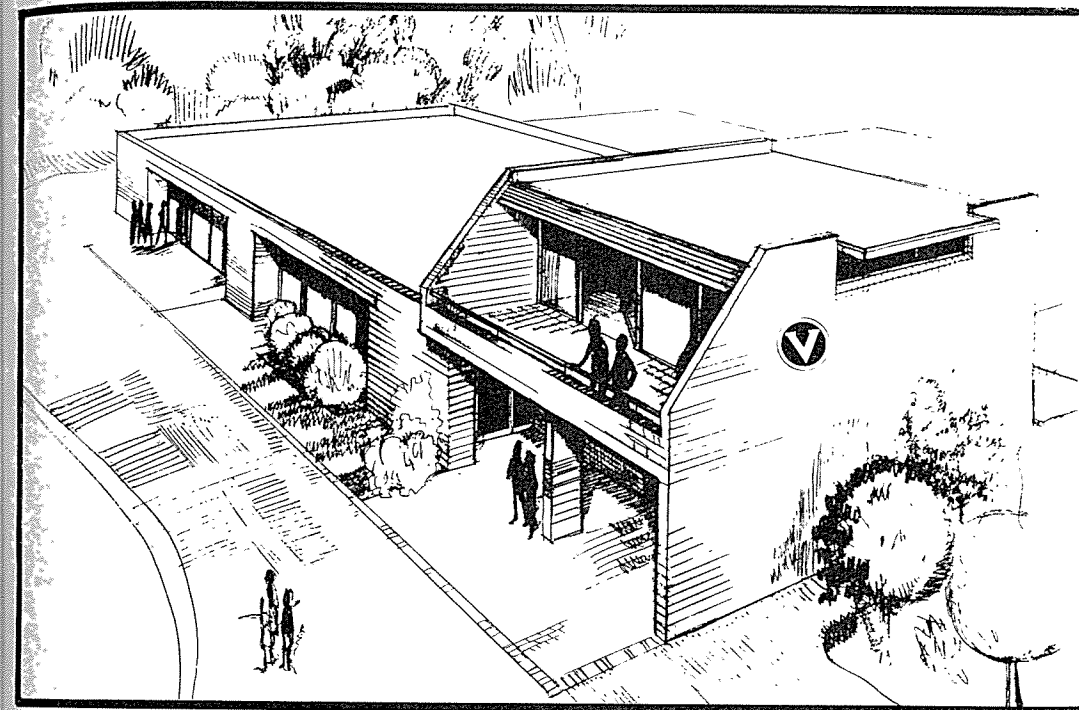
## 50 GAMES AT S.K.O.B.

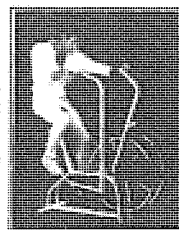

**A SECTION LEADERS CONSOLIDATE & ST. JOHN'S WINS FIRST GAME SINCE 22.8.81 COLLEGIANS & BLUES BY A MILE, MARCELLIN SCRAPES HOME, DE LA & OLD SCOTCH UNTROUBLED AT THE FINISH**

A Section tipsters had an easy round of selections with the favourites all winning. **Old Xavs** had the chance to upset **Marcellin** at Bulleen but poor kicking let them down. Xavs certainly have some star players and will be hoping to repeat last season's effort when the second round begins after Queen's birthday. Its home match today against **Collegians** is crucial. Collegians ran riot against a disappointing **Ivanhoe** and had many good players, although none better than the **Bennett** brothers, who kicked 16 goals between them. The Lions have had a great year to date and are certainly equal favourites for A Section honours.

After an even first half **Blues** pulled away from **North O.B.** and won by ten goals. Its clash today with **De La** will highlight the round. **Ormond** showed great character to come from behind and lead **De La** at 3/4 time but had run its race and **De La** added 7 goals to 2 in the final term to record its seventh win and remain at the head of the ladder. **Ormond** is struggling in the relegation zone and its match today at **Cordner oval** against **Old Melburnians** who have been crippled by injuries will mean much to both clubs. **Scotch** who have been well down of late had far too much system and purpose for traditional rivals **O.M.s** and with continual good form and a reasonable draw may be on the verge of a winning streak.

Like B Section, C Section too is extremely even and percentage will be telling by the end of the season.

D Section appears to have sorted itself out with **Therry, Banyule, North Brunswick** and **Fawknor** leading the field. **Power House** and **State Bank** have eyes on the 4 but will have to improve during the second round.

**Thomastown** alone remains undefeated in E Section, although **Balaclava** and **Old Trinity** will be hard to crack when next they meet. In 4th place **Peninsula Old Boys** have a 2 game break but the "Pirates" are finding E Section a tough proposition at this stage.

The highlight of F Section and possibly the round was **St. John's** 3 goal win over **Monash Whites**. **St. John's** last win was back in August 1981 when they defeated **La Trobe** by 10 points. I'm sure the win was celebrated in **Doveton** till the wee hours. They have a strong chance of back to back success as they meet **A.N.Z.** who have yet to open their account at home today.

**Old Geelong** still lead the table from **F.I.T.O.B.** and the not to be underrated **Clayton**.

In U.19 football **North Old Boys, Banyule** and **St. Bernard's** are the top sides in Premier Division whilst **Marcellin** and **St. Kilda CBC** are both undefeated and lead zones 1 and 2 respectively.

**150 GAMES TO A TIGER**

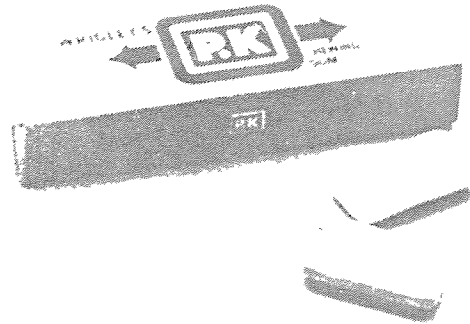

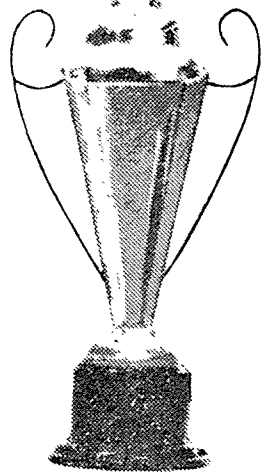

## LOOKING BACK

5 YEARS AGO — 1978

35 YEARS AGO — 1948

Club history was made at **St. Kilda C.B.C.O.B.** when **John White** ran onto the field to be the first player in the club's history to play 300 games. Committeeman for 17 years, president (1976-78), best and fairest, captain, top goalkicker — all from 5'10" and barely 10 stone, the club was proud of John White and hoped that talk of retirement was premature.

Top goalkickers after 9 rounds were: "A" O'Connor (N.O.B.) 35, "B" P. Harvey (P'side) 29, "C" Bromley (A'ton) 49, "D" Sykes (Power House) 57, "E" I. Henderson (A.M.P.) 43, "F" Hayman (T'bury) 27, "Junior 1" Richardson (N.O.B.) 33, "Junior 2" P. Greene (De La Salle) 61.

151 games to veteran full back **Peter Murphy (Ormond)** (Interstate selector — 1983), a member of the club's "A" Section premiership teams in 1971, 1972 and 1973, and to **Old Paradians Tony Johnson**, captain in 1978, who joined the club in 1968 as a member of the last group of recruits from "The Old Bluestone Pile", was a member of that year's Junior Section premiership team.

**Old Haileybury** tipped Old Paradians out of "B" Section four with a 3 point victory, gained by straight kicking as compared with the losers' inaccuracy. Paradians were a bit unlucky as goalless at half-time, 0.7 to 7.2 they kicked 11.10 to 6.6 the second half. Best were **Cocks, Corrigan, Bouris (Old Hail.)** and **Roe, McCarthy, C. Hughes (Old Parad.)**.

10 YEARS AGO — 1973

**Reservoir Old Boys (B)** were held to a draw by Old Carey in a thrilling finish to the game at Elsternwick Park. This put an end to Reservoir's run of 26 wins in succession. Best were **M. Cooke, Hutchins, Birrell, Freeman (Old C.)** and **Bates, R. Shepherd and Tuininga (R.O.B.)**. It was a great comeback by R.O.B. as they trailed Old Carey by 7 goals at half-time.

**De La Salle (B)** after 5 straight losses, beat Uni. Blacks by 1 point and then continued their revival with a 13 goal win over Old Scotch. **Mitchell (8 goals), M. & B. Bourke (De La)** and **Sloan, Addison, Anderson (Old S.)** were best.

150 games to **Russell Abernethy (Brunswick), Don Strachan (West Brunswick)** and 200 games to **Graeme Templeton (Old Brighton), Bill "Jet" Jackson (A.N.Z. Bank), Ron Bungey** became first Old Mentonian to reach 100 games.

15 YEARS AGO — 1968

"A" Section underwent another reshuffle — **University Blacks and Kew**, on top, were beaten and tumbled out of the four, their places being taken by **University Blues and Old Paradians**.

Four teams were now level, with pride of place going to **Caulfield Grammarians** who had a 4.7% margin over Coburg.

**Coburg** were 7 goals in front of Kew at half-time but Kew fought back to go down by only 3 points in a high scoring game. Coburg's straight shooting (16.5) saved the day. Best for Coburg were **N. Beattie, Warfe, T. Salter (5 goals)** and for Kew, **Taylor, Lister and Hiscock**.

The 150 games mark was reached by Parkside life member, **Albert "Rags" Bolger and Elsternwick's Graham Holmes**.

**Bill Beasley, Old Geelong**, celebrated his 21st birthday by getting the club vote for the second week in succession.

Only undefeated teams were **Ormond (B Section), Footscray Tech. (C Section), A.M.P. Society (E Section)** and **Old Paradians (Junior Section 2)**.

25 YEARS AGO — 1958

In an upset, inconsistent **Hampton Rovers** toppled "B" Section leader Uni. Blacks. Rovers played tight football to record Blacks' first defeat in a low scoring game played in unpleasant conditions. Best were **Willson, Kennedy, C. Adamson (H. Rovers)** and **Tuohey, Walker** (a member of V.A.F.A. tribunal, 1983 — N.R.) and **J. Winneke**.

Interstate team to play S.A. was announced, **G. Hibbins (Coll.)** was captain and other members were: **J. Whitfield (Alph.), A. Roberts (Coburg), R. Daff, J. McDonald, M. Rush (Coll.), R. Burt, B. Heather (Ivanhoe), I. Mort, N. Stokes (Kew), J.F. Nelson (M.H.S.O.B.), D. Morris (Old Melb.), I. Law (Old Scotch), A. Capes, P. Slattery (Old X.), D. Macmillan (Ormond), L. Grant (Power H.), G. Surtess, G. Watson (S.S.B.), J. Winneke (U. Blacks) and D. Shaw (U. Blacks).**

(Three members of the team went on to play in **Hawthorn's** 1961 V.F.L. Premiership team, another to play over 150 games for Essendon, another to play league football in W.A. for Claremont and later became President of Footscray, another two were state selectors in 1982, another a member of the tribunal for some years, and yet another is father of a player picked in the team to play V.F.A. in 1983. Can you name them? N.R.) Mr. J.B. Corder and Mr. J.S. McCann were manager and assistant manager and Ray Martin of Kew was coach, having replaced Mr. Joe Kelly who had withdrawn on medical advice.

**Doug Arnold (Hampton Rovers)** and **Mike Fitchett (Old Scotch)** were appointed captain and vice captain respectively of the Carnival team to play in Perth.

It was the day for the undefeated to lower their colours — **Coburg** downed Old Melburnians — O.M.s were 32 points down at three-quarter-time and just failed by 2 points, while **Balwyn** annihilated Parkside 15.20(110) to 8.7(55).

"B" Section captians were **Colin MacDonald (Uni. Blues), Peter Murphy (Old Xav.), P. Melville (Balwyn), Gordon Miller (S.S.Bank), Ken James (Comm. Bank), V. Searf (Parkside)** — who captained Elsternwick?

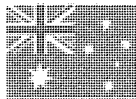

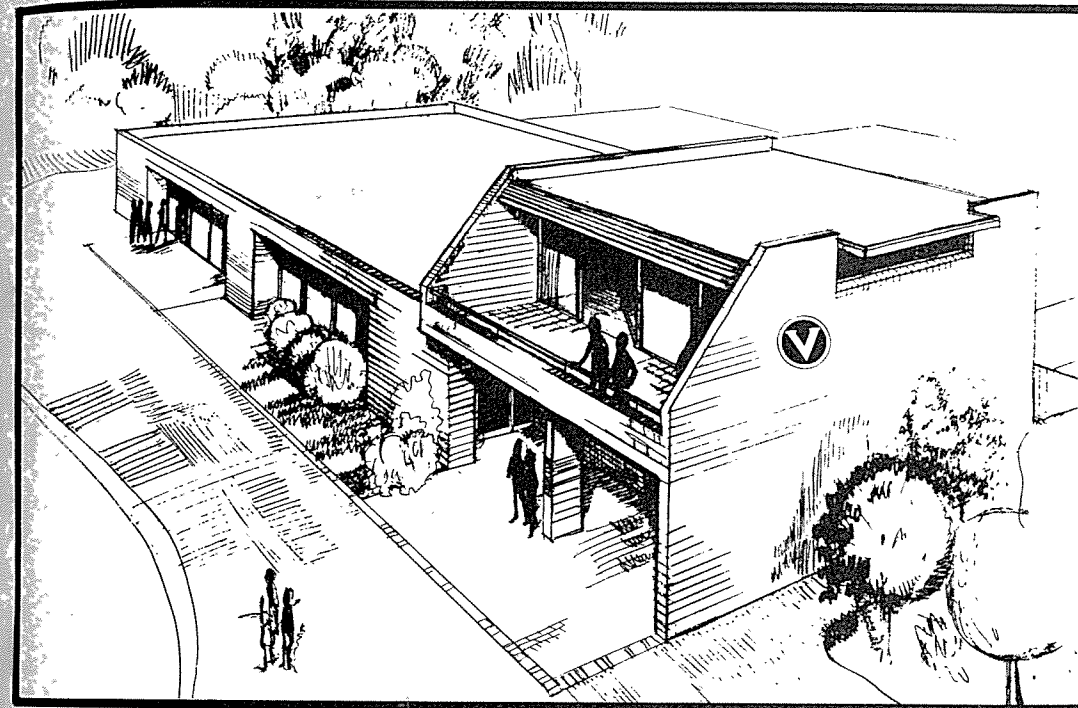

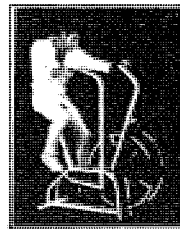
