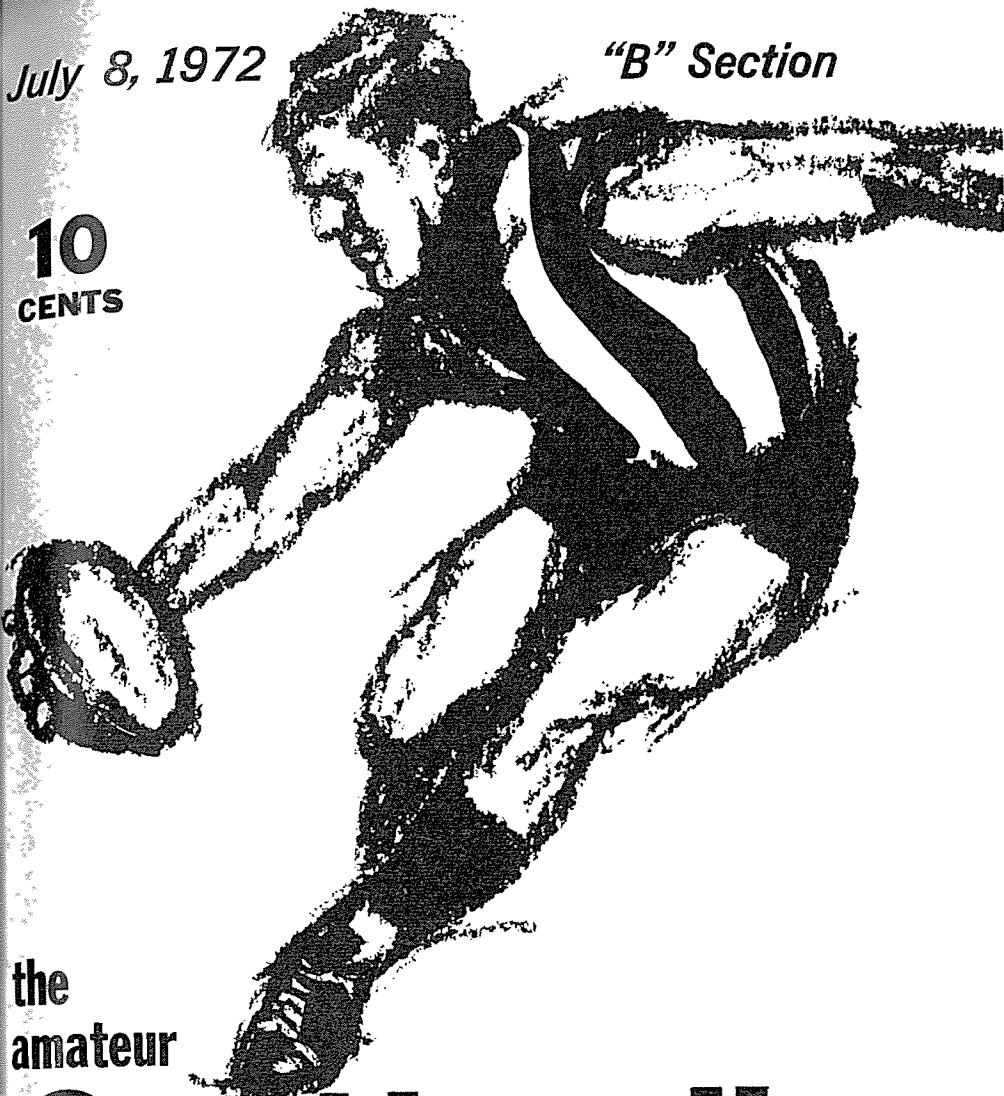

MONASH UPSET PARADE ST. BERNARD'S DOWN TO BLUES More Surprises in B Section

Monash Blues caused a surprise in last week's round when they outplayed Old Paradians and won by 20 points.

But Parade held their place in the top section as Old Trinity and St. Bernard's, went down narrowly to University Blues.

But the upsets were not confined to the top section as Old Trinity and Ivanhoe, joint leaders in B Section were both beaten.

Three other leading teams, Brunswick, Ormond Juniors and Coburg reserves, also suffered defeat. It was Brunswick's second in succession.

Monash's inaccuracy in front of goal contrasted with Parade's straight shooting in the first half and Monash led by only 2 points at the interval.

Monash broke right away in the third term when they put on 7-5 to 2-5 and looked to be in a good position with a 32-point lead at the last change.

But they had to hold off a strong challenge from Parade late in the game before emerging winners by 20 points.

University Blues and St. Bernard's staged a ding-dong struggle, and poor shooting for goal probably cost St. Bernard's the game.

They led by 8 points at half time (6-11 to 6-3) but the Blues added 6 goals in the third quarter and held on to win by 6 points.

Melbourne High put up a valiant struggle against the leaders, Caulfield Grammarians, but Caulfield held too many guns and finally won by 7 goals.

Coburg and North Old Boys were very evenly matched in the first half, but Coburg got clear in the third term with a 6-goal burst and finished on to win by 6 goals.

Old Xaverians beat National Bank by 4 goals and Fairfield had a comfortable win over Old Melburnians.

Ormond were not greatly troubled by De La Salle and won as they liked.

University Blacks shocked Ivanhoe with a 22-point win in a high-scoring game.

Old Scotch and Old Trinity were level at half-time but Scotch did a little better in the second half and won by 11 points.

Kew gave Geelong plenty of anxious moments. They led by 5 goals at half-time and nearly 4 goals at the last change, but Geelong came home strongly to add 7 goals in the final term and win by 16 points.

Old Carey's accurate kicking was a big factor in their 26-point win over Collegians and Toorong-Malvern scored easily against Uni. High.

Reservoir Old Boys had a big win over Assumption while Power House kicked 7-4 in the last quarter and held St. Kilda CBC scoreless, to win easily.

Old Xaverians beat National Bank by 4 goals and Fairfield had a comfortable win over Old Melburnians.

Alphington finished strongly to beat Brunswick by 14 points, adding 7 goals in the last quarter.

St. Pat's beat Footscray Tech by 2 goals in a high-scoring encounter.

West Brunswick kept with State Savings Bank in the first half, when they trailed by 9 points, but Bank went on to win by 29 points. This was another high-scoring affair.

Glenhuntly beat AMP Society by 21 points and Marcellin and Old Ivanhoe had comfortable wins over AJAX and ANZ Bank respectively.

Elsternwick trounced Monash Whites to the tune of nearly 12 goals, and Old Mentonians beat North Brunswick by 19 points.

University Blacks scored a surprise win over Junior Section leaders, Ormond, the margin being 6 goals. Monash beat Old Scotch by 22 points.

All games in Section 2 were decided by big margins, with each of the top four teams winning.

There were some surprises amongst the Reserves, too. Ormond beat De La Salle by only 8 points, Monash Blues crashed badly against Parade, going down by 5 goals, and North Old Boys beat Coburg by a point.

Geelong and Kew provided a contrast in kicking. Geelong had only one more scoring shot but won by

over 9 goals (14-3 to 3-13). Old Scotch thrashed Old Trinity, U.H.S. easily beat Tooronga-Malvern, and Collegians beat Carey.

La Trobe Blacks beat Old Geelong by 9 points, Hampton Rovers beat St. Kevin's by a point. AJAX were well beaten by Old Ivanhoe, and Monash Whites scraped home by 3 points (16-8 to 16-5) from Elsternwick, who had kicked 10 goals straight up till half-time.



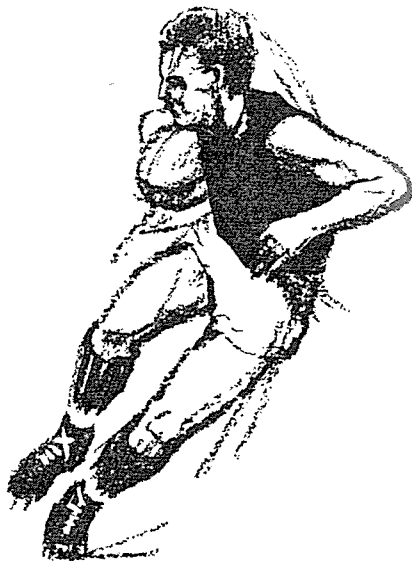

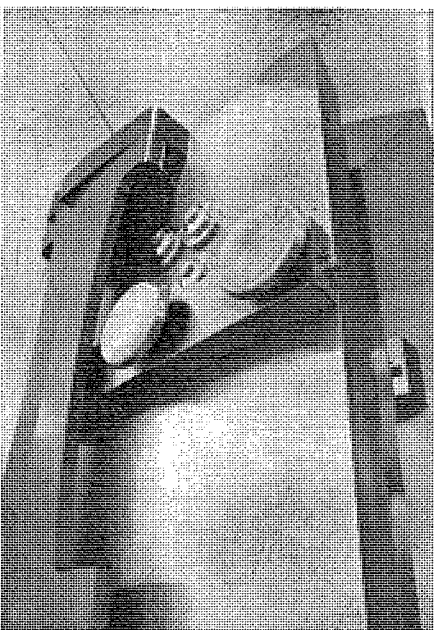
