

UMPIRE'S CORNER

With so many new umipres joining us over the past two weeks, it is probably a good time to discuss one of the most important; means of field umpiring - ball

It is imperative that an umpire be able to bounce the ball consistently well, straight and high

A great deal of practice is required.

The following fundamentals are common to all umpires who bounce the ball well. THE GRIP - Two alternative grips are

commonly used by umpires:-

- Seam running Into body (Method A). - Seam running across body (Method B).

In "Method A" both hands are reasonably close together, giving more control over the direction in which the ball will rise after being bounced.

The possibility of the ball bouncing to your left or right is negligible.

 If the ball is not placed flatly on the ground during the bounce, it can either bounce away from you or over your head. - A disadvantage of this method is that you will have more difficulty in gripping the ball in slippery conditions,

- In Method B" a firmer grip can be taken over the ends of the ball which is important in slippery conditions

- The ball will not skid on wet surfaces as with "Method A".

- The ball will bounce either left or right if it is not placed flatly on the ground. For this reason it is perhaps more difficult to control than "Method A".

A great deal of practice is required to learn to apply equal strength with both hands which will enable a flat, straight

Umpires should learn both methods, commencing with "Method B".

The bounce - you must aim to obtain a straight, high bounce. This requires careful control whilst placing the ball on the ground.

The closer the hands can actually guide the ball to the ground, the greater control you have over the bounce.

This is best done by Stepping forward with one leg, bending the knees and leaning forward at the waist so as to be able to place your hands and the ball right down onto the ground.

Your hands must be exactly opposite each other to place the ball flatly

Place the ball down onto the ground directly in front of your leading foot.

Maintain your balance during this procedure - do not bounce the ball too far away from your foot.

Practice will indicate the appropriate dis-

The bounce should be strong but not so strong that you lose control.

Timing and balance will also assist you to gain correct placement of the ball onto the ground.

Achieving good balance starts from the time you commence to walk in for the bounce.

It does not matter if you are better balanced by walking in two, three or four paces before placing your front foot forward, just so long as you find a pattern which suits you and then stick to it.

Once the ball has left your hands, immediately step back a few paces, both to give the ruckmen clear passage to the ball, and to allow you to view the contest.

Do not watch the flight of the ball. Always practice the whole procedure the same as you would bounce in a match, -.. Get a secure grip.

- Walk In. - Bounce the ball.

- Move back quickly a few steps.

"POSITION AND DIRECTION FOR THE BOUNCE"

Every umpire must know the correct direction to walk in for the bounce.

On sunny days, bounce the ball with the sun at your back to avoid being blinded by the sun.

On windy days bounce the ball so that the wind will tend to carry the ball away from you, not over you. Umpires are instructed that "baulking" when bouncing the ball MUST NOT be practised.

If because of adverse ground conditions it is decided to "throw up the ball" the players should be advised of your intention.

Do you know that on June 2nd, 1899 Essendon player A. J. Thurgood using the place kick, kicked the ball 107 yards 2 ft. I inch (slight wind assistance).

On August 6th, 1912 using the place kick and kicking into the wind D. J. McNamara reached the distance of 102 yards.
