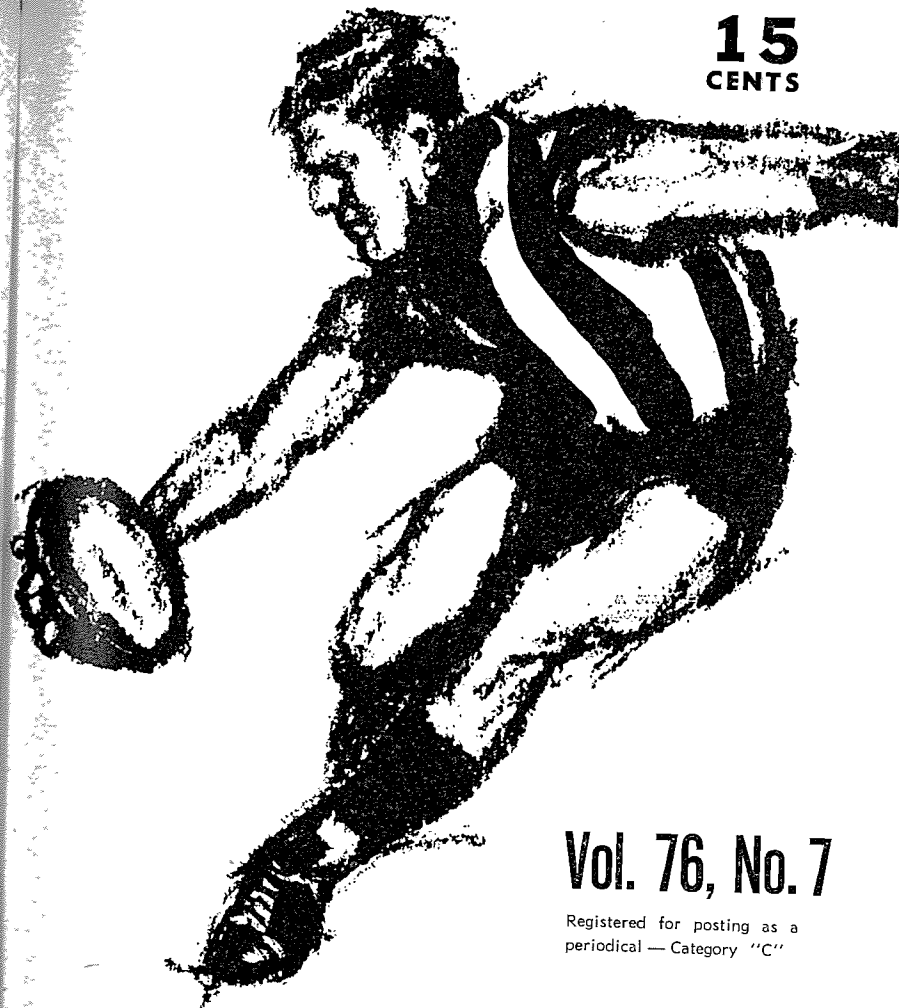

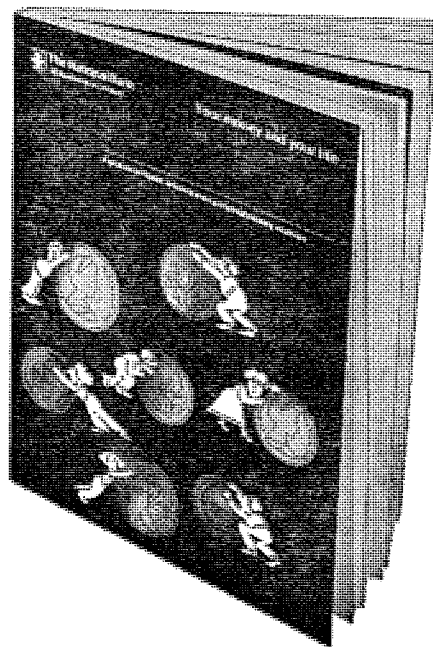

## LAST WEEK'S HIGHLIGHTS

### NORTH HOLD ST. BERNARD'S OFF— AVENGE 1975 GRAND FINAL DEFEAT

Scotch Hold Top Place — Geelong "Pip" Ivanhoe

Three goals straight against the wind in the last quarter enabled North Old Boys to beat St. Bernards by nine points in what was virtually a replay of last years Grand Final, which St Bernard's won quite easily.

Old Scotch retained their unbeaten record with a 5-goal win over Collegians and Geelong sprang a surprise with a 3-point win in a high-scoring game at Ivanhoe.

Despite the strong wind, there was still some high scoring — Old Melburnians kicked 31-29 (215) against Kew, and Thomastown in the Juniors tallied 40-25 (265) against Alphington.

Five other teams kicked more than 20 goals, but there were many scores at the other end of the scale.

University Blacks Reserves failed to kick a goal, scoring only 10 behinds, and Melbourne High and St. Kilda CBC Reserves played a drawn game, each side kicking 4-17.

University Blues made the leaders, De La Salle, fight all the way, but "De La" got a break near the finish to go on and win by 14 points.

Ormond's last quarter challenge to Coburg just failed as the home side held on to win by 7 points. Coburg can probably thank their victory to the fact that they kicked 1-3 against the wind in the second quarter, the only score at the northern end for the day.

Old Trinity showed that their defeat of De La Salle the week before was no fluke, when they beat University Blacks by 27 points, knocking the Blacks out of the four. Coburg are now fourth on percentage from Blacks and Trinity.

Old Ivanhoe's inaccurate kicking cost them the game at Fawkner, where they had six more scoring shots and went down by four points.

AJAX and Old Xaverians remain unbeaten in D Section, Xavier defeating their Como Park "ground-sharers" Old Geelong by 19 points.

Four teams share the leadership in A Reserve Section, each with one defeat, while four are equal second in C Reserve Section, and four equal third in F Reserve Section.

De La Salle and North Old Boys meet today to decide outright leaders, and the two level in second place in B Section, Marcellin and Caulfield Grammar, provide the main encounter in that section.

# UMPIRE'S CORNER

Umpire committee chairman: Alf Keam.

This year the umpire committee is being most capably led by Mr. Alf Keam, a man whose sporting life has been one of Amateur Football.

Alf, who played over 200 games of football with Melbourne High School Old Boys when they were a real power in A Section, has been a member of the umpire committee for 7 years.

A very strong personality, not afraid to make a decision and stick to it, he has the full confidence and respect of all umpires.

This was shown quite strongly when he recently attended an umpires' meeting and made a short address.

Although he spends many hours on football duties, Alf still manages to wield a decent golf club on occasions.

Every umpire who has reached the top in any competition will always give this message to young umpires: "To be a good umpire you must look like one."

Summed up, it means "take special care of your gear."

Wear comfortable, clean boots and carry spare laces in your kit bag.

Socks must be clean and well fitting. Wear a comfortable support, and your shorts and shirt must be neat and clean.

Above all, don't leave your gear in your kit bag after matches — especially if wet.

Clean mud off your boots as soon as possible after the game.

Wear one set of boots for training and keep another pair for Saturday umpiring.

Take pride in your appearance and you will not only "look the part" but play the part of being a top umpire.

## "GOAL UMPIRES"

An error in judgment by a goal umpire could mean the difference between a win or a loss for a team.

Because of this it is imperative that when judging a score you place yourself in the best possible position to see the actual flight of the ball over the goal line.

Players may shoot for goal from set shots or they may snap for goal. They may shoot from angles or from the front. They may shoot from close in or from far out.

In every case, once the ball has left the player's boot you must place yourself in a direct line with the flight of the ball to accurately judge its direction.

Stand one or two metres behind the goal line.

Stand in a direct line with the centre of the goal line and the player taking the kick.

When the ball is kicked, if you can see that it is travelling off line one side or the other, move across accordingly and place yourself in a direct line with the line of flight of the ball.

If the kick makes the distance and you are in correct position the ball will pass directly over your head after crossing the line.

Should you see that the ball is likely to fall short and land close to the line you should first move into line to line you should first move into line to pick up its line of flight and then move quickly to the nearest goal post and sight along the line to see whether it is touched or not before crossing the goal line.

The same principles apply in taking position for a snap shot at goal excepting that you will not have so much time before the ball is kicked to attend to your "lining up" procedure of the centre of the goal line and the player with the ball.

At such times you will need to be continually alert to the need to change (or adjust) your position as various players in the forward area appear likely to shoot at goal from various positions.

The most difficult situation in which to judge correctly is the angle shot from close in which skews off the side of the boot.

Excepting when there is a chance of a shot at goal, you should position yourself midway between the two goal posts.

Wait until the ball has definitely crossed OVER the line before committing yourself to a decision.

## DO YOU KNOW?

That last Saturday saw the introduction of the "two field umpires" in the West Australian Football League. One umpire, Mike Ball (only 20 years of age), is believed to be one of the youngest senior umpires in a major Australian competition.

## A SECTION

Strong winds made selection of winners difficult — at least for me. However, it was comforting to peruse the progressive table in the Amateur Footballer and discover, contrary to popular opinion, there are worse tipsters.

The two University teams, neither of which has really started firing yet, meet "at home", but I feel the Blues have the better credentials. Could it be that star players of all sides opposing the Blacks turn it on in front of State coach Peter O'Donohue?

Reservoir Old Boys won me with their wet weather form recently but appear to lack consistency. I must select Old Trinity and suggest that the ruck duels between two giants, Mike Bates and Chris Hansen, will be worth seeing.

Monash Blues could be on the improve and should delay Ormond's long-awaited climb up the ladder for yet another week. — ALF KEAM.

Disastrous to say the least! I didn't like the wind as a player (Aghan and "Ando" doubt I ever was one) and I don't like it as a tipster. It completely upset well reasoned judgment — or that's what my children told me.

Last week I was treated to a class performance by Marcellin in conditions more suited to Parade, and they will play a part in this year's proceedings.

## LOOKING BACK

### 5 Years Ago — 1971

O.G.G.'s farewelled one of their greatest players, former captain, Bill Tunbridge, who had been transferred to Tasmania.

200 games to Alphington's Doug Puddy (Doug is now an umpire, Ed.).

Past and present players gathered at Kew to honor Ray (Weeties) Martin. After 154 games with Richmond, Ray coached Kew for 12 years, including two premierships.

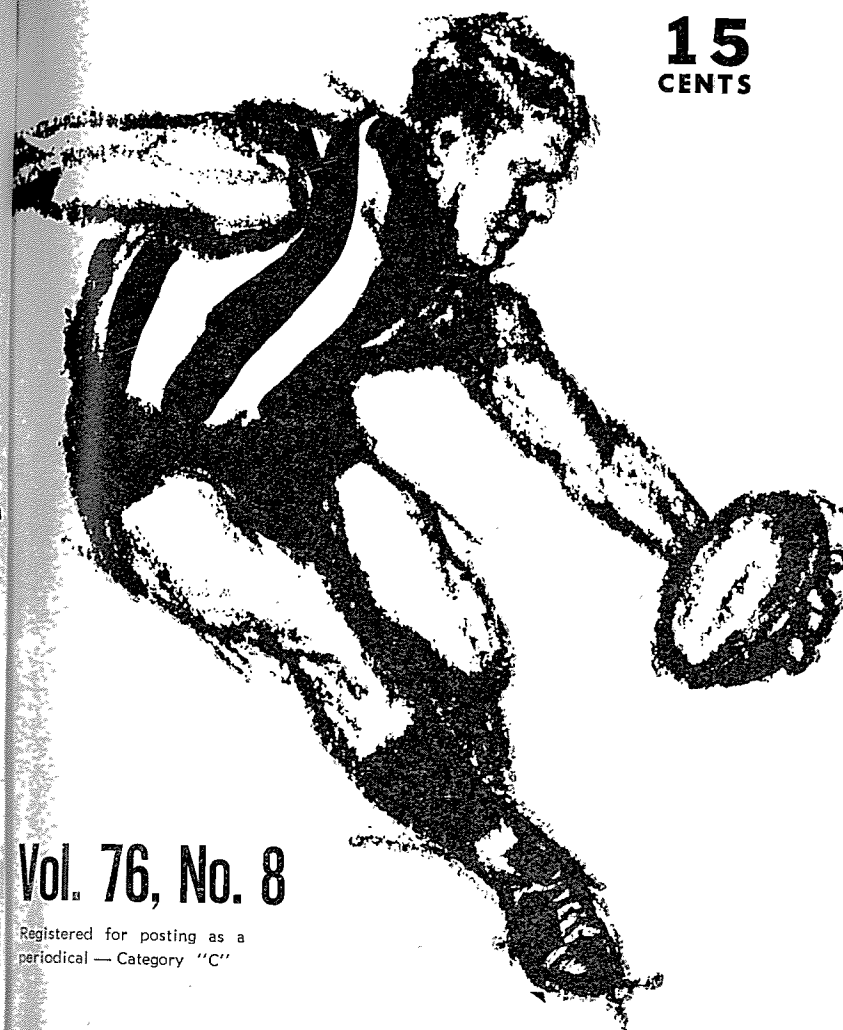
