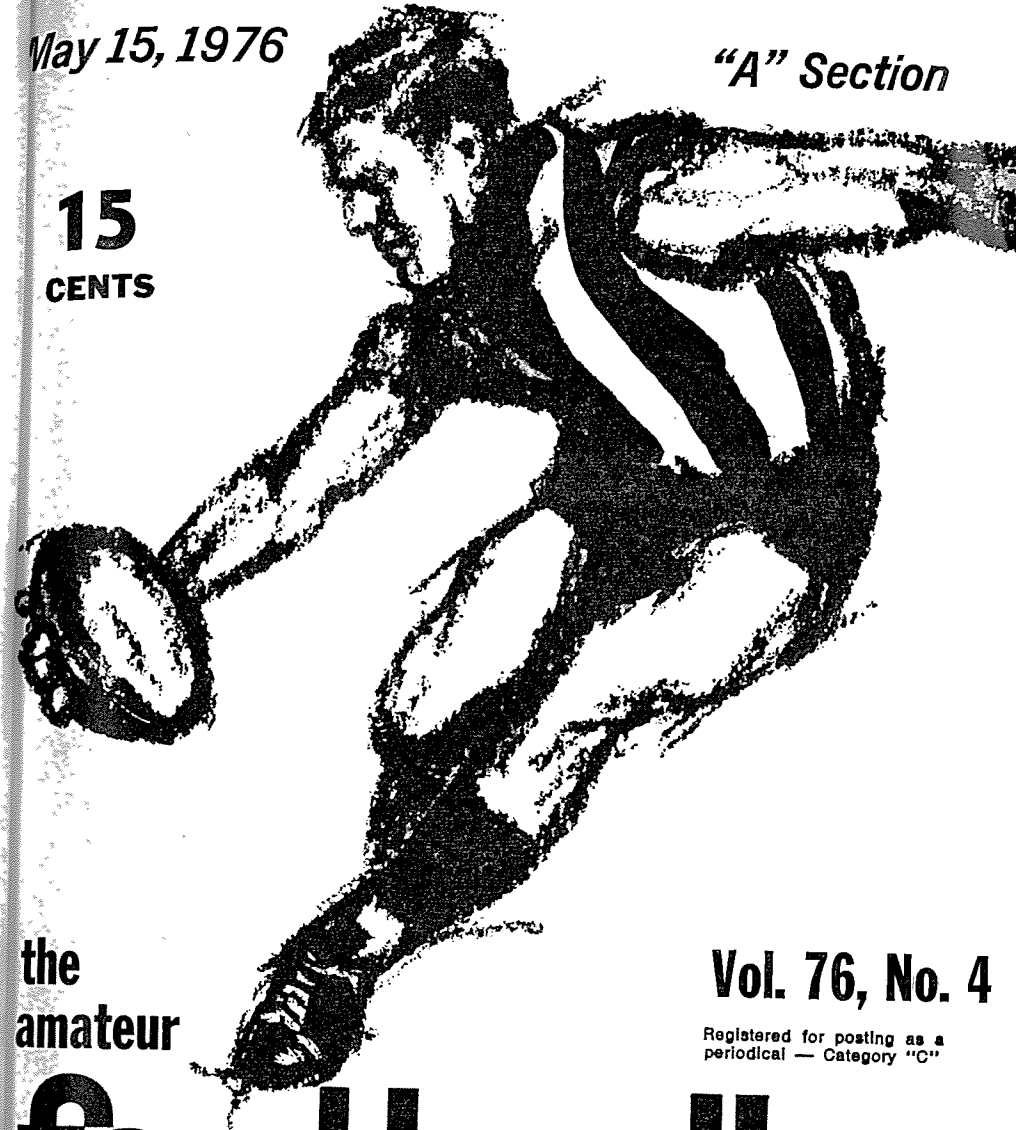

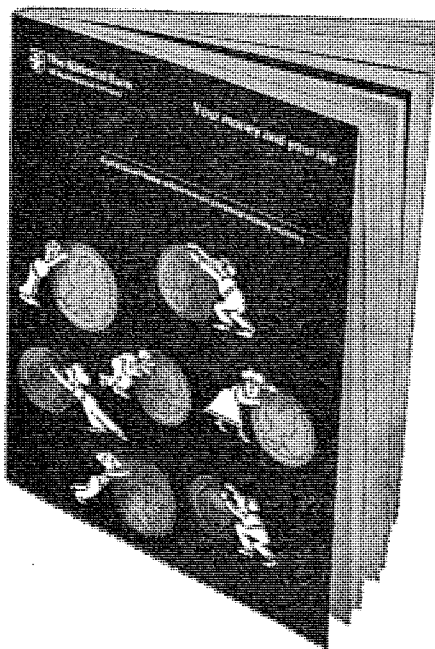

# LAST WEEK'S HIGHLIGHTS GREAT LAST QUARTER AT NORTH — FINE EFFORT BY COBURG More Big Scores, But Many Close Finishes

What a great last quarter it was at North Old Boys' ground last Saturday, when a total of 16 goals was scored for the term!

North led University Blues by six points at three-quarter time, then kicked 9-2 to 7-2 in the final period of play to win by three goals.

A little further out, at Coburg, the home side kicked 12-5 to 1-1 in the third quarter against Old Trinity, who were five points in front at the interval.

And that wasn't the end of the run either — Coburg added another 4 goals early in the last quarter before Trinity found their feet to rattle on five at the finish. So at one stage Coburg kicked 16 goals to one.

Once again there were some big scores recorded, 15 teams kicking over 20 goals. Top spot went to Monash University Juniors who kicked 43-27 (285 points) against Power House.

But there were some close games too — Marcellin beat Collegians by 5 points, after Collegians looked to be in control when they led by 22 points just before half time.

Marcellin rattled on 3 quick goals and then added four in the third term for a 14-point lead, and held Collegians off in the last quarter.

Caulfield Grammar had a battle to beat Geelong by 10 points. They

added 5 goals in the final quarter to do so, after trailing by 10 points at the final change.

Alphington's straighter kicking enabled them to beat Old Ivanhoe by 6 points. Old Ivanhoe were nearly 8 goals down at the interval and trailed by 6 goals at three-quarter time, then kicked 6-6 to 3 goals in the last term.

Brunswick drew with State Bank, and ANZ Bank went down to Heather-ton by 5 points, despite remarkably accurate kicking (16-5).

Coburg Juniors beat University Blacks by a point, and in the Reserves University Blues beat North by 3 points. Old Ivanhoe beat Alphington by 5, ANZ Bank beat Heather-ton by 3, Beverley Hills beat Footscray Tech. by 6 points and Old Brighton played a draw with Old Xaverians.

# UMPIRE'S CORNER

## SOCIAL

Next Saturday night is the date of our Social at the "Empress of China" in Lt. Lonsdale Street, City. See Graham Halbish for tickets. New umpires — be in this and get to know your fellow umpires in a social atmosphere.

## "INTERPRETATIONS ALL SHOULD KNOW"

**CHARGING** is violently meeting and pushing a player in a manner not authorised by the laws, when he is not in possession of the ball, or when he is in the air.

**HANDBALL** is clearly holding the ball with one hand and striking it with the clenched fist of the other hand.

**HOLDING THE BALL** — A player shall be deemed to be holding the ball if he retains possession of it while being firmly held by an opponent.

**HOLDING THE MAN** — A player shall not be deemed to be held within the meaning of the laws unless he is held firmly enough to stop him or retard his progress.

**SHEPHERDING** — Is the act of pushing, or shouldering or blocking an opponent not in possession of the ball.

**SCRIMMAGE** is a group of players struggling in undue confusion for possession of the ball.

**THROWING THE BALL** is throwing or handing the ball to another player other than by handballing.

**"ALL CLEAR"** is the signal to be given to the goal umpire by the field umpire indicating that the goal umpire is at liberty to decide whether a goal or behind should be recorded.

No player shall be permitted to play in a match while he is wearing a finger ring or neck chain.

## "CONTROL"

When an umpire receives an appointment to officiate he is expected to ensure the game is played according to the Rules, as laid down by the National Football League.

To do this he must be in control of the game.

Control means to be in charge at all times and hold in check all infringements of the Laws of the Game.

Three factors affect control —

1. The infringements the umpire sees and pays.
2. The manner in which the umpire addresses players.
3. Reportable offences. The quickest way to lose control of a game is by not awarding free kicks for infringements which should be penalised.

The field umpire should penalise the first infringement he sees and pay the first mark, and set a pattern of authority. He should sound his whistle with authority, "the whistle is all powerful".

Control means protection for the ball player — all players should be encouraged to go in for the ball.

Umpires must control players — players must also exercise control over their own emotions and frustrations.

Umpires are instructed to look behind play at all times, as it is the foul "behind the play" incident which causes the most trouble.

A firm but friendly manner of an umpire gains the respect of players.

Tim Collie played a superb game for Monash Blues with 8 goals from a half-forward flank in his team's 2-point win over Uni. Blues and won the match with 2 goals in the last five minutes. Final scores were 16.17 (113) to 17.9 (111).

## 10 Years Ago — 1966

Coburg's defeat of Old Scotch and Melbourne High's win over Old Paradians left M.H.S. alone on top of the 'A' Section premiership list.

M.H.S. won it in the first quarter, kicking 4.3 to 1.1, and only managed 2.6 after quarter time. Parade spoiled their chances by kicking 4.11.

Surprises in 'C' section were wins by Hampton Rovers and West Brunswick over previously undefeated North Old Boys and Monash University.

Ken "Bones" Rogers, after 15 years and 277 games with Kew, had finally hung up his boots. The club had recently honoured Ken's dedication by naming the best first year player trophy the "Ken Rogers Trophy". Ken won interstate selection also in his long career.

John Dillon was elected to the Executive Committee of the V.A.F.A. in place of Mr. Geoff Moore who had resigned.

Collegians farewelled Neil Evans after 150 games as Neil was off to Berkeley University, U.S.A. to study under the American Space Programme.

## 25 Years Ago — 1951

Ormond continued its slump when Ivanhoe (up from 'B' section) kicked 6.4 to Ormond's solitary goal in the last quarter to win by 7 points.

Skipper Wal Sparkes, Neil Whittaker, the Clarkes and the Rosenbergs were Hoes' best while Stock, Sheehan and Hardy battled like tigers all day for Ormond.

In a stirring finish Old Melburnians beat Uni. Blues by a point — 16.13 to 16.12. Old Xaverlans, down from 'A' section, and without a victory after 3 games, were hoping that, under captain-coach Esmond

Downey and experienced players in Gordon Laird, Mick Peppard, Brian LeFebvre, Jack Greenway and Adrian Schrader, victory would soon be theirs.

Kew, after 30 wins straight, went down to Malvern for whom Teddy Jane, Dave Bills, Fred Booth and Rod Curtis were best. Trophy winner for Kew was Ken Rogers, superb on the wing — yes, the same man you read about above — 15 years later.

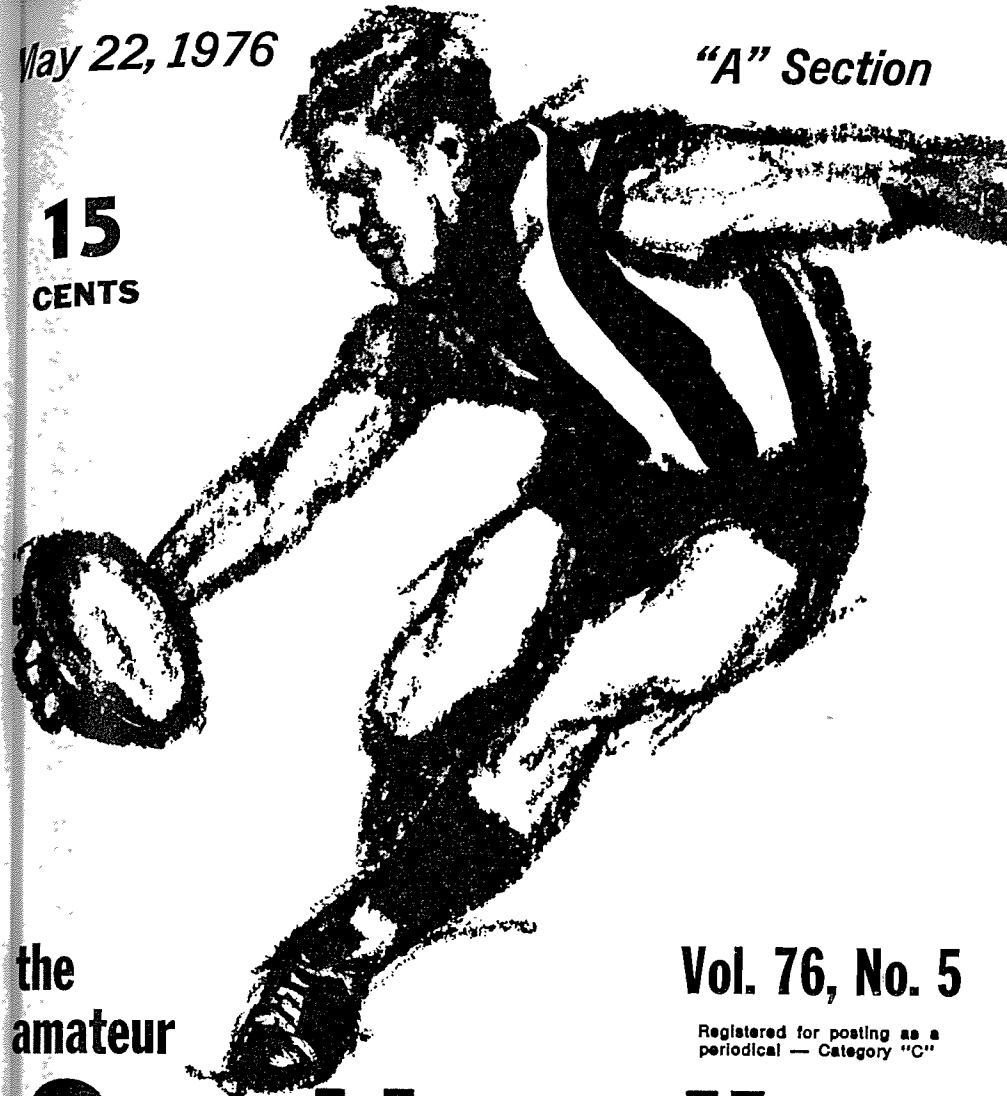
