ELIGIBILITY

The following extracts from the "Rules of the Association" are published to remind Club Secretaries of the requirements regarding player eligibility for the final series as passed at the V.A.F.A. Members' Meeting on 1st November, 1980 and amended at the V.A.F.A. Members' Meeting on 2nd August, 1982.

- Rule 13. Grades shall be the categories of the premiership competition matches in which a player may be eligible to represent a Club.
- Rule 14. The Grades shall be the Senior Grade, the Junior Grade and the Reserve Grade.
- Rule 15. The first* and second† rounds of the Senior Grade shall be open to all eligible and registered players to represent the Club with which they have been granted a permit.
- Rule 16. The first round of the Junior Grade shall be open to all eligible and registered players who have not attained the age of 19 years on or before the 31st December of the preceeding year.
- Rule 17. The second round of the Junior Grade shall be open to all eligible and registered players within the age limits prescribed in Rule 16 to represent the Club with which they have been granted a permit provided that a player who has represented a Club in an aggregate of more than five matches in the Senior Grade and Reserve Grade in the first round in any season shall not be eligible unless he has represented such Club in more than five matches in the first round of the Junior Grade in the same season **unless such Club shall be represented in a match of the second round in the Senior Grade on the same day. In the event of a draw taking place in a match in the second round of the Junior Grade, all players who took part in the drawn game shall be eligible to take part in the game to be replayed.**
- Rule 18. The first round of the Reserve Grade shall be open to all eligible and registered players to represent the Club with which they have been granted a permit.
- Rule 19. The second round of the Reserve Grade shall be open to all eligible and registered players to represent the Club with which they have been granted a permit provided that no player shall be eligible to represent a Club unless such player shall have represented such Club in at least two matches of the Reserve Grade in the first round in the same season and further provided that no player shall be eligible to represent a Club after having represented such Club in more than eight matches of the Senior Grade in the first round in the same season unless such Club shall be represented in a match of the second round of the Senior Grade on the same day. In the event of a draw taking place in a match in the second round of the Reserve Grade, all players who took part in the drawn game shall be eligible to take part in the game to be replayed.
- Rule 20. Notwithstanding anything herein contained in these Rules a player shall not be eligible to play —
 - (i) In any Grade whilst under suspension by the Independent Tribunal.
 - (ii) In any Grade pending investigation by the Independent Tribunal of any charge against such player unless the Independent Tribunal otherwise orders.

*Rule 35. The first round shall be the home and home matches in which each team shall be scheduled to play every other team twice provided that this may be varied by the Executive Committee to meet the exigencies of the number of Clubs represented in a Section.

†Rule 39. The second round shall comprise the first semi-final match, second semi-final match, preliminary final match and grand final match in each Section. Any drawn match shall be replayed.

Collegians assured itself of a semi final by out-playing Marcellin in the A Section match of the day last Saturday. It was the Eagles fourth loss on end and also meant losing 4th place to North Old Boys who won convincingly against Old Melburnians. North has a danger game today at Ormond who given the right combination of results over the next three weeks could snatch fourth spot themselves.

De La Salle were kept on their toes by an encouraging performance from Trevor Read's Old Scotch. Paul Meadows in particular worried the De La defence and his 8 goals was a fine effort. Lack of height in key positions is a worry for the brains frusts at De La.

Old Xaverians lost another game at home by less than a goal this time to the never say die spirit that has marked Ormond sides over the years. When faced with relegation the Brown and Blue have responded magnificently and with their U19s playing premiership football in Premier Division the future looks bright.

Kew sounded a warning that it has recovered its form by accounting for Bulleen-Templestowe and now has a great opportunity of taking the coveted double chance which will prove vital for the A Section hopes of Alphington, Kew & Bulleen-Temp. We're certainly in for some great finals games in B Section.

Caulfield Grammarians have pulled a game clear in C Section which is delicately poised. Hampton Rovers finds itself in the hot seat as it must play the other 3 sides in the 4 and win two to so remain. Certainly St. Kevin's eyes will be on the Rover's results over the next 3 weeks.

Old Ivanhoe has a similar task in D Section as North Brunswick (5th) have a much easier run home. Power House too could still make it, as their fine win over Fawkner last Saturday would indicate.

Thomastown beat a determined Peninsula to keep its unbeaten record intact whilst Balaclava has assured itself of the all important "double chance".

St. John's upset the Footscray apple cart with their unexpected yet grand win which sent FITOB from third to fourth. While Clayton and La Trobe have a game's breathing space any one of five clubs could fill the remaining two positions. The newly found form of ANZ and St. John's has created the most even F Section in years.

In U.19 football, the Premier Division 4 is settled although positions will vary, but in Zone 1 Old Ivanhoe, Williamstown and Kew will fight out 4th place and in Zone 2, other than unbeaten leaders St. Kilda CBC anyone of 6 clubs will battle for the right to challenge the Saints for whom Tony Riddell with 13 goals last week, has now kicked 122 for the season.



5 YEARS AGO — 1978

Ormond, sixth in 'A', stayed among the possibles when they kicked 4.2 to 0.3 in the final term to beat **Ivanhoe**, fourth on 32 points, level with **North Old Boys** (third).

While **De La** were two points ahead in second position, **Uni. Blues**, even though they went down by 18 points to **Blacks** (8th), were three games clear on top.

Power House 'D' held on to top place when they defeated **St. Kevin's O.B.** (third) 23.16 to 13.7. Best were **Dempsey, Bredyk, Evans (P. House)** and **Brennan, Radford, Hannan (St. K.O.B.)**.

St. Bernard's welcomed back former captain, best and fairest (1972) **Michael Ginnivan**, who had spent the last three years in England studying for his doctorate in agricultural science.

Kew congratulated 6'3", 14 stone **Ken Rowland** who, despite work commitments, had played 50 consecutive games in the seniors.

U.H.S.O.B. thanked **Barry Parks** for his 150 game service and his energy as 1978 reserves coach.

150 games also to 'A' section top goalkicker, **Barry "Kanga" O'Connor (N.O.B.)** previously a full back of note for many years. Fast, a great mark, sure ball-handler and big kick, "Kanga" was a great clubman as well.

St. Bede's O.C.F.C. were holding a Sportman's Dinner — guest speakers were **Ron Barassi, Harry Beitzel, Ray Jordan, Stan Alves, Hyperno** and **John Stocker**.

10 YEARS AGO — 1968

Bottom team **Old Paradians** scored a shock win over equal leaders **St. Bernard's**. Parade led all day and won by 26 points. **Grace, Ford Hough (O.P.)** and **Burgin, Iannazzo, Drennan (St. B)** were the stars.

Coburg failed to make sure of their finals position when **Uni. Blues** (7th) held them to a low scoring draw — 8.6 apiece, but were helped when top team **Ormond** 21.13 beat St. team, **Caulfield Grammarians**, 17.11.

150 games to **Ivanhoe** veteran allrounder **Ralph Bourke**, a career stretching over many years and interfering with a very illustrious career as a punter, and to **Bruce Watt**, an inspiration to **Brunswick** over many years.

Phil Rowell and **Don Dodds** shared the winner's trophy at the **Umpires' Golf Day** at Torquay.

All at **Ormond** were deeply saddened at the death of **Dennis Drum**, a former great player and club captain in 1963. Dennis also played for **Uni. Blacks** and **Old Xaverians** before joining Ormond and also represented Victoria.

Congratulations to **Jack McCann** who, after a lifetime of service to Amateur Football, was made a **Life Member of the Australian Amateur Football Council**.

Marcellin offered plaudits to **Michael Power** on being first 100-gamer in the club.

15 YEARS AGO — 1963

In the battle of the top two teams, **Uni. Blues** gained an early break on **Old Paradians** and went on to win by 8 goals. **Calcott, Moylan, Whittakers and Moran** (6 goals) dominated the game.

Chris Milburn played his 150th game for **Parkside** while another to make that number was talented allrounder **Denis Grace** for **St. Kevin's O.B.**

Old Geelong scraped home from **Old Brighton** by 4 points, wiping out Brighton's last hope of making the Four.

25 YEARS AGO — 1958

Alphington's poor kicking (7.15) threw the game away to **Old Scotch** 12.7. **Reed** was a tower of strength in the ruck for Alphington and was well supported by **Hippiatt, R. Morris, Maughan** and **K. Melville** were best for Old Scotch.

Old Paradians rover **Brian Hill** received best wishes on his 100th game. In his career, starting with B grade Grand Final in 1951 (while still at school), Brian won a Victorian guernsey, the club's best and fairest, and many other awards — with one ambition to fulfil — a premiership. Was 1958 to be the year?

A battle of top 'D' section teams and **St. Kevin's** finished strongly to defeat **Port Melbourne** by 28 points. **Welsh, Rogers, Buckley, O'Brien (5)** (St. Kevin's) and **Stevenson, Aghan, Murphy (Port Melb.)** were best.

National Bank held on to their place in the 'C' Section Four with a three point win over **U.H.S.O.B.**, both teams kicking poorly 6.11 to 5.14. Bank stars were **Woolley, Goddard, Selleck** while U.H.S.O.B.'s best were **Peterson, Lever and Thorley**.

Junior section captains were: **B. Keane (Parkside), J. Maglen (M.H.S.O.B.), N. Gilmour (Coburg), B. Lake (C. Bank), W. Rush (A-ton), A. Square (Uni.), G. Bradford (F.I.T.), M. Read (Ivanhoe), P. Ouley (Ormond) and D. Thompson (Power House).**

35 YEARS AGO — 1948

Hampton Rovers (3rd) made their finals place almost safe with a 5-goal win over **Coburg**, who slipped out of the Four with **Old Scotch** moving into the Four — **"Prickles" Noble, Breadon, Lucas** and **Geoff Jones** were stars for the Rovers.

Collegians, still without a win, were outclassed by **O.M.s**. At the **Carnival in Perth**, **Victoria** defeated **W.A.** in the Final, the victors kicking 4.6 to 2.3 in the final term.

Ken Rollason (O.M.) won the trophy for **Best and Fairest** at the **Carnival**, while others who starred for Victoria were **John Backhouse (M.H.S.O.B.)** and **Jack Grainger (O.M.)**.
