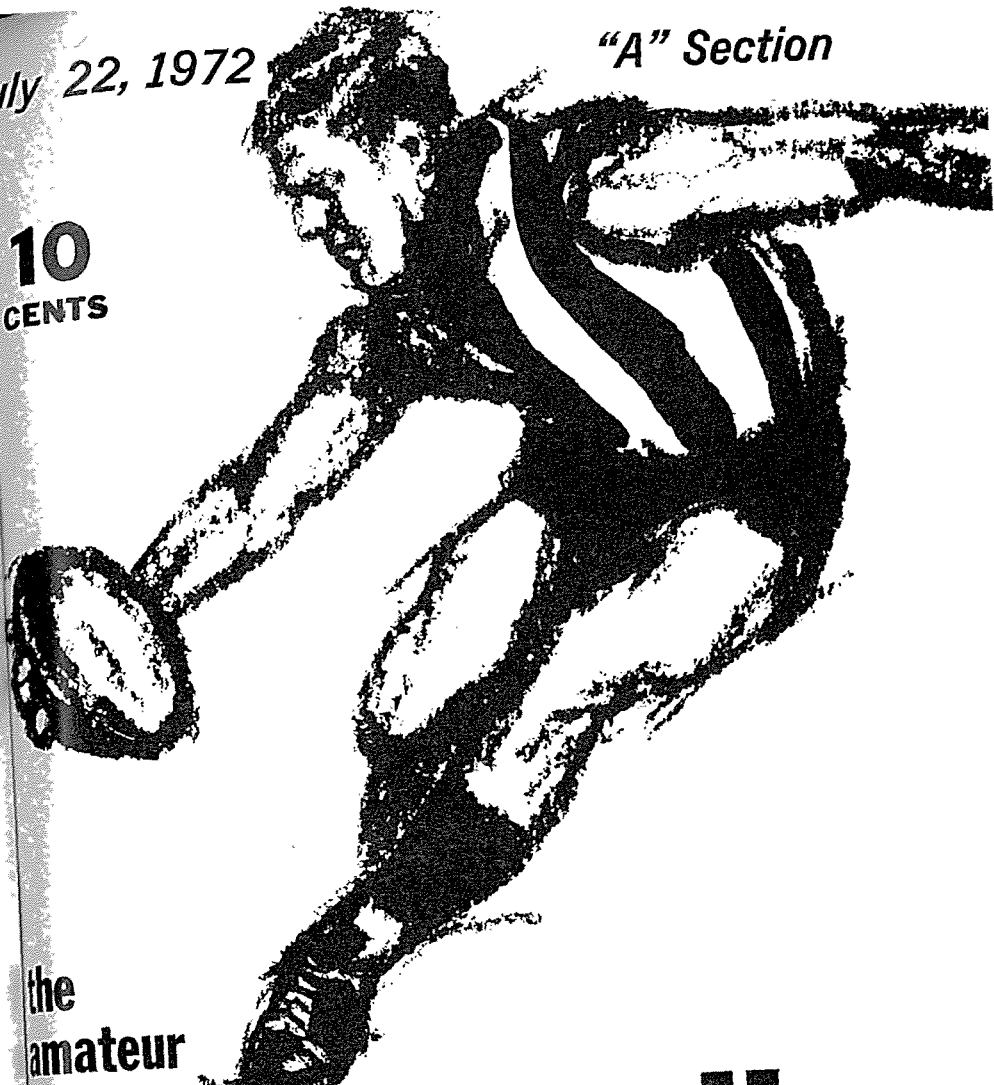

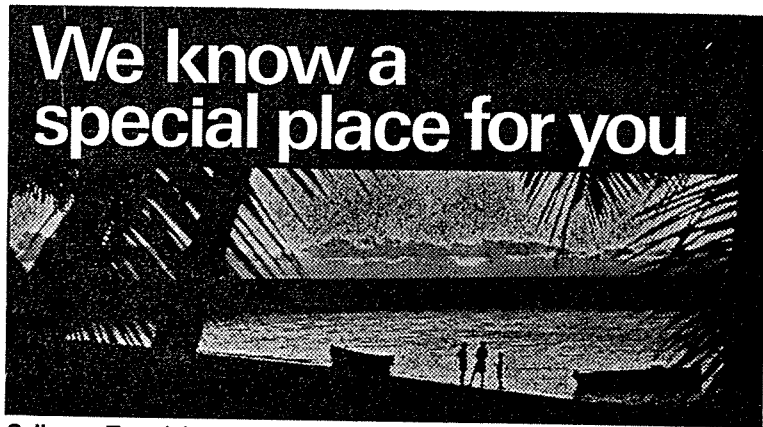

ST. BERNARD'S LOSE ANOTHER CHANCE POOR FIRST HALF COSTLY FOR COBURG *De La Salle Open Account*

St. Bernard's lost another chance of getting back into the four last Saturday when they faded towards the finish and went down by 11 points to a determined Monash Blues.

Ormond opened up a big lead in the first half against Coburg, who found the leeway too great in a good fight-back after the interval and Ormond scored by 20 points.

Eight goals in the first quarter by De La Salle proved too much for Old Paradians, who were beaten by 14 points. It was De La Salle's first win for the season.

University Blacks scored a 10-goal win over Old Trinity to take over the top place in B Section, which is still wide open.

Ormond were on top of Coburg in the first half and led by 39 points at the interval. Coburg were well off the target, kicking only 4 goals from 17 scoring shots. Ormond caught the complaint in the third term and kicked 1.7 while Coburg recovered well to add 4.6 and trail by 22 points.

Coburg continued to press the leaders and were only 5 points down shortly before the finish. But Ormond steadied and scored a couple of goals to seal the game.

St Bernard's went to a 15-point lead over Monash Blues at half-time but Monash fought back well in the third term to gain a lead of 2 points and were too strong and determined in the run home, and were winners by 11 points. Poor kicking by St. Bernard's contributed to their defeat, as they scored 9.19 to Monash's 12.12.

Melbourne High kept with University Blues until halfway through the last quarter when the Blues' superior teamwork and position play enabled them to move away to a 28-point win.

Caulfield Grammarians were not impressive in the first half and led North Old Boys by only 21 points at the interval. But they improved after

that and played more determined football to run out easy winners, kicking 8 goals in the last quarter.

Caulfield now head the list on percentage from Ormond, and they are three games ahead of Coburg and Old Paradians, with St. Bernard's another four points behind.

Kew scored a surprise win over Ivanhoe by 16 points to knock them out of the four, and keep their own chances alive, even though only faintly.

Geelong rose to second place on percentage when they beat Old Carey by 25 points, but Carey's inaccurate kicking didn't help them. Old Scotch made the most of the chance to boost their percentage at the expense of Uni High who were beaten by more than 16 goals, and Scotch moved into the four.

Collegians also won easily from Tooronga-Malvern and also still have an outside chance of taking part in the finals. Trinity's defeat caused them to drop from first place to fourth.

Reservoir Old Boys beat St. Kilda CBC by 22 points and Old Melburnians caused Assumption some trouble before going down by 4 goals in a high-scoring game.

Another high-scoring affair was the one in which Old Haileybury beat National Bank by 21 points, and Commonwealth Bank did quite well in kicking 14-9 against Power House who however, still won with plenty to spare.

Old Xaverians moved out of the relegation zone at least for the time being when they beat Fairfield by 9 goals.

Brunswick broke their run of outs with a morale-boosting win over St. Kevin's, the margin being more than 14 goals. LaTrobe Blacks scored a 49-point win over Alphington, and Parkside were much too strong for Footscray Tech.

St. Pat's kicked slightly better than Old Geelong to win by 7 points and Old Brighton had an easy win over Hampton Rovers.

State Savings Bank beat AJAX by 22 points and Marcellin and Old Ivanhoe kicked big scores against AMP Society and West Brunswick respectively, although AMP kicked 16.13, a score that would have won on most occasions.

There were two surprises in F Section — North Brunswick sneaked home by a point from St. Bede's and Dookie & Longerenong beat Monash Whites to the tune of 51 points, knocking Monash out of the four in the process. Old Camberwell scored a big win over Elsternwick.

In Junior Section games, St. Bernard's beat University Blacks by 5 points, and Old Scotch failed badly against Power House, losing their place in the four to Monash University, who easily beat Hampton Scouts.

In Section 2, North Old Boys held top place when they beat University Blues by a goal, but Blues' inaccuracy cost them the game. They kicked 8.20 to 11.8.

Of the Reserves, the most interesting results were the drawn game between Coburg and Ormond, St. Ber-

nard's big win over Monash and North Old Boys' 5-point win over Caulfield. Ivanhoe beat Kew by 4 points, University Blacks trounced Old Trinity, St. Kilda CBC easily beat Reservoir, Fairfield crashed against Old Xaverians, Hampton Rovers had 28 points to spare over Old Brighton, State Bank beat AJAX by 3 points, Old Camberwell beat Elsternwick by 5 points and LaTrobe Reds beat Old Mentonians by 11 points.

FAREWELL TO "JOE"

Joe has been a great lover of Amateur football and admits that he will miss his association with our game.

He is proud of the fact that he has been able to tip the A Section premiers (early in the season) each year except 1971, when he selected University Blues, who were runners-up.

His choice for 1972 — CAULFIELD GRAMMARIANS.

We all wish Joe every success in his change of scenery and climate and hope that he will spare a thought for us occasionally while he is pulling in the fish.

His place as Duty Officer has been taken by Mr. ERN FULLER, who commences his duties today. We wish him well, too!

ELIGIBILITY OF PLAYERS FOR RESERVE AND JUNIOR SECTION FINALS

The attention of clubs is drawn to the restrictions which apply concerning players eligible to take part in Final matches in the Reserve and Junior Sections.

The Rule relating to eligibility of players in Reserve Section Finals now reads:—

A player who has been a member of a senior team of any club in nine or more matches during the home-and-home matches in any season shall not be eligible for inclusion in the reserve team of a club taking part in a final match in the same season unless both the senior and reserve teams are participating in a final match on the same day.

Provided that no player shall be eligible for inclusion in a reserve team taking part in a final match in any season unless such player has been a member of such reserve team in at least TWO home-and-home matches during the said season.

JUNIORS

A player who has been a member of a senior or reserve team in more than five matches during any season shall be ineligible for inclusion in a junior team taking part in a semi-final, final or grand-final match in the SAME SEASON UNLESS he has been a member of the junior team for more than five matches in the same season.

Congratulations from all at St. Bernard's to Terry Booth who has now played 50 games for the club. Terry has been around for a few years now but has been continually plagued with injuries. He has shown himself to be a very fine player and a worthy representative of the club.

THE FIGHT FOR THE FOUR — AND RELEGATION

With only five rounds to go the fight for places in the final four is on in earnest, and there are still many contenders in the running.

In A Section the field is virtually narrowed down to five, with a couple more having only a rough chance of playing in the finals. In B Section it is much the same, with four teams equal in second place, four points behind the leader.

No less than nine teams are in the running in C Section, where the second last team is only a game outside the four. Seven still have a chance in D Section, a couple of them being only a game out of the four.

The four in E Section is almost settled, the fifth being three games behind and in F Section, five are still in the fight.

In both Junlor Sections the field looks to be narrowed down to five, with a couple of others in Section 2 having an outside chance.
