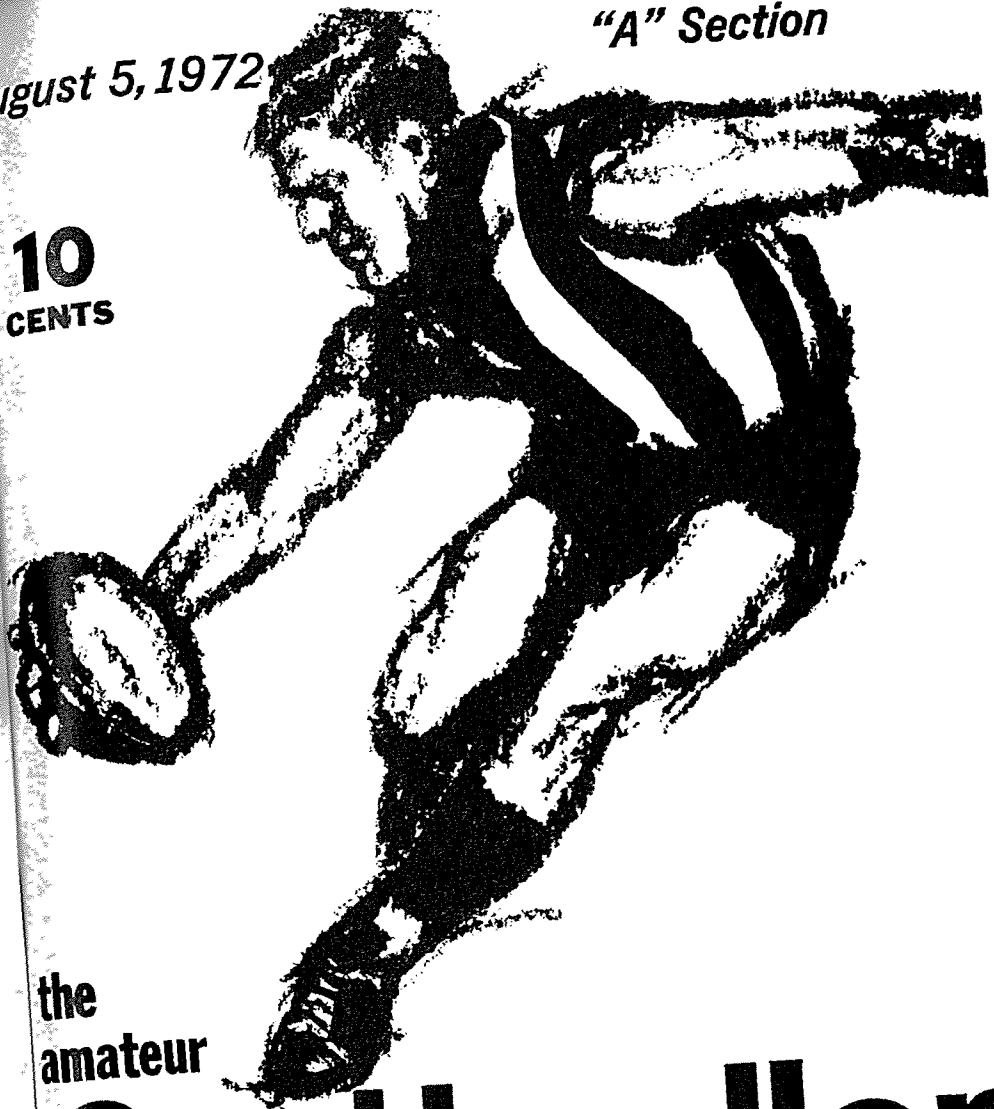

TOP FOUR WIN AND HOLD PLACES HARD NOW FOR ST. BERNARD'S, BLUES Many Teams Have Last Chance Today

The top four teams all won their matches last Saturday and helped to consolidate their places in the final four. St. Bernard's and University Blues, the only others with any real chance of taking part in the finals, will now have to hope for some upsets, as they are both two games outside the four.

In other sections, many teams still have hopes (and chances) of making the finals, but today's round will certainly spell "curtains" for some of them. Three leading teams were beaten last week — Old Brighton, Ormond Reserves and Monash Whites Reserves. It was Monash's first defeat of the season.

Caulfield Grammarians played only spasmodically in defeating St. Bernard's by 17 points, and but for poor kicking in the first half, which left them trailing by 22 points at the interval, St. Bernard's might have won it. led by 39 points at the last change, but the Blues staged a fighting recovery in the final term and went down by only 11 points.

De La Salle shocked Monash Blues with a second half recovery which converted a 4-goal deficit into a 10-point win. "De La" kicked 5 goals straight to 1-3 in the third term and were only 3 points down, then finished too strongly for Monash.

Ivanhoe lost their place in the four when they went down to Old Scotch by 39 points, in the match at Elsternwick Park. Old Trinity, with a big win over Tooronga-Malvern, have ousted them on percentage.

Kew's hopes of making the four vanished when they failed by nearly 7 goals against University Blacks, and Collegians, beaten at Geelong by 37 points, can also practically forget about the finals. They are three games outside the top bracket.

Old Carey scored easily at the expense of Uni High, but are out of the running.

The position is still wide open in C Section, where eight teams remain in the fight — although Fairfield and Old Haileybury have only a faint chance.

Caulfield went to a lead of 5 goals in the third quarter but St. Bernard's fought back well and cut their leeway to a goal. Then the leaders recovered and kicked a couple of goals to ease the pressure.

Caulfield shot away to lead by 5 goals again in the last term but the tenacious St. Bernard's fought the game right out.

Ormond, on top in the ruck and in attack, held control all day against North Old Boys and led by more than 13 goals at three-quarter-time. North surprised them by kicking 8 goals in the last quarter but Ormond coasted to an easy win.

Coburg scored a 5-goal win over Melbourne High in a poor game but were not impressive in doing so. Both sides made many mistakes, one of the worst features being the shockingly inaccurate kicking (12-26 to 8-20).

Old Paradians looked to have University Blues well covered when they

Reservoir thrashed Power House by more than 22 goals causing House to drop from second to third. Their place has been taken by Assumption, who finished 38 points ahead of Fairfield.

St. Kilda CBC doubled Old Haileybury's score and National Bank and Old Xaverians won easily from Old Melburnians and Commonwealth Bank respectively.

St. Pat's kept their chances alive when they scored a shock win over leaders, Old Brighton, the margin being 9 points, and Brunswick (second) went down to La Trobe Blacks by 15 points.

Parkside beat St. Kevin's by 16 points, Alphington also still in the running had 17 points to spare from Hampton Rovers, who dropped down into the relegation zone as a result of Old Geelong's 6-point win over Footscray ITOB in a high-scoring game (20-13 to 18-19).

Marcellin beat Old Ivanhoe by nearly 8 goals and State Savings Bank crushed Glenhuntly by over 13 goals. Old Ivanhoe's defeat cost them second place, Bank moving up to that position. ANZ Bank scraped home from AMP Society by 2 points (19-12 to 18-16) and AJAX easily beat West Brunswick, to keep within striking distance.

Old Camberwell overwhelmed Monash Whites to score by more than 16 goals and St. Bede's trounced Old Mentonians by almost 10 goals.

Monash now have only a slender chance of making the four, as do North Brunswick.

The top four in Junior Section 1 are still equal on points, with Old Scotch the only other contender for a place in the finals. Their hopes didn't improve when they suffered a 21-point defeat by St. Bernard's, and they are now two games out of the four.

The "hopefuls" in Section 2, Toorong-Malvern and Old Brighton, didn't improve their chances either, as the top four all gained the four points. Toorong-Malvern actually

lost ground, failing by 27 points against Caulfield. With Old Brighton, they are now eight points outside the four.

In the Reserves, North Old Boys handed out a 16-point defeat to Ormond, who hold top place now only on percentage. Power House crashed against Reservoir and Fairfield went down to Assumption by 5 points.

Parkside beat St. Kevin's by 4 goals and Alphington beat Hampton Rovers by a goal. Old Ivanhoe scored a big win over Marcellin, Monash Whites suffered their first defeat for the season when they went down to Old Camberwell by 17 points and Elsternwick beat La Trobe Reds by 39 points.

ELIGIBILITY OF PLAYERS FOR RESERVE AND JUNIOR SECTION FINALS

The attention of clubs is drawn to the restrictions which apply concerning players eligible to take part in Final matches in the Reserve and Junior Sections.

The Rule relating to eligibility of players in Reserve Section Finals now reads:—
A player who has been a member of a senior team of any club in nine or more matches during the home-and-home matches in any season shall not be eligible for inclusion in the reserve team of a club taking part in a final match in the same season unless both the senior and reserve teams are participating in a final match on the same day.

Provided that no player shall be eligible for inclusion in a reserve team taking part in a final match in any season unless such player has been a member of such reserve team in at least TWO home-and-home matches during the said season.

JUNIORS
A player who has been a member of a senior or reserve team in more than five matches during any season shall be ineligible for inclusion in a junior team taking part in a semi-final, final or grand-final match in the SAME SEASON UNLESS he has been a member of the junior team for more than five matches in the same season.
