



PARADE HOLD ON TO DOWN COBURG ORMOND CHOP CAULFIELD OUT OF TOP SPOT Fight is on for Fours — and Relegation

Old Paradians held off a determined last quarter challenge by Coburg last Saturday to score a 2-goal win and hold their place in the four.

Ormond's big win over Melbourne High gave them top place on the list over Caulfield Grammarians on percentage. They now lead by 2.6%.

The fours are taking shape in many of the sections, with only six rounds of home-and-home matches to be played, but in some others, the position is wide open.

For those who have not done so well this season, the battle is on to avoid relegation, and in some cases clubs within striking distance of the four are also in danger of going down. The next few weeks will solve the problem.

Parade opened in good style against Coburg — they led in the race for the ball, won in the ruck and in the air and generally outplayed their opponents to thoroughly deserve their 29-point lead at quarter time.

Parade went further ahead in the second term and looked like scoring a runaway win but Coburg fought back well to be 3 goals behind at the inter-

It had been a great display of foot-

ball — fast and entertaining.

But both sides sagged in the third quarter and the game lost all its first-half sparkle, in a battle that see-sawed between the back lines, with both sides full of mistakes. It took 20 minutes of play to score the first goal of the quarter, and each side managed only one goal for the term.

Paradians were 23 points in front at the start of the last term then Coburg whittled it down to 11 points, and

were still in the game.

But Parade's defences held firm and Coburg went down by 2 goals. University Blues were a shade too

University Blues were a shade too strong for North Old Boys all day and ran out winners by 20 points. They were on top in the air and their tight defence held up North's bid for victory in the last quarter.

Ormond overwhelmed Melbourne High in a game that was very onesided after the first quarter. Ormond kicked 8 goals in the second term and 9 in the third and won as they liked.

Much the same could be said of the Caulfield Grammar - Monash Blues game, in which Caulfield hopped off with 10.2 in the first quarter. Monash never recovered and Caulfield coasted to an easy win.

Poor kicking by St. Bernard's in the first half held them to a 20-point lead over De La Salle. But St. Bernard's added 8.10 to a point in the third quarter and won by 15 goals.

The top five in B Section strengthened their positions and the next three now have only a rough chance of

playing in the finals.

Ivanhoe beat Old Carey by more than 8 goals, Kew failed by nearly 6 goals against Old Scotch, and Collegians put up a good fight before going down to Old Trinity by 17 points in a high-scoring game. Trinity's straighter kicking may have saved the day for them — they kicked 19.11 to Collegians' 15.18.

Geelong beat Tooronga-Malvern by 13 goals to boost their percentage and University Blacks had almost 10 goals

to spare over Uni High.

Poor kicking (8.20 to 10.14) played a big part in St Kilda CBC's 6-point defeat by Old Melburnians. Assumption beat Old Xaverians by 9 points and Reservoir Old Boys continued their unbeaten run with a big win over Old Haileybury.

National Bank had only three less scoring shots than Power House but went down by nearly 10 goals, and Fairfield scored a big win over Commonwealth Bank.

Brunswick lost their game in a row when they went down by 19 points to Parkside. They have now lost top place to Old Brighton, who beat Old Geelong by 33 points.

LaTrobe Blacks could manage only a draw with St. Kevin's, Footscray Tech. beat Hampton Rovers by 4 goals, and Alphington scored comfortably from St Pat's.

Glenhuntly beat AJAX by 7 points, ANZ Bank ran State Savings Bank to 21 points and Old Ivanhoe scored by 16 points from AMP Society. Marcellin had 9 goals to spare over West Brunswick.

Old Mentonians pipped Elsternwick by 2 points and Dookie and Long. ran St. Bede's to 23 points.

Old Scotch scraped home from University Blacks by 2 points in the main Junior Section match. Ormond, St. Bernard's and Power House all had big wins over Ivanhoe, Melbourne High and Hampton Scouts respectively.

In Section 2, Caulfield Grammar surprised Coburg, beating them by 19 points and Old Brighton beat West Brunswick by 2 points. University Blues, North Old Boys and Tooronga-Malvern scored easily.

In the Reserves, Monash Blues beat Caulfield Grammar comfortably, Old Carey beat Ivanhoe by 7 points, Reservoir went down to Old Haileybury by 2 points, Old Xaverians beat Assumption by 9, Old Brighton beat Old Geelong by 2 goals, AMP Society went

down to Old Ivanhoe by 5 goals, Old Camberwell beat LaTrobe Reds by a point and Elsternwick downed Old Mentonians by 17 points. In each of the last two games the winners kicked 4.8.

THE FIGHT FOR THE FOUR

The fight for places in the final four looks to be confined to five teams in A Section — Ormond, Caulfield Grammar, Coburg, Old Paradians and St. Bernard's — with North Old Boys and University Blues having only an outside chance.

Old Trinity, Ivanhoe, Uni. Blacks, Geelong and Old Scotch are the main contenders in B Section, with Collegians, Old Carey and Kew having practically dropped out of calculations after last week's defeats.

But there are nine with a chance of making the finals in C Section, Commonwealth Bank being the only one out of the running.

St Kevin's, Parkside and St. Pat's must be considered to have a chance in D Section with Old Brighton, Brunswick, LaTrobe Blacks and Alphington the established four at present.

In E Section, it's Marcellin, State Bank, Old Ivanhoe and Glenhuntly, with AJAX two games outside the four.

There are five in the running in F Section — Old Camberwell, Elsternwick, St Bede's, Monash Whites and Old Mentonians — but the main battle is between the last two for fourth place.

It's very open in Junior Section 1, with only four points separating the top five — Ormond, St. Bernard's, Power House, Old Scotch and Monash University — who are really the only ones in it.

North Old Boys, Uni. Blues, Coburg and Caulfield Grammar comprise the Junior Section 2 four, with Tooronga-Malvern and Old Brighton two games outside.


