


FIFTY GAMES FOR A TIGER



5 YEARS AGO — 1978

'E' Section coaches were David Crompton (AMP), Rod Butterworth (Bv. Hills), Phil Butcher (B'wick), Alan Quaife (Bull-Temp), Ian Duncan (North B'wick), Des Kennedy (Old Geel), Bernie Maher (Old Mentonians), Bill Turner (St. Bede's). Who coached ANZ Bank and La Trobe Blacks? The bubble burst for 'A' Section leader Old Scotch when their inaccuracy, 9.17, cost them victory against Marcellin's 13.8. Well in control in the third quarter, Old Scotch kicked 3.9 in that term to Marcellin's 2.1 Best were F. Allosio, Jones, Price (Marc.) and Marx, Bowden, Bubb (Old Scotch).

Joint 'A' Section leader U. Blues also was trounced when De La, with the wind, kicked 8.6 to 0.0 in the first quarter, equalled Blues second quarter (2.2 each) and coasted home to a 51 point victory. Best were Loft, Halasa (State Selector — 1983), McHenry, Beddoe (6 goals) (De La) and Carroll, Curnow, Moore (U. Blacks).

North Brunswick battling to get off the bottom of 'E' were unlucky to go down to Old Mentonians, 6.16 to 7.13. Peel, Upham and Ingram starred for the victors and D. Dimarco, Strickland and Holdsworth for North Brunswick.

10 YEARS AGO — 1973

'B' Section coaches were Jim Gallagher (Assump. O.C.), Ross Oakley (Coll.), Graeme Johnston (De La Salle), John Fisher (Kew), Ron Read (M.H.S.O.B.), Brian Steele (Old Scotch), Ian Law (Old Scotch), Brian Kann (Old Trinity), Laurie Aghan (R.O.B.) and Peter O'Donohue (U. Blacks).

Ormond scraped home by a goal from Caulfield Gram. in an exciting finish at Elsternwick Park. The defeat dropped Caulfield Grammarians from first to fourth.

Collis, Webster and Spithill starred for S.S.B. in their victory over Marcellin to give the Bank 5 wins and 1 defeat.

150 games to Robert Reid (U.H.S.O.B.), 100 to Rob Dean (Alphington), Alan Graham (Ormond), Tony Costello (U. Blacks), Rick Sykes (Power House) and 200 to Foots. Tech captain coach Geoff Fletcher — 'a grand effort from a grand club man'.

15 YEARS AGO — 1968

Kew suffered their first defeat for the season at the hands of University Blacks who in a brilliant first half kicked 9.4 to 2.4. Kew added only another 2.4 in the second half. Sinclair (4), Stevens and Carnie dominated for Blacks while Mullin, Haldoups and Ridd were best for the losers.

Ormond undefeated in 'B' Section, kicked the sweep against St. Kilda CBC 18.21 to 3.6

Monash Uni., also undefeated, went away in the last quarter to have a convincing win, 8.10.58 to 4.9.33 over De La Salle (5th). McMasters, Grey and Taylor, for Monash, and Dorrizzo, Broderick and Walsh were best.

U.H.S.O.B. farewelled Jim Nettleton — captain, best and fairest in 1966, and only member of the Club's 1960 premiership team still playing.

100 games to Peter Sedgewick (Old Brighton), Peter Curtis (Ormond) and Rob Thompson (Old Melburnians).

25 YEARS AGO — 1958

State Savings Bank's defeat of joint leader, Old Xaverians by 6 points, left Collegians alone at head of 'A' Section ladder. Bank led all day and held on desperately in last 10 minutes with Hill, Salmon and Douglas best. Old Xaverians were best served by Callen, Carroll, Gibson.

'D' Section captains were John Douglas (St. Kevin's), K. Washfold (Pton), Lionel Rosenberg (A.J.A.X.), T. Baird (F.T.O.B.), P. Mills (Fairf.), W. McGrory (Murrumbena), Harrison (Port. Melb.), who captained E'wick, Melb. Blues and Bellfield?

Ormond welcomed old players Laurie Mithen, Colin Wilson, Brian Walsh and Neil Crompton to training.

Old Brighton Grammarians congratulated temporary coach, Horrie Berry, on his debut and wished him well for next three weeks.

35 YEARS AGO — 1948

Ormond 3 points down at ¾ time kicked 42 to Old Scotch's 32 in the last quarter to reverse the result. Jack Stock and Bob Rowe were stars for the victors while Keith Gough with 5 goals from centre half-forward dominated for the Cardinals.

Parkside continued their unbeaten run with a victory over State Savings Bank — for the victors Harry Nance gave a grand performance of sustained football. (Harry was a V.A.F.A. umpire for many years and assistant umpire's coach.)


