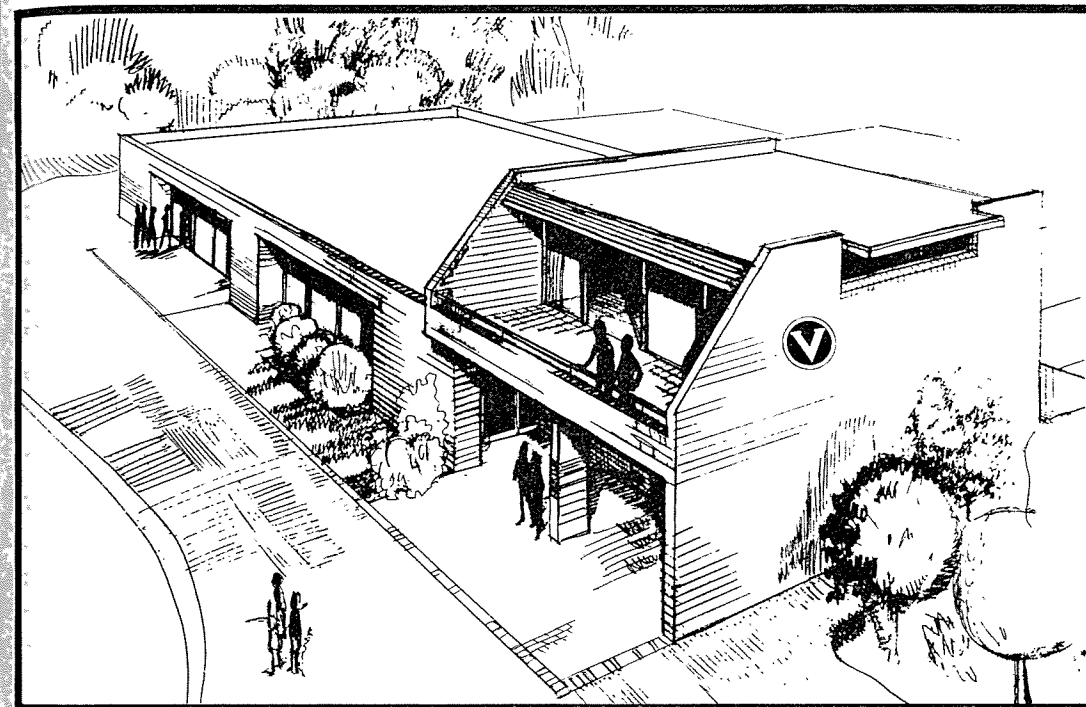

North O.B. ended Ormond's faint hopes of a final berth and ensured their own place in the first semi with a 12 goal win in the A Section match of the day last Saturday. After a dismal start to 1983 North are now in top form and their clash today with competition leaders, Univ. Blues highlights the round. North appear certain of defending their 1982 flag and an in form North will cause Neil LeLievre (De La) and Syd Myers (U. Blues) some anxious moments before September 11th.

Old Scotch carried on their recent return to form and surprised Collegians, winning by 5 goals. Scotch are now free of relegation worries and should finish the season with nine wins and possibly miss 4th spot due to a poor percentage.

According to former Marcellin coach, player and current State Selector, Gavin White, Marcellin created history last Saturday in suffering its fifth successive defeat. The Eagles had never lost 5 straight although Ivanhoe's performance was full of merit and its home clash today with Collegians will decide their fate for 1984. At home they're a good chance to win, especially if it's heavy, conditions relished by prime movers, Pratt, McDonald and Balcombe. Their 6th win would make the final round in A Section particularly interesting.

For Old Camberwell to remain in B Section they must win the last 2 games and even then could still be relegated. Their clash with St. Bernard's at Essendon today will decide the fate of both club and at home St. Bernard's should win. Bulleen Templestowe had to work hard for the 4 points against a spirited Coburg but should win its remaining 2 matches and retain the double chance which means a Kew v Alphington first semi.

Old Haileybury beat Old Brighton to ensure their place in C Section in 1984. Old Brighton will now join M.H.S.O.B. in D Section, although the Brighton lads believe where there's life there's hope and they've still plenty of both!

Wins by St. Kilda CBC and Hampton Rovers will now mean a replay of the St. Pius St. Kilda CBC match and West Brunswick's win over St. Kevin's has ended Bill Nettlefold's chance of taking St. Kevin's to B Section for 1984.

Old Ivanhoe continued its consistent winning form by toppling D Section leaders Therry and securing fourth place, and although they've two tough games remaining they're certainly playing well enough to feature in the finals.

Big question in E Section is whether Thomastown can remain the only undefeated team in the competition, with 2 rounds to go they're a strong chance for the title of "Champions".

The F Section four is still a long way from settlement with Commonwealth Bank the latest club to flex its muscles and show out as a promotion candidate and possible premier. Old Geelong returned to the winning list but are still a game out of the four as is Univ. High.

In Reserves football, Marcellin replaced Ivanhoe in the A Section four due to a five point win and West Brunswick moved back into the C Section four by defeating the previously unbeaten St. Kevin's. F Section Reserves are as close as the Seniors whilst Williamstown will be struggling to oust Old Ivanhoe in U.19 Zone 1. In Zone 2 St. Kevin's provided the upset of the round by defeating St. Kilda CBC thus denying the Saints any chance for an unbeaten run. More importantly for St. Kevin's it gives them a good chance of making the finals. Collegians kicked an incredible 43 goals in its match against Old Camberwell whilst David Matthews of Caulfield Grammarians is to be congratulated on kicking 11 goals against Parkside and becoming the second forward to reach the coveted century so far this season. Maher (Marcellin U.19's) and Broderick (Thomastown) are also close to the magical 100.

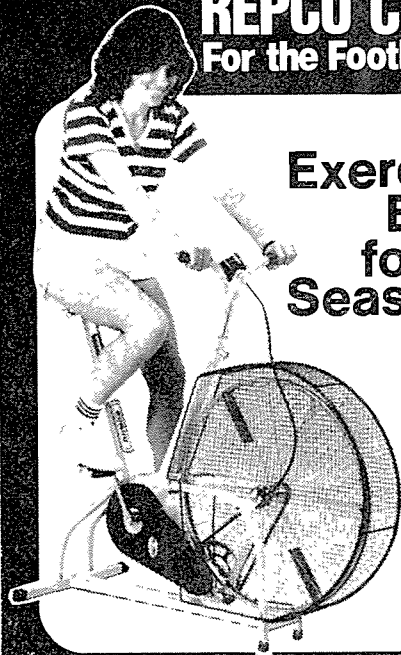

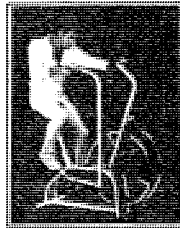

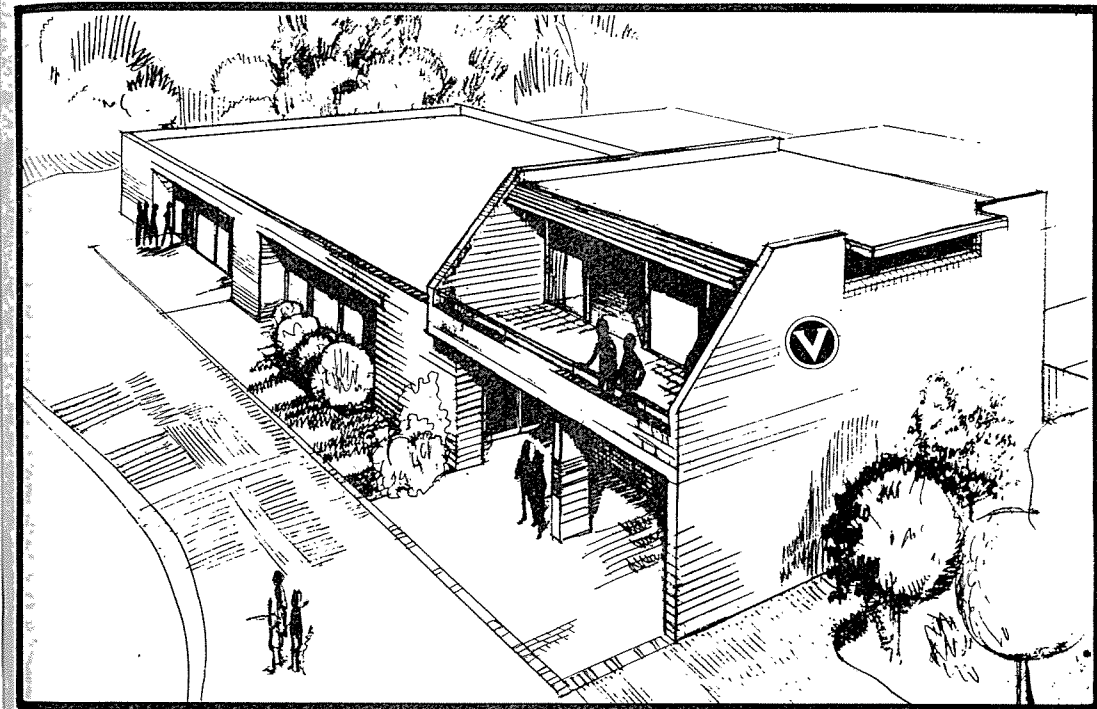
