Country Side Too Big, Too Strong, Too Good and Too Tough for VAFA

The V.C.F.L. defeated the V.A.F.A. by 10 goals in what was a most disappointing display by the V.A.F.A. Intimidated early by fierce tackling and close checking the V.A.F.A. was never allowed to settle down and wasted a number of opportunities despite having use of an **Elsternwick Park** type breeze. Fourteen points down at quarter time became 33 at half time and any hope of an upset was lost due to poor forward work when the V.A.F.A. could only manage 2 goals 6 behinds in the 3rd term. Certainly the V.A.F.A. played with far greater determination and spirit in the second half, but you cant win games when only a third of the side played well.

However it was not all bad! Some bright spots were the polished display from **St.Kilda CBOC** champion **Charlie Capiron** who received a trophy as the V.A.F.A.'s Best on Ground. Other winners were dependable **De La Salle** defender **Michael Deveson** and **Old Scotch** winger and ruck-rover **Brian Hodge**. **Stevie Wiltshire** from **Peninsula OB** brought great credit to himself and the lower sections with a splendid first up performance. So too did big **Uni Blacks** ruckman **Nick Heath** who due to injury to **Rohan Brown** was forced to assume the role of number one ruckman and was often under notice due to his strong around the ground marking. Other

prominent V.A.F.A. players were **Ivanhoe** captain **Peter Gittos** who took 16 marks at centre half back and had the call over talented **Robinvale** forward **Pat Healy**, whilst **Nick Wilton** from **Old Xaverians** was the other amateur to show out before being forced from the field with a torn hamstring.

All in all not one of the Association's most memorable seasons of Representative football. However coach **Michael Green**, captain **Shane Murphy**, **John Miles** and the selectors plus the associated staff and officials certainly have our gratitude and appreciation for their selfless devotion to the course of Amateur football.

A Section Review

It is three weeks since A Section last played and the results of that round leave the ladder in a very interesting position with six rounds to go until the finals.

Ormond is on top, two games clear and then come four sides all with 28 points and separated only by percentage: **Collegian**, **Old Scotch**, **Ivanhoe** and **North Old Boys**. One game further back are **Bulleen-Templestowe** and **De La Salle**, both of whom lack consistency. The fight to avoid relegation remains tense. **University Blues** have a good percentage and the same number of wins as **St. Bernard's**, but **Old Xaverians** are a game further back.

Back on June 29th, Ivanhoe moved into the four with an important and impressive 29 point win over North Old Boys who dropped from second to fifth. Ivanhoe jumped North and kicked 9 goals in the first term and held North to one. But in the second term the situation was reversed: North kicked 8 and held Ivanhoe goalless to go to a 4 point lead at the break. After that, North could only manage another 2 goals for the day whilst Ivanhoe managed another 6 goals. **Flynn**, **O'Sullivan** and **Russell** were all part of Ivanhoe's solid defence and up on the half forward line **Taylor** and **Morcom** were busy and kicked 4 goals each. **Busutill** was North's major goalkicker with 4 goals and **Atkinson**, **Cahill** and **Brown** all did good work on the ball.

University Blues moved out of the relegation zone with a 7 goal victory over St. Bernard's. Blues had a good second term with Don McInnes spectacular on the half forwardline. Blues led by 33 points at half time but St. Bernard's hit back with 8 goals straight and led by a point at the last break. **Roger Curnow** went into the ruck after being well held by **Corey Klaaysen** and took over — the result; a 9 goal quarter to the Blues and victory in what was a very torrid game.

Collegians beat **De La Salle** by 8 points after trailing by 11 points at three quarter time. It was a low scoring encounter though De La Salle did manage 5 goals in the third term. De La Salle, badly weakened by injuries and missing State representatives were not good enough on the day. **Collegians Tony Baum** got another 4 goals and **Schmidt** on the wing was a good player. De La Salle's best were backmen **Bourke** and **Hollier**.

Scotch scored a big 69 point win over bottom-placed **Old Xaverians**. The Xavs started well kicking the first 3 goals but after that they had too many lapses in concentration which allowed Scotch to score easy goals. **Tom Mason** kicked 7 and **Rick Lloyd** at full forward kicked 5. **Rob Fuller** back from Richmond showed out in the centre as did **Moir** in the ruck and **Nelson** at centre half back. Xav's best were the reliable **Geoff Greetham** at full back and **Martin Beatie** in the pocket next to him. The lowlight of the day was the fact that the game was played in the smoke of a burning Blue Harris carriage set alight by vandals in the Jolimont yards the night before.

Ormond had a convincing 27 point win over **Bulleen-Templestowe** at Koonung Park and remain in top position. **Singleton** kicked 5 for Ormond and **Harisiou** rucked well for the Bullants. I hope that **Greg Miles** is well on the way to recovery after his recent scare. Perhaps some more consistent form from Bulleen-Temp. might improve the secretary's health.

The Whisper Looks at Last Week and Previews Today's Games

Well, with all the representative stuff behind us its down to the business end of the season and in every grade the 'fight for the four' is now on in earnest.

In A section they've had a fortnights spell and as six clubs has a chance of finishing 2,3 or 4 all rounds will be chock full of interest. **Ormond** are safe and **Uni Blues**, **St. Bernard's** and **Old Xavs** have no hope. In fact **St. Bernard's** and **Old Xaverians** can start preparing for **B Section**, which leaves us with **Ivanhoe**, **Collegians**, **Old Scotch**, **North Old Boys**, **Bulleen-Templestowe** and **De La Salle**. With only a game between **Collegians** 2nds and **De La Salle** 7th the remaining 6 games will be mini finals and on checking the draw **De La Salle** has one of the more favourable. Their biggest hurdle is their poor percentage and certainly the reigning Premier has a huge task in reaching the 1985 finals. **Collegians** are a far different proposition than previous seasons. They're tougher this year and bigger and with a percentage worth a game they'll be there in September. **Ivanhoe** too has a favourable draw with 4 of the remaining 6 matches at home. **Old Scotch** would need to win 4 of the remaining games to be sure of its first finals appearance since its **A Section** flag win in 1978 which leaves us with **North Old Boys** and **Bulleen-Templestowe**. North has the easiest run in terms of ladder position whilst **Bulleen-Templestowe** will need to call on all its character and team spirit if it is to repeat last season's efforts. The club has been raided by VFL clubs and must trust in the depth and skill of its Reserves. What a month and a half awaits us.

Today **Collegians** at home will repeat their first round win over the **Bullants** and give itself the breathing space required. **Collegians** will win across the centre and has the more mobile forward line. In fact **Bruce Ferguson** is doing something of a **Kevin Sheedy** and has players such as **Tim Bennett** and **Tregear** capable of palying in either defence or attack. The **Bullants** will be in this game for the first half but **Collegians** skill, pace and home ground advantage will give them the points.

Ivanhoe meet **St. Bernards** at the Boulevard Oval and with the return of skipper **Peter Gittos** who has had a great represtative season highlighted by All Australian selection will be too talented for the **Saints**. Time is running out for **St. Bernards**, and **Old Xaverians** for that matter, and as a result they can be expected to fight the game right out. However **St. Bernards** "blue" it against the **Blues** and must be resigned now to rebuilding for another crack at **A Section** in 1987.

Match of the day will be played at **Old Scotch** between the home side and the competition leaders **Ormond**. **Scotch** in particular has welcomed the spell and hopes for the return of

Mason and **Kiel**. The reinstatement of **Fuller** has meant a lift up forward and **Hodge** will also add bite around the packs. Despite all these gains its had to go past **Ormond**. Their consistency is remarkable and they have match winners on every line. **Oaten** is close to returning and the form of **Ritchie**, the brothers **McDonald** and young **Eishold** in representative football suggests an **Ormond** victory. For me if its wet or windy its **Ormond**, but if dry **Old Scotch**.

I certainly don't need to have 2 bob each way on the outcome of the **De La Salle—Old Xavs** game. **De La** will win and be looking for a huge one to boost that woeful percentage. **Old Xavs** have disappointed their supporters and themselves in too many games this season to cuase an upset today.

North Old Boys play the **Blues** at Brens Oval and will be hard pushed for victory. **Blues** have the ability to beat any side in **A Section** including **Ormond** as the "Mons" know only too well! None the less **North** have so much at stake that I'll be most suprised if they fail to win at home.

Marcellin's loss to **Parkside** allowed the **Devils** to slip into second spot where I reckon they'll be damned hard to shift. With **St. Kilda CBOC** on the way back and a rapidly improving **Uni Blacks** capable of beating all comers that includes **Caulfield Grammarians** the remaining spots in the **B Section** 4 have all of a sudden become wide open. **O.M.'s** will be hoping that the injury sustained by **Rohan Brown** in Mildura is not serious as they'll certainly need his strength and leadership if it is to appear in the finals. At the other end of the scale **AJAX** is doomed and bound for C Section whilst **Old Paradians** fine win over **Kew** lifted the club 2 vital points clear of that club and place the **Browns** in the hot seat.

Caulfield Grammarians at **Bulleen**. The **Field's** will welcome the return of both **Kanis** and **Mathews** and rightly start favourites. On the other hand the **Eagles** will be smarting after their loss to **Parkside** and the vital double chance and at home I've a hunch they'll win this one.

Another game of significant proportions will be played at the University between **The Blacks** and **St. Kilda CBOC**. Both will welcome the return of representative players, especially the **Blacks** for whom **Dempsey** and **Heath** were indeed prominent in Mildura. With a sniff of the four in their nostrils the **Blacks** may have the greater incentive, although **St. Kilda CBOC**, with **Charlie Capiron** arguably the most skilful player in Amateur football and prime mover back in the side, are favourites in the game. I'm going for the **Blacks** whose strength in the air and up forward where **Lewis Garde** and **Dempsey** are bound to prove troublesome, to win the day and move another step closer to a final's appearance.

Collegians trying to avoid relegation, disappointed **Monash's** final four hopes when they trailed **Monash** by 38 points at the last change and then kicked 10.2 to 0.2 in the last quarter to run away and win by 22 points. Best were **C. Roach** (5 goals) **Lucas** and **Hughes** for **Collegians** while **Peers** (6 goals), **Knight** and **Galbraith** starred for **Monash University**.

Nick "Shoulders" Lolatgis, **Melbourne High** half back flanker, was named as best man afield for the fourth successive week.

25 YEARS AGO — 1960

Teams yet to put points on the board were **E.S. & A. Bank (C)** and **Old Camberwell**.

Uni Blues, although kicking poorly with 9.20 (74) got home by 9 points from **Old Xaverians** 10.5 (65) to move into second position in 'A' section. Best were **Abbott, Aldred, P. Rush** (U. Blues) and **Capes, McIsaacs, Gibson** (Old Xav.).

35 YEARS AGO — 1950

Heavy fog spoilt **Uni Blacks'** visit to **Geelong** where the home side pushed the ball forward with more direction for the first three quarters only to have **Blacks** get direction and range in the last quarter — not from suggestions of portable wirelesses and flare systems, but the hoarse voice of their coach **Keith Fleming. Pat Cash, Bruce Sutherland** and **Ken Melville** were best for the **Blacks** while **Noel Hirst, Vic Hornsey**, and **Fred Herd** revelled in the heavy going.

Top goalkickers in 'B' section were **Smith** (Nth. Alph.) 62, **Walker** (M.H.S.O.B.), 42 and **John Hinton** (Collegians) 29.

5 YEARS AGO — 1980

Old Melburnians threw away the chance to be fourth in "A" Section when, 15 points in front at the last change, they could not hold off **North Old Boys** who got up to draw the game, 11.18 to 12.12. Best were **Lester, Morphett** and **Murnane** (Old Melb.) and **Butera, S. Maguire, Griffin** (N.O.B.).

Old Carey saluted two veterans, **Roger Morgan** (250 games) and **Ian (Ocker) England** (200 games).

100 games to **Wayne "Wilbur" Blay**, following in his father's (Ken) footsteps at **Kew**, and a respected player and a great clubman. **Wayne** had represented **Victoria** in many games, and won best and fairest, best clubman and many other awards over the years he has given to **Kew**.

Power House were holding a reunion luncheon, 21 years on, of their 1959 premiership team, coached by **John Layton** and whose champions included captain **John McLure, Leigh Grant, Bruce Thompson, Peter Hutchinson, Les Gordon, Neville Hughes** and **Morrie Priestly**.

Ormond held on to fourth place in "A" with a three point win over **Uni Blacks**, 9.16 (70) to 10.7 (67). Best were **McLean, Naylor, Crump** (Ormond) and **Christie, C. Cordner, S. Costella** (Uni. Blacks).

The Amateur Footballer featured **John Tudor**, 15 years and 250 games with **Old Paradians**, carnival and interstate representative and a member of 5 'A' section and 1 'B' section grand final victors. In his first 10 years **John** played at full forward and centre half forward and then like most veterans switched to defence.

Old Trinity lost the battle for fourth spot in 'A' section when they went down by 14 points to **North Old Boys** who were 38 points ahead at the last change and scored enough against the wind to hold off **Old Trinity's** 8 goal burst. Best were **O'Connor, Leeack, Wilson** (N.O.B.) and **Bartley, S. Kennedy, Watsford** (Old Trinity).

In 'C' section, **Alphington** (6th) were too strong for second team, **Old Ivanhoe Grams**, 14.16 to 11.17. **Eaton, Skerry, Shearer** were best for the 'Tons'.

Top side, **St. Bernard's** were off target against **Reservoir Old Boys**, going down 10.20 to 15.10. The losers were best served by **Burgin, Santamaria, Snowden**.
