

North O.B. and Marcellin played a high standard and thrilling match to climax the first round of the 1983 season. A large crowd gathered in ideal conditions to witness a game that was worthy of a final. and they were not disappointed. Jim Hawkins who attended believed it was the best home and home game he'd seen in more than a decade and a delighted Gus Carroll told me after the game that it "felt like a Grand Final". He was confident North O.B. could go on and upset the favourites and repeat their 1982 success. North's winning goal came 30 seconds from time and the Marcellin players and supporters were stunned by the result and its fatal consequence. The Eagles had the chances to win but the cramping of some key players and inexperience may have cost them the game and a place in the four.

In other A Section matches, **Uni. Blues** demoralised rivals **De La Salle** winning by more than 16 goals in an aweinspiring display of 1980's football. De La sorely missed Green & Deveson and will need to show a lot more if it is to worry the Blues next week.

Collegians were untroubled in beating Old Xavs as were Ormond against Old Melburnians, and Old Scotch finished its season well with a strong win over Ivanhoe.

In B Section. St. Bernard's ensured its place in B Section with a good win over Alphington whilst Coburg's failure against Old Paradians means relegation. Monash Blues stayed with Bulleen-Templestowe for three quarters before going down by 5 goals. A.J.A.X. ended the season in fifth place with a good win over the disappointing Uni. Blacks.

In C Section Parkside ensured its finals place by defeating Hampton Rovers, and although St. Kevin's came home with an eight goal last quarter and victory over Old Haileybury it had to be content with fifth place.

North Brunswick's win over Univ. Reds and Old Ivanhoe's loss at Fawkner, reversed their ladder positions and enabled N.B. to feature in the first semi.

There were no surprises in E Section, although **Thomastown** with 18 wins, earns the Championship tag if it can win two more!

In F Section, **U.H.S.O.B.** came from 6th place to fourth with a 16 point win over **Clayton** whilst **Old Geelong's** win over **La Trobe** earnt it the double chance and pushed the students out of the four.

In U.19 Zone 2 Old Brighton scrambled into 4th place at the expense of Old Haileybury who were beaten by Monash Blues.

In Reserves football **St. Pius** ousted **West Brunswick** in C Section whilst **Power House's** win over **State Bank** saw them hold onto fourth place. **Old Mentonians** finished fifth in both seniors and reserves, although it was the latter team that was most unfortunate.

I mentioned last week that the **St. Pius** and **St. Kilda** replay was probably the first Amateur match played under lights for 4 points. **Peter Dakin** of **Power House** fame rang to advise that in 1979 Power House juniors played Old Brighton under lights at South Melbourne and lost! Thank you Peter for the information which proves that some people do read the Amateur Footballer.

General Manager, **Peter French**, was all smiles Monday after his wife, **Jennifer** presented him with their first child — a daughter, "**Georgina**". Congratulations and best wishes to the three of you.

DERELICTION OF DUTY STANDS CORRECTED

Season 1983 has seen a large number of significant milestones attained by members of the **Collegian Football Club.** Sadly, with only one exception, they have gone unheralded and unacknowledged. Collegians press correspondent pleads guilty to gross dereliction of duty and now undertakes to improve his efforts for the balance of the season in the hope of redeeming his ravished reputation.

Before attacking the embarrassing backlog on an individual basis the writer extends preliminary congratulations to the following players:

50 Games: Simon Day, Angrew Guiney, Stuart Hinchen, Peter Lawrence, Roger Teale, David Tadgell, Rodney Walker and Andrew Daff.

100 Games: Colin Singleton, David Bickford, Glen Cook and Nick Chosich.

400 Games as either Player or Senior Coach: Bruce Ferguson.

The first player to face the lime-light is **Colin Singleton** who played his 100th game for the Lions in round 5 against University Blues. Colin, the current deputy vice-captain of the Reserves, joined the club in 1977. He had previously played with his alma mater, Melbourne Grammar, and while at Melbourne University for Trinity College before giving the game away for 3 full seasons.

During season 1977 Colin was persuaded by a misguided Collegian to terminate his premature retirement. As the Club XVIII was then in dire need of players of whatever calibre and character the Collegians F.C. waived its normally strict entry requirements (which preclude persons of depraved tendencies such as O.M.s from joining) and allowed Colin membership.

Colin subsequently played 4 seasons and approximately 50 games with the club XVII1, winning the Best and Fairest Award in 1978. Only his obstinacy in refusing to train prevented promotion until season 1981 when Col finally relented. The rewards of training were immediate. Not only did Col become a fine Reserves key position backman but he was chosen for several games in the senior XVIII before returning to the Reserves as a forward. Colin relished the change and was a vital member of the Reserves 1981 B Reserve Grade Premiership side, kicking four goals in both the preliminary and Grand Finals. In that year he also won the Reserves Best First Year Player Award.

Colin's enthusiasm for training has since waned but he has remained a great contributor for the Reserves over the past two seasons with his versatility, sure marking pace and fine disposal. Col has been injured for several games and all Lions look forward to his return and more match-winning finals performances. Well done Col, from all at Collegians.

150 GAMES AT BULLEEN UNITED

In 1973 a young skinny kid named **Richard Morley** played his first senior game with **Bulleen United**. Ten years later, that same skinny kid lines up for his 150th game this week, which is just another milestone in Dick's amazing record for the Bulls.

During his career with Bulleen United. Dick has won the Best & Fairest on five occasions — 1977. 78, 79, '81 and '82, and in 1978 was runner-up in the competition Best & Fairest, which he lost on a countback. This is a record which most players only dream about, however Dick is not prepared to rest on his laurels — he seems to get better as the years go on.

As a footballer, Dick is renowned for possessing amazing skills and fortitude — his marking is strong and often spectacular, his kicking long and penetrating and he plays the role of an attacking defender almost without fault. Such is his effectiveness that in a match against Beverley Hills a few years ago, he was credited with 52 kicks and 28 marks — from centre-half back!! His attitude to training, which is a grind for most players, is very refreshing. Dick trains as hard as he plays, continually shouting encouragement and urging on his team mates. I believe it is this positive commitment to track work which has made him the champion he is today.

Dick's talents are not only confined to the football field, however. As a valued member of the social committee, Dick is instrumental in organising club functions, and enthusiastically supports all the turns. Looking back on the first ten years, Dick lists his most memorable occasion as the 1982 Premiership victory, the first senior flag in the club's history. As one would expect. Dick also picked up the club award for the best player in that finals' series. I'm sure all involved with Bulleen United, and many opposition players and former team mates over the years, will join me in congratulating Dick on his magnificent record and latest achievement. One can only hope that Dick remains with the Bulls for many years to come, so the club can benefit even more from his footballing prowess.


