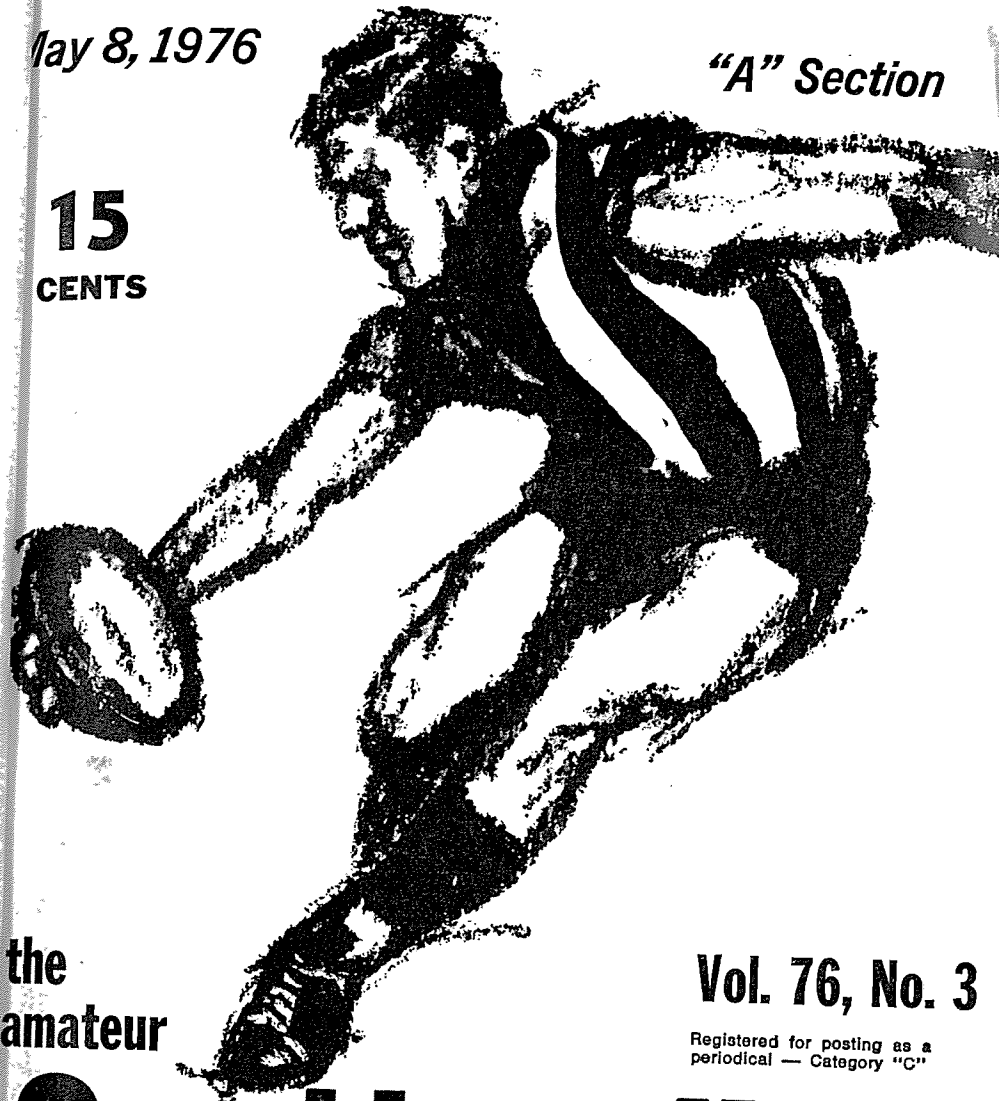

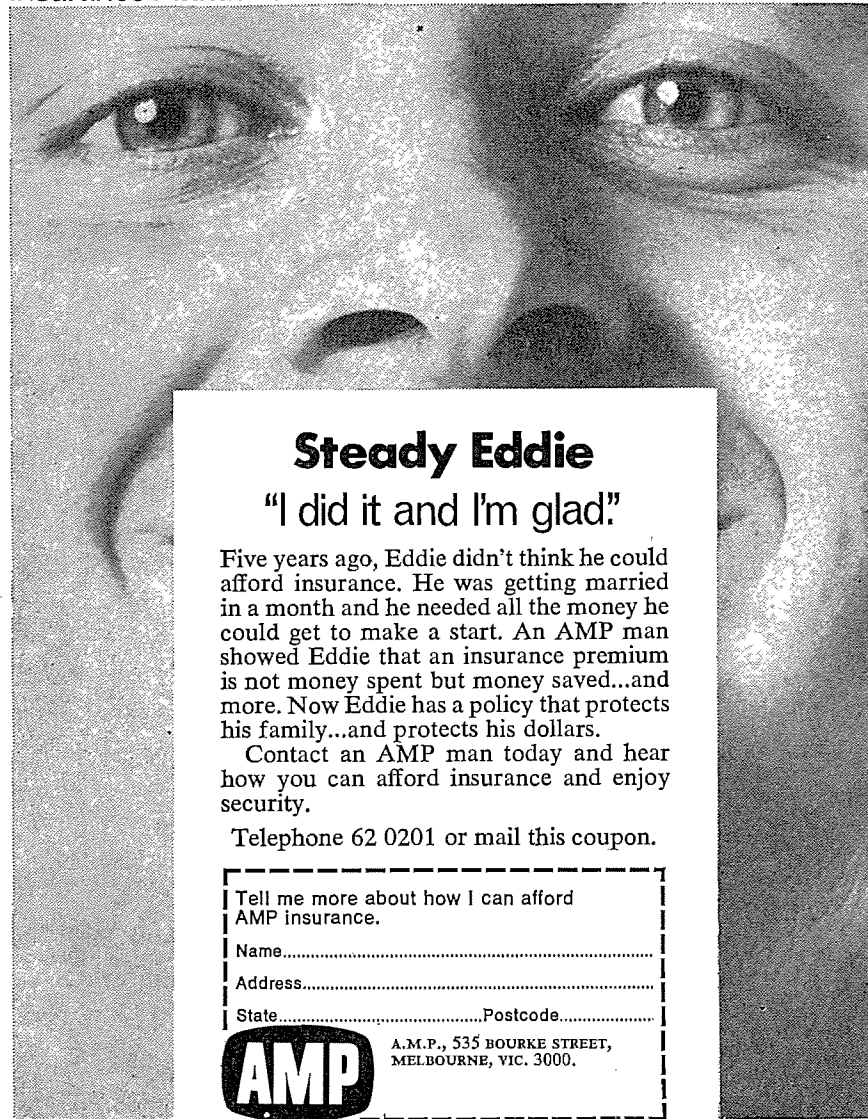

LAST WEEK'S HIGHLIGHTS

ORMOND, MONASH, TRINITY CAUSE UPSETS

Geelong's First Win Since 1974

The spate of sensations in the opening round a fortnight ago continued last week when three of the A Section winners in the first round were beaten by teams which lost on the opening day.

Ormond, well beaten by De La Salle, turned round and toppled University Blues by six goals — Monash Blues, after an inglorious display against North Old Boys, beat Coburg by 21 points — and Old Trinity, who finished a long way behind the Blues, accounted for North Old Boys, the margin being 34 points.

De La Salle, who just held on long enough to beat University Blacks by a point, are now at the head of the list. St. Bernard's, premiers last year, played an unregistered player against the Blacks in the opening match and so lost the four premiership points, otherwise they would be sharing the lead with De La Salle.

Geelong scored a 33-point win over St. Kilda CBC, their first taste of victory since the 1974 season.

Reservoir Old Boys Juniors, who kicked a record Junior score the previous week, were beaten last Saturday, going down to West Brunswick by 7 points. And their percentage crashed from 2446.7 to 463.2 — still not a bad percentage all the same.

Incidentally Thomastown's percentage quite naturally also dropped con-

siderably despite another big win — from 2581.8 to 591.5.

Melbourne High again kicked a century score, but their 17-15 (117 points) fell 53 points short of Caulfield Grammar, who kicked 25-20 (170). The week before High kicked 21-8 (134) to be beaten by 9 points.

University Blues Juniors, who put up a poor showing against North Old Boys (Section 2 premiers last year) repeated their Section 1 Grand Final win over Coburg, the margin being 4 goals.

Of the teams promoted this season, De La Salle, Fawkner, AJAX and North Old Boys Juniors are still unbeaten. So too are Monash Whites, but their match against ANZ Bank last Saturday was not played because no umpire was available.

UMPIRE'S CORNER

"FITNESS"

What are we striving for when we commence training the umpires at Elsternwick Park

We aim to develop and improve the general and specific components of fitness in order to maximise their performance when they are umpiring.

Once again general and specific conditioning are both inter-related and combined with the most vital requirements of a field umpire — stamina and speed.

They are all brought together for the overall improvement of physical fitness and the final objective which is the correct performance response on the field.

It should be remembered that the development of one component of fitness will not guarantee the same response towards another component. — For example, if one is training to improve his strength by the appropriate training, he cannot expect the same improvement to show in his cardio-respiratory fitness. (Heart and Lungs.)

Therefore the golden rule to remember is that "Training in Specific".

Consequently, training should be aligned as closely as possible to the task undertaken by the individual.

Every part of the body should be brought to efficient working level before specialised training is undertaken.

This level should be reached PRE-SEASON BEFORE arrival at Elsternwick Park.

UNFORTUNATELY only a few umpires do PRE-SEASON WORK.

Physiological functional improvements are brought about by correct training, but the organism tends to revert to its former state once training is discontinued.

The longer the build up brought about by training the more slowly does the reversal take place.

Training to be effective must follow a plan and must be of regular intervals.

Training time must be concentrated and it must be in a situation which is not vitally different from what is required on the actual day.

Boredom after lengthy training periods is almost inevitable. Therefore it is essential that changes be made from time to time within the training routine.

DO YOU KNOW?

That one of the greatest goal kickers in the history of Australian Rules Football was East Fremantle player George Doig.

In 1934 this great forward kicked 152 goals during the West Australian League season, which included 32 in two senior games in successive weeks, 19 of his club's

22 the first week, and 13 out of 20 the following week.

As a youngster in 1931, playing for East Fremantle Juniors against Palmyra Doig scored every goal and every behind 26-20 scored by his team.

LAWS OF THE GAME

RULE 17G —

States that a free kick shall be awarded against a player who wilfully kicks or forces the ball out of bounds without it being touched by another player.

RULE 17E —

A free kick shall be given against a player who wilfully wastes time.

A player with the ball may be fairly met by an opponent by the use of the hip, shoulder, chest, arms or open hands.

A player may be pushed in the chest or side or shepherded in accordance with these laws, by an opponent, provided the ball is not more than 5 metres away.

Umpires should at all times use common sense in their decisions.

WE'RE SHORT OF UMPIRES

The Association is desperately short of umpires and urgently requires young men to take on this very important part of the game.

On the opening day, we only just managed to supply umpires to all games by using two members of the Umpire Committee, who have "retired" as umpires, and last Saturday the position was even worse, with one game having to be cancelled because of the shortage of umpires.

Anyone interested in becoming an umpire in the Association, whether he has had umpiring experience or not, is requested to contact the Secretary to the Umpire Committee, Mr. Lynton McLeod, of 9 Mason Court, Highbett 3190. His phone number is 95-7321.

The greatest need is for Field Umpires, but Goal Umpires are also required.

Payments range from \$20 for those in Group 4, to \$33 for Group 1. Goal umpires receive \$14.

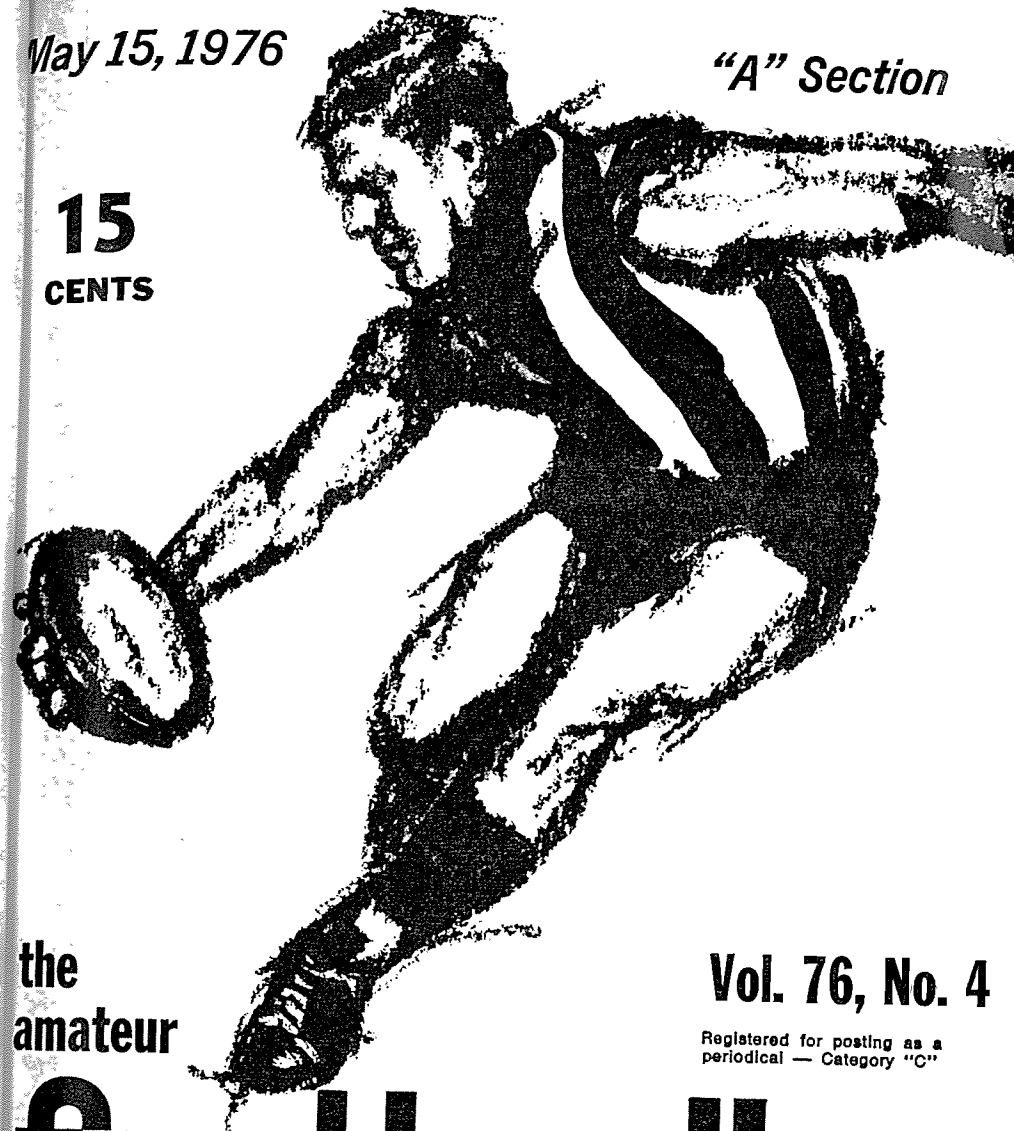
