played only 8 clubs managed more than 100 points. **Commonwealth Bank** had the honour of the highest score (27.19) which says much for the surface of Harry Trott. Two other F Section clubs scored freely despite conditions — **Footscray Tech** and **La Trobe** each kicking 21.15.

No club in E Section managed the century whilst **Old Ivanhoe's** 15.19 in D Section against **North Brunswick** was a major upset which gives that club a big hope of grabbing fourth place.

In C Section **Caulfield Grammarians (16.16)** beat **Old Brighton** but those familiar with Albert Park will appreciate that score.

B Section saw 2 centuries. **St. Bernard's** and **University Blacks**. Both wins were of great relevance. **St. Bernard's** moved off the bottom and gained much heart from its big win over A.J.A.X. whose 2 goals were scored in the last quarter. whilst the Blacks are now only 2 games from the 4 and have a more than useful percentage. Given their recent off field troubles the Blacks win was a wonderful tonic.

North O.B. was the only A Section side to top the ton. In fact the lowest scores of the day were recorded in this section. At **Ormond** where the home side managed only 3 goals, their opponents and competition leaders **University Blues** had scored only 2 goals up till 3/4 time. North's win sees them only one game outside the 4 and their clash today with the rapidly improving **Old Xaverians** highlights the round. These clubs were winless when they last met and Old Xavs. emerged victorious. I've a notion they'll win again today and give Collegians breathing space. At the other end of A section **Ormond, Ivanhoe** and **Old Melburnians** have a very tough time ahead and only a brave man would select his relegations at this juncture.

Under 19 football is full of interest. In premier division leading sides **Banyule** and **St. Bernard's** were both defeated whilst **Old Scotch** has recovered some early season form and is pressing for a finals berth.

Zone 1 has seen **Marcellin** replaced as leader by **Fawkner** and **Old Ivanhoe** has moved into the 4 at the expense of **Kew**.

In Zone 2 **St. Kilda CBC** hung on to beat **Old Xaverians** and maintain its unbeaten record. Xavs and Old Melburnians lie second and third with **Monash**

4th. **Old Brighton (5th)** is playing very well of late but its poor percentage could prove costly.

150 GAMES AT ST. BERNARD'S



5 YEARS AGO — 1978

Uni. Blacks "A", desperate for a victory in the relegation battle, let De La (4th) off the hook, and had to settle for a draw when they kicked 1.6 to 3.2 in the final term. Best were **Allanson, S. Costello, O'Donohue (Uni. Blacks)** and **McDonald, McDonnell, Hollier (De La)**.

"C" Section coaches were **Sid Myers (A.J.A.X.), Ivan Bromley (A ton), Laurie De Goldi (Geel), Jock Granger (H. Rovers), Alan Rodda (Kaw), Bill McGrory (Old B ton Gramm.), Michael Cooke (Old Carey), Graeme Johnston (Old Ivanhoe), Jack Batten (Old Xavs), and Maurice Bilston (St. Kilda C.B.C.O.C.)**.

Kevin "Ox" White, first game in Reserves at 14, played his 200th game for St. Kilda C.B.C.O.C. — Club best and fairest 1975, captain '74, '75, '76. (Kevin went on to star in Victoria's successful 1979 carnival team).

Ormond "A", fifth, showed their best form for the season when they overran second team Old Scotch, 19.17 (131) to 11.13. (79). Best were **Holdsworth, Andrews, Chisholm (Orm.)** and **Bates, Cox, Kiel (Old Scotch)**.

150 games to Elsternwick's **Gary "Lumpy" Rosewarne** and 200 to Hampton Rovers **John "Slag" Macnish**, a "specialist" drop kick, most consistent (once) best clubman (twice), committee (9 years) and club delegate (3 years).

Parkside "B" third, missed the chance to boost their percentage against Collegians, fourth, when they kicked 9.15 to 3.6. Best for Parkside were **R. Johnstone, Fitzgerald and Steven Wilson**.

10 YEARS AGO — 1973

Ormond completed the cycle of beating every team in turn when they finished 23 points to the good against **North Old Boys** — ninth win in succession with their only defeat for the season being by North in the opening round. **Bourne, Graham, Curtis (Ormond)** and **Murray, Peasnell, O'Connor (North O.B.)** were best.

Parkside continued their great form in 'C' (9 wins 1 loss) with a 67 point win over **Old Melburnians** who were in fourth position. Stars were **King, Hayes, Wiseman (Park)** and **Weir, Cloke, Dick (Old Melb.)**.

150 games to **Mick Johnson (A.M.P.), John Rigby (Old Hailey)**, and 100 games to **Phil Simon (St. Kev's O.B.), Ray Moore (P side)**.

Coburg also praised forward **Peter Callesen** who played his 100th game against **Ormond** today. Two years ago Peter had a serious knee injury but a successful operation and a year's rest worked wonders. Peter's marking ability and strength had made him a very valuable player for Coburg.

Only undefeated teams were **Ormond (A Reserve), U. Blacks (B Reserve)** and **Coburg (Junior 2)**.

Old Brighton (C) kicked 22.22 to U.H.S.O.B.'s 11.13. Best were **Agar (11), J. Shepherd (5)** and **D. Wood (Old B)** and **J. Griffin, Flavel, Boag (U.H.S.O.B.)**.

15 YEARS AGO — 1968

St. Bernard's skipper **Geoff Tobin** played his 100th game. **Doug Puddy** of the **Alphington** football family recorded his 150th game with the club as did **Julian Prendergast** with St. Kevin's O.B. and **Tony Fink** with Old Carey.

"Gympie" noted that in the Reserves **Jim Carroll** broke down and it looked like the end of a playing career that started in 1947. He was replaced in the last term by that recruit **Alan Kirby** (only 38 years old)! (Jim Carroll won three Association best and fairest awards.)

Perhaps **Gympie** was a little overcome as, despite **Commonwealth Bank's** highest score for some weeks, 12.11, they were annihilated by **Monash Uni.** who kicked 22.7 with 8 goals straight in the second quarter. **Malcolm** (11 goals), **Rattray** (4), **Home** (4) starred for the students while **Borrock, Edwards** (6) and **Ventura** (4) kept Bank in the game.

Melbourne High, ninth with 18 points in 'A' Section, but only 6 points away from fourth position, defeated **Uni. Blacks** by 3 points. High kicked 1.6 in the last quarter to Blacks 5.4 and were lucky to scrape home.

West Brunswick, bottom in 'C' Section and battling to avoid relegation, were unlucky to lose by 5 points to **Power House** (5th). **Allen, Lewis** and **Murray** were good players for **West Brunswick**.

25 YEARS AGO — 1958

Victoria, after trailing **5th. Australia** by 13 points at last change, finally triumphed by 4 points with a goal scored seconds before the final siren. Best for **Victoria** were **Law, Nelson, Grant, Capes, Stokes, G. Hibbins**. Victorians selected

to play in **Australia Amateur** team as part of ANFC Centenary Carnival were **Geoff Hibbins, Leigh Grant, Ian Law, Noel Stokes, John Winneke, Les Edlering, Alan Pinkus**.

Ormond (7th) surprised **Old Xaverians** (3) with an all the way win by 29 points in very windy conditions. It was Ormond's best performance for the season. **Sonneleiter, Mau, Killmorgan (Ormond)** and **Burnes, Carroll, Sanders (Old X)** were best.

A.J.A.X. congratulated **Dave Burston**, nippy little rover who marked sensationally over a pack of six footers — also kicked 5 goals too.

Brunswick (6th) (C) trailed **Parkside** (2nd) until the last change, and then attacked continually in the last quarter to win by 4 points. **Strachan, A. Diggerson (B'wick)** starred while **Kane, Coventry** and **Biff** held Parkside together.

Old Melburnians welcomed back state star winger, **Bryce Thomas**, who had been out of the game for almost a year through illness. His absence had not dimmed his pace which was an important factor in **Old Melburnians'** win over **Ivanhoe**.


games. Fortunately for other fullbacks, Hunto shares his Saturdays between footy and his veterinary duties! Congratulations on your 50th Hunto!


