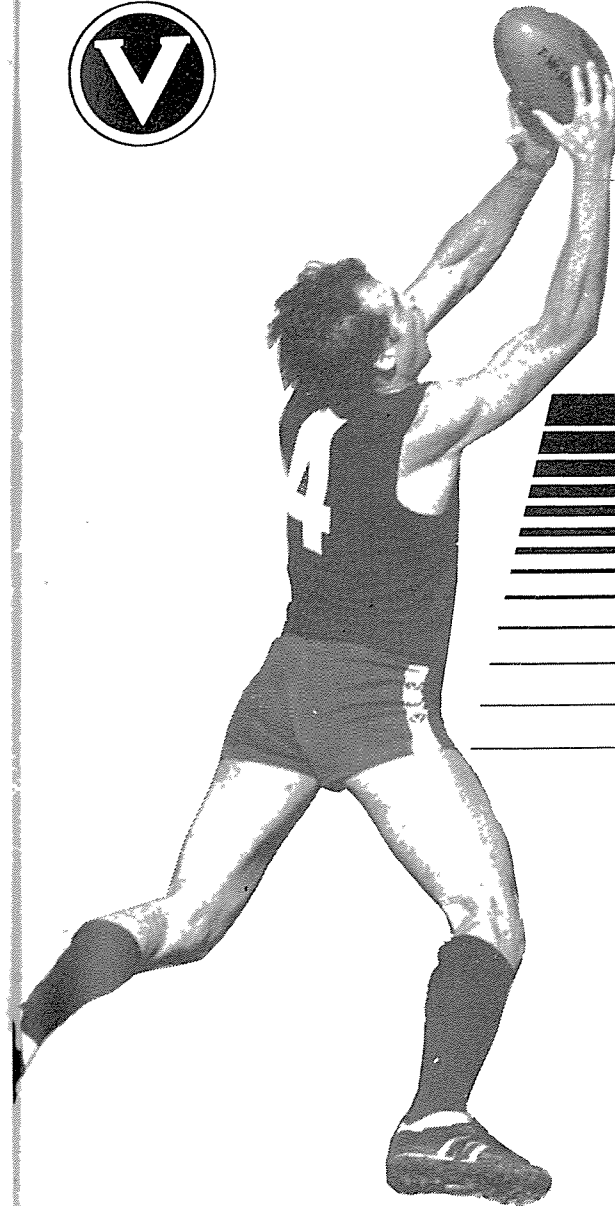

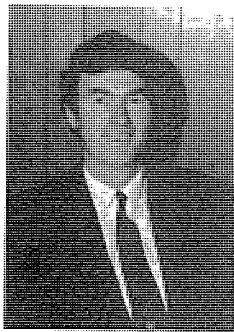

A Section Review by Ross Booth

Old Scotch and **Collegians** have emerged as the top two sides at this early state of the season. **Old Scotch** trounced **Old Xaverians** and **Collegians** had a good win over **De La Salle**. I saw both sides last week: **Scotch** confirmed my high opinion of them and **Collegians** were much more impressive than the previous week.

Old Scotch were untroubled against **Old Xaverians** and won by 99 points. What I thought might be the match of the day turned out to be a 'fizzer', though I think **Scotch** might have been surprised at the ease of **Xav's** capitulation. **Scotch** looked to be a highly skilled combination, with a strong defence, a dangerous forward line and plenty of in form on the ball players: none more so than ruck rover **Jim Marx**, back from a stint in the country. Along with **Rick Senior** he formed a dynamic duo, and **Peter Sherwen** is back performing his magic in the centre. **Andrew MacMillan** turned on a class performance on the half forward flank with 7 goals from his spearing left foot. **Scotch** have some good big men too, with the tall **Warwick Matthews** allowing **John Moir** to play at centre half forward. It was interesting to see **Peter Brown** playing his first game, but apparently he is heading overseas shortly. The **Xavs** form is enigmatic but the way they looked on Saturday in the match against **Ormond** appears to have been a flash in the pan. It is up to them to show that it wasn't. They missed **Godsell** in the ruck last week. **Steve Curtain** did not get enough chances up forward but still played well, as did his brother **Paul**, in the back pocket. **Geoff Greetham** impressed me with his running out of defence and wing play and **Tony Barry** was a lively rover. Ruck rover **Peter Klein** had quite a good afternoon too, but most of his teammates seemed to lose interest as the afternoon wore on. Or, have I underestimated **Old Scotch**?

In the other main game last week **Collegians** came of age with a 13 point win over last year's premiers, **De La Salle**. They have faded in other years after good starts but I don't think they will this year. The

side has matured over the last couple of seasons and they are a stronger physical side. They might not have the high marking of **Scotch** but they have got everything else. **Stuart Hincen** had the better of **Shane Murphy** and young **Greg Irvine** was the best ruck rover on the ground. **Ian Herman** was back and he kicked 5 wonderful goals and added that touch of class to the **Lions** forward line. **Glen Cook** had a good battle with **De La's** young ruckman **Dave Nugent**. **Wayne McDonnell** had a great day on the wing for **De La** and so too did half forward **Greg Hill**. **Mick Deveson** shaded **Tim Bennett** but **Wolff, Baum** and rover **Keith Parsons** chipped in with 3 goals each. **Phil Kerin** was **De La Salle's** chief goal kicker with 4. It was nip and tuck all day but the **Lions**, with the wind in the last quarter, converted a 4 point deficit into a 13 point victory.

Ormond beat **Bulleen-Templestowe** by 14 points in a low scoring, scrumbly game in the mud at **Ormond**. We all know how difficult it is to score goals in those conditions and **Ormond** kicked away with a couple of quick goals at the start of the last quarter and hung on. **Mark McDonald** at centre half forward kicked 3 of **Ormond's** goals, but their best player was young ruck rover **Simon Eishold**. **Mark Tobin** in the centre is having an excellent season and back pocket **Guy Ritchie** and rover **Tony Boyanton** are making useful contributions. For **Bulleen-Templestowe**, captain **Andy Smythe**, now playing on the wing, is doing very well. Rovers, **Vince Asdagi** and **Stephen Clark** are giving bite to that division, and **Paul Lockhart** in the centre continues to perform. **Bulleen** must also have been pleased with the form shown by **Rick van den Driest**.

Ivanhoe beat **North Old Boys** by 35 points in a game where defences shone out, particularly that of **Ivanhoe**. Centre half back **Peter Gittos** and half back **Greg Cameron** gave the **Hoes** great drive and so too did centreman **Mick McDonald** and wingman **Ted Flynn**. **Ivanhoe** rely on many of their forward thrusts from this region. For **North**, ruck rover **Anthony Cahill** was best along with the reliable **Paul Considine** and **John Dore**. It is good to see **Steve Hibbert** striking some form too. **North** are simply not kicking enough goals. They are struggling in their key forward positions.

St. Bernard's broke the ice at the expense of **University Blues**. **Greg Wood** and **Gary McAllister** on the ball played well and so too did consistent

wingman, **Ray Czajko**. **Darren Melia** kicked 4 goals. For the **Blues**, **Don McInnes** returned with 3 goals but his fitness must be suspect. **Roger Curnow** lifted them at centre half forward but it was not enough. It

was a windy, scumbly game and **St. Bernard's** eald on to their 4 goal lead established by half time. But for **Blues** full back, **Pat Salinger**, the margin might have been greater.

The Whisper Previews Today's Games

Four out of five A Section winners suggest I've almost got the form in A section covered and certainly I've now far more respect for **Bruce Ferguson's Collegians**. Today the **Lions** travel to Royal Park and with the roar of their name sakes within earshot should put a further dent in the confidence of **North Old Boys**. After such a promising start the wheels seem to have fallen off at **North** and they could not have drawn **Collegians** at a worse time. The return of **Herman** and the top form of the veteran **Cook** plus the strength of **Hincen** and **Parsons** in defence has **Collegians** the favourite in this match.

St. Bernard's cracked the ice last Saturday but lets face it they only beat **Uni-Blues** who are but a ghost of the side of recent seasons. Today they'll yet again be shown what A section football is all about by **Ormond** whose fine showing last week was just the answer to it's critics. Make no mistake **Ormond** will be playing at Elsternwick Park come September as second fiddle has never been acceptable at Malane Street, and to play finals, early wins are the secret and so even out at West Essendon where many of the younger **Ormond** players have never been the visitors will come away with the points.

Over the past few seasons a **Uni-Blues De La Salle** encounter would rightly have been billed as the Match of the Day, but with one win to share between the two the giants of yesterday have fallen on bad times. To be true **De La** was just pipped by an in form **Collegians** and they were impressive in beating **Ivanhoe**. The **Blues** on the other hand are team building after an exodus of coach, players and administration. **De La's** record at the Beaurepaire Oval in recent years does not inspire confidence but such is the state of the **Blues** football that **De La** as victors is the only possible result.

The Match of the Day will in fact be played on **Bulleen-Templestow's** "borrowed" ground against competition leaders **Old Scotch**. The Cardinals may be fortunate that the Doncaster Council decided to resurface the Recreation Reserve as the wide open spaces at Koonung Park will better suit the game that **Read** has them playing. The **Bullants** brainstrust will have spent many hours on preparations for this match as a further loss today will see them lose contact with the top teams. They're bound to throw everything at **Scotch** but the **Cardinals** have found a strength of character to match their consistency, and their ability to discipline their running and win defence possessions should see them maintain their unbeaten record. It's not so much that I lack regard for the **Bulleen** lads but **Scotch** has won respect and is deservedly the side to beat.

Ivanhoe returned to the winning list with a solid performance last Saturday whilst an undermanned **Old Xaverians** were thrashed by neighbours **Old Scotch**. **Xavs** appear unable to improve their side whilst **Ivanhoe** is bound to have learnt from its away loss to **De La Salle** and will consolidate its position amongst the leading teams by 5 p.m. today.

The spotlight in B Section will shine on Pitcher Park where the home side **Parkside** take on a decidedly new look **Old Melburnians**. Last Saturday **Parkside** scraped home from the **Blacks** whilst **OMs** was most impressive in accounting for **Marcellin**. The return of **A. Witts, Davine** and **Hec Thompson** has added depth to the **Navy Blues** but the evenness of **Parkside** for whom **Jack King** is in fine touch plus the home ground advantage should give the **Devils** its third win and joint leadership with **Caulfield Grammarians** who themselves face a danger game against **Uni Blacks**. **Blacks** have been done twice whilst **Caulfield** despite some spirited resistance from **Ajax** has yet to be tested over 4 quarters. Despite rapid improvement by the students **Caulfield** will win.

Old Brighton had the wind taken out of their sails last Saturday putting in a weak effort against **Kew**. Today they meet **Ajax** who are still to wing a game. However **Ajax** was far from disgraced last Saturday and I feel they have the spirit and desire to handle **Old Brighton** and open their account this afternoon.

Winners **St Kilda CBOC** and **Kew** meet at North Road where the Saints are always a handful. **Kew** will stay with the home side for much of the day but lack the class to cause an upset.

A disappointing **Old Paradians** meet **Marcellin** at Bundoora and will be desperate for success. Both sides appear unlikely to worry the **Parkside's, Caulfields** and **O.M.'s** as they both lack height and experience. At Bundoora **Parade** like **Ajax** at the Beach Oval should open its account for 1985.

In C section **St. Kevins** came back to earth with a bang at the hands of **Therry** and today take on **Old Haileybury** at Kooyong. **Haileybury's** win over **Thomastown** has done wonders for the boys from Keysborough and I believe they can go on with it today.

Coburg who are in the doldrums play host to **Therry**. This is not even a danger game for the visitors who will win and win well.

Thomastown and **Banyule** clash at Thomastown with form about even. Both have won at home and lost away. Following that pattern **Thomastown** will win again.

Hampton Rovers like most amateur clubs are a different proposition at home and whilst **Fawkner** is certainly the form side, can be expected to perform well today. However the **Rovers** appear to lack depth whereas **Fawkner** are teaming splendidly and even allowing for the trip across town will come away with the points today.

Monash Blues are gradually getting their act together and meet **Old Camberwell** after a hard match and loss at Fawkner. I believe the **Light Blues** can jump their visitors and go on and win their 2nd game of the year.

Match of the Day in D section will be played at Melbourne High between **Old Melburnians** and the **High School**. **MHSOB** are undefeated whilst the **Panthers** have one win and a narrow loss. The small

ground will suit the visitors who have good big men and I'm selecting them to halt the High School's victory run.

In other matches, **Balaclava** to beat **Nth. Brunswick**, **West Brunswick** to handle an improving **Power House**, **Old Ivanhoe** to beat **St. Bedes** and **Old Trinity** will have no worries with **State Bank**.

In E section winners will be **Peninsula OB** over **Old Carey**, **Elsternwick** easily from **Uni Reds** who let me down last Sunday. **Preston HBOB** at home over **F.I.T.O.B.**, **Old Geelong** at home to bounce back

over **Bullen United** and **Williamstown CYMS** at home will beat **Heatherston**.

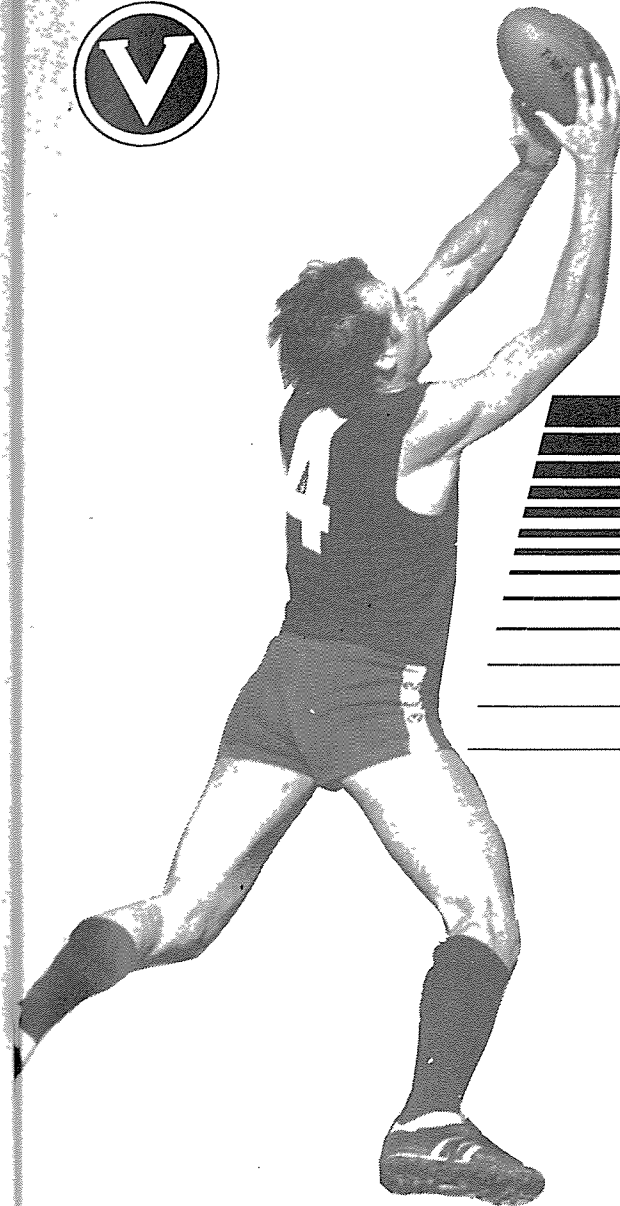
