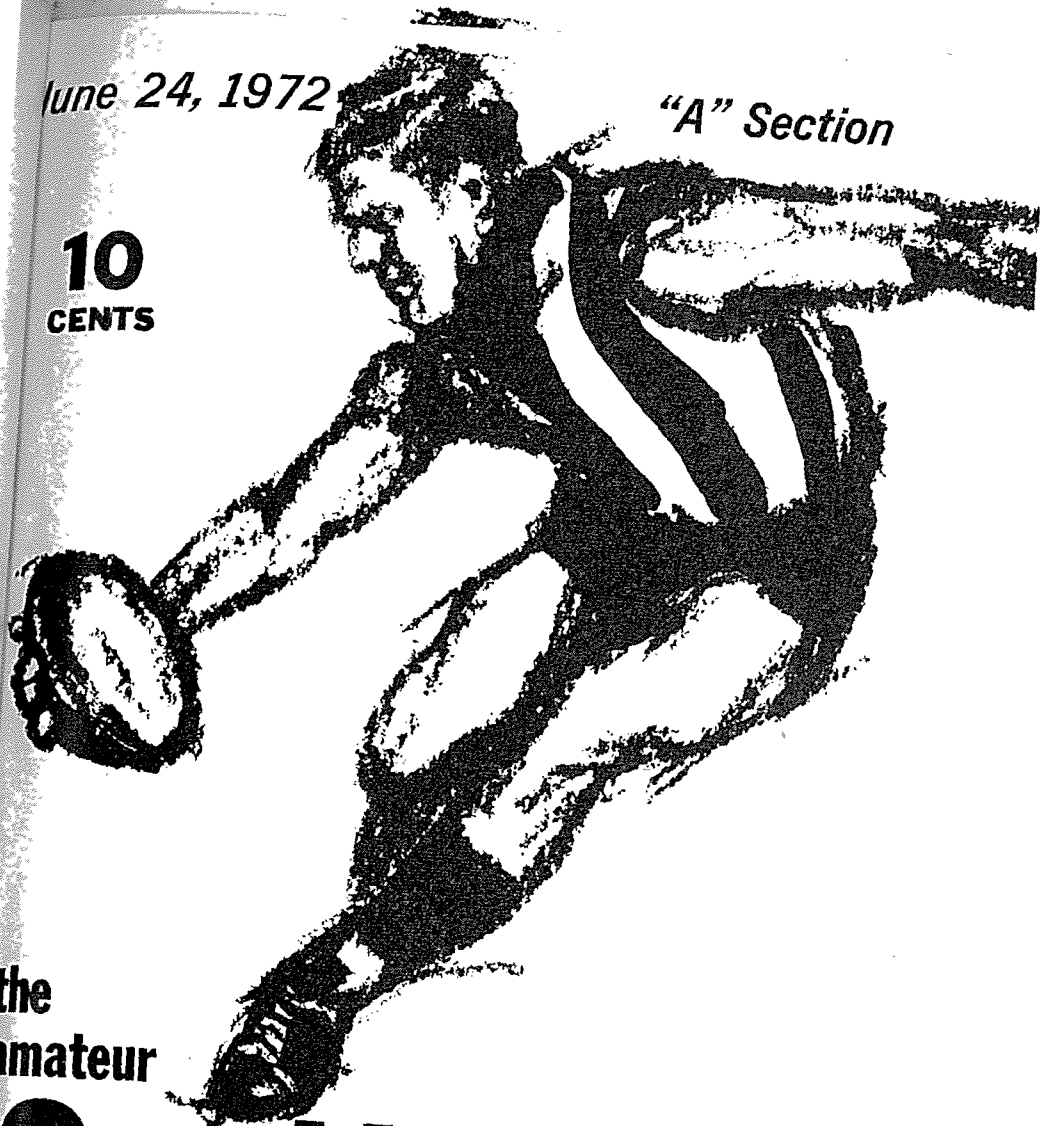

# COBURG SWAMPED BY ST. BERNARD'S Parade Down to Caul. Gram., Lose Place in Four

St. Bernard's upset calculations last Saturday when they scored an overwhelming win against Coburg, gaining a place in the four in the process. Old Paradians, soundly defeated by the leaders, Caulfield Grammar, slipped out of the top bracket to make way for St. Bernard's.

Geelong, B Section leaders, were badly beaten by University Blacks and dropped down to fourth, with Blacks the new leader. State Savings Bank and University Blacks Reserves were other leading teams to suffer defeat.

With half the home-and-home round completed, six teams remain undefeated — Reservoir Old Boys, Brunswick, Old Camberwell, North Old Boys Juniors, St. Kilda CBC Reserves and Monash Whites Reserves.

St. Bernard's were faster to the ball than Coburg, and kept it moving well to open up an early lead. They used handball to advantage and prevented Coburg from effectively using their play-on game until the last quarter, when it was too late.

Caulfield Grammar's pace and height were too much for Parade who gradually dropped further and further behind. Caulfield's big men dominated the game and they ran out easy winners.

Ormond opened with a terrific onslaught on the University Blues' defence and quickly gained a sizeable lead. The Blues tried hard to overcome their early leeway but Ormond were too strong and won very comfortably.

De La Salle put up a strong fight against North Old Boys in a fairly even, high-scoring game. North finished a little better and won by 14 points.

Melbourne High's better teamwork and superior play in the first half against Monash Blues was nullified by poor shooting for goal and Monash led narrowly. Monash improved

after the interval and went on to win by 31 points.

University Blacks were always ahead of Geelong, and were not greatly troubled to score by 31 points.

Old Scotch and Collegians were evenly matched for three quarters, but Scotch cleared out in the last term and won by 29 points.

Old Trinity gained a firm grip on the game against Old Carey in the first half and then slammed on 9 goals in the last quarter for an easy win.

Uni High trailed Kew by only 7 points at three-quarter-time, but Kew were stronger at the finish and won by 4 goals.

Ivanhoe were too strong for Tooronga-Malvern and won by more than 8 goals.

Power House put in a strong last quarter to score a 31-point win over Assumption, and Old Melburnians' 9-goal burst in the third term enabled them to win easily over Commonwealth Bank.

Old Haileybury put in a good second half against Fairfield and were 4 goals ahead at the finish.

Reservoir Old Boys easily beat National Bank and St. Kilda CBC were winners by 20 points over Old Xaverians.

St. Kevin's overwhelmed St. Pat's and Brunswick were a little too strong for Old Brighton, winning by 3 goals. Hampton Rovers beat Old Geelong by 15 points.

Marcellin scraped home from Glenhuntly by only 2 points, Glen's accurate kicking almost winning it for them. State Savings Banks' inaccuracy in front of goal probably cost them the game against Old Ivanhoe, who scored by 20 points.

Poor kicking also played a big part in AJAX's 29-point defeat by ANZ Bank.

Old Camberwell overwhelmed Old Mentonians and St. Bede's scored a big win over Monash Whites.

Melbourne High scored a surprise win over Monash University in Junior Section 1, the margin being 28 points. University Blacks also caused an upset, beating Power House by nearly 7 goals.

In Section 2, National Bank beat West Brunswick by 5 points, and Coburg were run to a similar margin by Tooronga-Malvern.

In Reserve Section games, University Blues beat Ormond by 3 points, St. Bernard's beat Coburg by 15, Old Carey beat Old Trinity by 10, Geelong beat the Blacks by 9, Ivanhoe beat Tooronga-Malvern by 4, Assumption easily beat Power House, Fairfield beat Old Haileybury by 5 points and Old Brighton beat Brunswick by 10.

## PERMITS CLOSE SOON

Applications for permits for season 1972 will close with the Records Secretary of the V.A.F.A. Mr. Bruce De Lacy, 67 Charman Road, Mentone, 3194 on June 30th.

The only application considered after that date will be that of a player affiliated with a club in the amateur body of South Australia, Western Australia or Tasmania, who is transferred to Victoria in his employment, or a National Serviceman who returns to Victoria.

A player who has played with a club in the V.A.F.A. this season, and has subsequently played with another club, must stand down for two matches before being eligible to play for his V.A.F.A. club again.

In a case such as this, the date on which he last played with the other club must be shown on his permit application.

Re-registration of a player whose permit is still in force, that is, a player who has not played with any other club since he last played with the club with which he is seeking re-registration may be made at any time up to the last home and home match.

## UMPIRES CORNER

**SOLID BUMPING.** The rules of the game permit bumping or pushing from the side.

Sometimes such bumps or pushes are very vigorous, but if they are correctly placed on the side or front of an opponent they are quite fair under the rules and should not be penalised. Provided the ball is within five yards.

There is to be no jostling at the centre before the ball is bounced.

There must be no interference whilst the ball is about to be thrown in or is being thrown in from the boundary.

A player who is going for a mark legitimately and interferes with an opponent from behind — no free kick.

Breaches such as deliberately kicking or forcing the ball out of bounds must be penalised every time they occur.

A mark taken on the goal line is deemed to be a mark.

The ball must be completely over the goal line in case of a score, and completely over the boundary line to be out of bounds.

If a juggled mark is started on the goal or behind line and completed over the line it is a behind.

A similar case on the boundary line the decision would be out of bounds.

**BOUNDARY UMPIRES:** When a player is kicking for goal you should take up a position at the behind post in line with the flight of the ball.

You then command a view to give an accurate decision. The ball is not out until it has crossed the line.

If any portion of the ball is on the line it is still in play. Do not be influenced by players or spectators.

**GOAL UMPIRES.** Always keep your eye on the play and your fellow goal umpire when the play is in his area.

It is your duty to see who kicks the ball; also to watch for reportable incidents.

Reference to Reportable Incidents applies only to goal and boundary umpires appointed by the VAFA — not to club officials. Ed.
