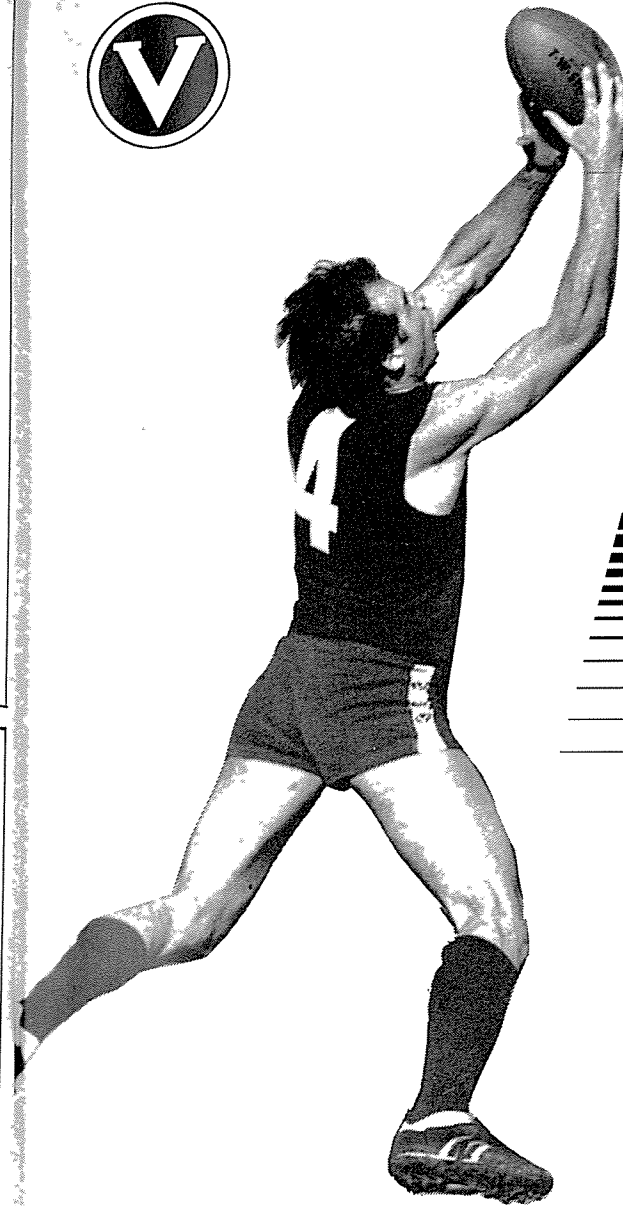

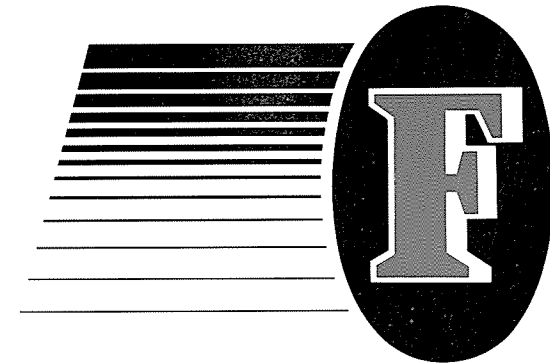

A Section Review by Ross Booth

It was a week of surprise results in A section, none more so than **Old Xaverians** humbling of first round winners **Ormond**, by 77 points at Yarra Park. **Steve Curtain** at full forward kicked 10 goals for the day and he was well supported by **Carlim** with 5 goals. **Terry Stanley** is proving to be a more than useful acquisition because he kicked 4 and so too did small man, **Nick Vale**. **Nick Wilton** has struck form and the return of **Brendan Ryan** has given the Xavs a lot of bite, as has backman **Doug Atkinson**. Young **Peter Metzner** was voted best afield; he is a strong player with a good pair of hands. The Xavs have some good big men and some very quick small men; it strikes me as being a side with quite a deal of versatility. **Ormond** were jumped early and wasted opportunities in the 3rd quarter. I suspect this might be an area of concern of **Ormond**. They lack real fire power up forward and rely on a number of their small and medium sized players to kick their goals, such as rovers **Tony Boyanton** and **Andy Mehrten**. **Chris McAsey**, **Gary Burke** and wing/haf back **Russell Barnes** played well for **Ormond**.

Old Scotch stomed home against **North Old Boys** to win by 69 points. **North** led comfortably in the second quarter but **Scotch** fought back to lead by 9 points at half time. **Scotch** took over in the 2nd half and in the final term kicking with the breeze slammed on 11 goals to 3 to cruise to a big victory. **Fewster**, **Sherwen** and **Thompson** each kicked 4 goals for **Scotch**, and **Edwards** kicked four for **North**. **Dave Bedford** back from overseas was a great rover for **Scotch** and big man **John Moir** had a good day in the air. **Scotch** also got great drive from **Andy Smith** on the wing and from captain **Fergus Kiel** at half back. For **North** again it was **Paul Considine** in the ruck who did the hard work and backmen **John Dore** and **Jerome Griffin** battled hard. At the end of the game **North** coach **Jim Durnan** was certainly not a happy man.

The Whisper Previews Today's Games

With 20 winners in the opening round I'm really pleased with myself although **Old Xavs** and **De La** of the A Section clubs certainly upset the apple cart. So too did **O.M.'s** in B section, **Therry** and **Fawkner** in C, **West Brunswick** and **Old Mentonians** in D, **Elsternwick** in E and finally **Doveton SIOC** in F. At least you've all now provided a yardstick for this weeks preview.

The match of the day will be played at Harry Trott between undefeated **Collegians** and reigning Premier **De La Salle**. **Collegians** as they have in past seasons have started well and their running game and skilful players will cause **De La** some headaches. **Jackyl and Hyde** is how VAFA personality **Tony O'Callaghan** described his old clubs efforts to date but with a win under their belt and the challenge of upsetting the **Lions** as an added goal its **De La** on this occasion.

De La Salle bounced back with a 50 point win over **Ivanhoe**. **De La** had their running game going and **Ivanhoe** appeared unable to handle it. The inclusion of young ruckman **Nugent** obviously paid dividends as did fullforward **Phil Kerin**, who kicked 7 goals. **Kerin** was unavailable last week. **Shane Murphy** found the goals too; he got 5. **De La Salle** got drive again from centre half back **Mick Deveson** and centreman **Tim Cooke**. **Ivanhoe's** on the ball players tried hard: **Bocabella** in the ruck and **Balcombe** and **Sedgwick** roving and around the goals. **Ivanhoe's** best forward was **Morcom** who kicked 4 goals.

Bulleen-Templestowe found their legs on Saturday at the expense of **St. Bernards**. **Gilmore** played well at full back and so did captain **Andy Smythe** in defence whilst up forward **Ongaro** with 8 and **Pace** and **Delanty** with 5 apiece were busy forwards. **ST. Bernards** are a little underanned. Captain **McAllister** did well along with **Sullivan** and **Monaghan** at half back. **Dave Burgin** gives the side some experience which is badly needed.

Collegians took a while to throw off a determined **University Blues** at **Elsternwick** on Sunday but never really looked troubled. The **Blues** had plenty of possession but the skill level in the side is not what it used to be and they are not as physically strong either. **Collegians** back line was very strong; **Tony Griffiths**, **Greg Parsons**, **Andrew Wright** and **Jeremy Twigg** did not let much through. **Russell Mann** was a good player early on at centre half forward for the **Blues** but his opportunities were limited. Full back **Pat Salinger** and ruckman **Rob Cordwell** were fine contributors on the day for the **University** side. **Greg Tregear** began in the centre for **Collegians** but went to the forward pocket when injured and kicked 6 goals, but apart from him the **Lions** struggled to kick goals.

The conclusions from Saturday's round are these: **Scotch** is a good side; **Bulleen-Templestowe** and **De La Salle** are back; **North**, **Ivanhoe** and **Ormond's** stocks need reassessing; the **Old Xavs** need to be watched; **Collegians** are workmanlike and the **Blues** and **St. Bernards** will stage a good battle this week. I wonder if I am right.

Another big game will be played at Yarra Park between "neighbours" **Old Scotch** and **Old Xaverians**. **Scotch** have two fine victories to date whilst the **Xavs** form compares with **De Las'** - cold and hot. **Xavs** are delighted with the form being shown by **Brendan Ryan** and newcomer **Tony Barry** but for consistency flair and new approach in 85 its **Old Scotch** for me. **Trevor Read** has them running backing up and their versatility impressed State selectors **Shane Maguire** and **Coach Michael Green** last Saturday.

Ormond and **Bulleen-Templestowe** clash at **Ormond** and the Bullant will remember the drubbing they received in last years preliminary final. With injuries to **Phil Mehrten** and **Mike Oaten** **Ormond** will need to call on all their pride and fighting spirit to handle their eager visitors and at home should hang on for a close win.

The two sides without success **St. Bernard's** and **Univ. Blues** meet at **W. Essendon** where the home ground advantage will surely favour **St. Bernards**. The game is absolutely vital to the long term prospects of both clubs and both sides will play desparate football. I like **St. Bernards** this time which puts the **Blues** last after Round 3.

The match at the Boulevard oval between **Ivanhoe** and **North O.B.** will be no game for weakies. After great starts both sides suffered bad defeats last week and **Ivanhoe** will be happy that the match is at home. In a no holds barred affair **Ivanhoe** to win.

In B section **Kew** has the chance to redeem itself by beating **Old Brighton** at **Victoria Park**. I doubt **Old Brighton** will enjoy the trip East and have a hunch **Kew** will open their account today.

Losers **St. Kilda CBOC** and **Old Paradians** meet at **North Rd** where **St. Kilda** are always a handful. As their performance against **Old Brighton** last week was far more impressive than **Old Paradians** against **O.M.'s** the saints are the selection.

Caulfield Grammarians opened up with a great win and even at this early stage look the major threat in the Section. Names such as **Cooney**, **Galill**, **Stone**, **Fish**, **Kanis**, **Berzins**, **Harlock**, **Watson** and **Ponsford** would be welcome in any A section team and the fields will be little troubled in accounting for neighbours **AJAX**.

Univ. Blacks and **Parkside** meet at **Uni.** in the match of the day. The **Blacks** have recruited reasonably well and played quite nicely in the opening round despite going down to **Marcellin**.

However, **Parkside** has a point to prove this year and will make it 2 out of 2 today.

Old Melburnians meet **Marcellin** at the **Cordner** oval full of confidence after their surprise away win over **Paradians**. **Yeo** has them more desparate and at home they'll be looking for victory. However the **Eagles** have responded well to **Neil LeLievre's** methods where their play on game and pace make up

for their lack of height. **Fawkner Park** will suit **Marcellin** and they'll win.

St. Kevin's and **Therry** find themselves in the match of the day in C section. Both won well last week and although I find it difficult to go against **Bernie Dunn's** boys 2 weeks in a row, I'm going to as **St. Kevin's** have responded well to **Tony Sullivan's** coaching and victory today will stamp them as the side to beat in C section.

In other matches the selections are **Monash Blues** over **Coburg**, **Old Haileybury** at home against **Thomastown**, **Hampton Rovers** to beat **Banyule** and **Fawkner** at home should just edge out the big improvers **Old Camberwell**.

In D Section **MHSOB** will do **Nth. Brunswick** whilst **Balacava** should celebrate the unfurling of its E section pennant with a win over **State Bank**.

At **Elsternwick Park Power House** meet **St. Bede's** with victory likely to go to the boys from the Eastern end of **Albert Park Lake**.

Old Mentonians at home to beat **West Brunswick** and **Old Trinity** must be favourites over **Old Ivanhoe**.

Univ. Reds and **Peninsula** meet at the **Melb. Univ.** tomorrow where a good crowd of **College** lads and lasses may supply enough vocal power to give the **Reds** a win. In other E section games **Elsternwick** will be too strong for **Williamstown CYMS**. **Preston MBOB** will thoroughly enjoy themselves at **Old Carey**. The **OGGS** will make it 2 out of 2 out at **Footscray** and **Heatherton** will also remain undefeated by accounting for a luckless **Bulleen United** at **Koonung Park**.

From Over The Fence

"The Whisper" has informed OTF that umpires advisor Neville Nash has sent all clubs a screed on abusive language. In fact "The Whisper" is a handy lad as he was able to obtain a copy for us and OTF has printed it for all.

After witnessing several practice matches it has become apparent to me that the use of abusive language to umpires and disputing decisions by some players was excessive and must be curtailed for the image and presentation of V.A.F.A. Football and V.A.F.A. Umpires.

Therefore, I have instructed the Umpires that action be taken against players who in "an obvious and demonstrative manner" dispute decisions and/or abuse Umpires.

A "demonstrative manner" covers giving thumbs up or two finger signs to Umpires.

In every instance, players who do this will be reported as follows:

I am reporting No..... for using insulting behaviour toward me in that he used an insulting gesture.

In instances where players dispute decisions or use abusive language "not in a demonstrative manner" umpires are expected to talk to the player and give him the opportunity to retract his comments. If a player retracts his comment the Umpire will take no further action. If the player continues with abuse, he will be reported for "using abusive language toward me".

They have also been advised to bear in mind that all players have the right to ask what a decision is for, and in all instances, the Umpire shall tell them.

The Umpires will use common sense as the object is to discourage players from creating a scene by abusing umpires or disputing decisions, in a "demonstrative manner".

The name of the game is COMMUNICATION and CONFRONTATION and the Umpires are doing their part by talking to the players during the game, encouraging players, but also being firm when appropriate.

The Umpires want the respect of the players, and of course, the players want the respect of the Umpires, but it must be a combined effort and I urge your support in this regard and request that you advise your players accordingly.

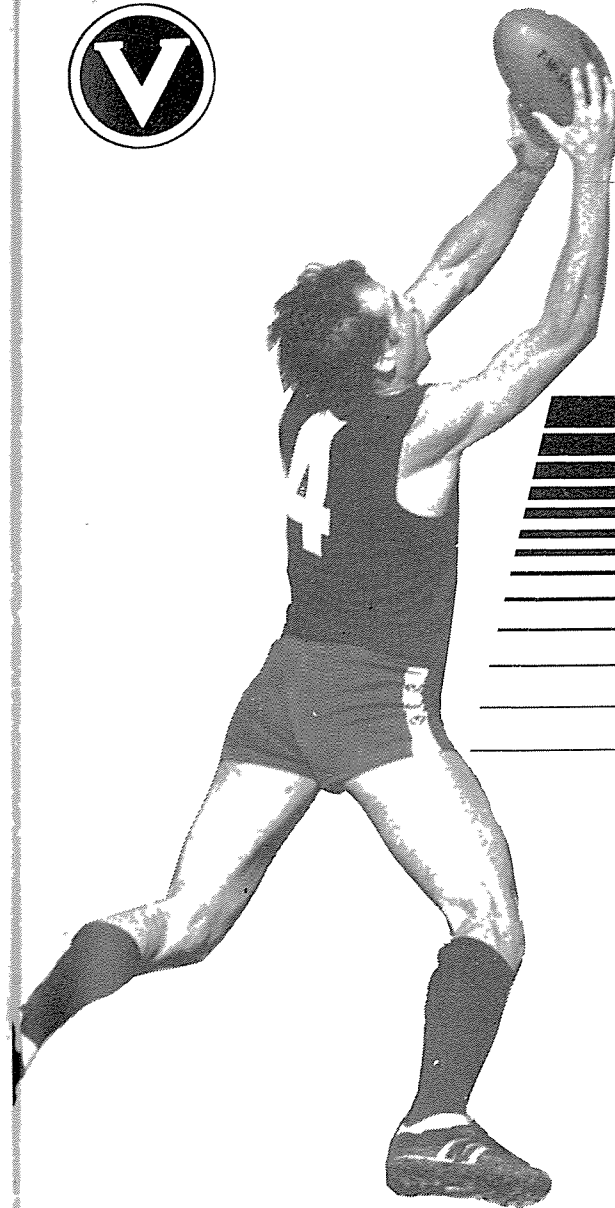
