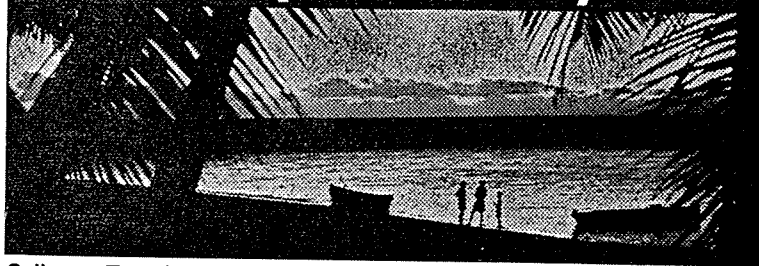

ORMOND'S FINISH TOO MUCH FOR ST. BERNARD'S Blues Worry Caul. Gramm. — North, Monash Draw Upsets in B Section

Ormond finished much too strongly for St. Bernard's after a fairly even first half and ran out clear winners in last Saturday's main game.

University Blues surprised the leaders, Caulfield Grammarians, and after trailing by six goals at three-quarter-time, made up quite a lot of ground in the last term to go down by 18 points. Had they kicked straighter it might have been a different story.

North Old Boys and Monash Blues played a drawn game, each side kicking 11-12. Five goals were scored in the last 10 minutes and the lead changed twice in this period before the scores were finally levelled.

There were two major upsets in B Section — the leaders, University Blacks, going down by over nine goals to Collegians, and Old Carey toppling Old Scotch.

The Ormond-St. Bernard's game was very scrubby up till half-time when Ormond led by 2 goals, but their rucks started to take charge in the third quarter and they edged away. It was all Ormond in the last term and they won by more than 10 goals.

Melbourne High shocked Old Paradisians when they slammed on 8 goals in the second quarter to gain a lead of 8 points at the interval, but they couldn't maintain their run and Parade got on top after that and went on to win by 31 points.

Caulfield won an evenly-contested game with their straighter kicking. The Blues won in the ruck but their kicking was astray under pressure. Caulfield looked to be in a good position when they led by 4 goals at half-time, but they had to withstand a strong last quarter challenge from the Blues, who kicked 6-7 to 4-1 in this term. Up till the last change the Blues had managed only 6 goals in 21 shots.

Coburg scored an easy win over De La Salle but they were not very impressive in doing so. They kicked 2-10 in the first quarter but restored their prestige by adding 7-4 in the second and were well in command

then. De La must be admired for the way they fought the game right out.

Fumbling play marred the North-Monash match, in which Monash's ruck dominance was pitted against the brilliance of North's little men.

Geelong suffered their second successive defeat when they went under by 33 points to Ivanhoe. Geelong finished well, kicking 7 goals in the last quarter but they had given Ivanhoe too big a start and were 10 goals behind by three-quarter-time.

Despite their defeat, Geelong held their place in the four, as Old Scotch went down by 11 points to Old Carey.

Poor kicking for goal did nothing to help the Blacks who were well beaten by Collegians.

This loss sent the Blacks tumbling down from top place to third, Old Trinity's big win over Uni. High carrying them to the top, ahead of Ivanhoe on percentage.

In the other game, Kew scored a comfortable win over Tooronga-Malvern, to keep themselves in the running, four points outside the four.

St. Kilda CBC scored a convincing win over Assumption in a game of contrasting kicking. They kicked 15-23

to Assumption's 10-4, and should have won by a much bigger margin.

Old Melburnians thrashed Old Haileybury to the tune of 50 points and Reservoir Old Boys overwhelmed Old Xaverians. National Bank were too strong for Commonwealth Bank and Power House won comfortably from Fairfield.

The biggest surprise in D Section was Footscray Tech's 34-point win over the leaders, Brunswick. Tech are on the bottom of the list and they inflicted Brunswick's first defeat.

And St. Pat's nearly caused an upset too — they ran La Trobe Blacks (third) to a single point in a high-scoring game. Old Brighton beat an inaccurate Alphington by 33 points and Parkside had 26 points to spare over Hampton Rovers. Old Geelong were well beaten by St. Kevin's.

Only Marcellin's good kicking (16-11) saved them from defeat by Old Ivanhoe, whose 14-18 fell 5 points short of their opponents' score. It was Marcellin's second successive narrow win as they scraped home by 2 points from Glenhuntly the previous week.

Glenhuntly toppled State Savings Bank out of top place when they beat Bank by 20 points. It was Bank's second defeat in a row as they went down to Old Ivanhoe by the same margin the week before.

ANZ Bank beat AMP Society by 40 points and AJAX easily accounted for West Brunswick.

Old Camberwell maintained their unbeaten record, but only just — they scraped home from Monash Whites by only 2 points. St. Bede's pipped Old Mentonians by 3 points and Dookie and Longerenong beat North Brunswick by 9 points.

In Junior Section games, Ormond beat St. Bernard's by 2 points and Monash beat Power House by 3 goals. Old Scotch had 5 goals to spare over Melbourne High.

Coburg scored by a goal from Old Brighton, but the other Section 2

matches were won by big margins, North Old Boys kicking 37-24 (246 points) against AJAX. Caulfield Grammar and University Blues also kicked big scores.

Among the Reserves, North Old Boys beat Monash Blues by 17 points, St. Kilda CBC easily beat Assumption, Power House beat Fairfield by 16 points, Parkside scored from Hampton Rovers by 3, Old Geelong beat St. Kevin's by 2 goals, Old Ivanhoe beat Marcellin by 3 points, AJAX were well beaten by West Brunswick, AMP beat ANZ by 17 points, Monash Whites thrashed Old Camberwell and Elesternwick beat La Trobe Reds by 10 goals.

It was a day of high scoring, no fewer than 35 teams kicking century scores, two of them exceeding the 200 mark. In three games, both sides kicked over 100 points.

ELIGIBILITY OF PLAYERS FOR RESERVE AND JUNIOR SECTION FINALS

Now that we are into the second
 round of home-and-home matches, it
 is not too early to draw the attention
 of clubs to the restrictions which ap-
 ply concerning players eligible to take
 part in Final matches in the Reserve
 and Junior Sections.

The Rule relating to eligibility of
 players in Reserve Section Finals now
 reads:—

A player who has been a member
 of a senior team of any club in nine
 or more matches during the home-
 and-home matches in any season shall
 not be eligible for inclusion in the
 reserve team of a club taking part
 in a final match in the same season

UMPIRES CORNER

GOAL UMPIRES

The goal umpire who is just as important as the field umpire, shall signal and record a goal or behind, as the case may be, upon receiving the "all clear" or "touched, all clear", signal from the field umpire, without making any comment.

Goal umpires shall not concern themselves with the question as to whether the time bell (or siren) has or has not sounded at any period of the match.

The goal umpire must watch the play closely, but if he is unable to decide who kicked the ball over the line he may consult the field umpire before recording a decision.

When a goal umpire is unable to see whether the ball goes over the goal line, and cannot give a decision, the ball must be bounced by the field umpire on the centre of the kick-off line in front of goal.

Goal umpires are particularly directed not to get in the way of players between goal posts.

DEFINITIONS OF LAWS

Charging — is violently meeting and pushing a player in a manner not authorised by the laws of the game, when he is not in possession of the ball, or when he is in the air.

Slings — is the act of catching a player by or around the neck and throwing or attempting to throw him to the ground. The neck includes the top of the shoulder.

Shepherding — is the act of pushing, shouldering, or blocking an opponent not in possession of the ball.

Throwing the ball — is throwing or handing the ball to another player other than by handballing.

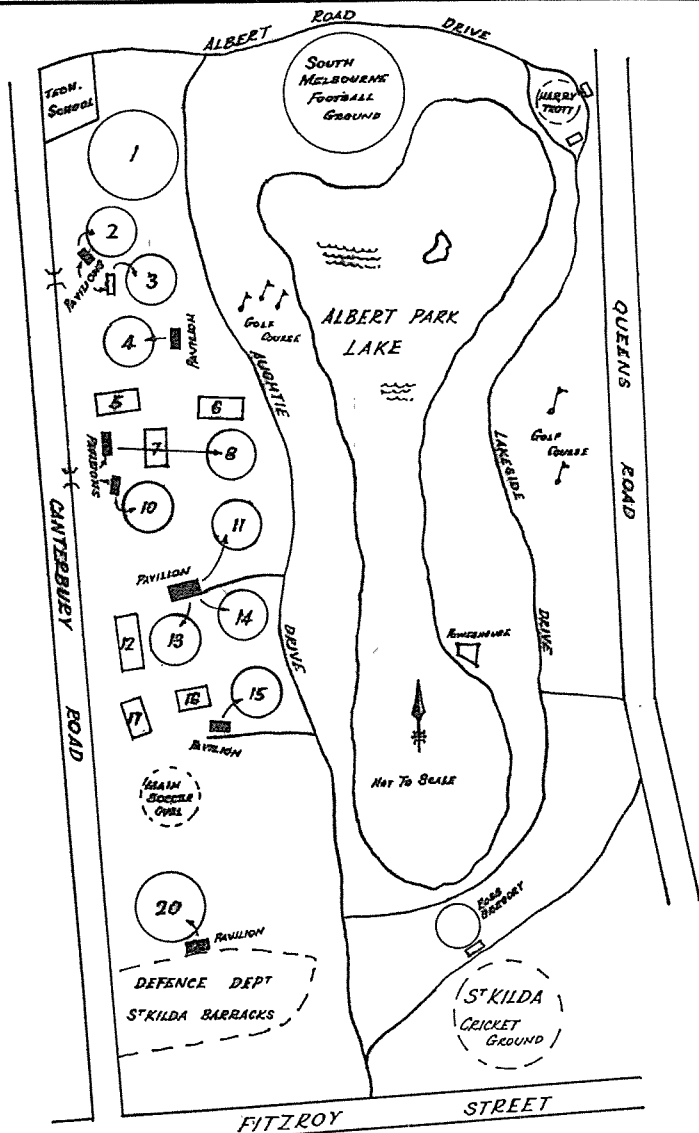
