

# NORTH O.B. SHOCK — XAVS & IVANHOE IN THRILLER

Collegians showing sparkling early season form outplayed the reigning premiers to record a most worthy win at Brens Oval.

Old Xaverians and Ivanhoe played a thriller at Swan Street which saw the visitors get home by 4 points.

Old Melburnians ran out of steam and experience against University Blues in their return to A grade whilst De La Salle handled the windy conditions far better than Marcellin to run out easy winners. Ormond with 16 year old Ricky Jackson in the thick of things proved too strong for Old Scotch.

In B grade Alphington gave promise of things to come by crushing Old Camberwell and AJAX came from behind to upset Monash, as did Kew to beat Coburg. St. Bernard's gave Bulleen-Templestowe too much of a start going down by just 7 points whilst Old Paradians edged out the Blacks by 10 points in another close game.

Bill Nettlefold led St. Kevin's to a crushing win over Melbourne High whilst St. Pius a new comer to 'C' Section easily out jointed Old Brighton. Caulfield Grammarians relegated have regrouped and won well at the expense of West Brunswick.

Newcomers to 'D' Section, Therry CCOB and Banyule had strong wins against University Reds and St. Bede's O.C. respectively as did North Brunswick over State Bank.

There were some huge wins in 'E' Section. Old Trinity demolished Bulleen United by 106 points and Balaclava had an 105 point win over Elsternwick. The one exception was at Mt. Eliza where the "Pirates" (Peninsula O.B.) snuck home by 2 points against Old Carey.

Old Geelong kicked the sweep in 'F' Section defeating St. John's by 162 points. Commonwealth Bank also had a big win of 112 points at the expense of U.H.S.O.B. as did Brunswick over ANZ Bank.




# **ALCOHOL AT GROUNDS**


